CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the body of a garment hanger showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, both ends being identical;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line IV—IV of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line V—V of FIG. 1.

The characteristic features of the design reside in the exterior faces of the front and back jaws at the ends of the bar.

The broken line showing of a hook or portions thereof are for illustrative purposes only.
