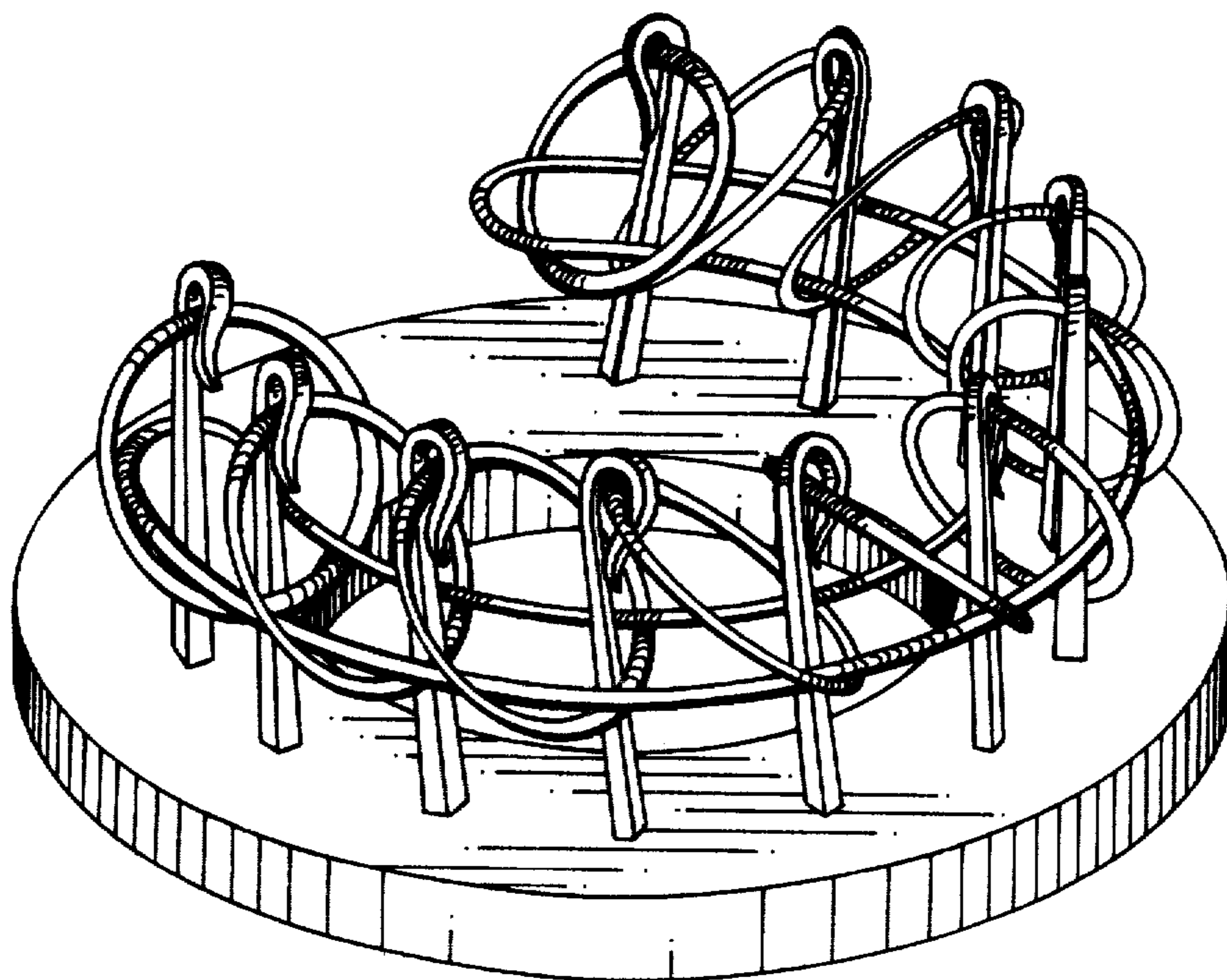

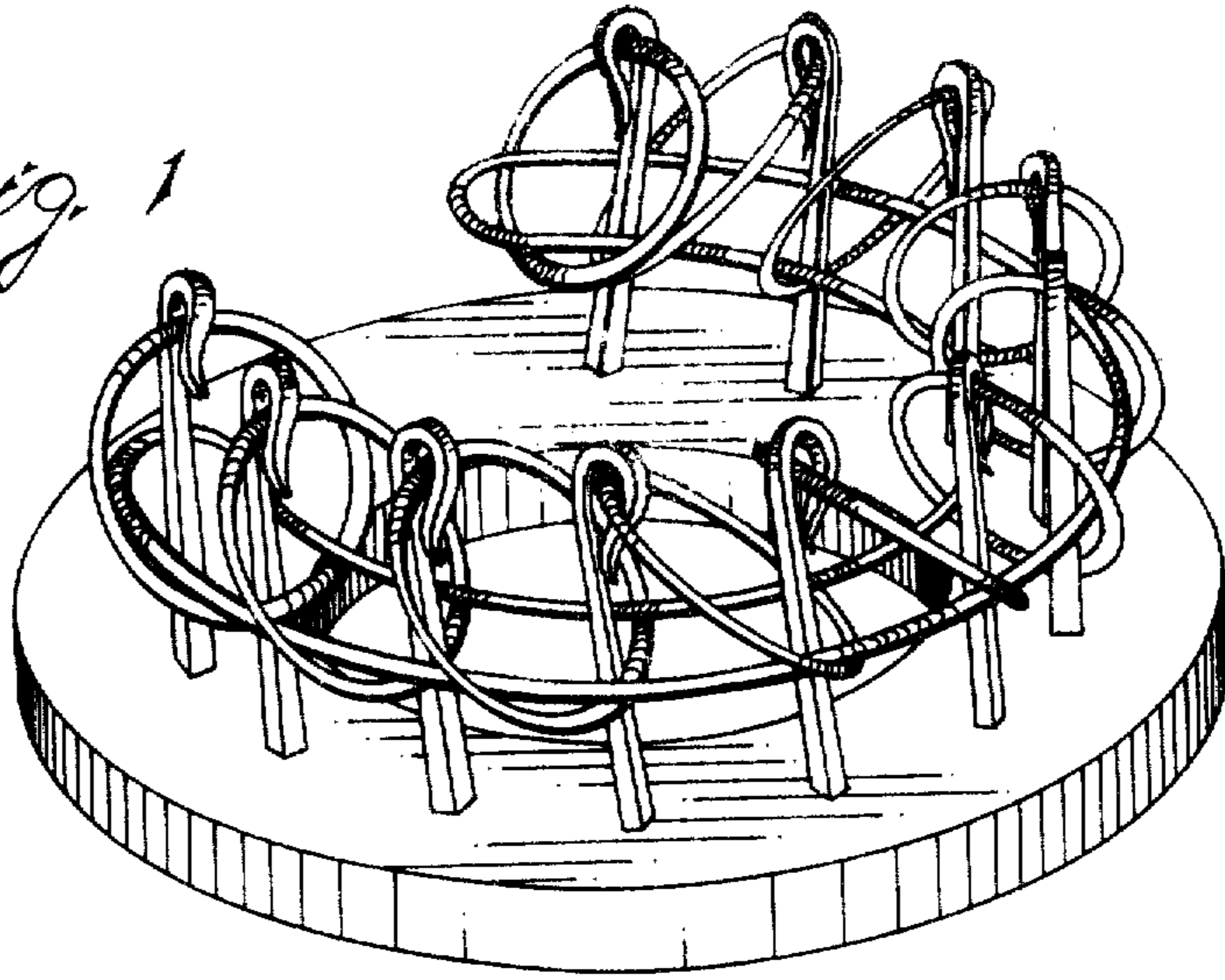
The ornamental design for a ring puzzle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

