FIG. 1 is a front perspective of the doll showing my new design,

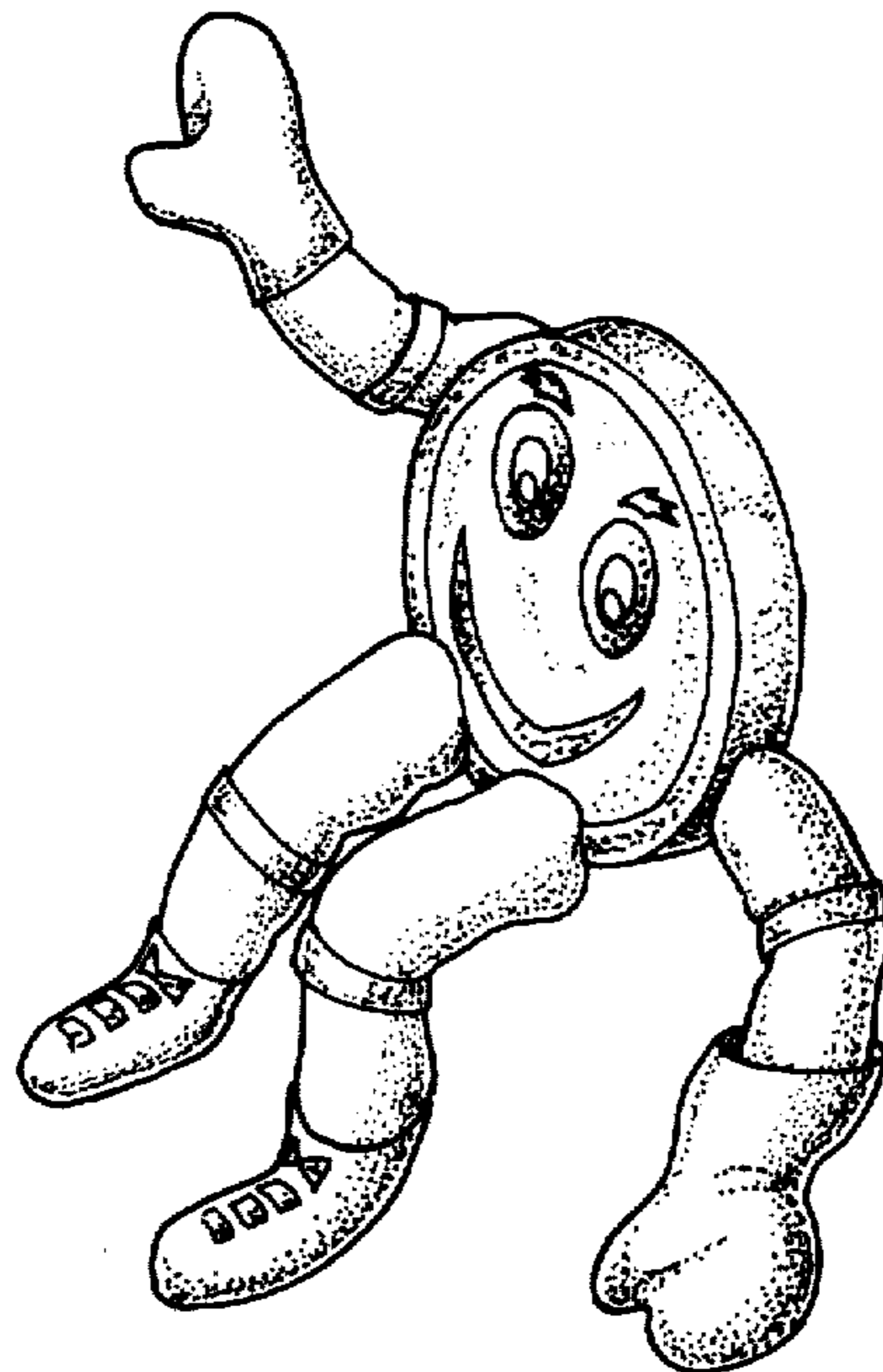
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective thereof,

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof.



