FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stackable box, showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the other side being the same.

FIG. 3 is an end view, the other end being the same.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view.

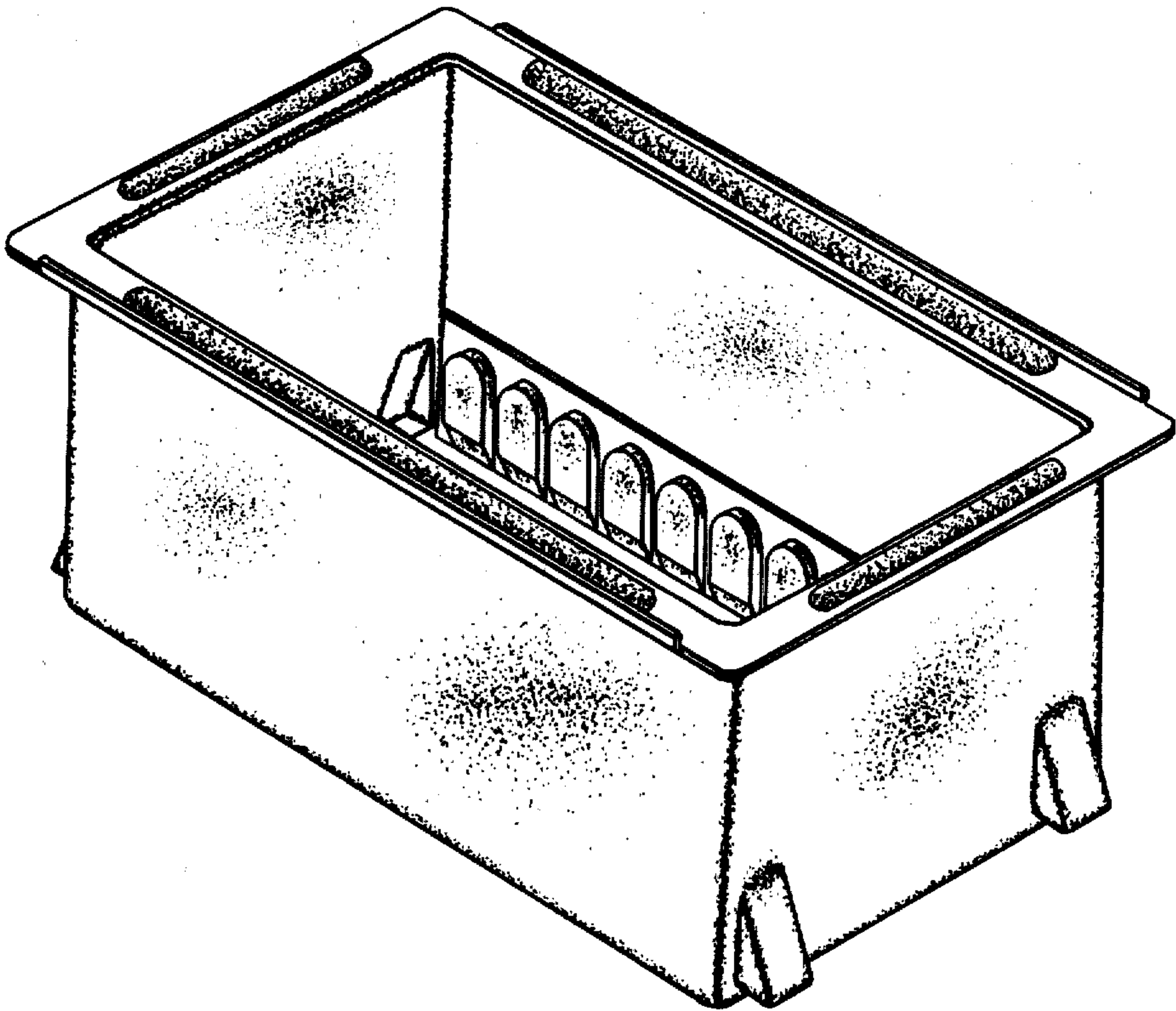
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 9—9 of FIG. 6.



