FIG. 5 is a rear view.

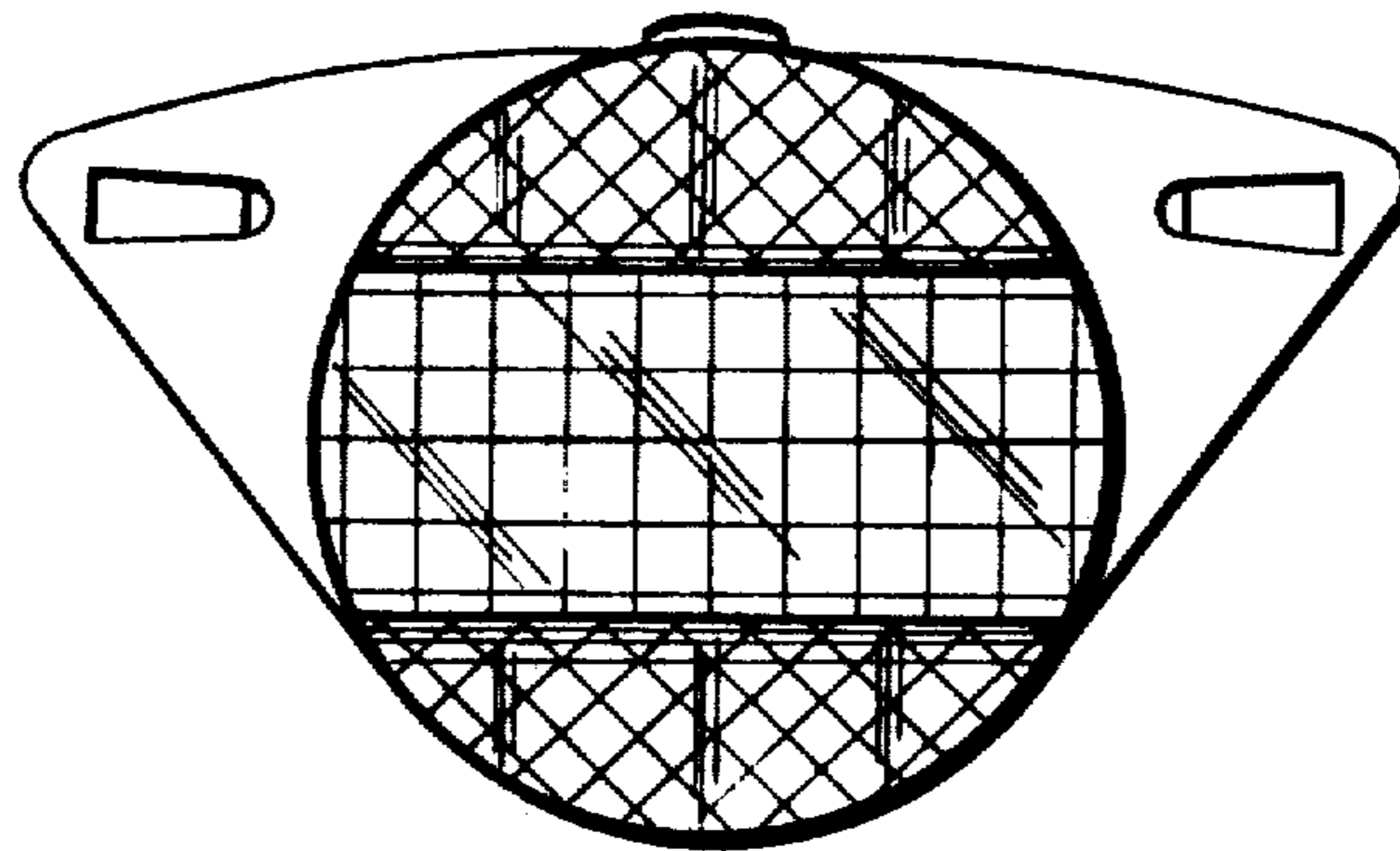

