[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sanitary countertop machine for storing and dispensing particulate ice, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking downward at the front, left side and top of a sanitary countertop machine for storing and dispensing particulate ice, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

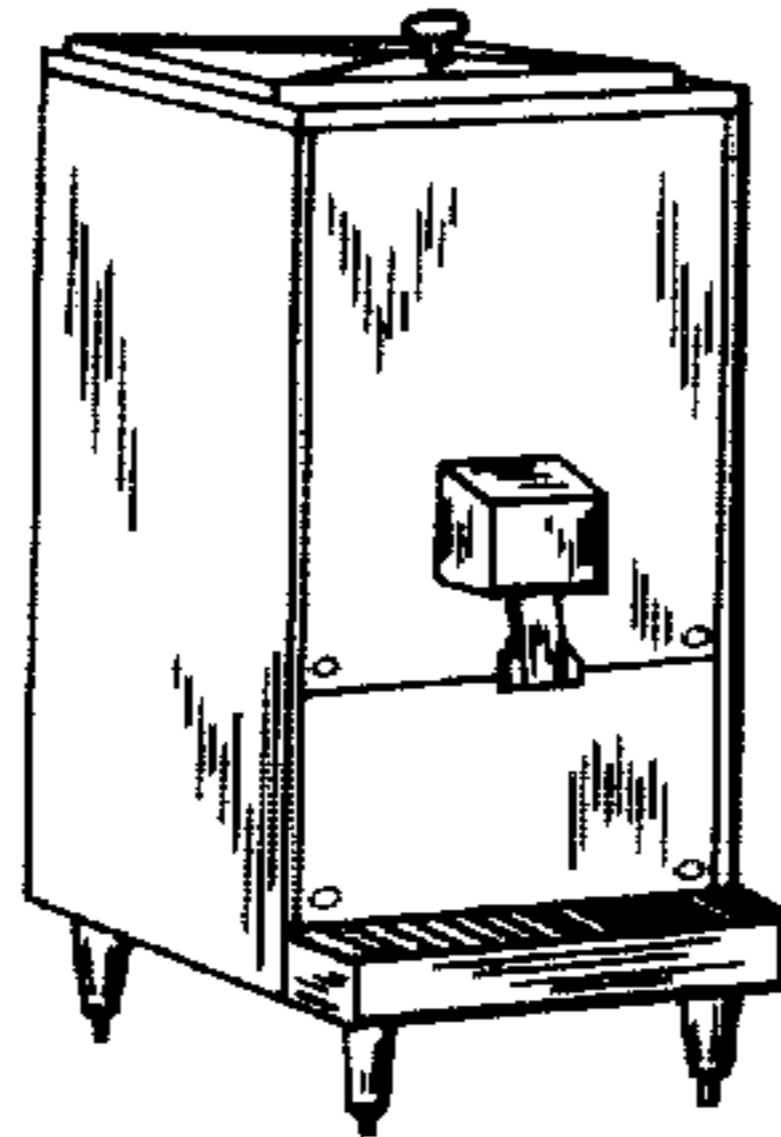
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the right side thereof;