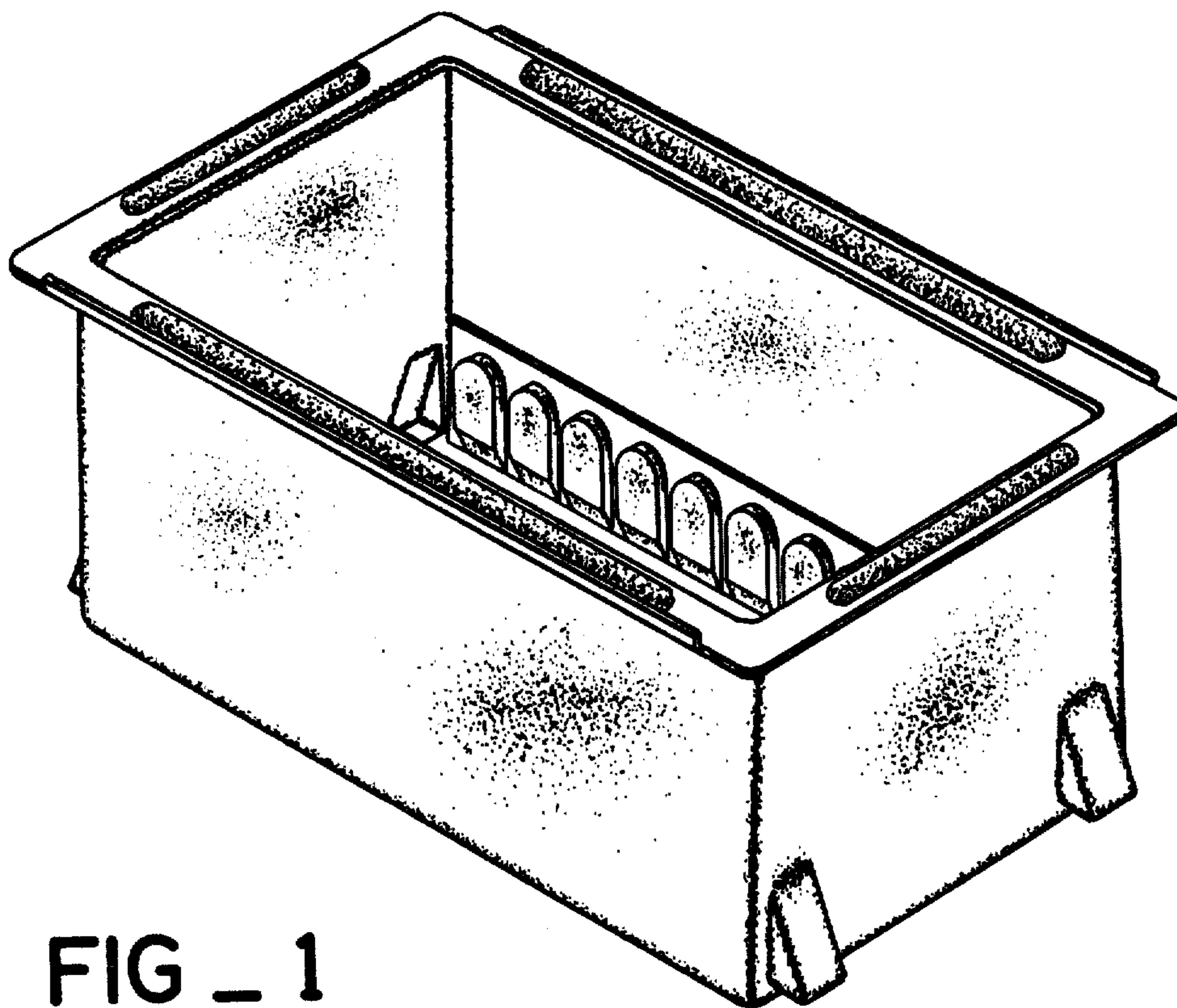