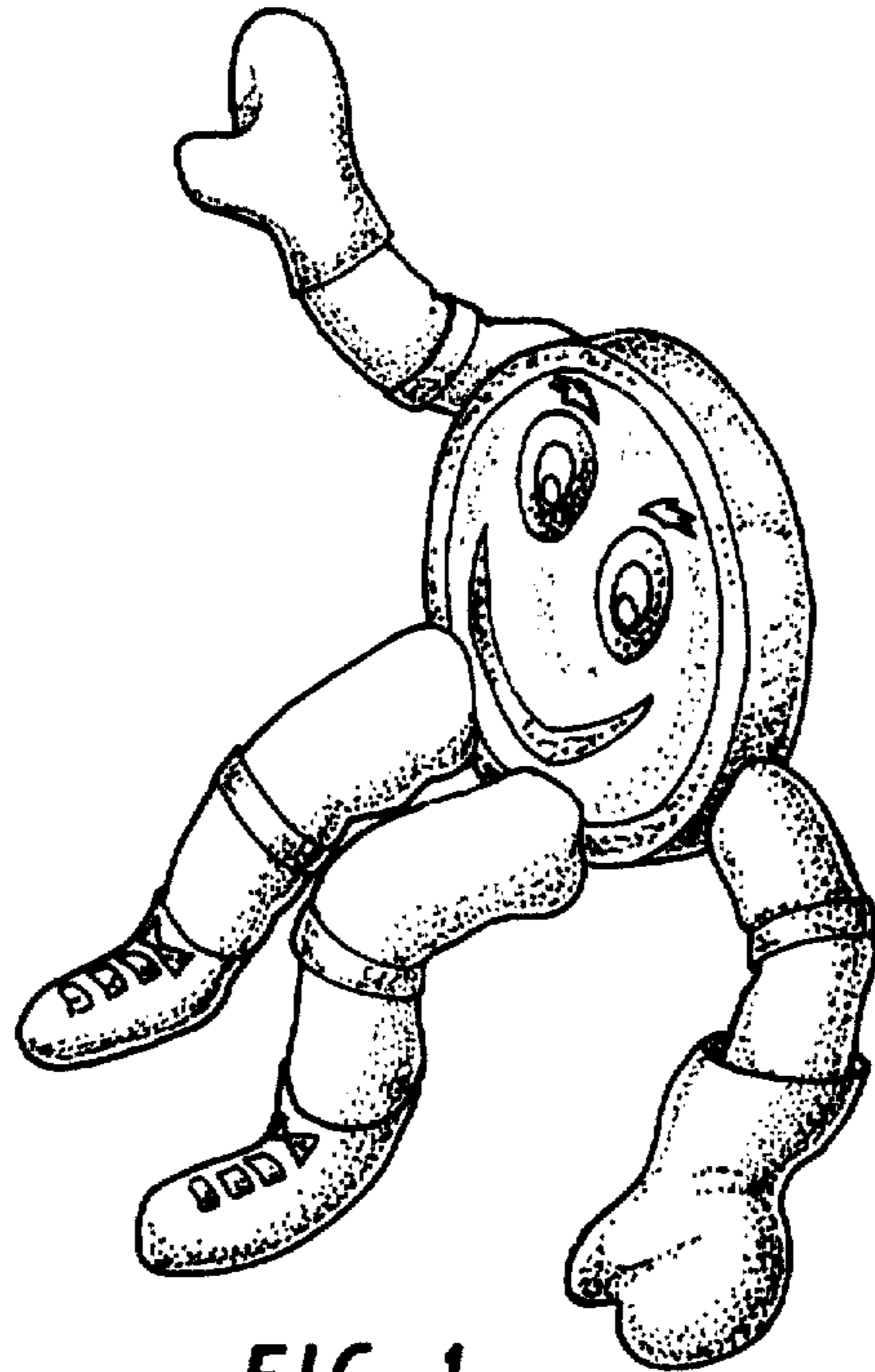

