DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a projectile for a shotgun embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a side elevation thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a vertical sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2; and
 FIG. 6 is a side elevation of a projectile for a second embodiment of a shotgun embodying my new design.

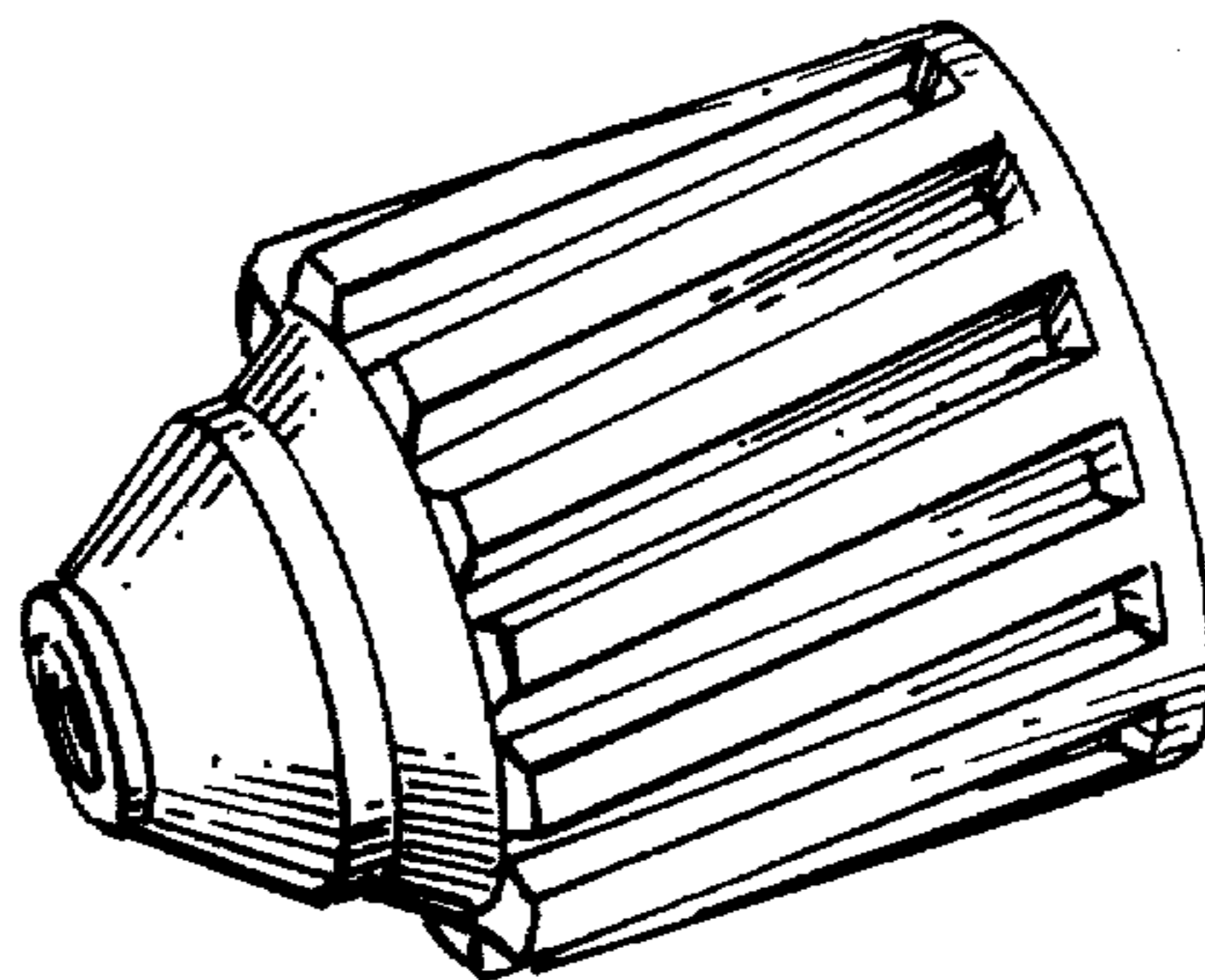

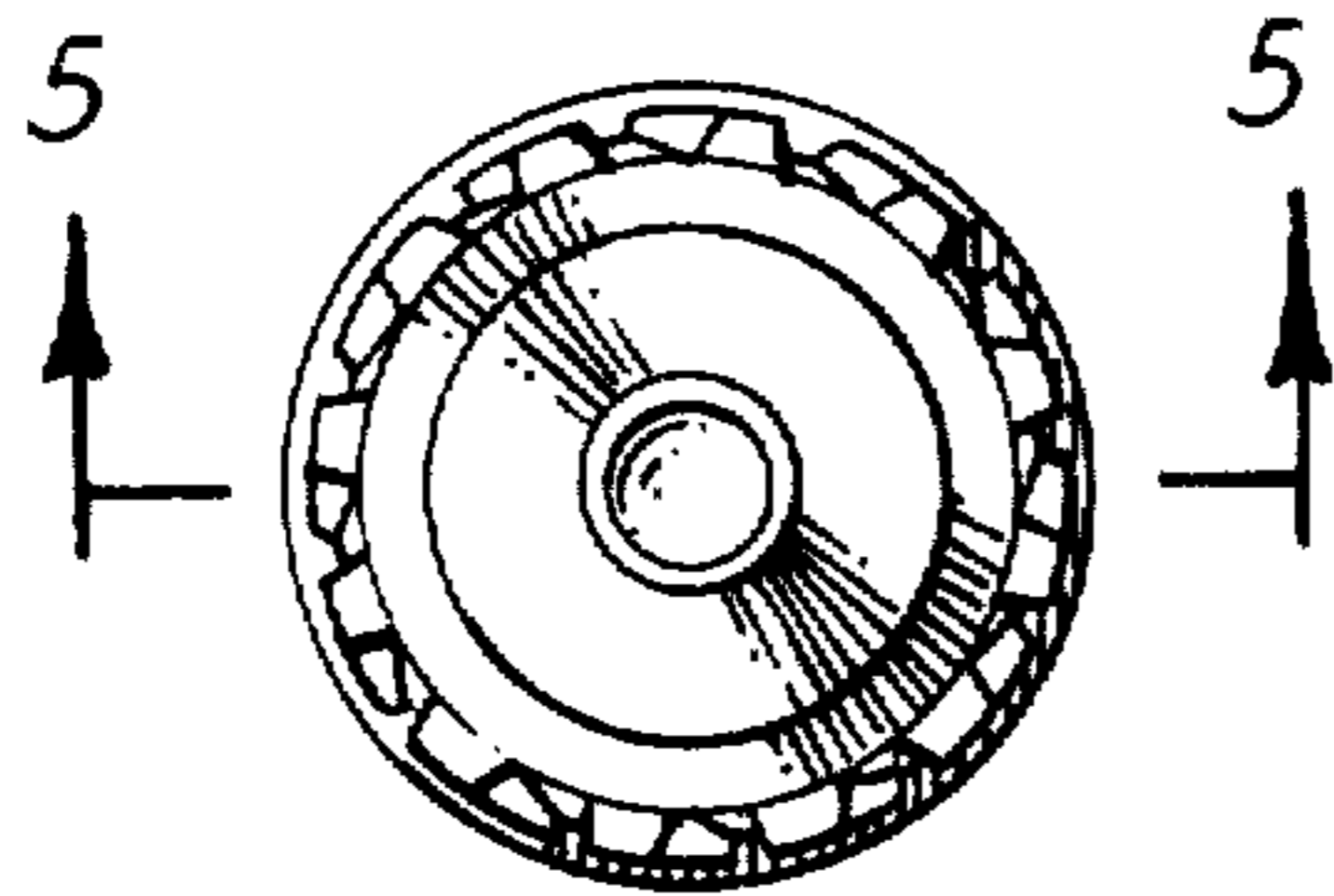
