[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sport shoe, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sport shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof, the broken-line portions of the sole are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

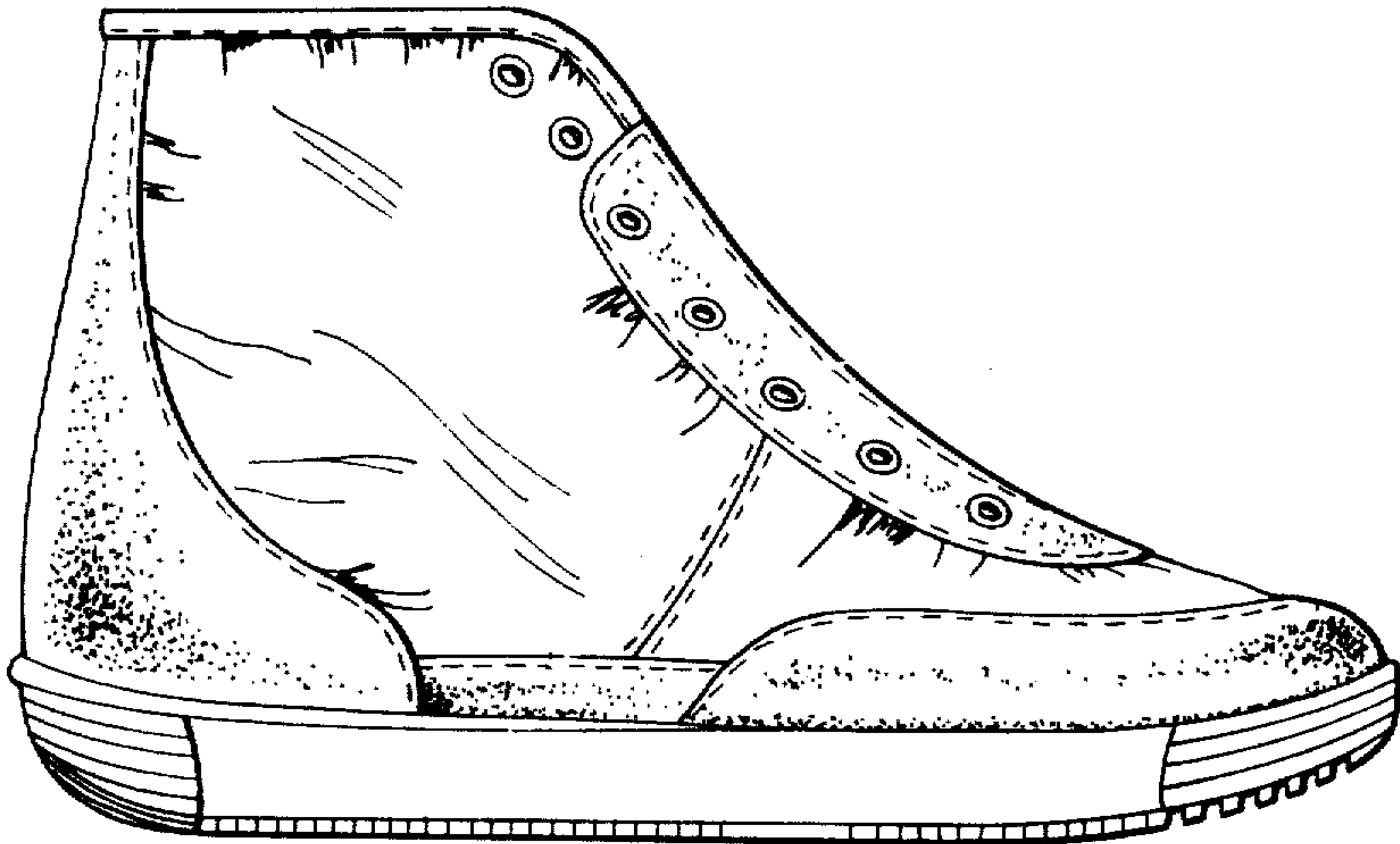

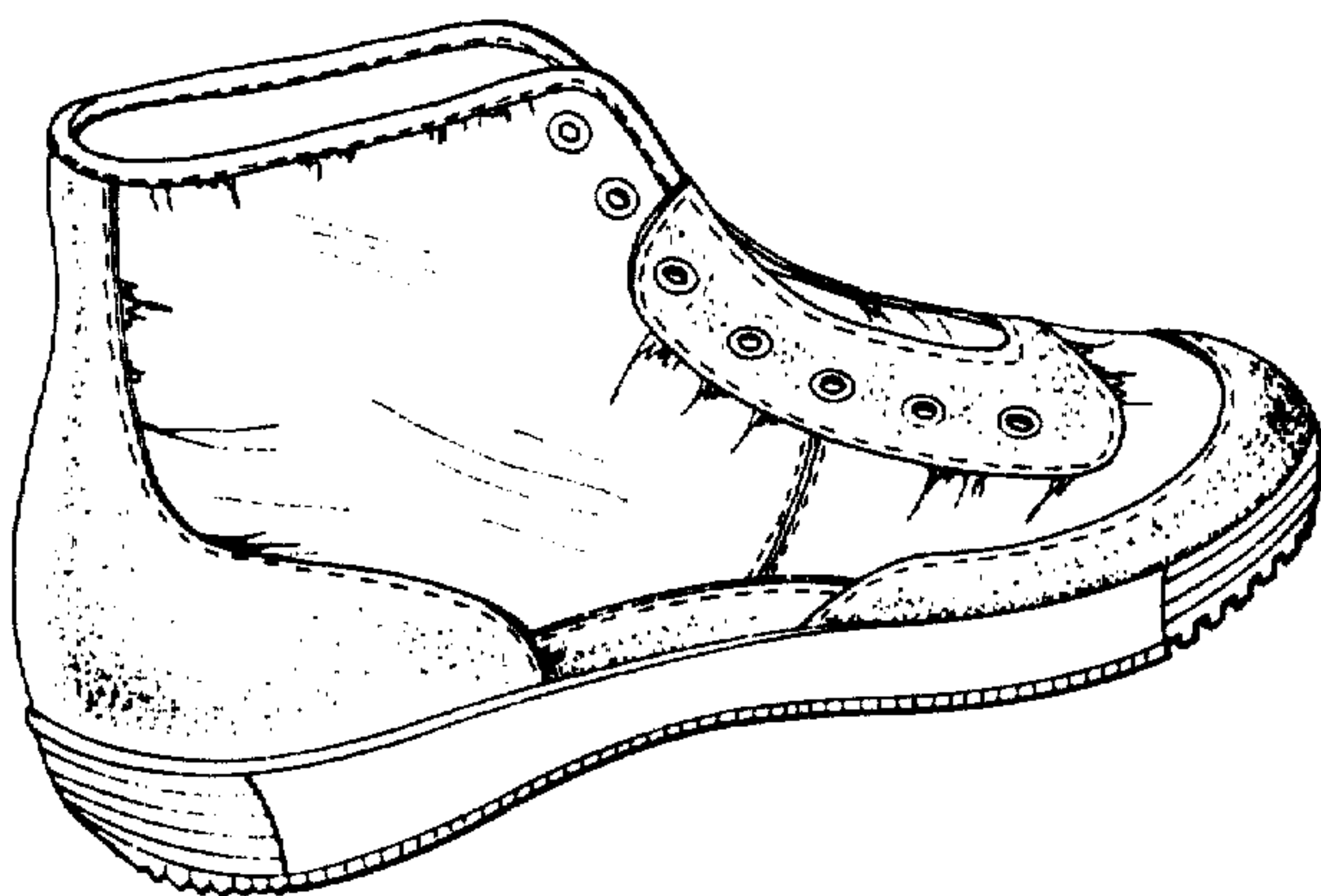

