The ornamental design for a fork or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fork or similar article showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view on an enlarged scale taken from line 4—4 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is an enlarged section taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is an enlarged section taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1.

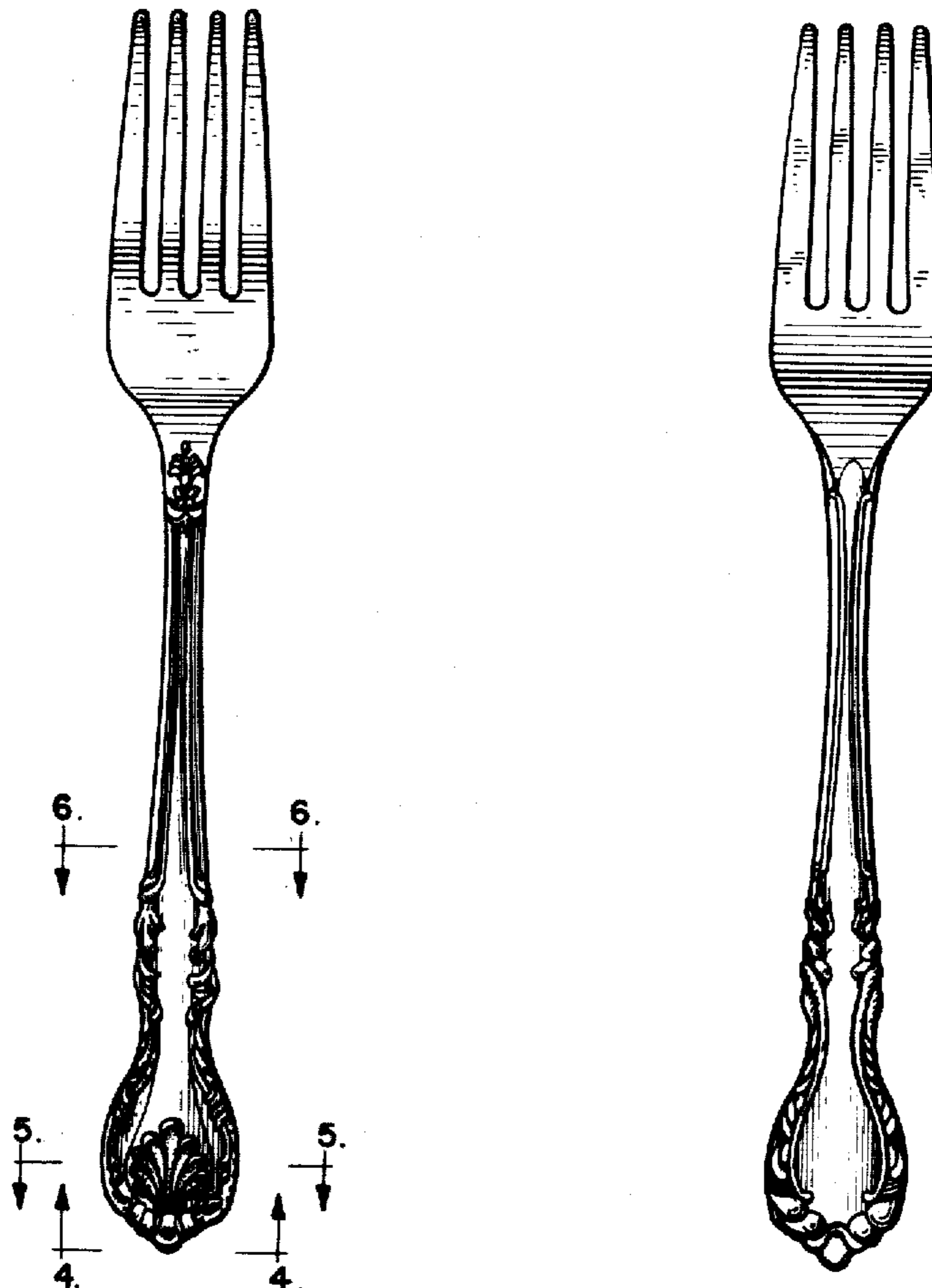

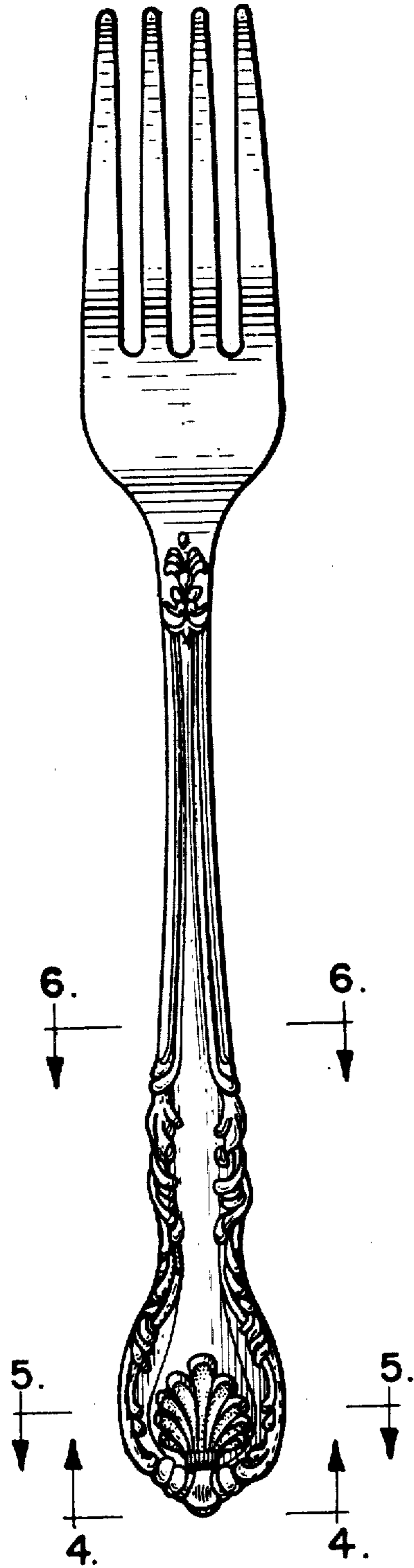

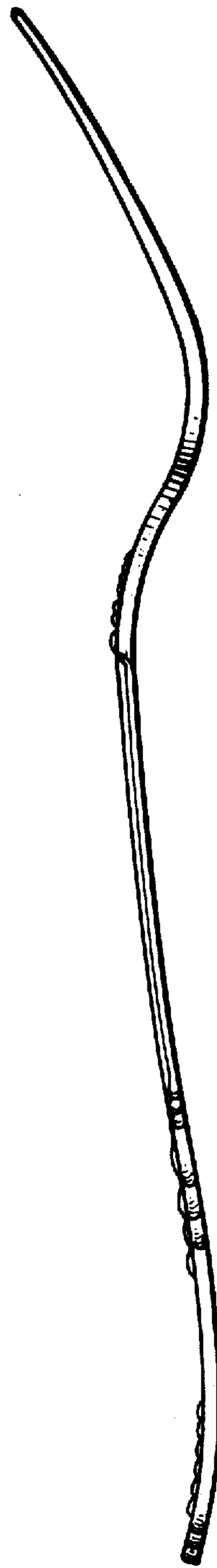

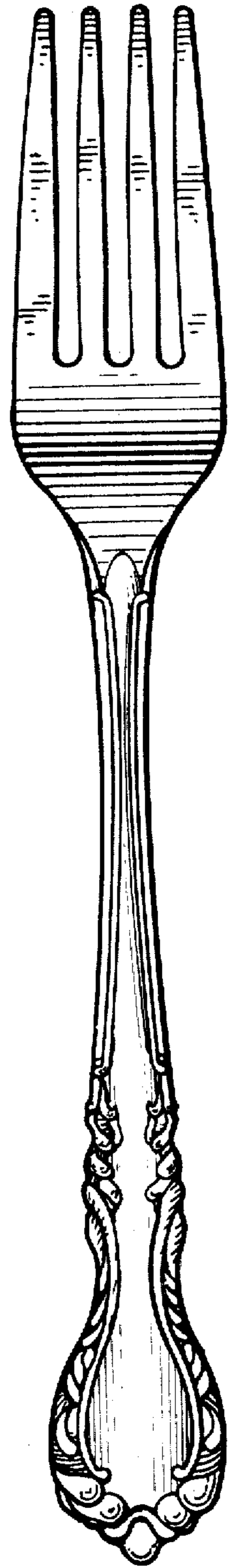