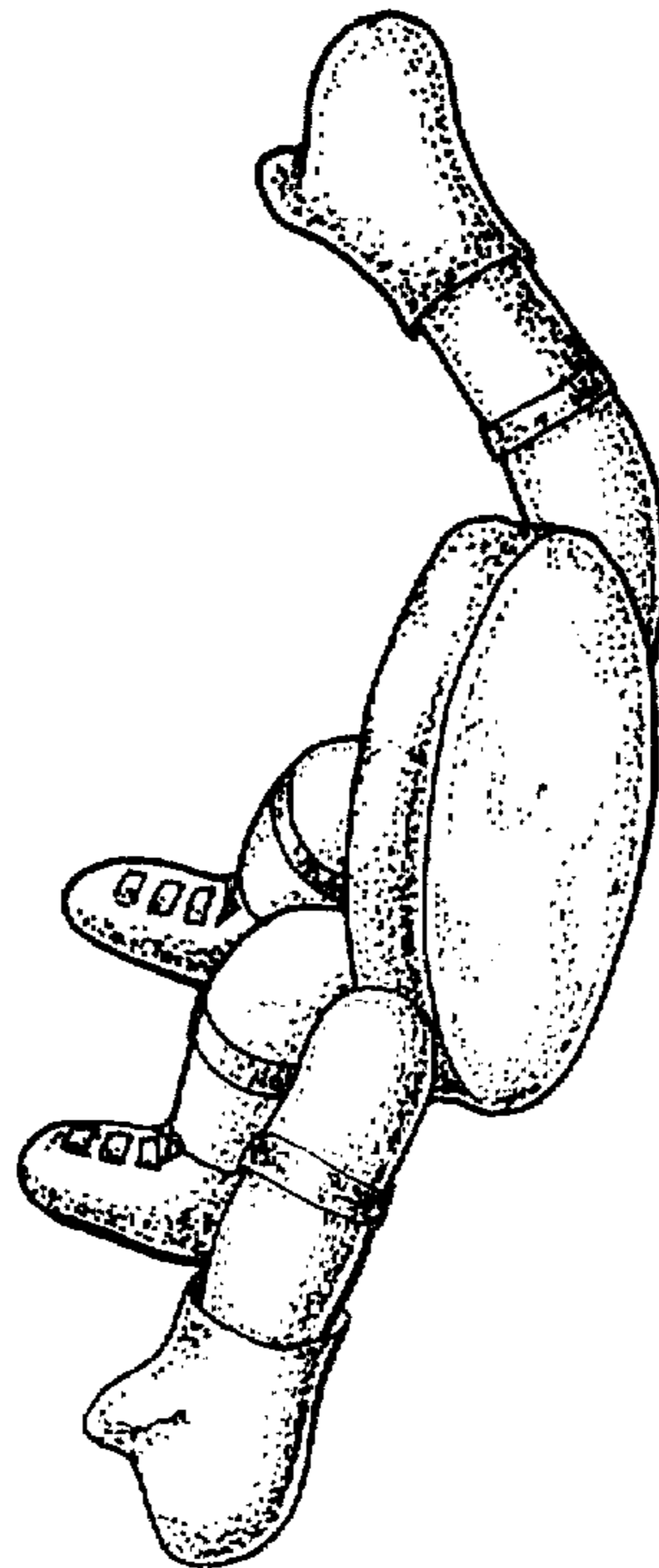

