FIG. 3 is a side elevational view in open position, the broken line showing of a human profile is for convenience of illustration only.

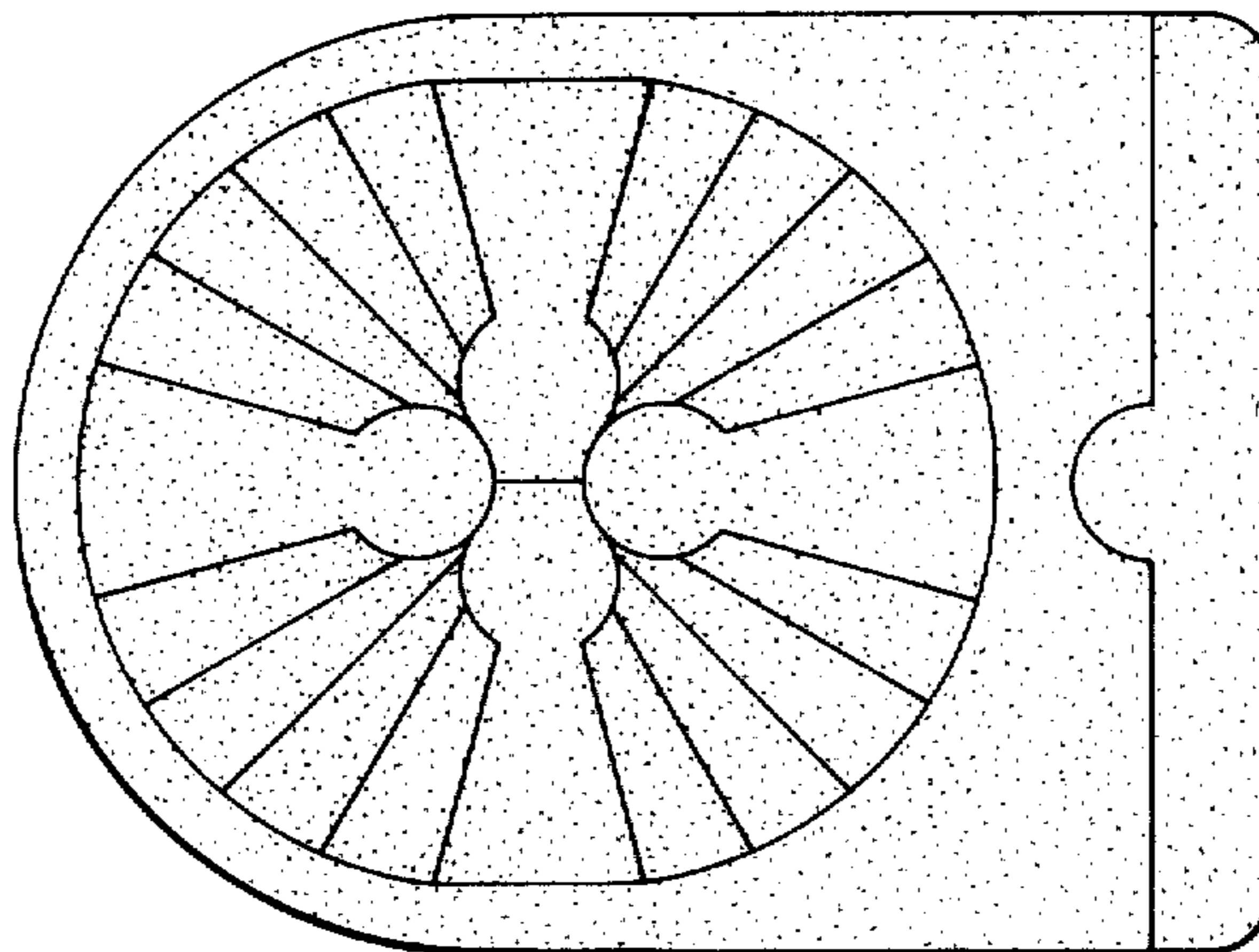