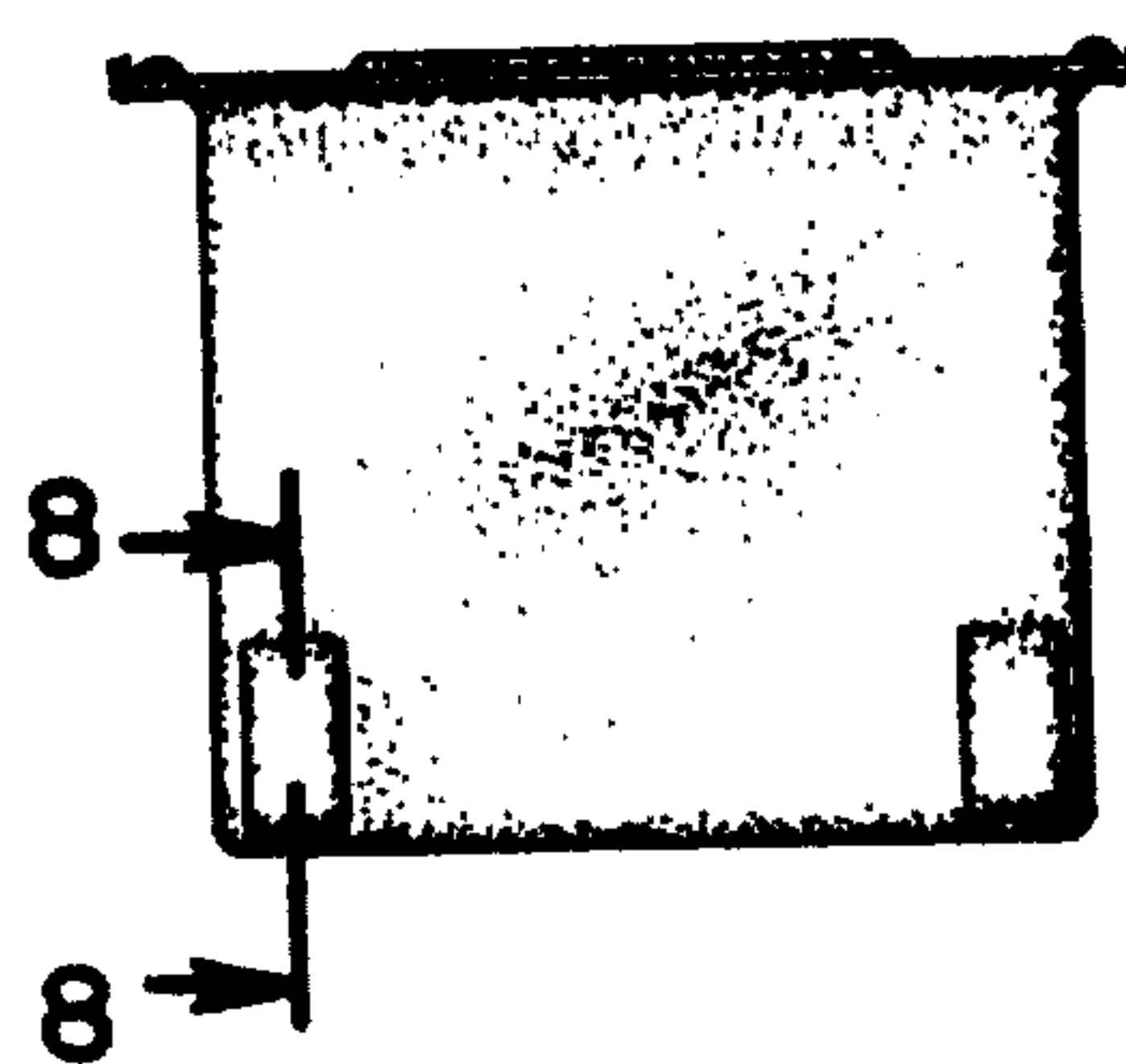