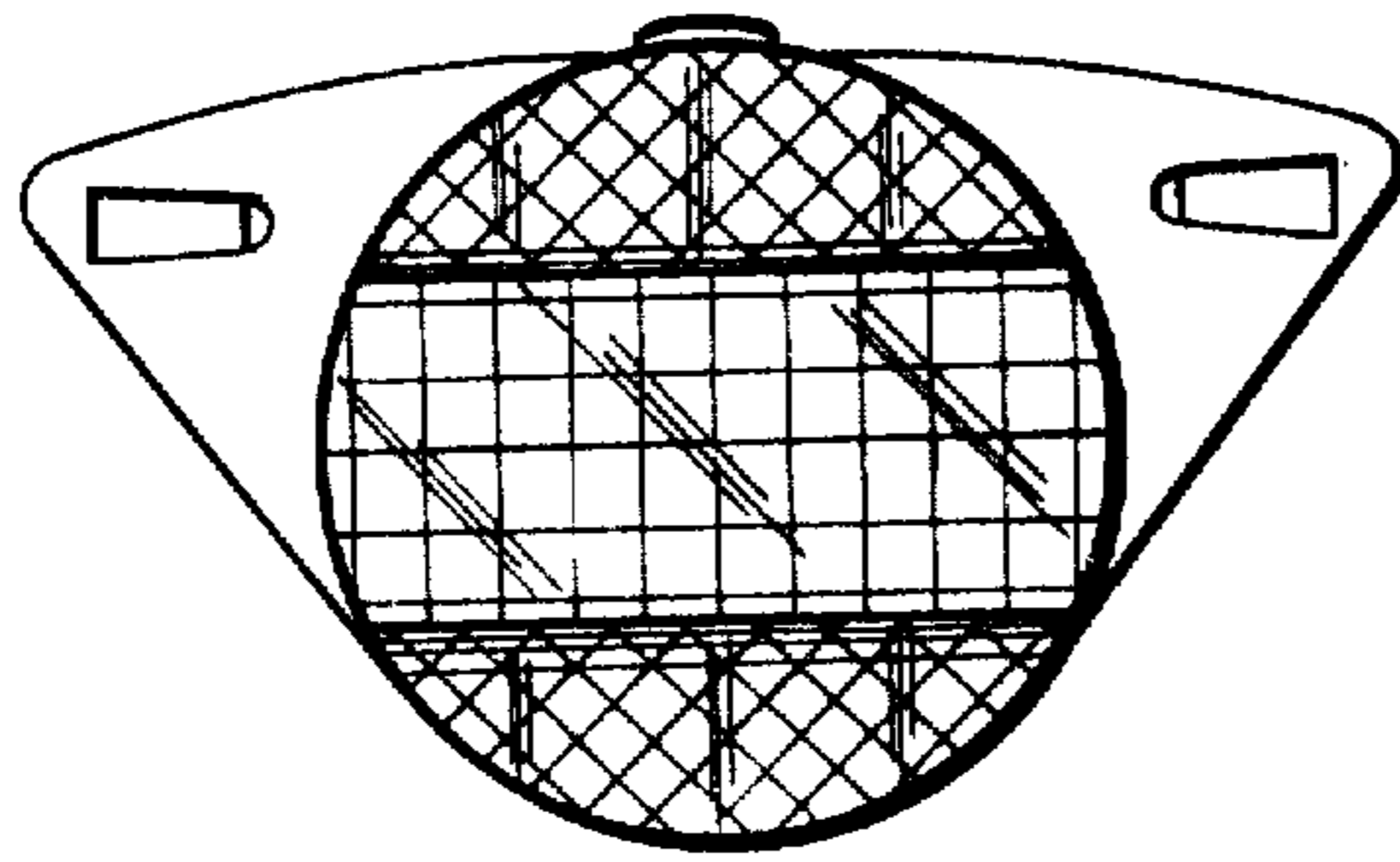