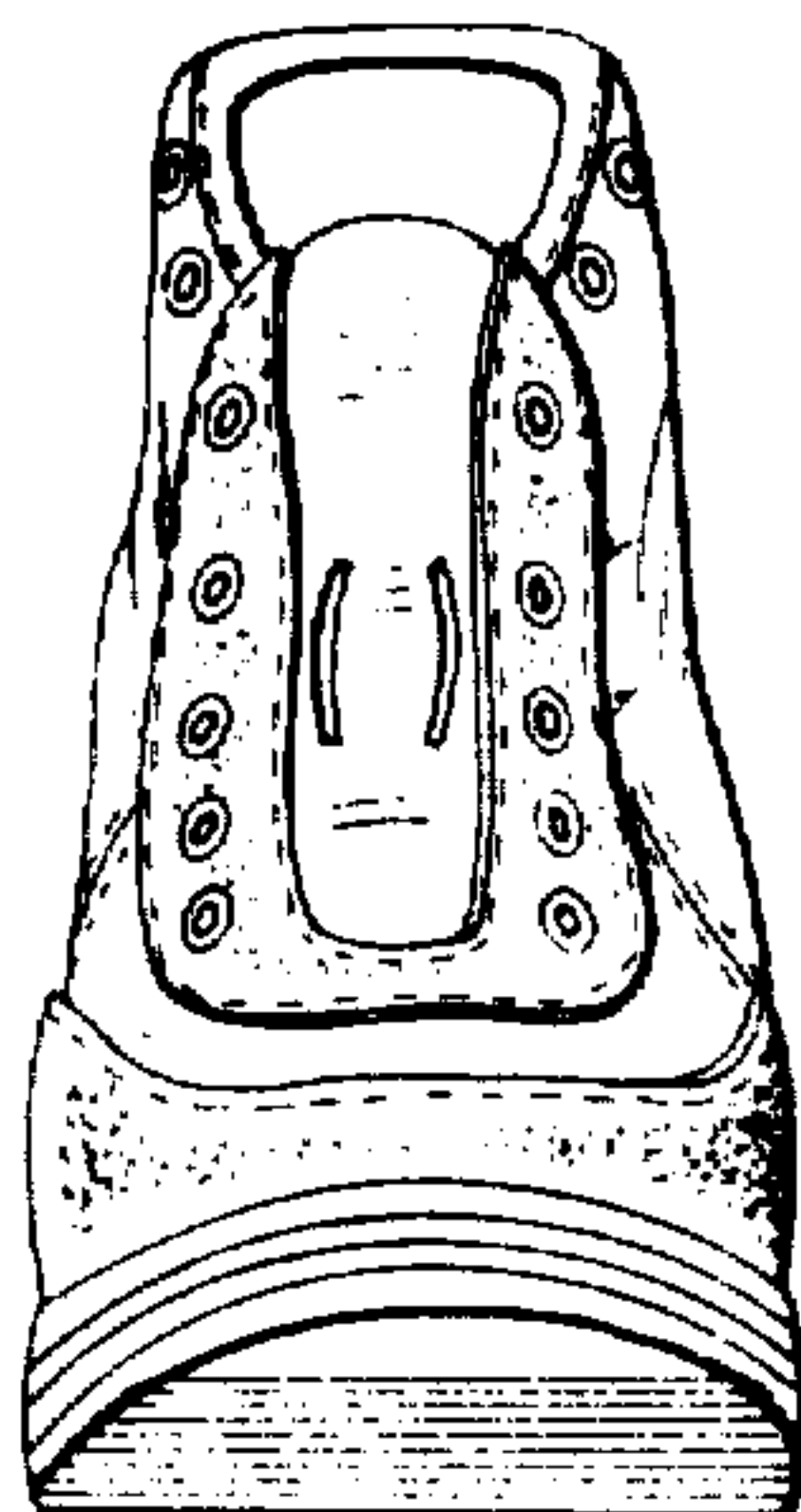
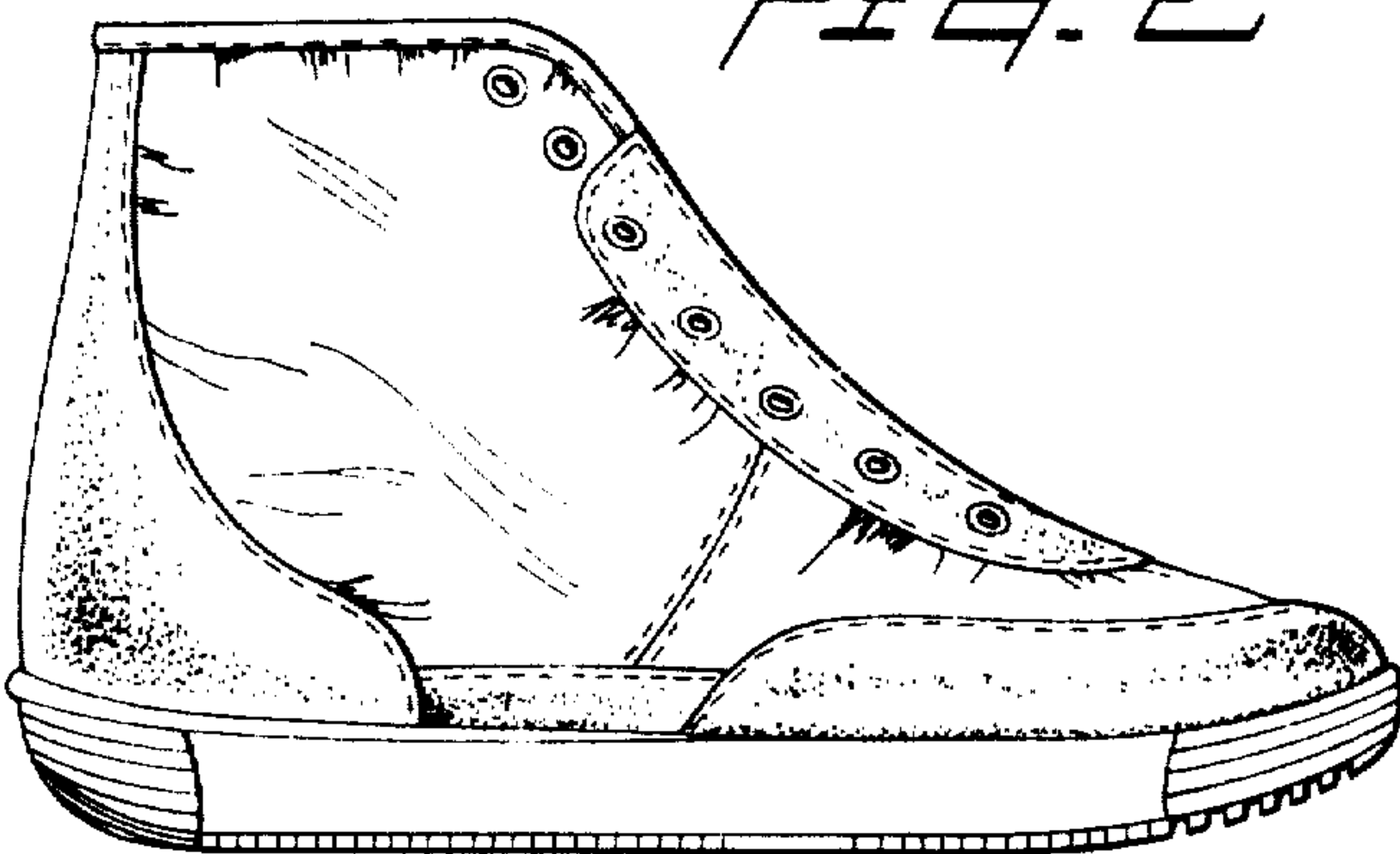

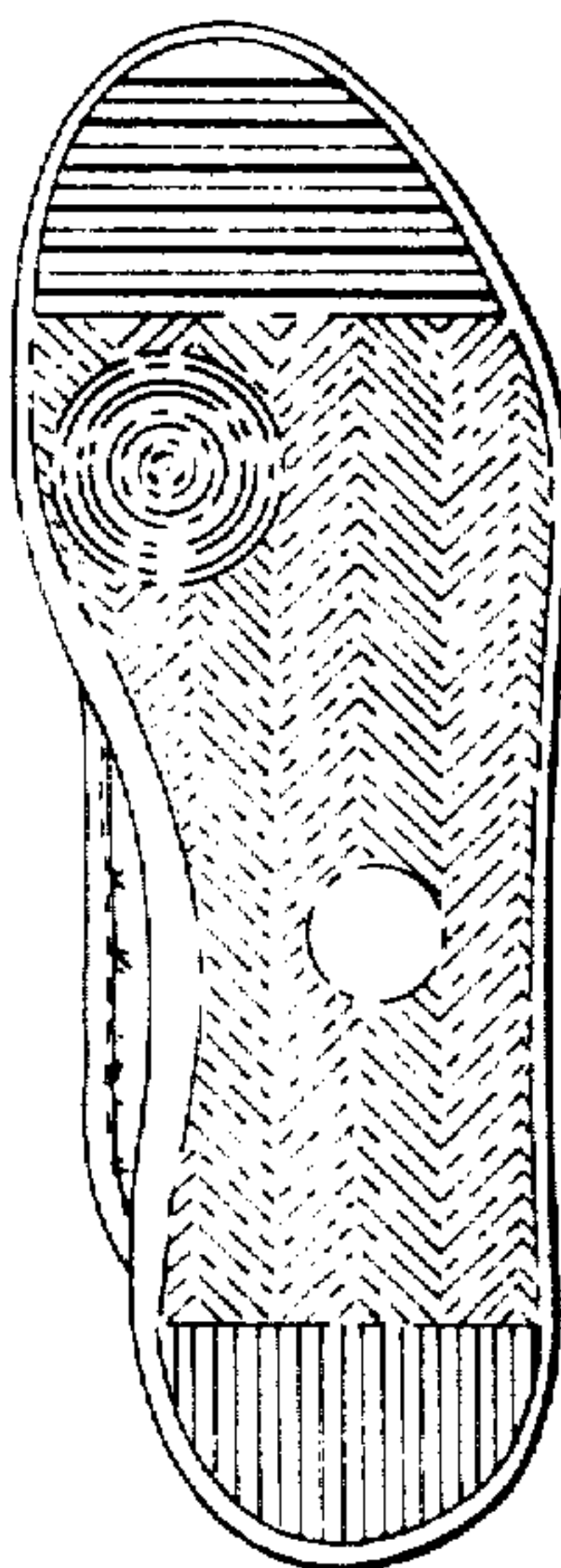
