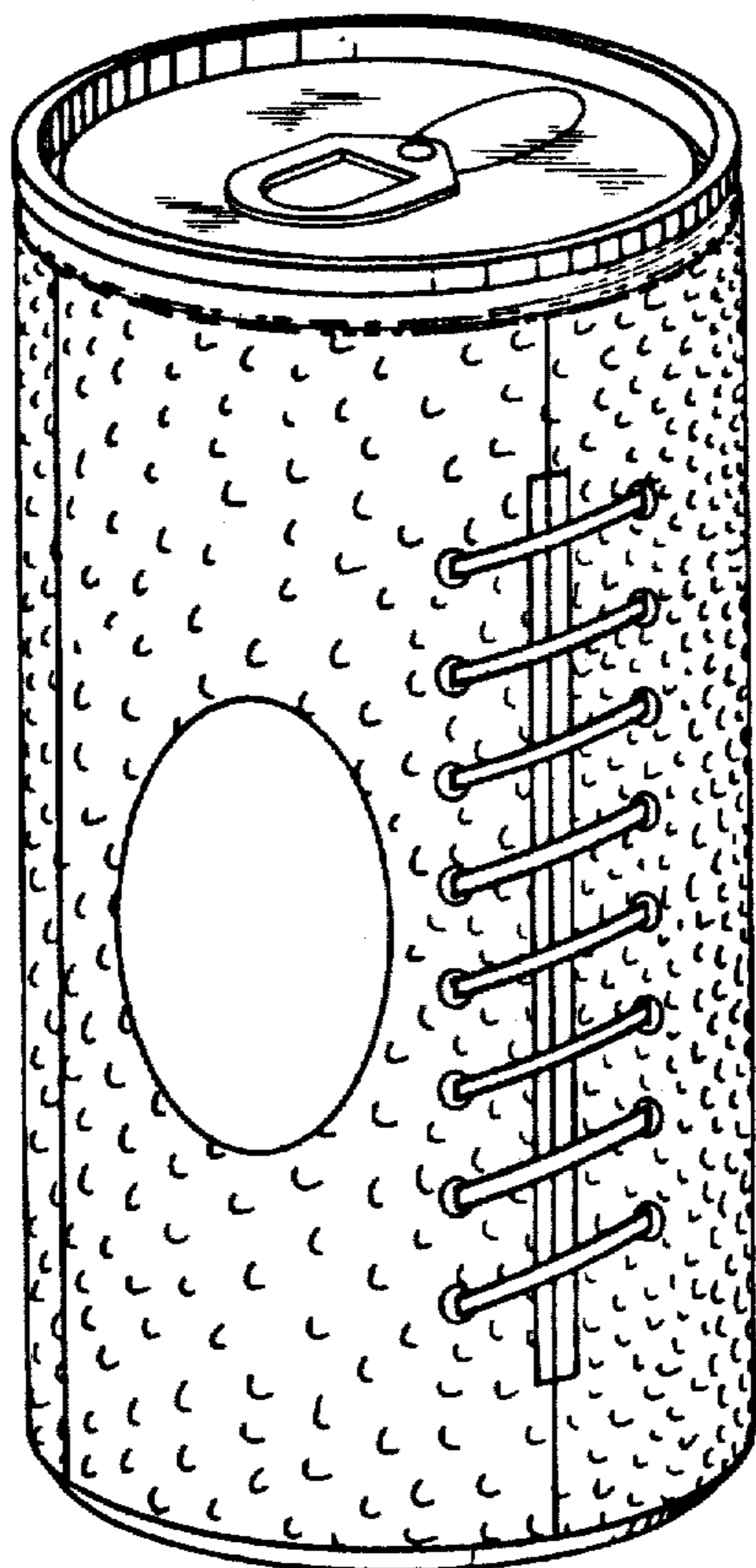

