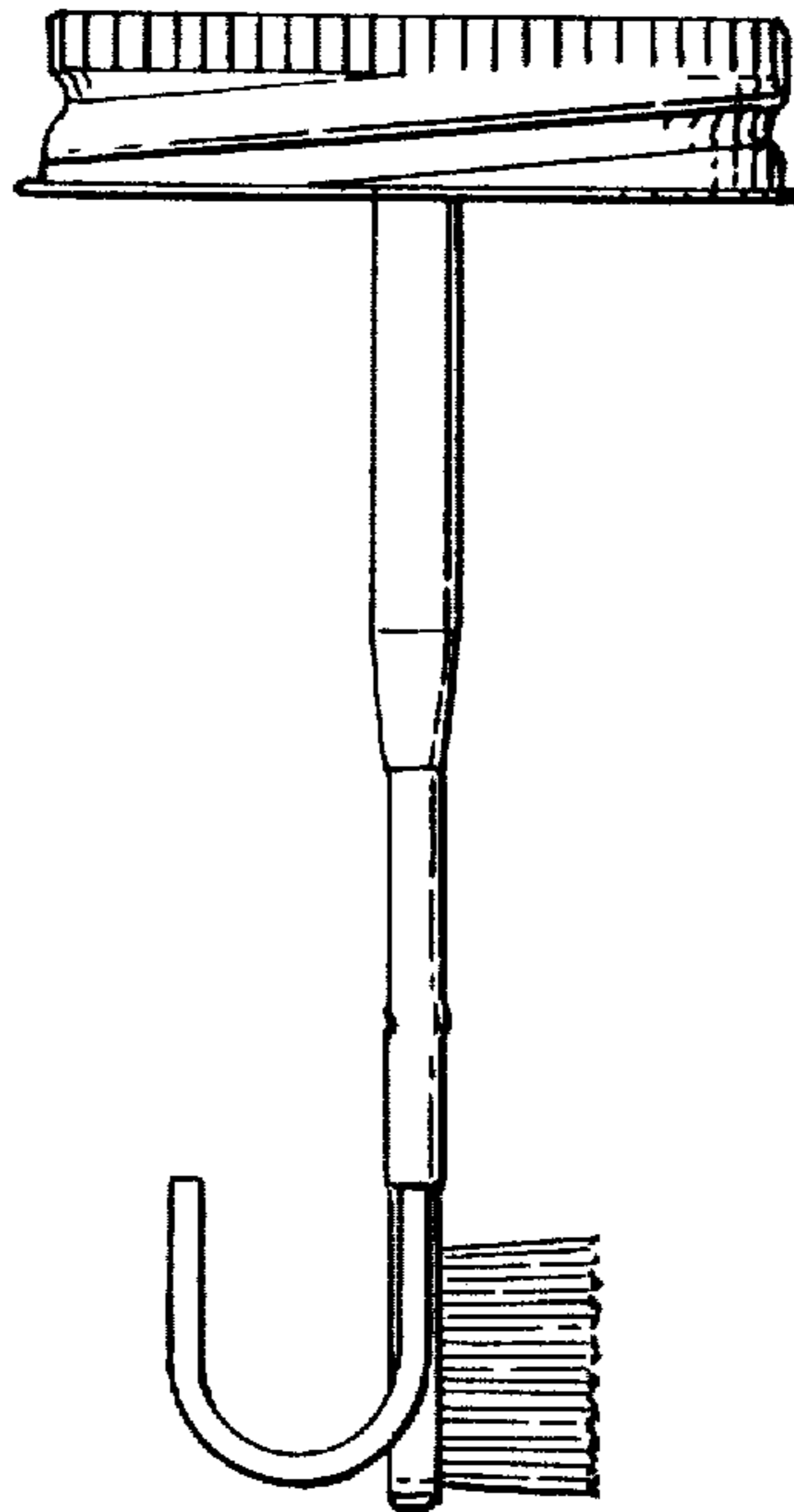
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a