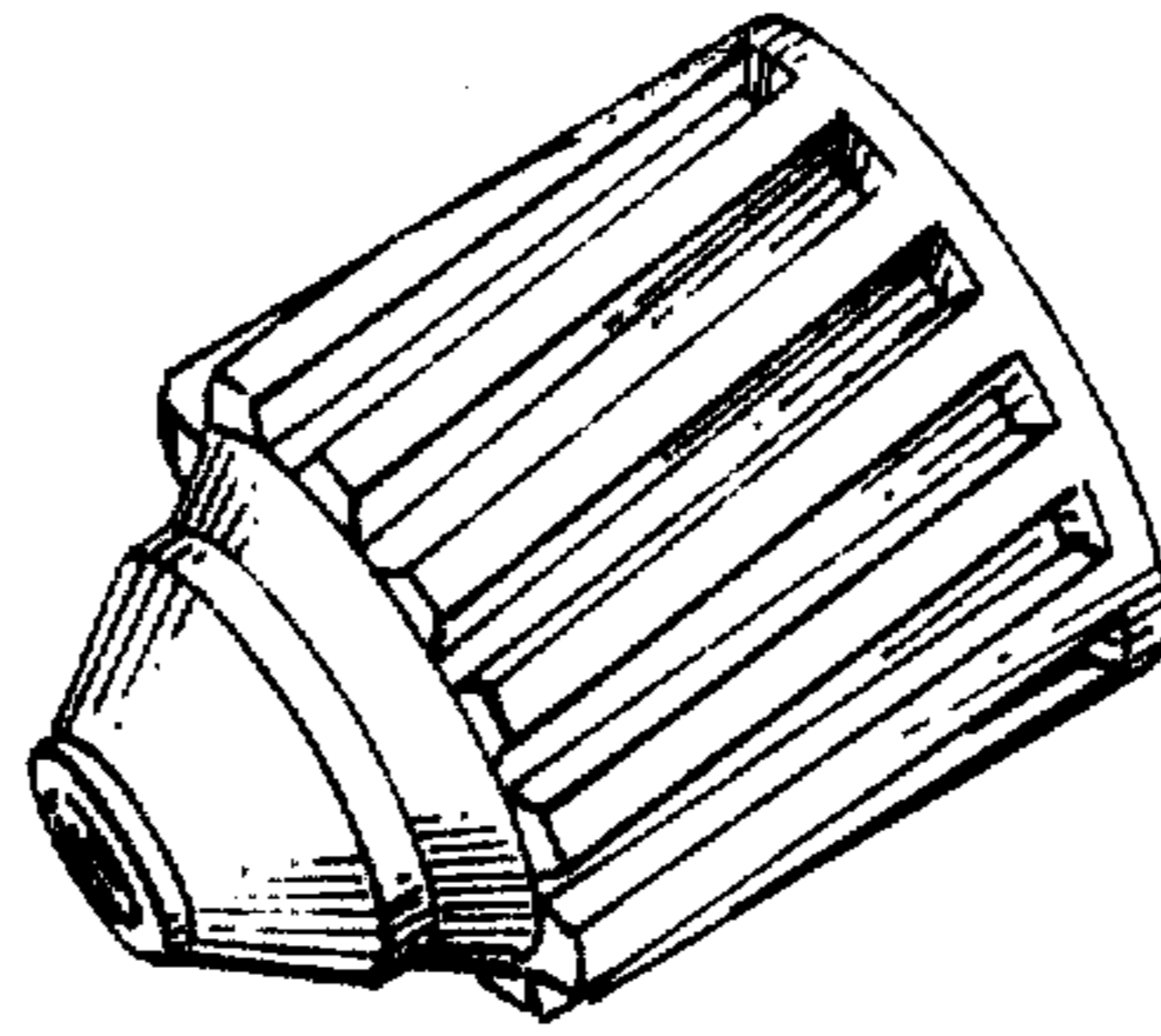

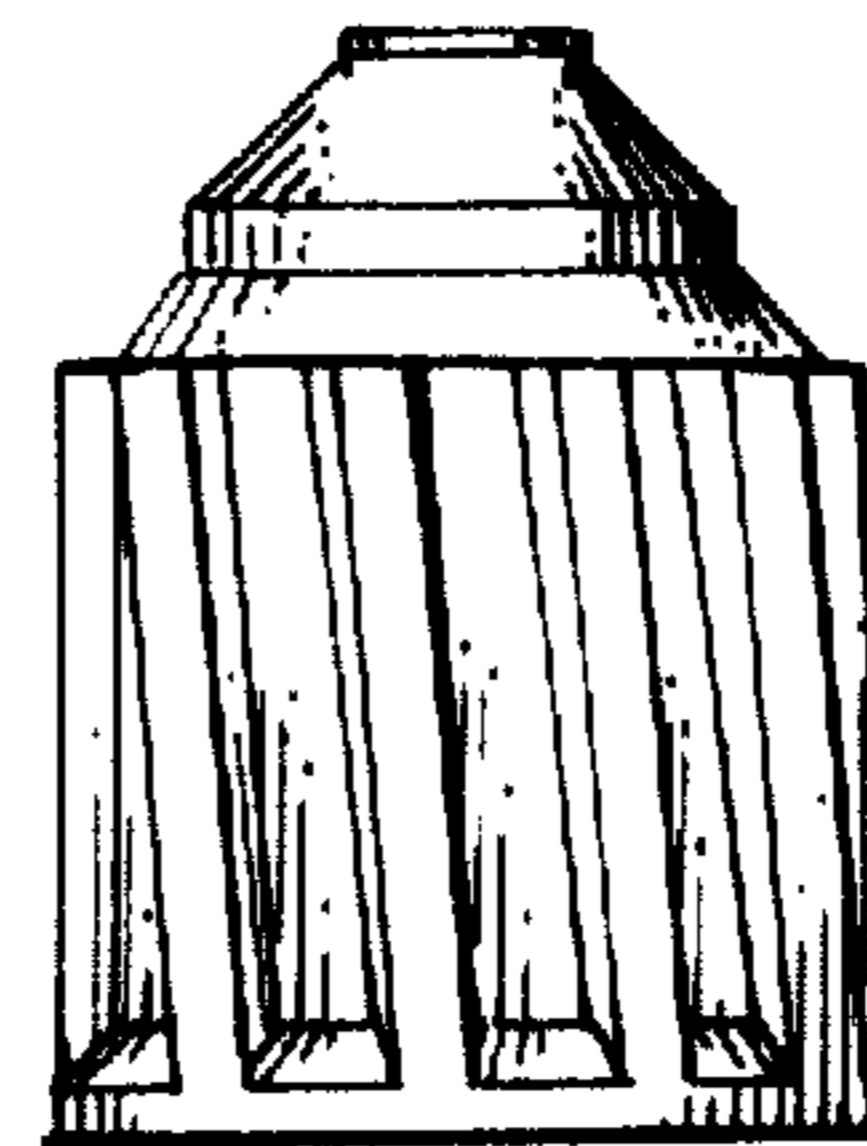