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a beverage can showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



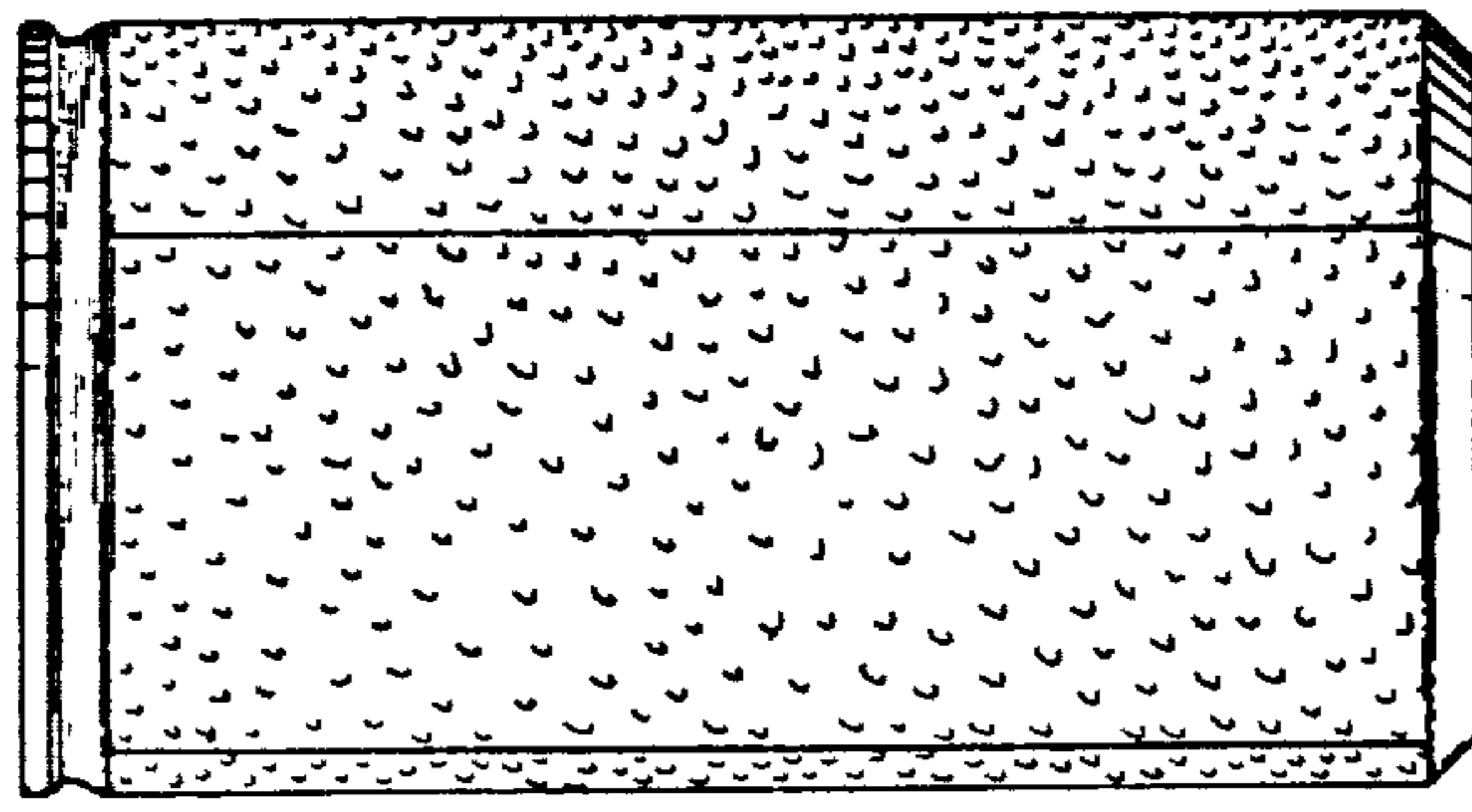

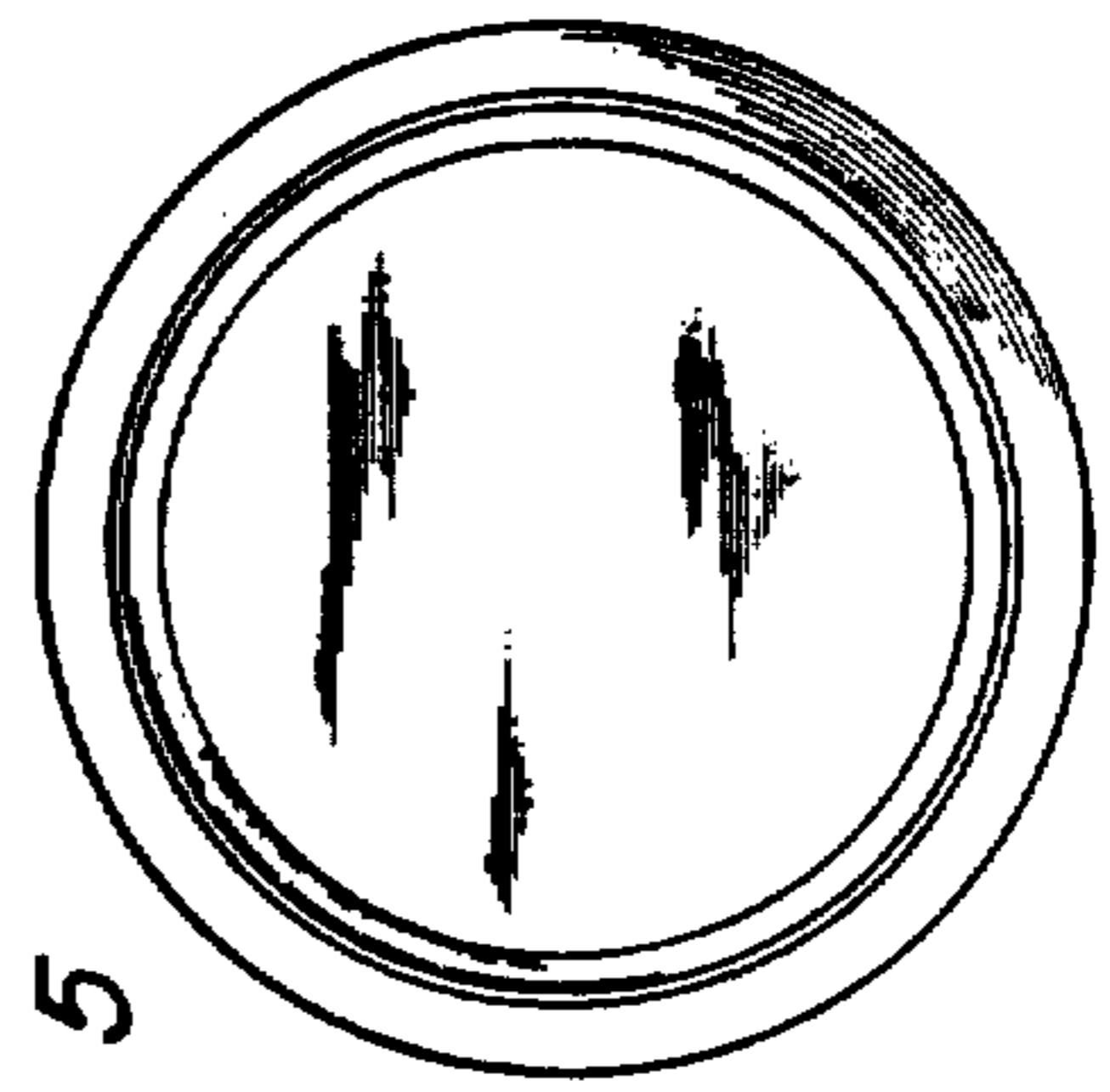