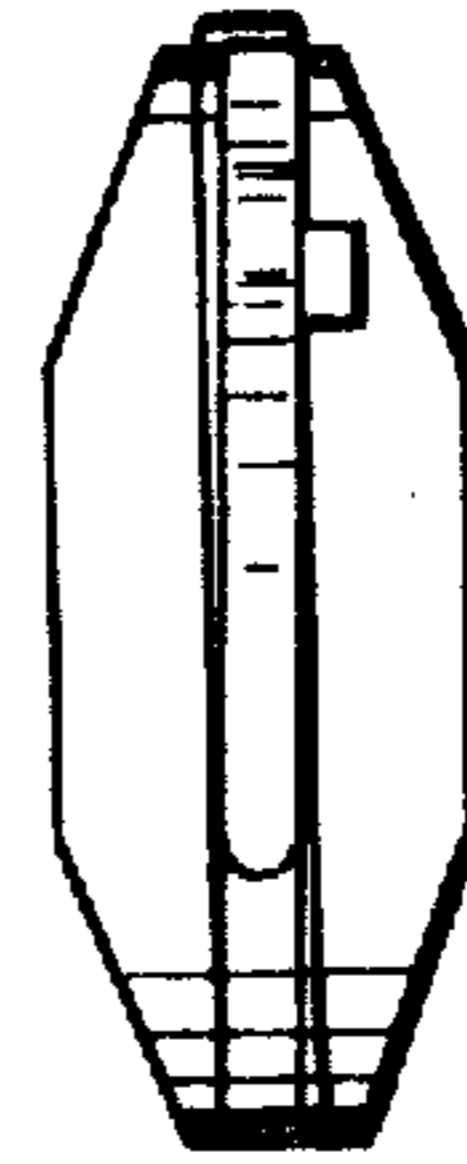

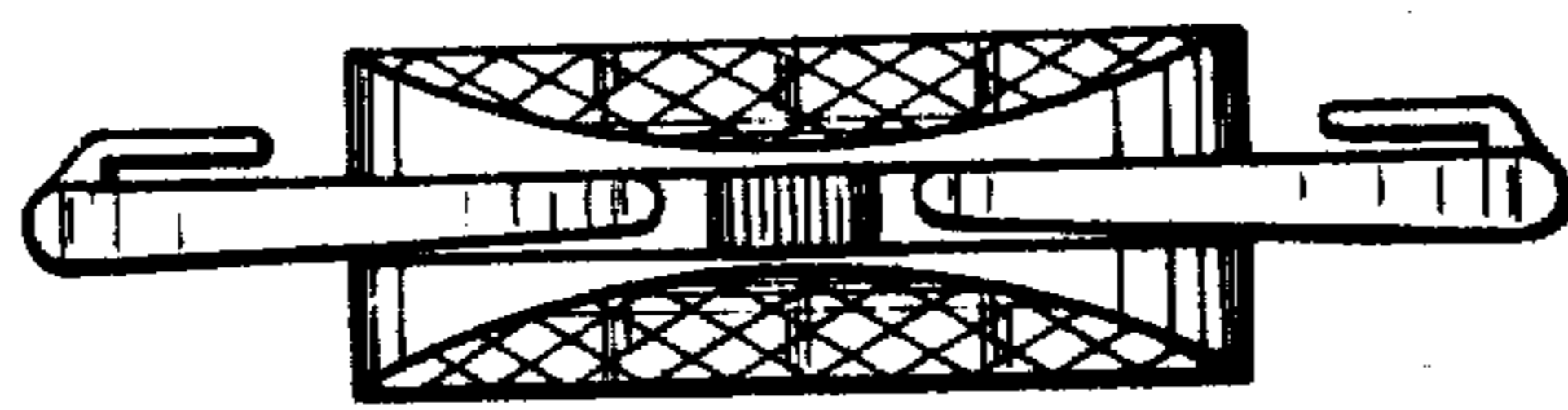