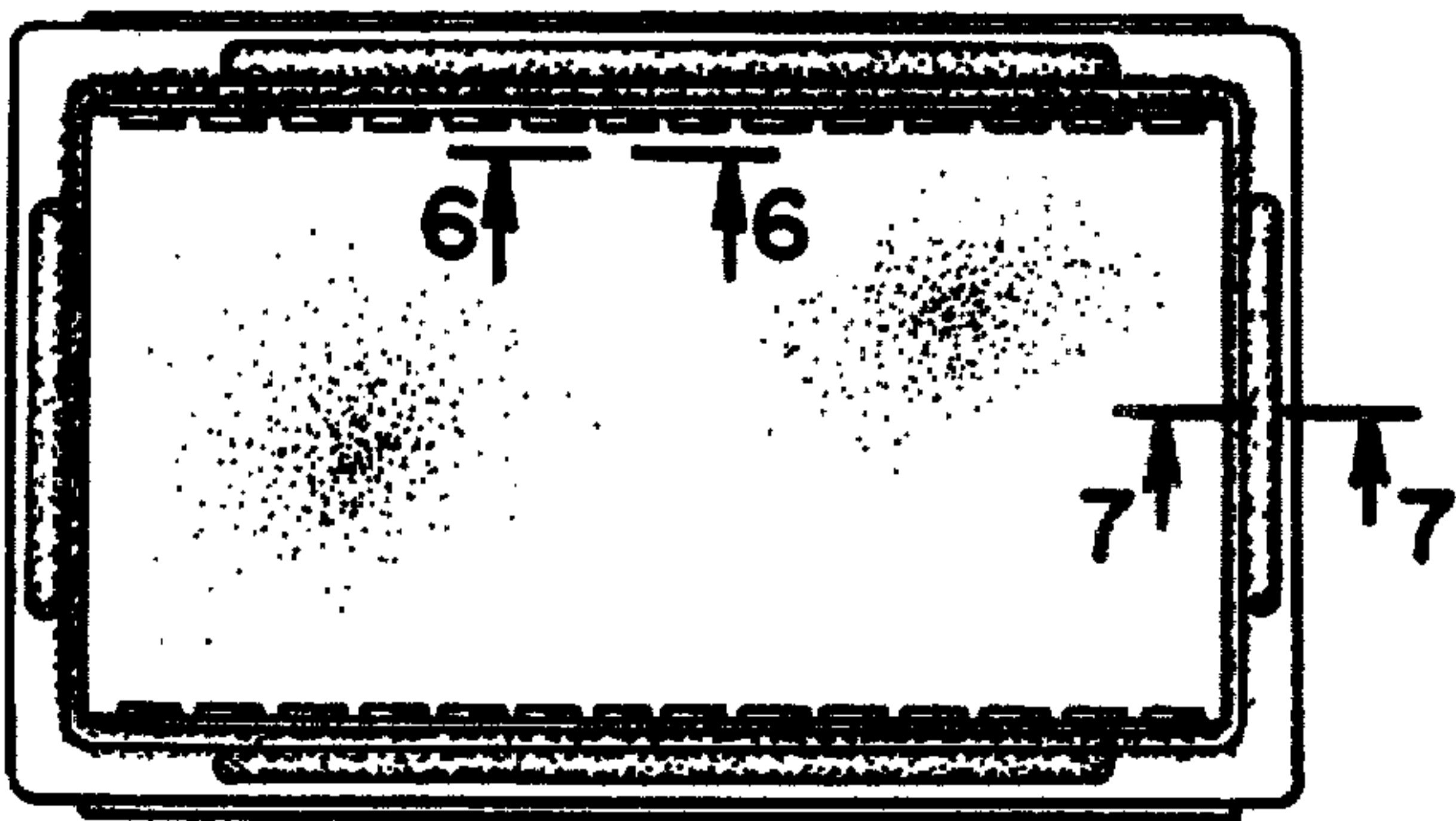