The bottom is substantially planar and unornamented.



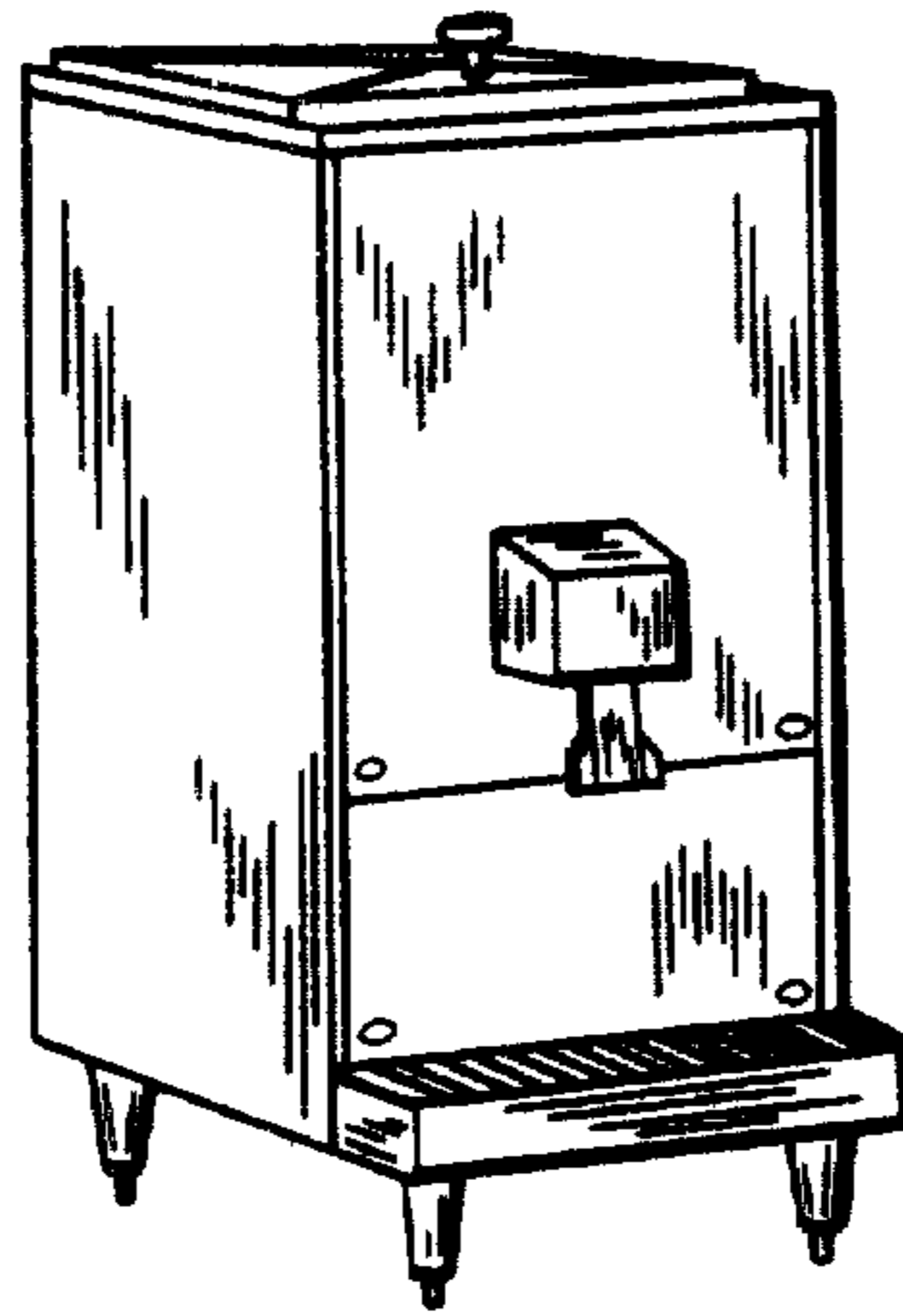

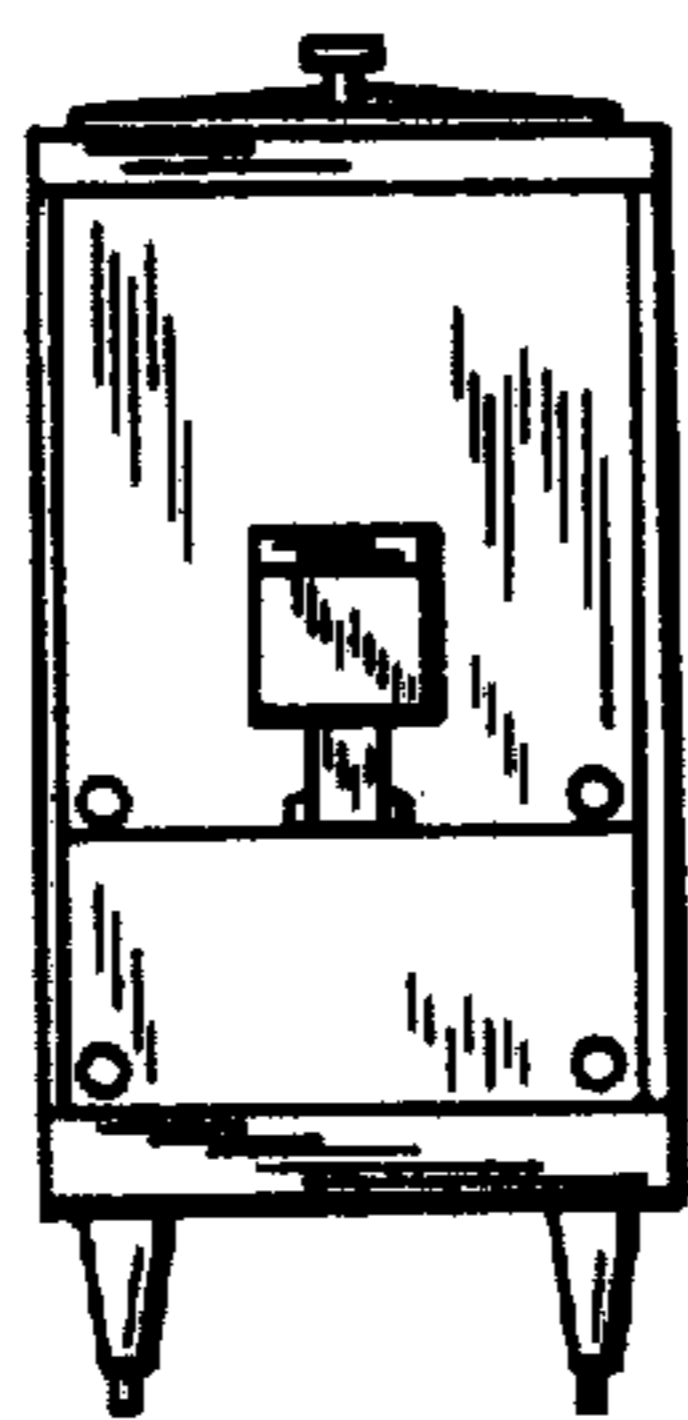