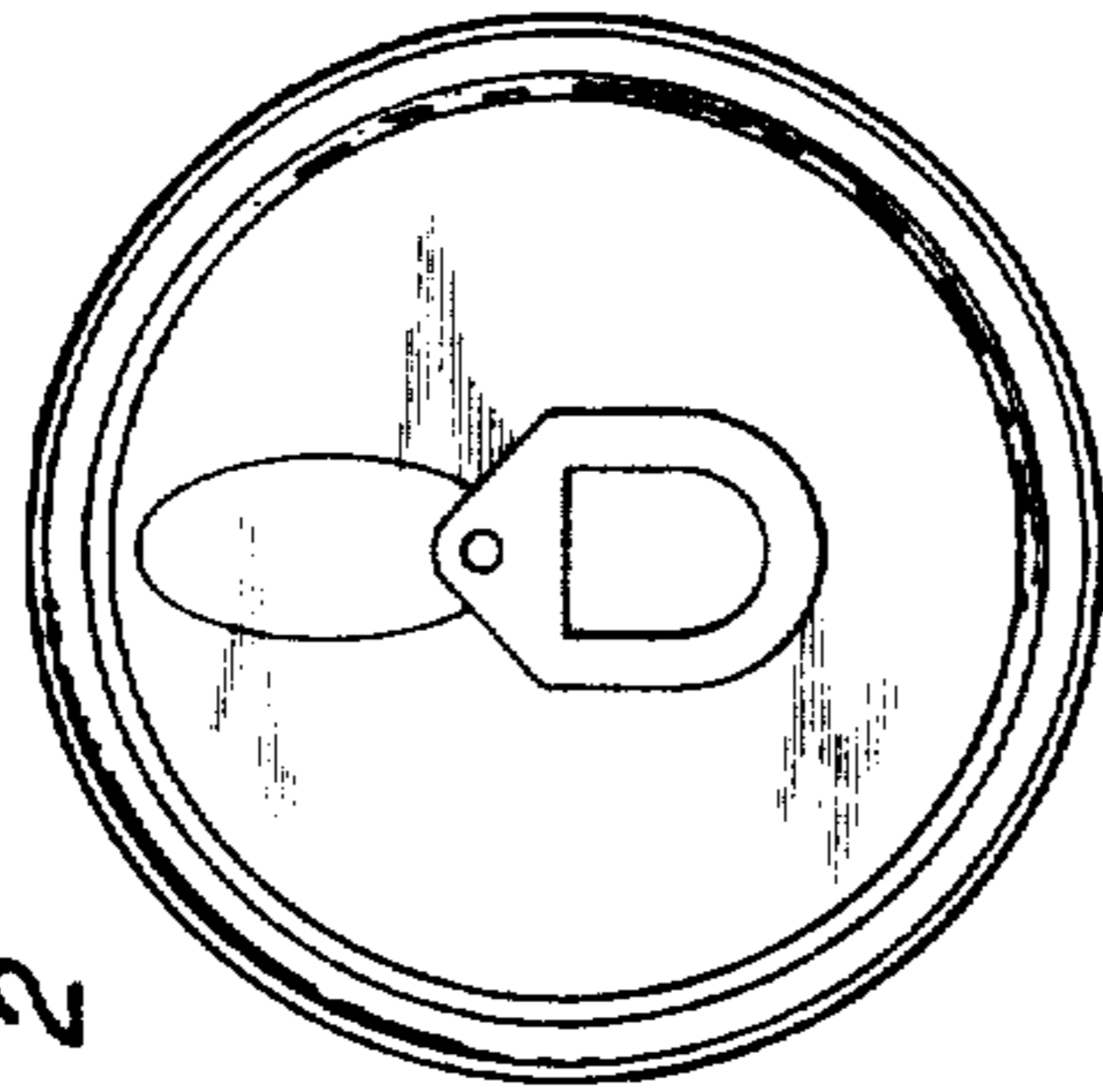