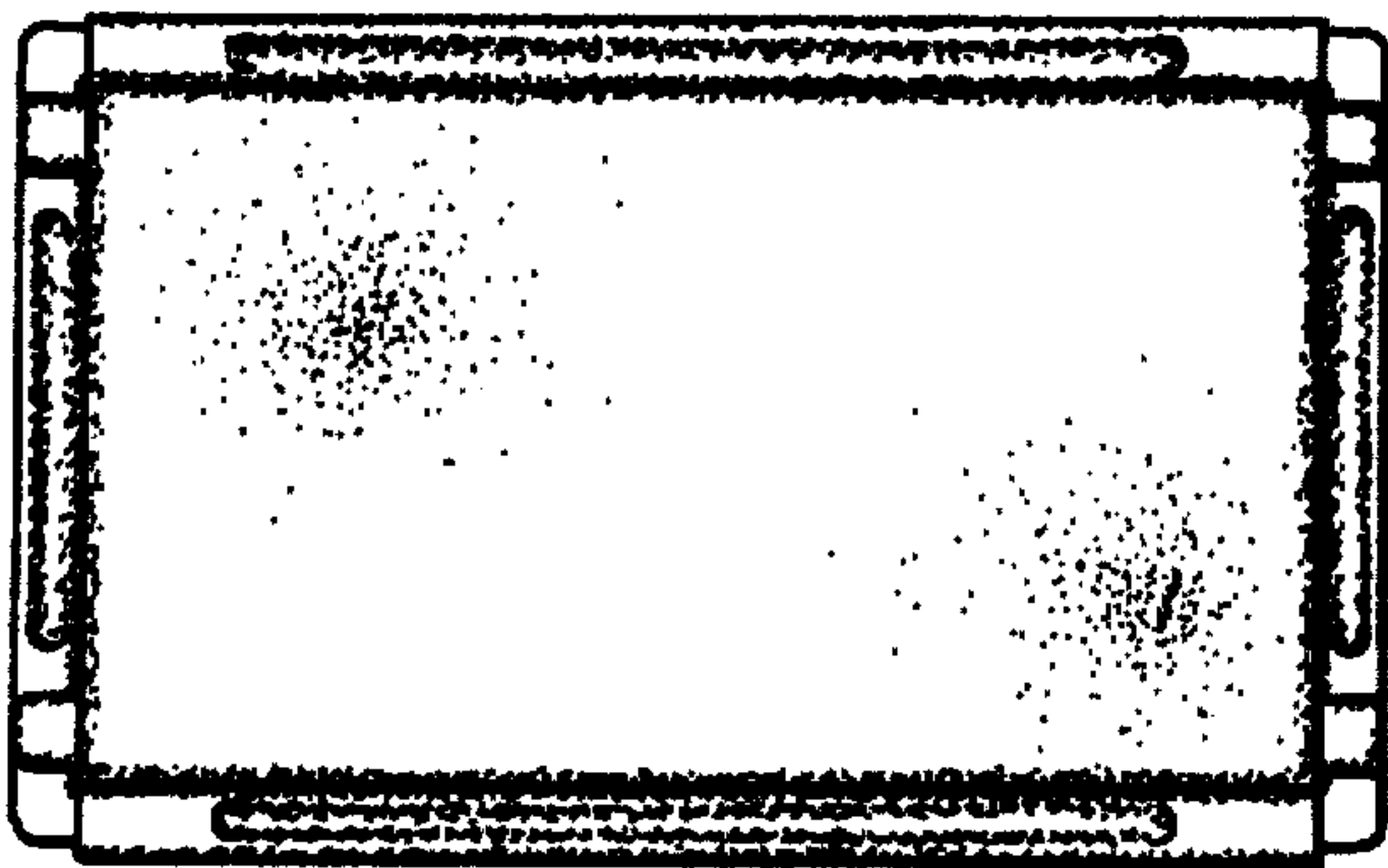

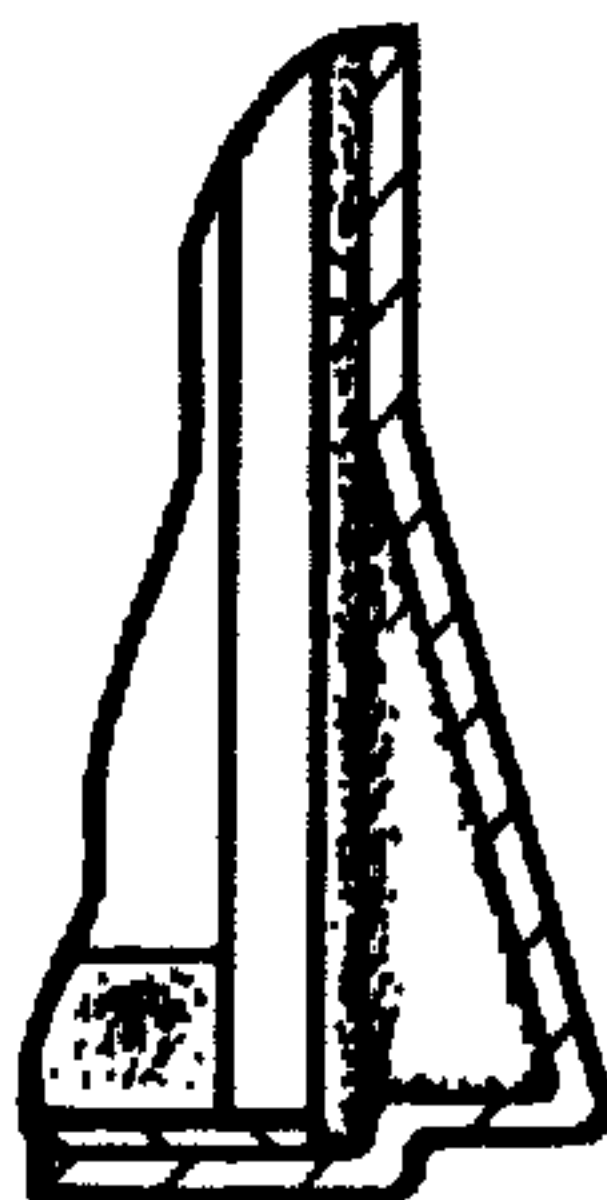

