[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a disposable staple cartridge for a linear closure surgical stapler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a disposable staple cartridge for a linear closure surgical stapler showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view as seen from the side opposite FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof;

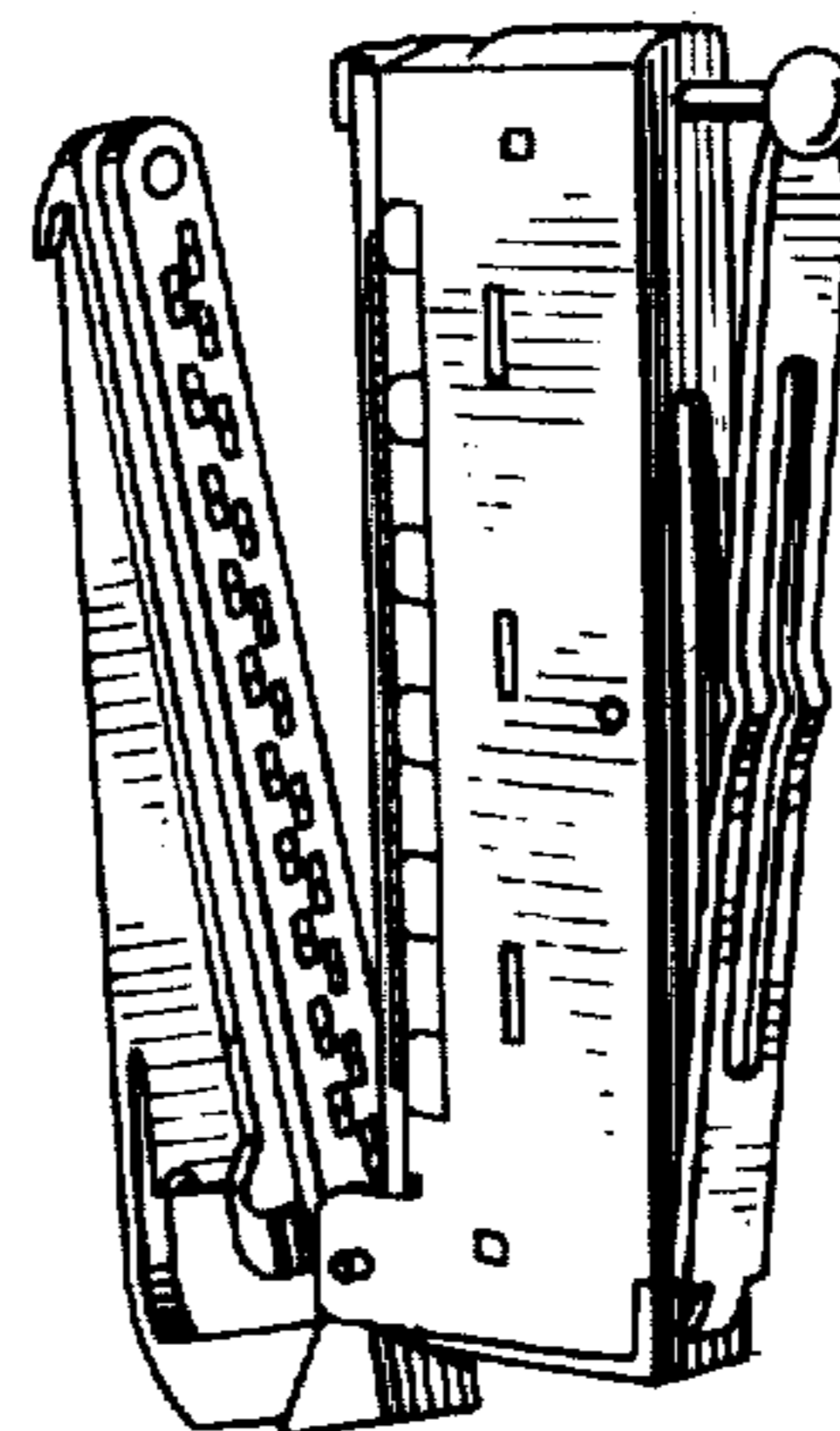
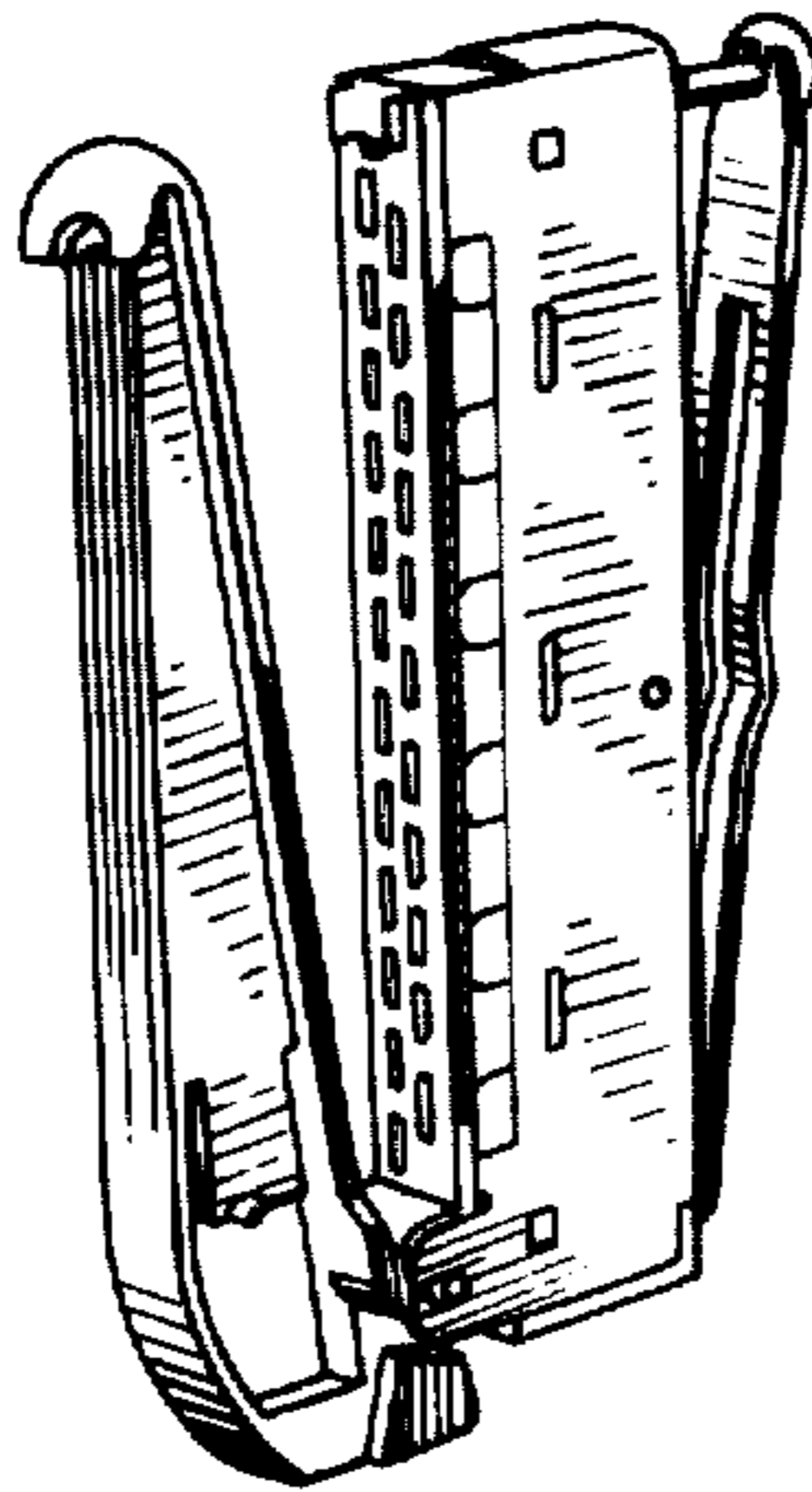
FIG. 4 is an end elevation view as seen from the right of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view.