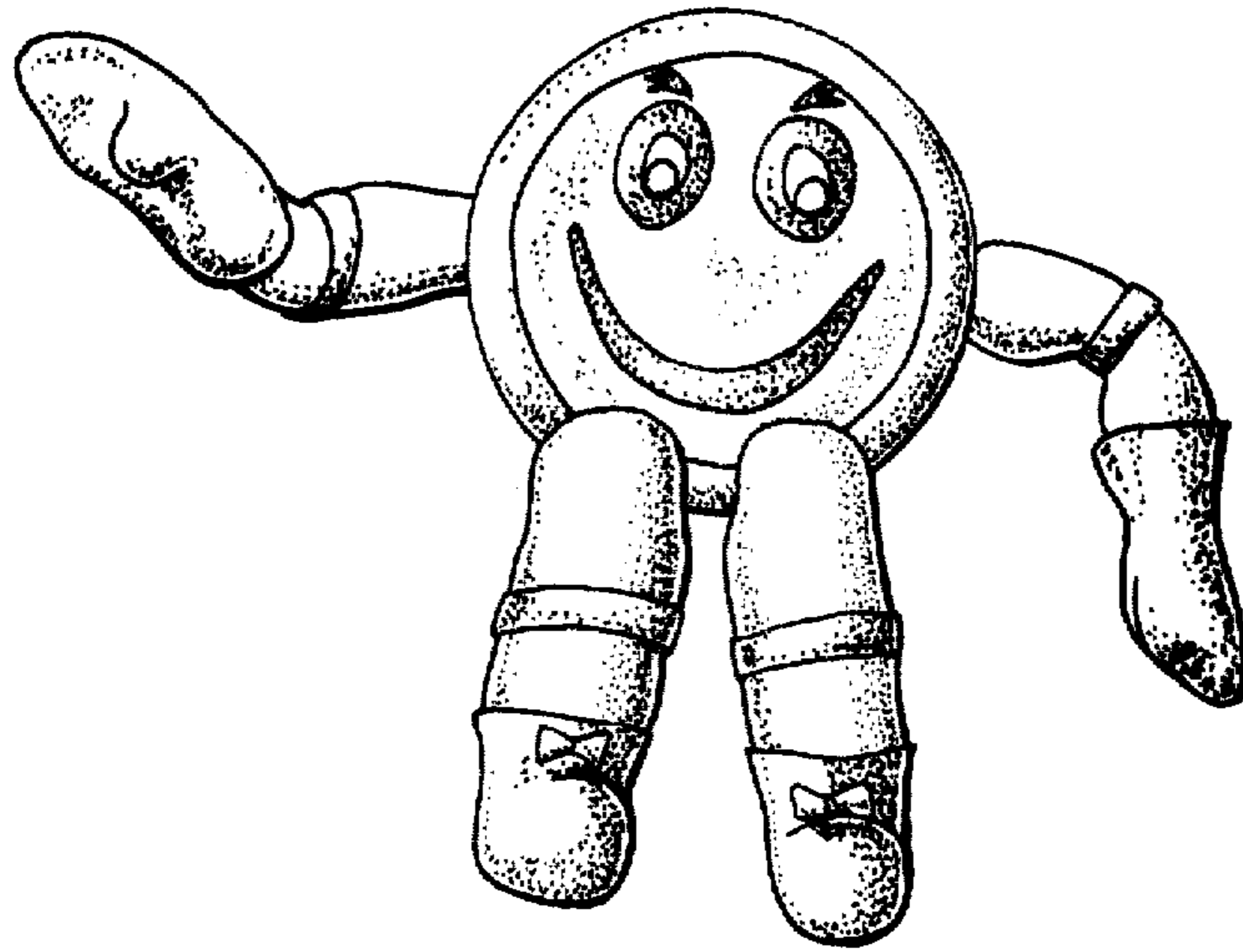

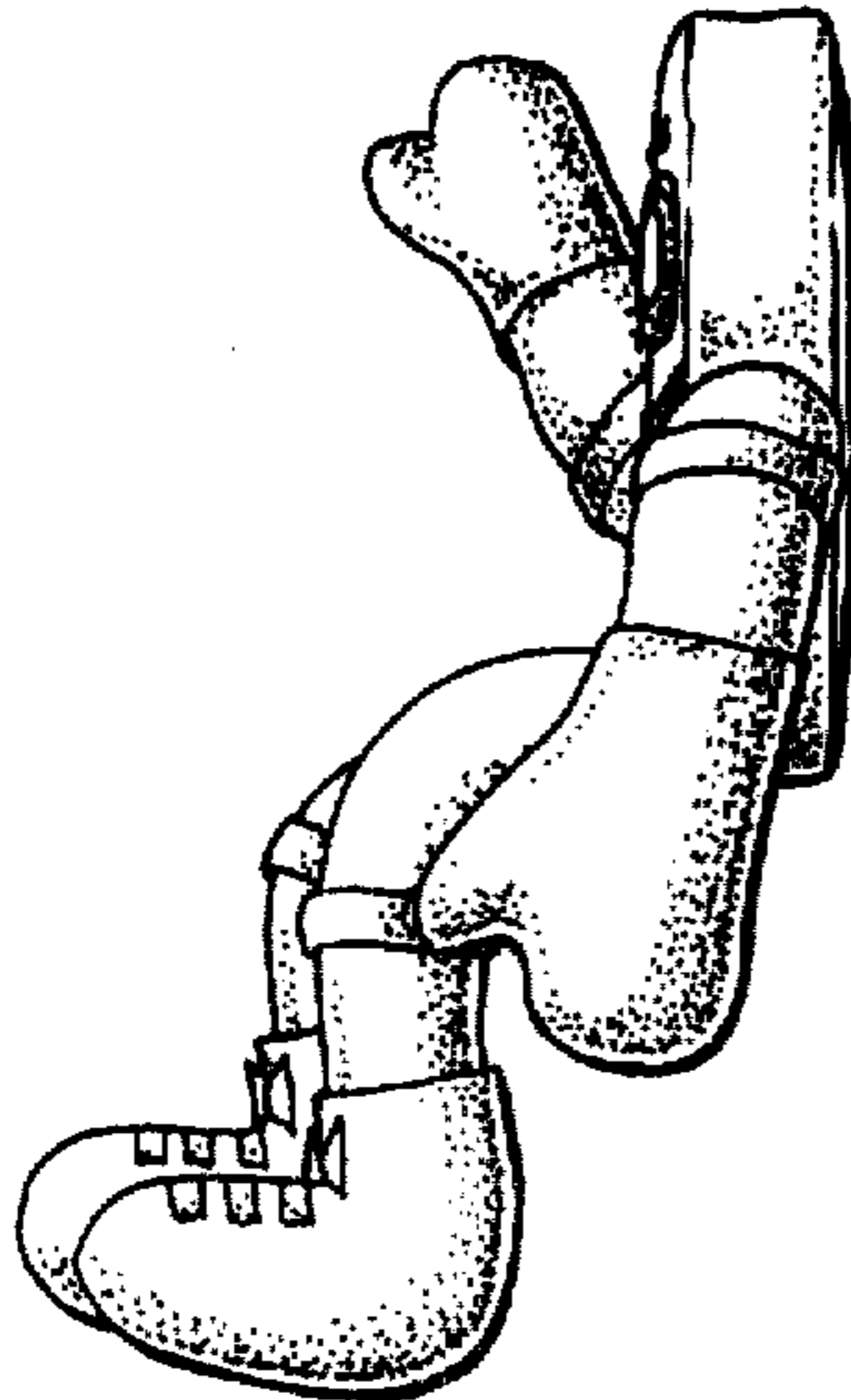