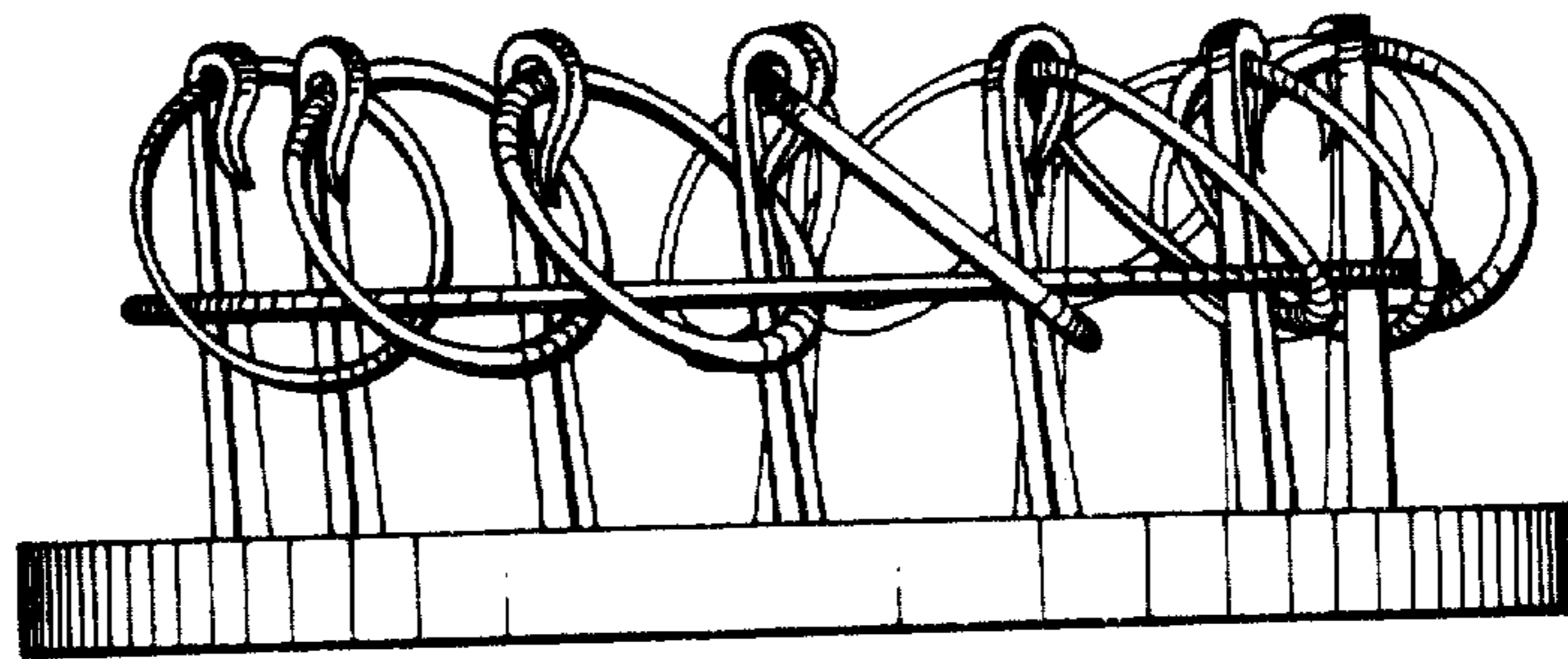
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ring puzzle illustrating my new design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.