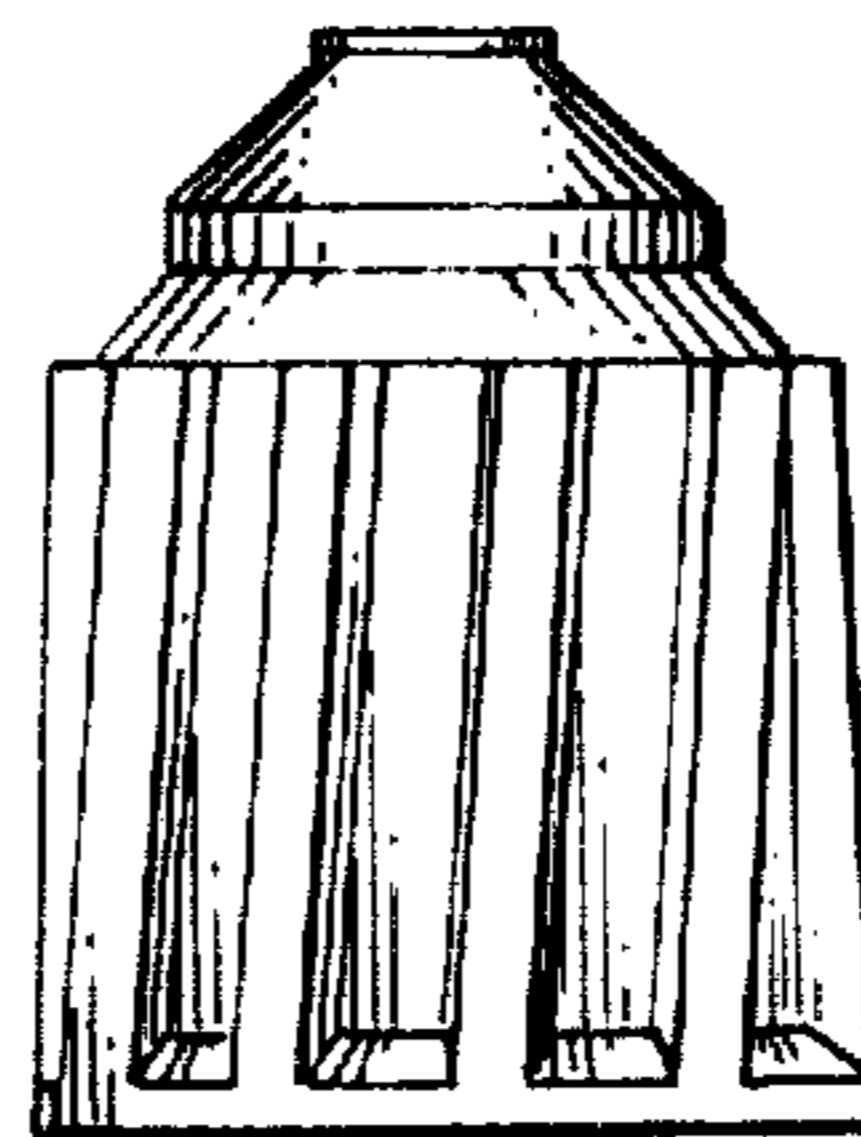

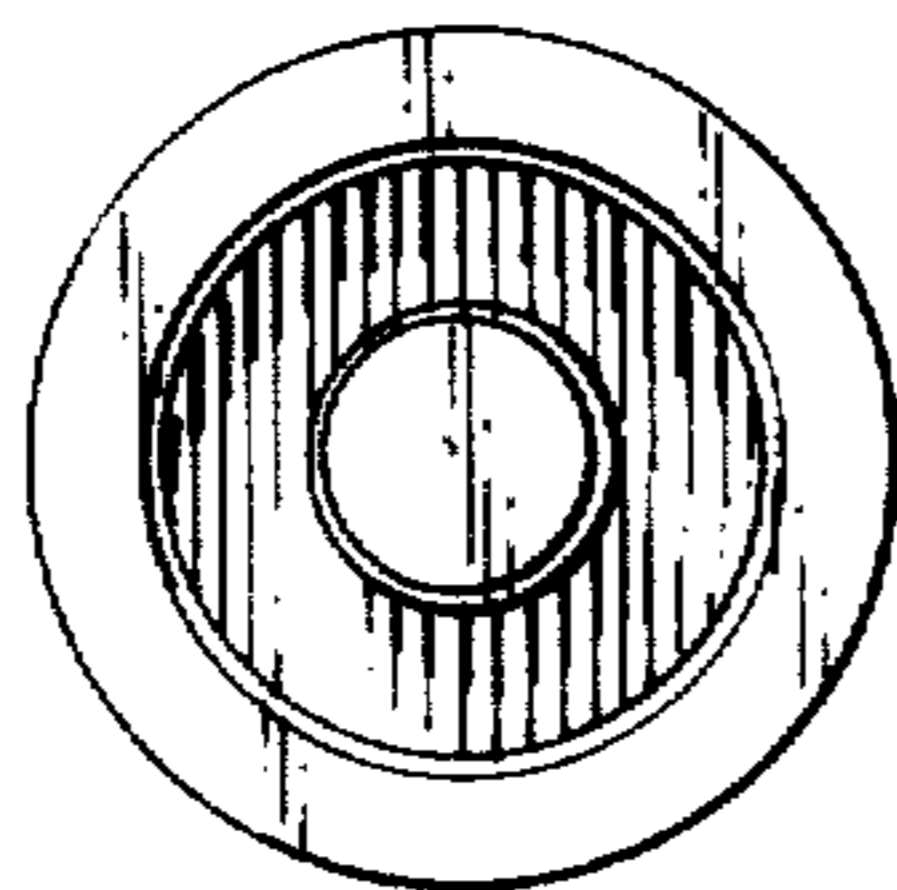

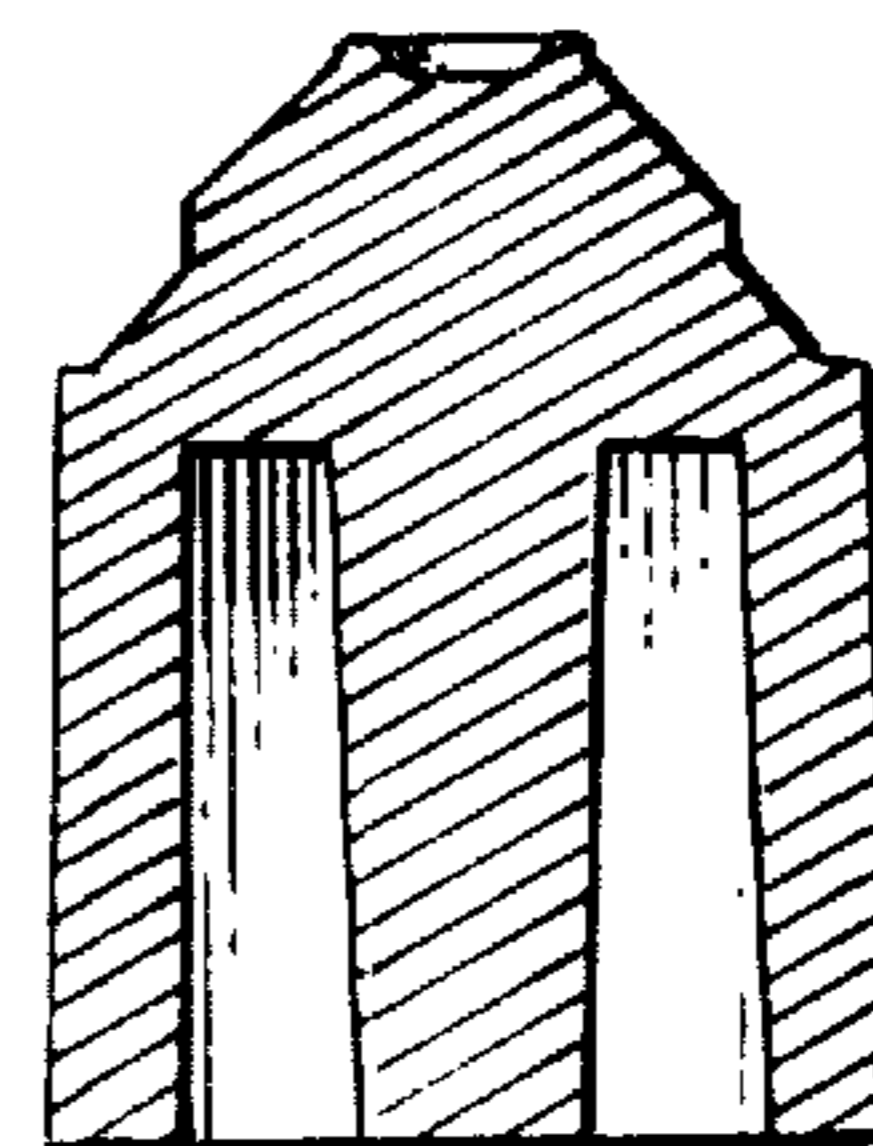