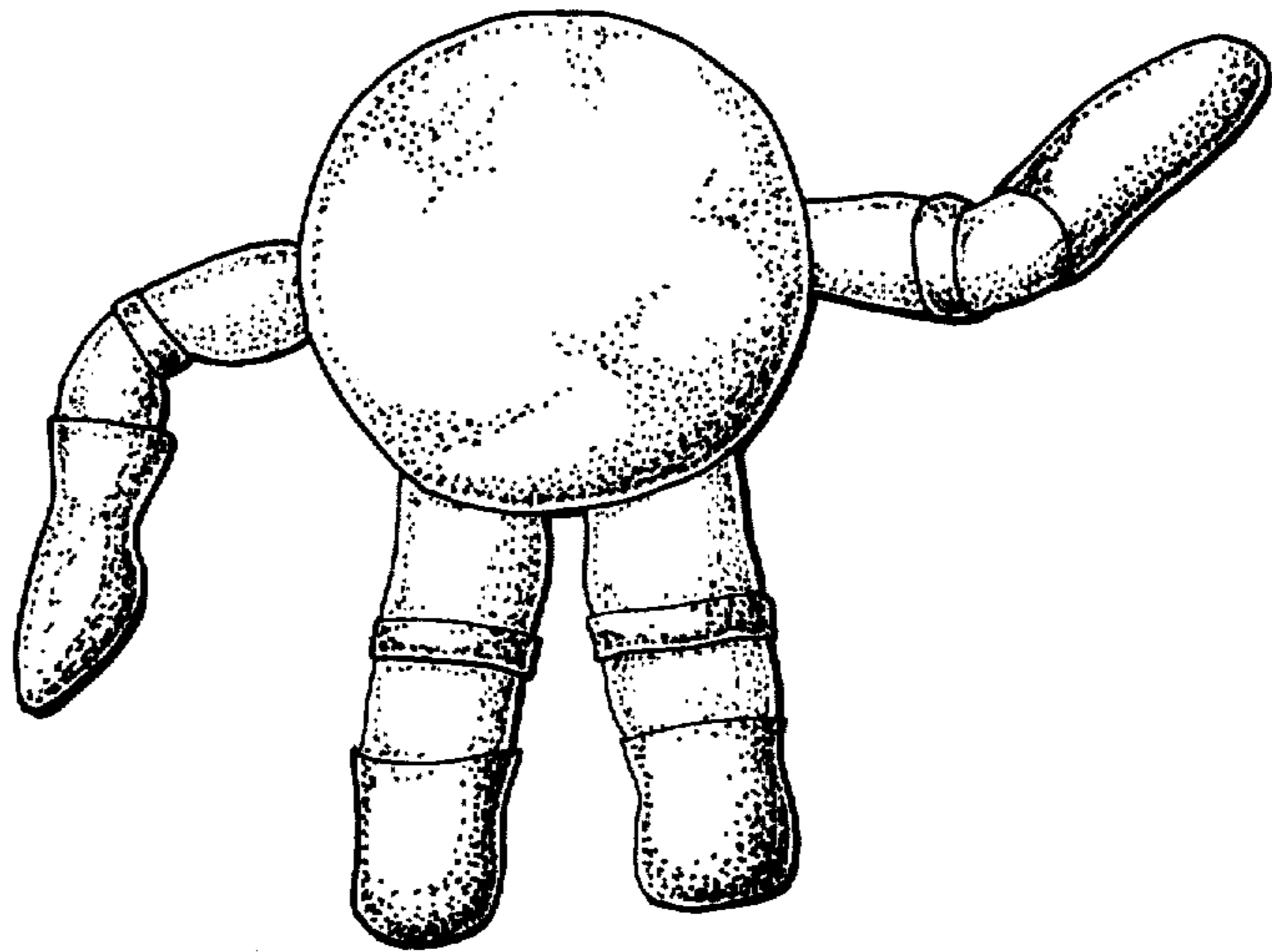