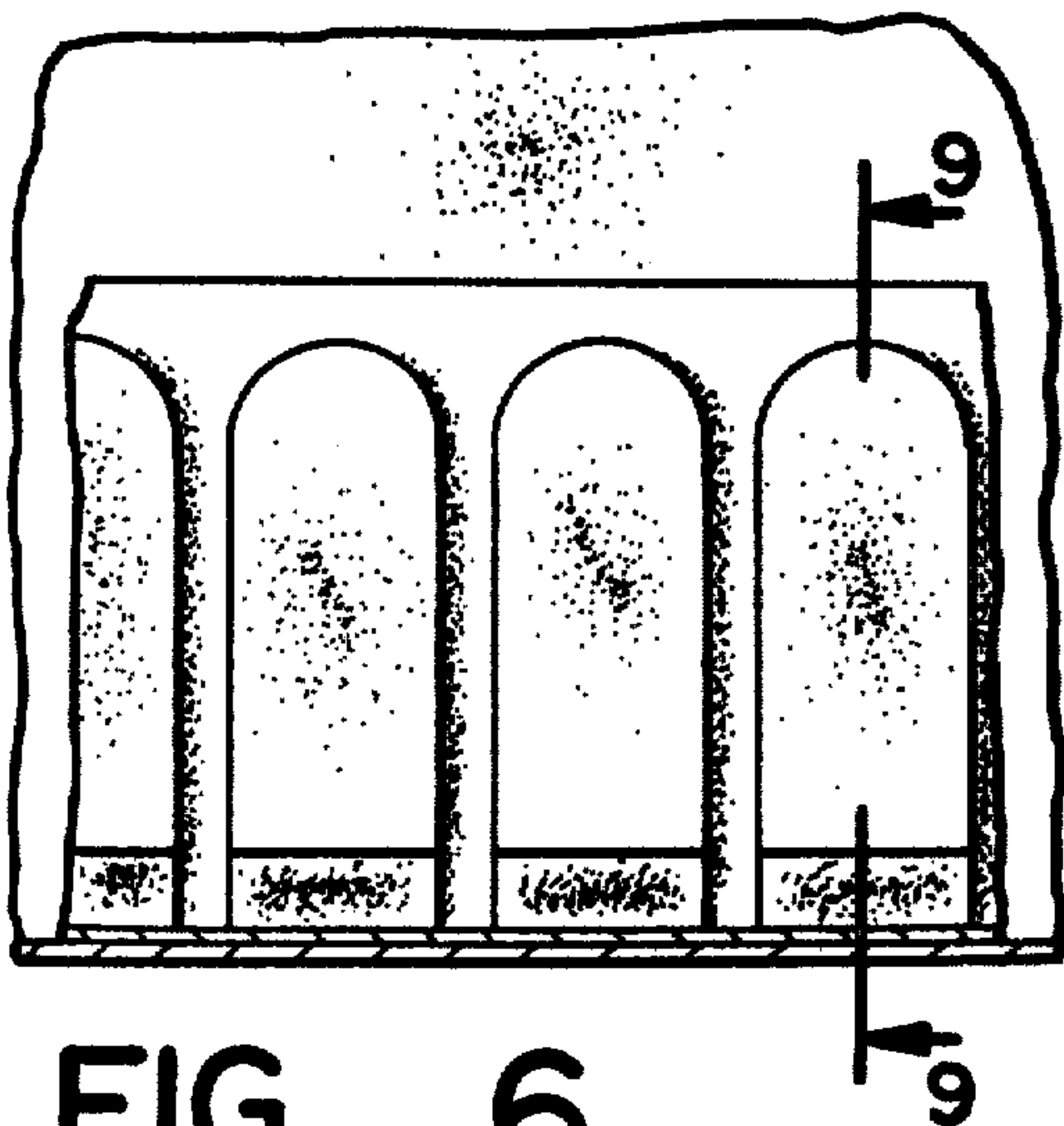