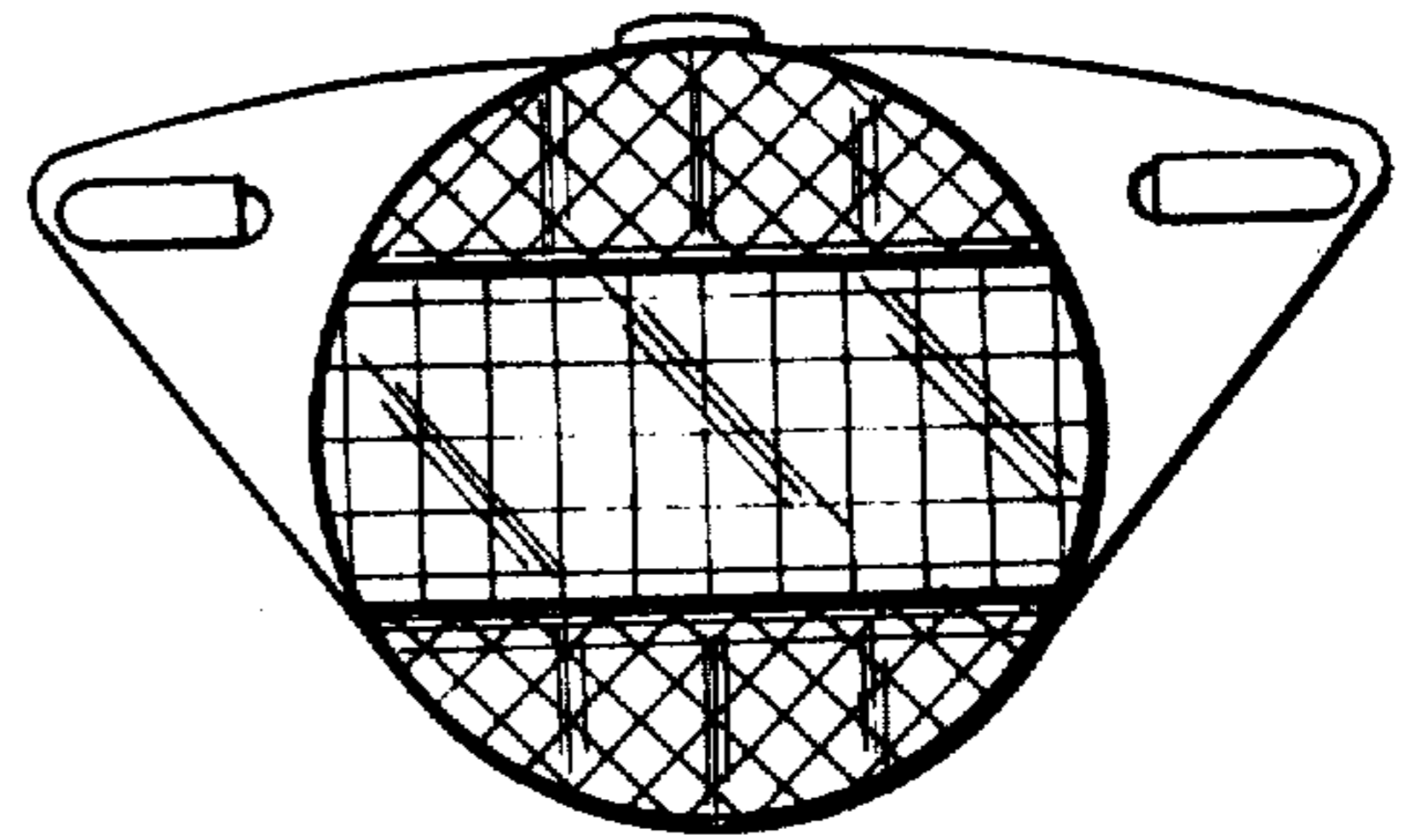
