[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined rear window and trunk lid for an automobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined rear window and trunk lid for an automobile embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken generally along the plane indicated by line 4—4 of FIG. 3; and

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken generally along the plane indicated by line 5—5 of FIG. 3.