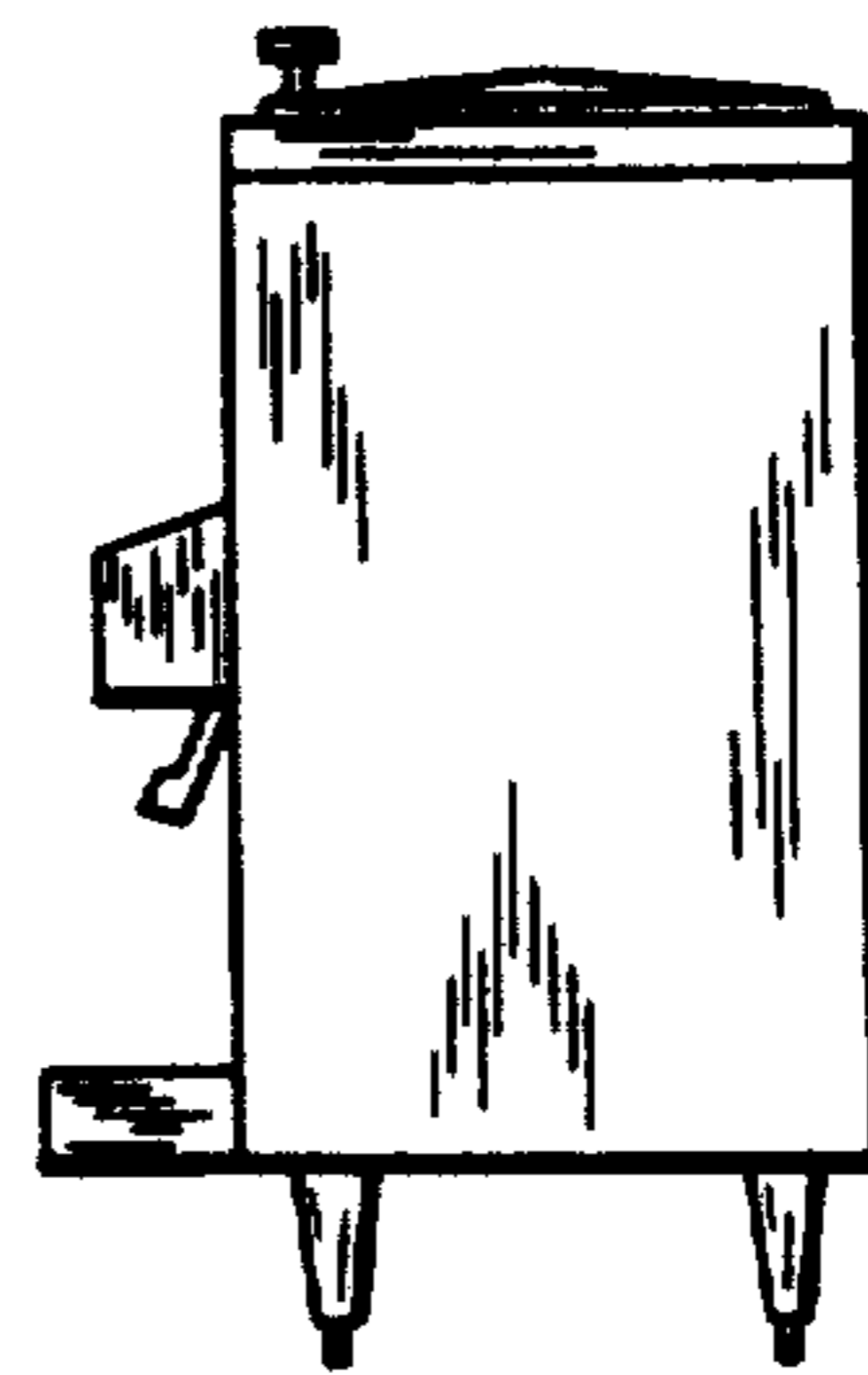

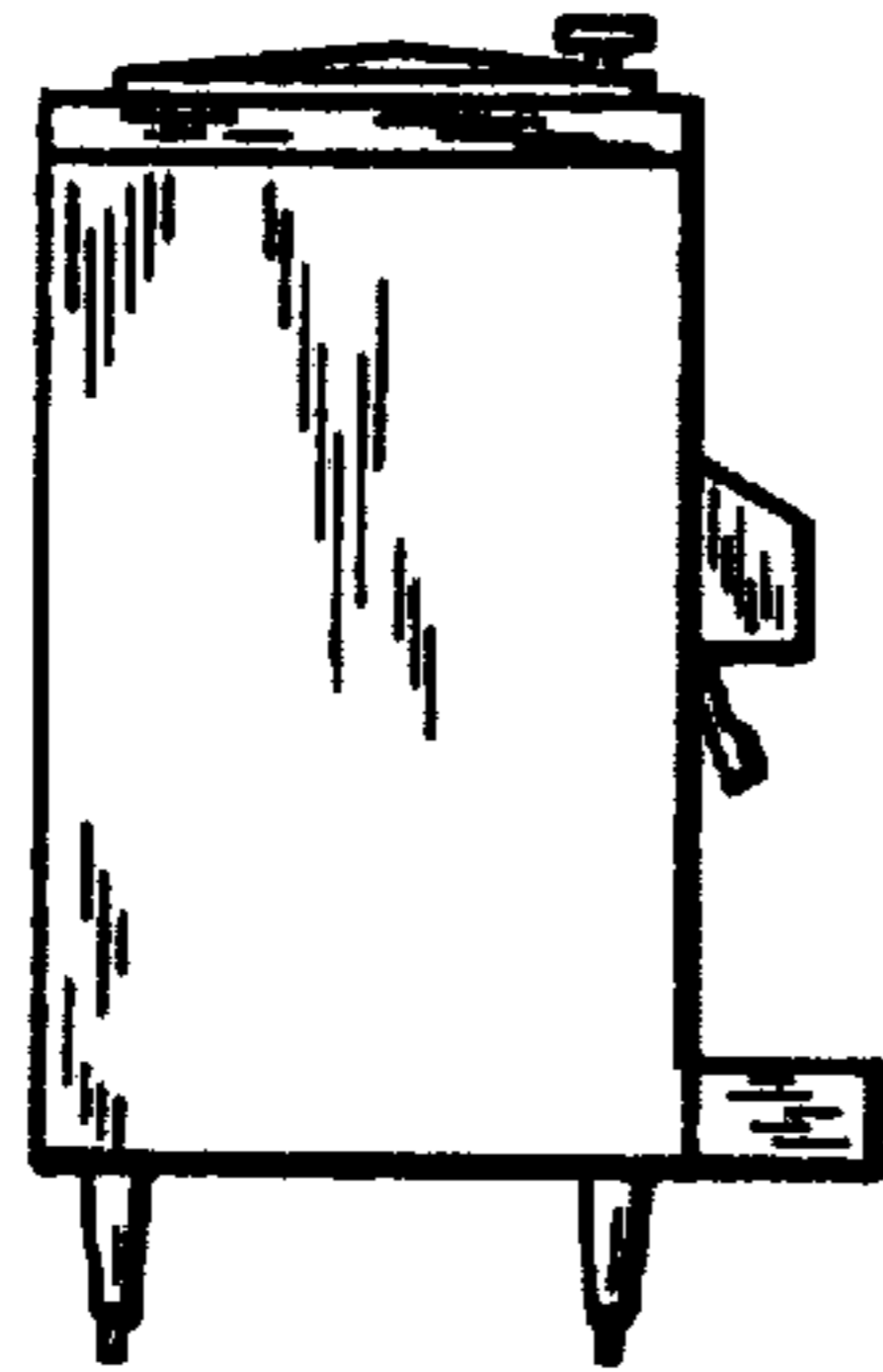

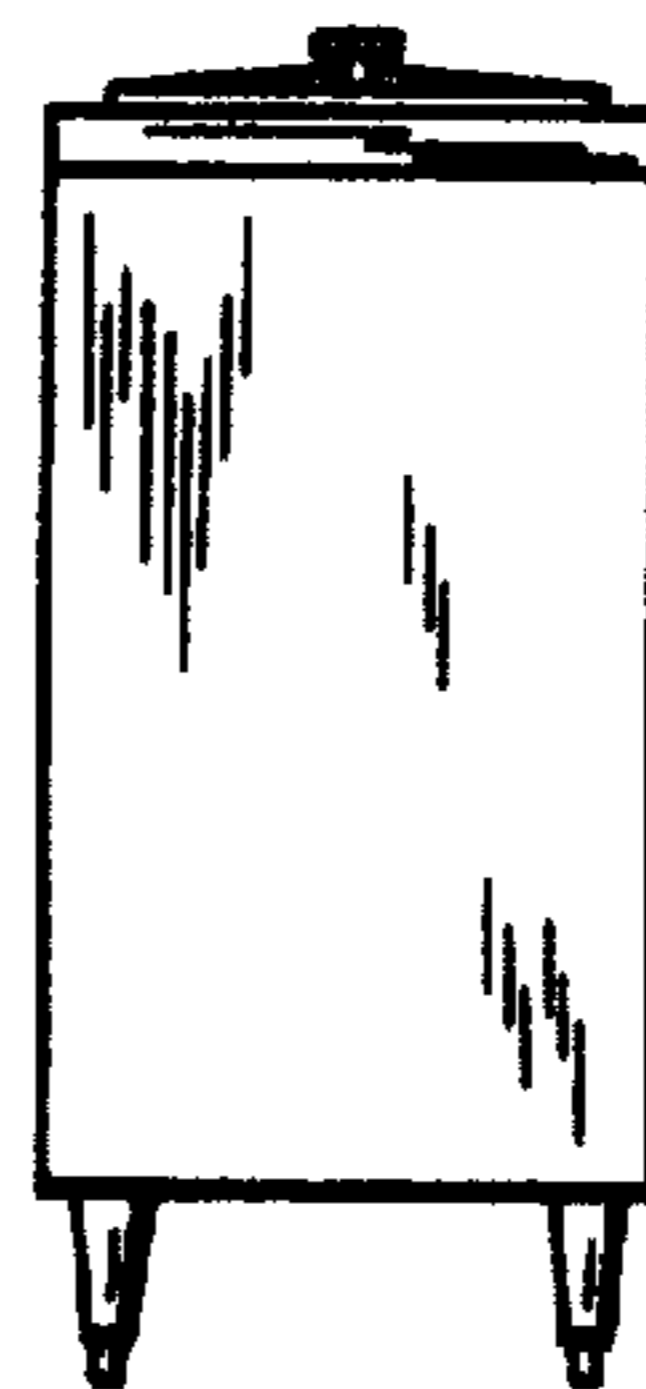

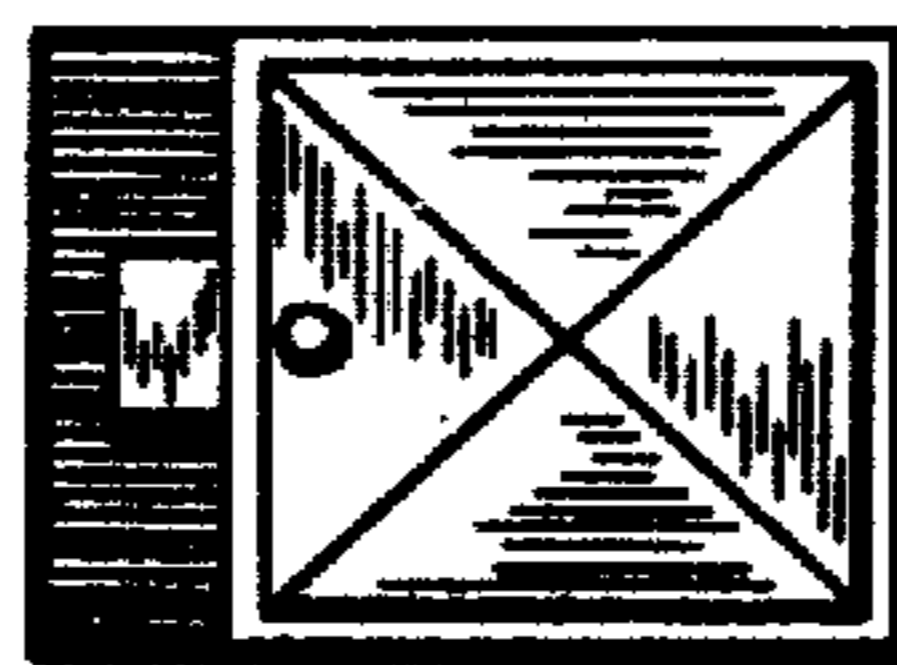