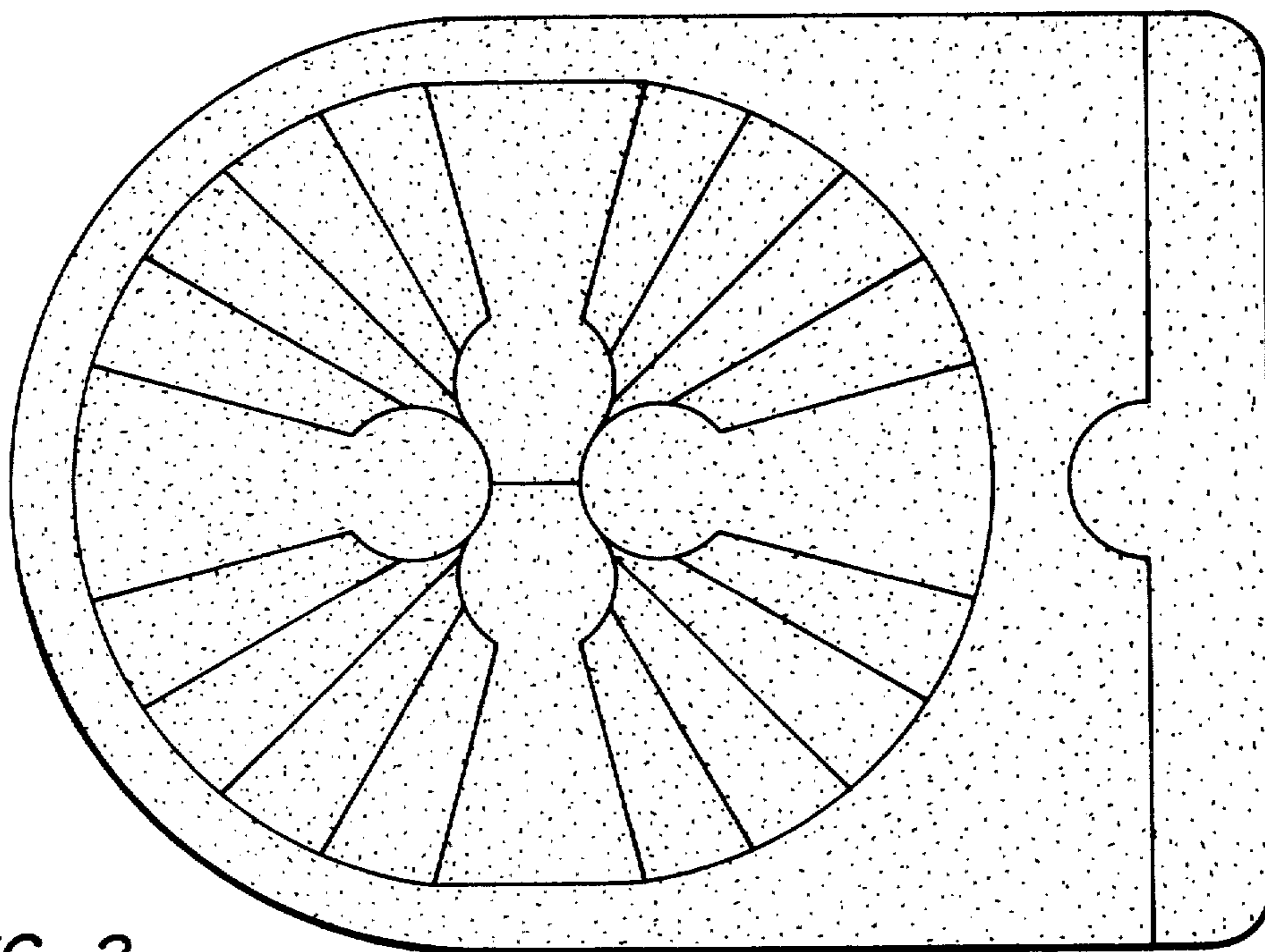

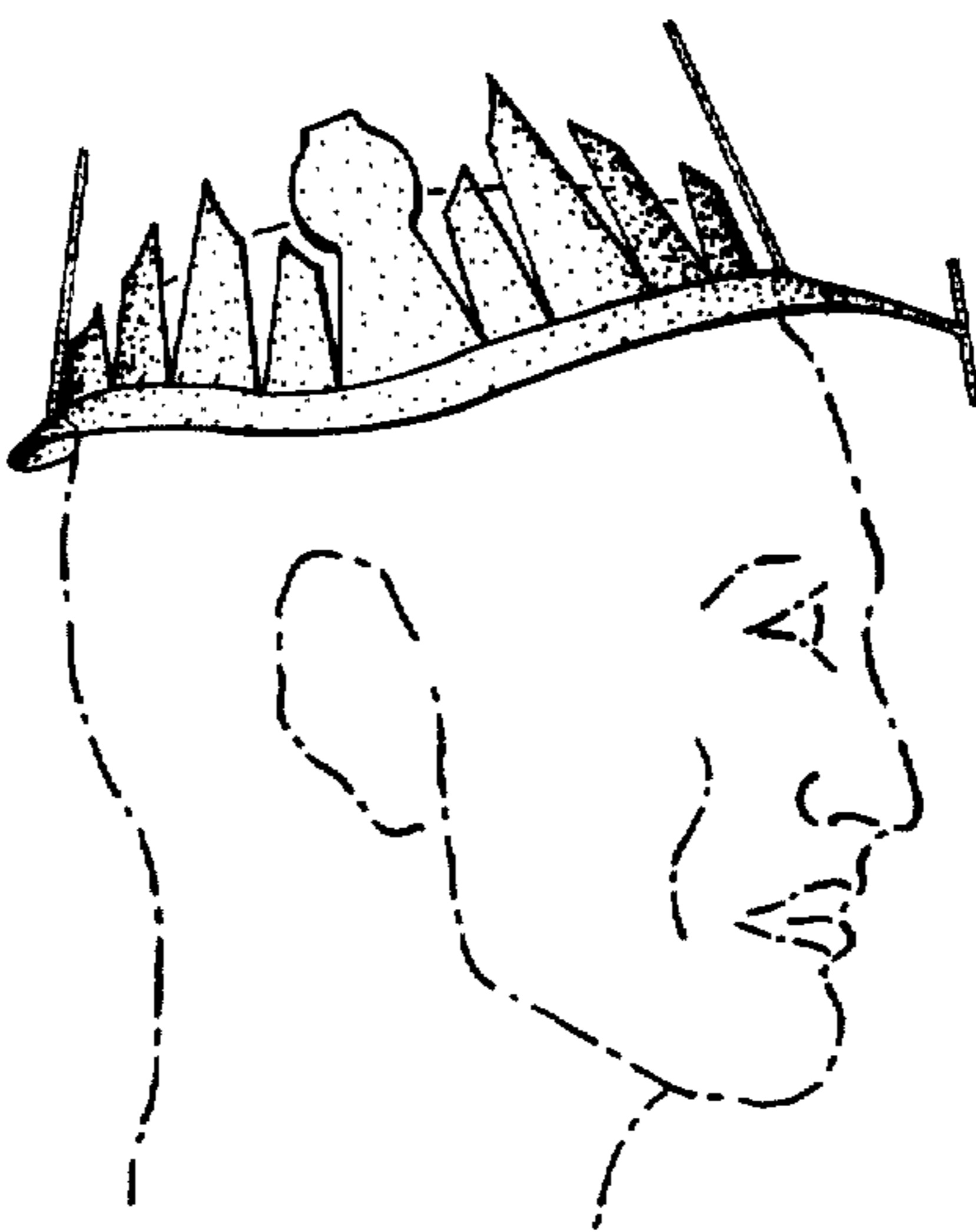