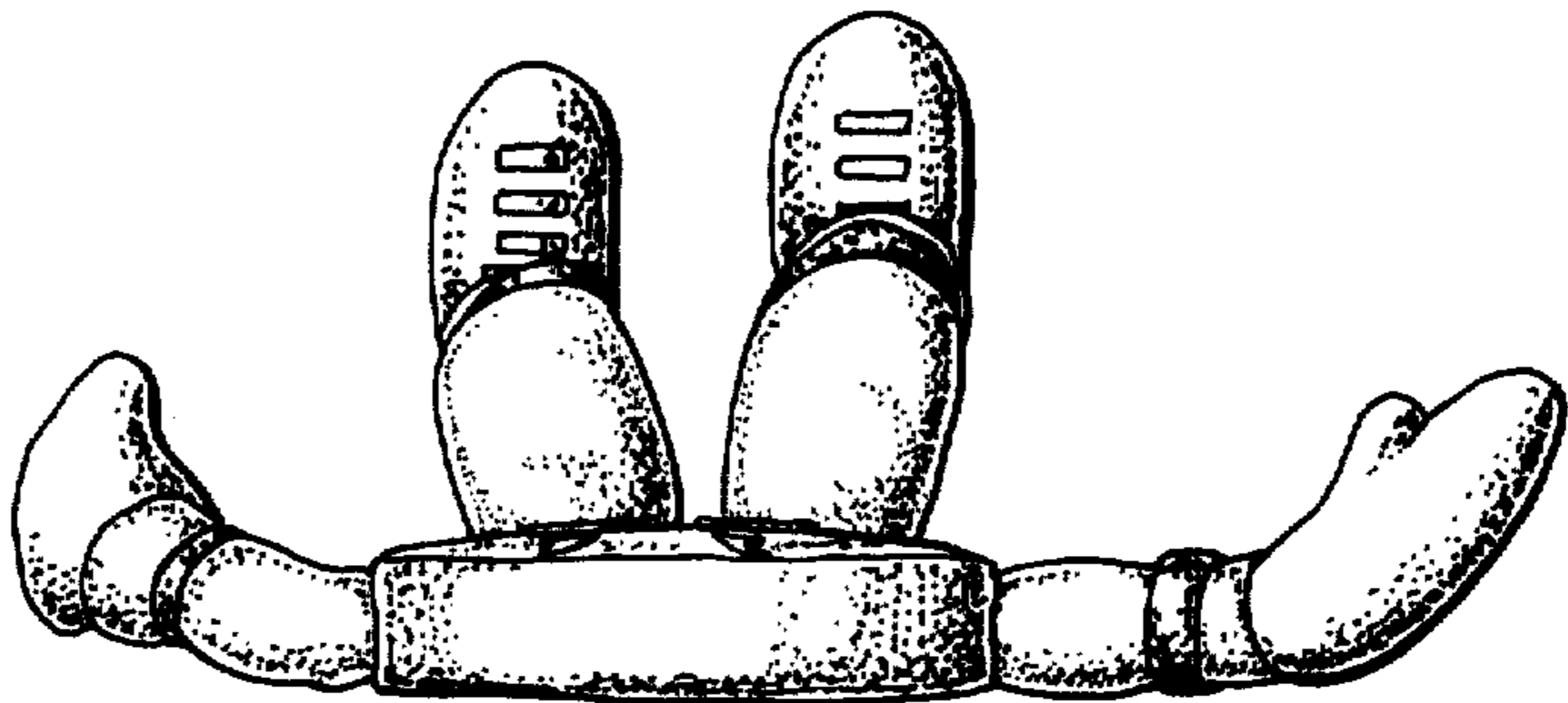