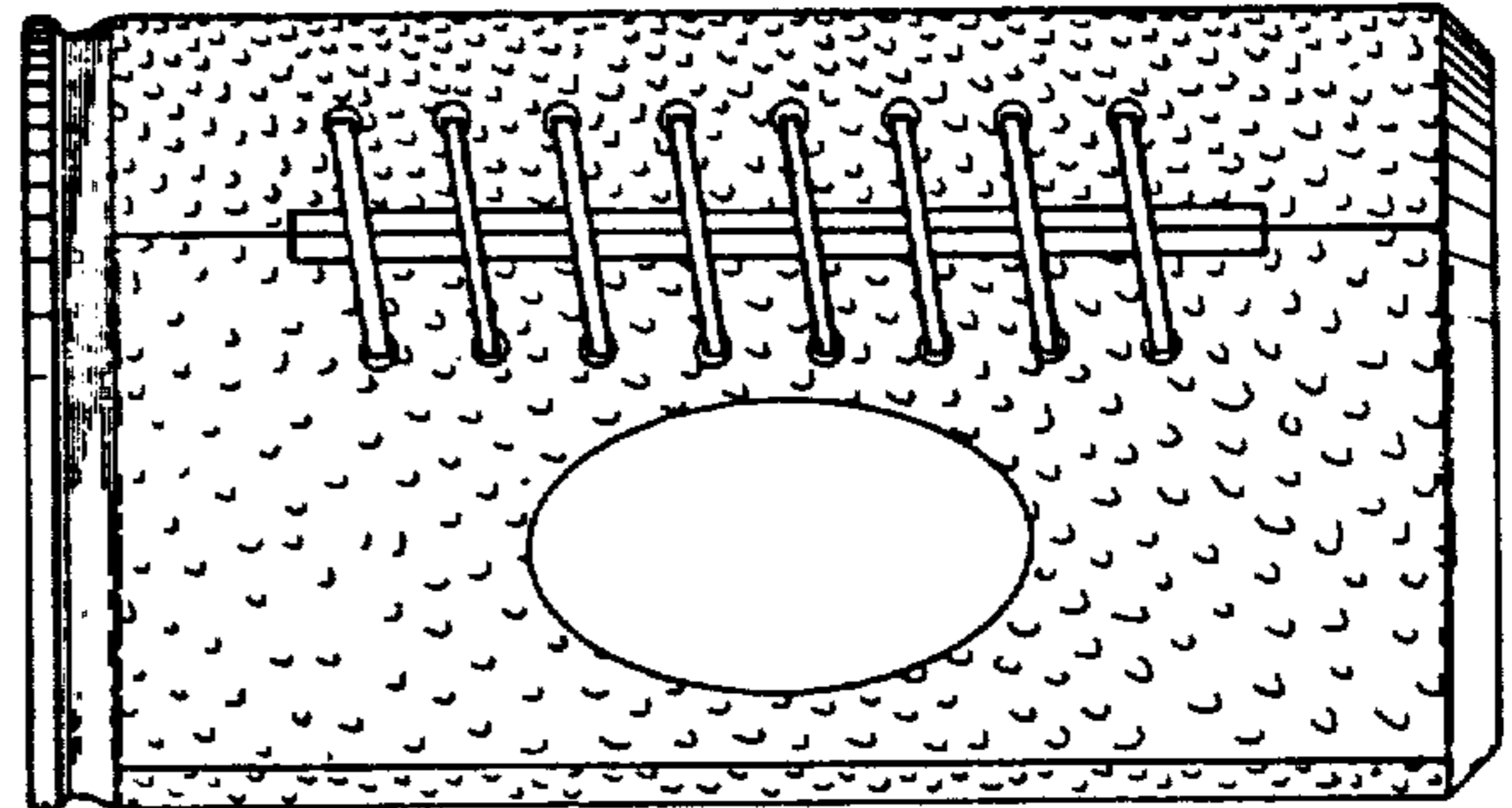

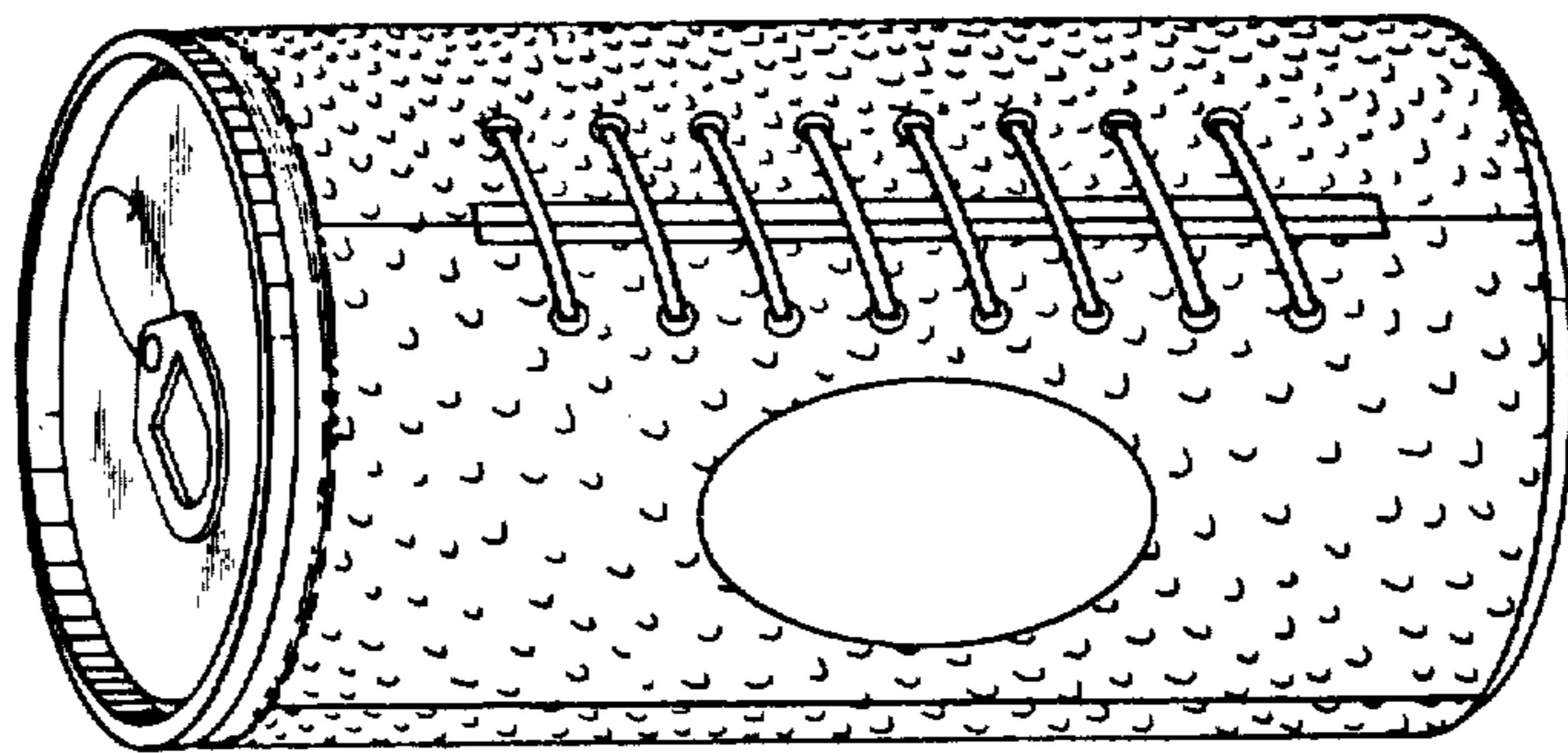