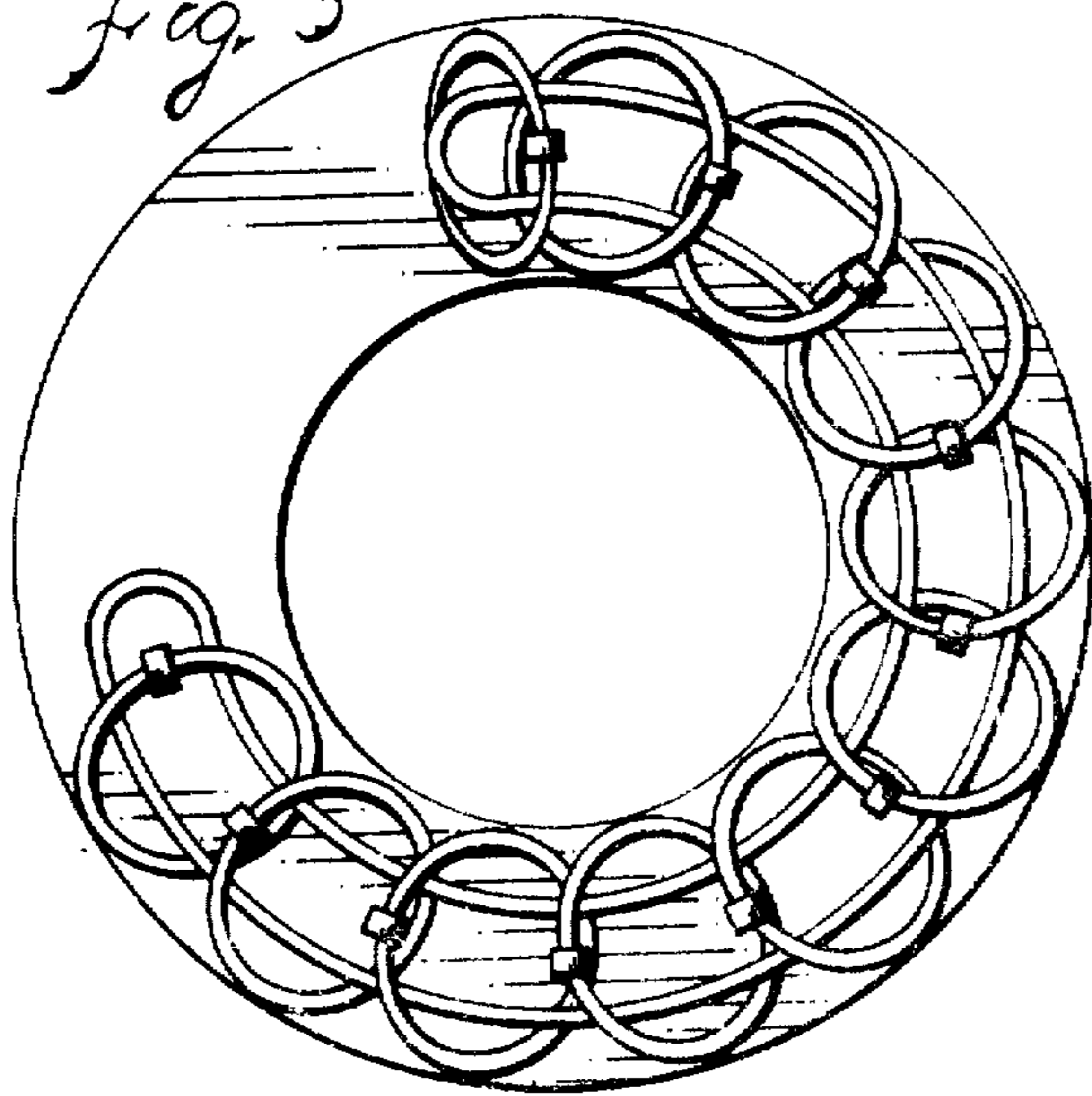