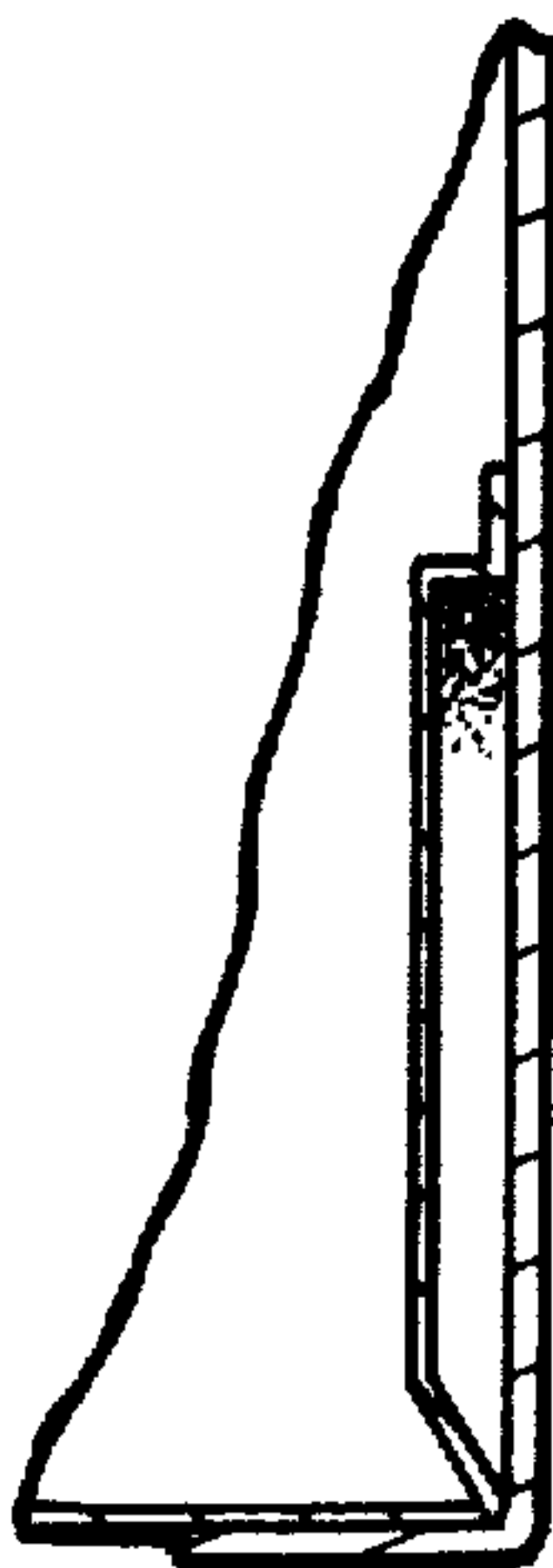