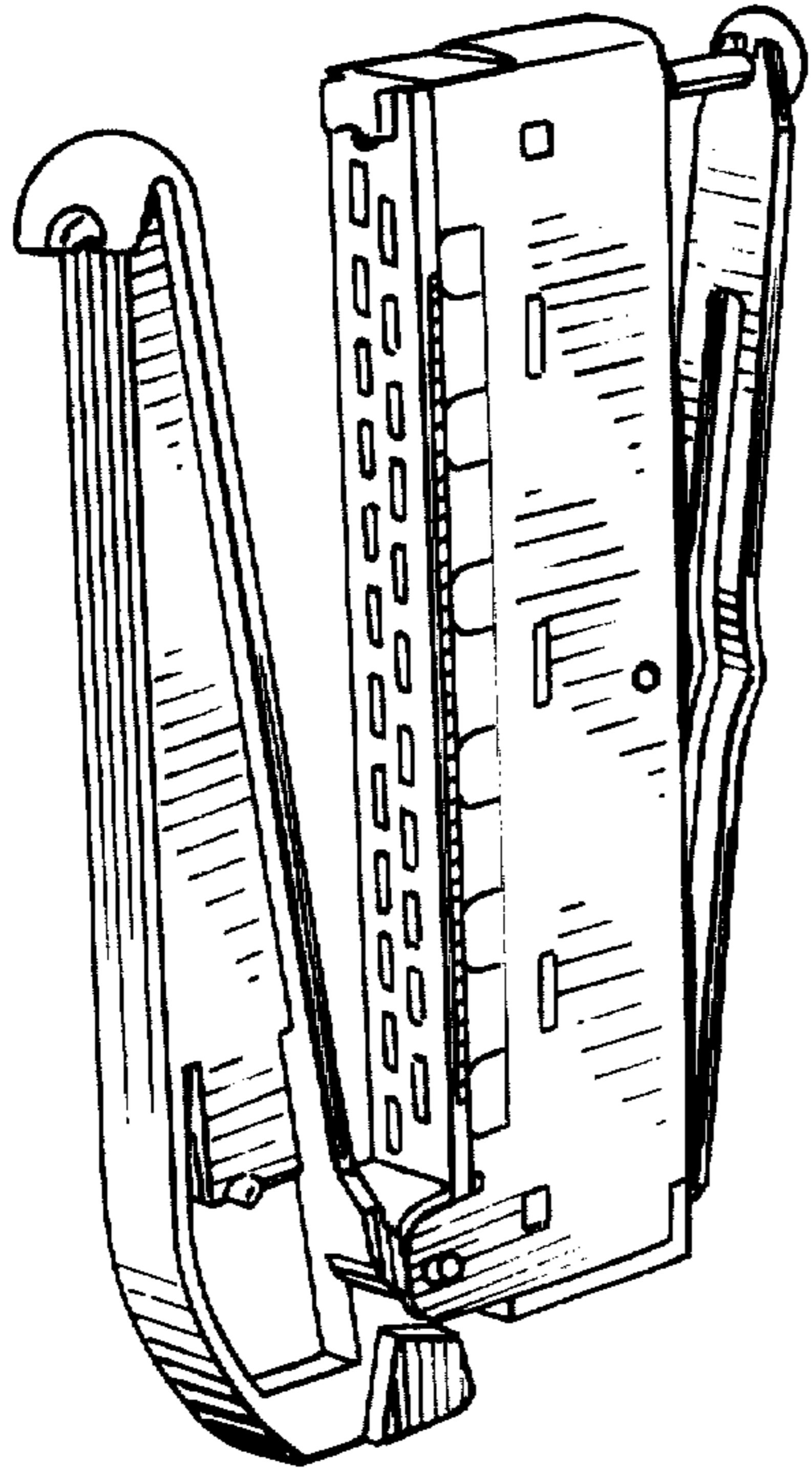

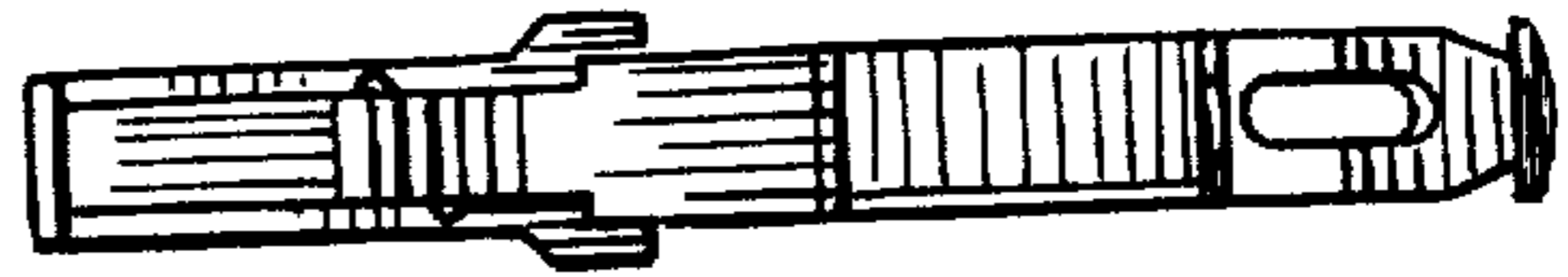