jar cap showing my new design;

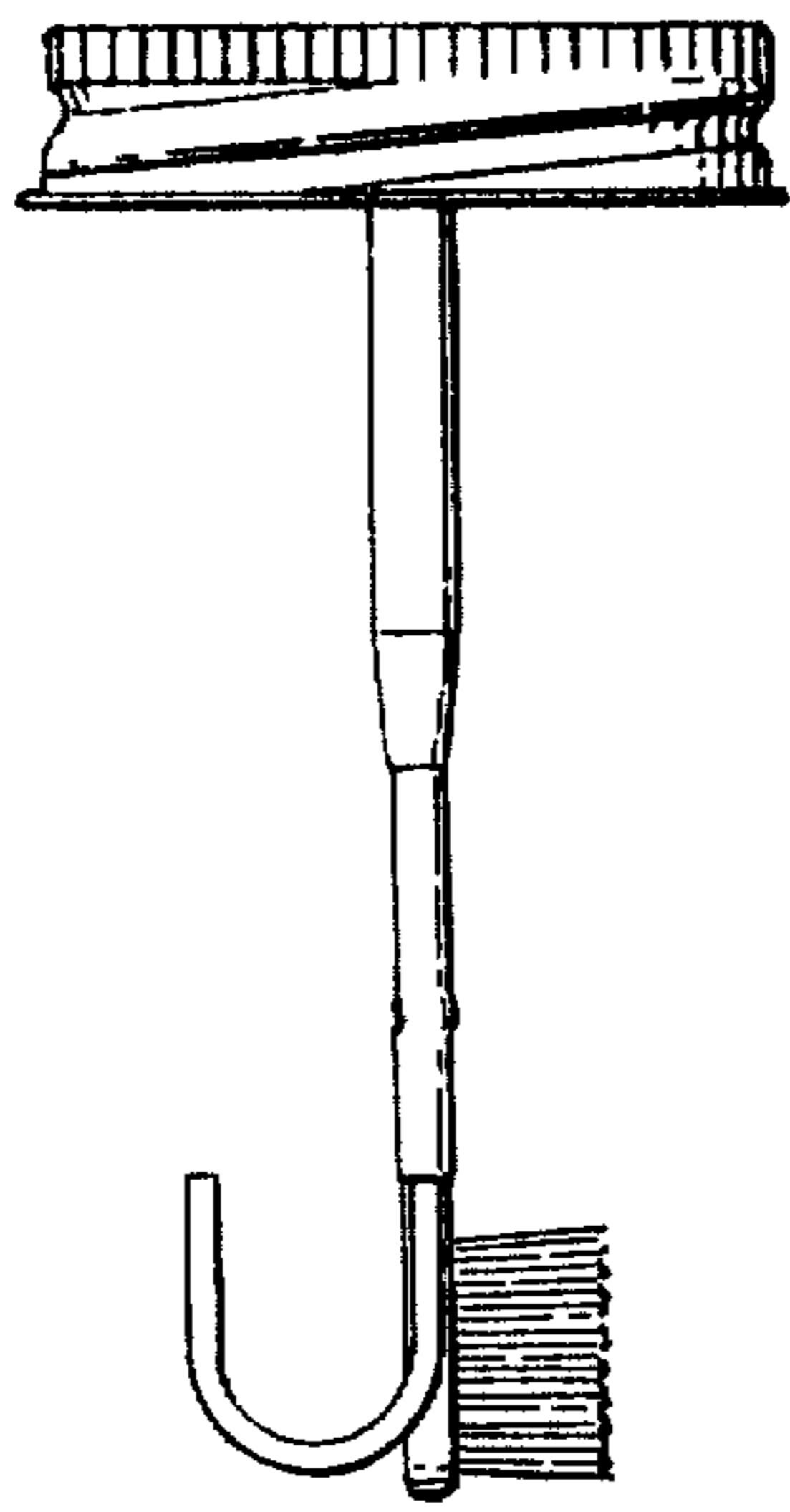

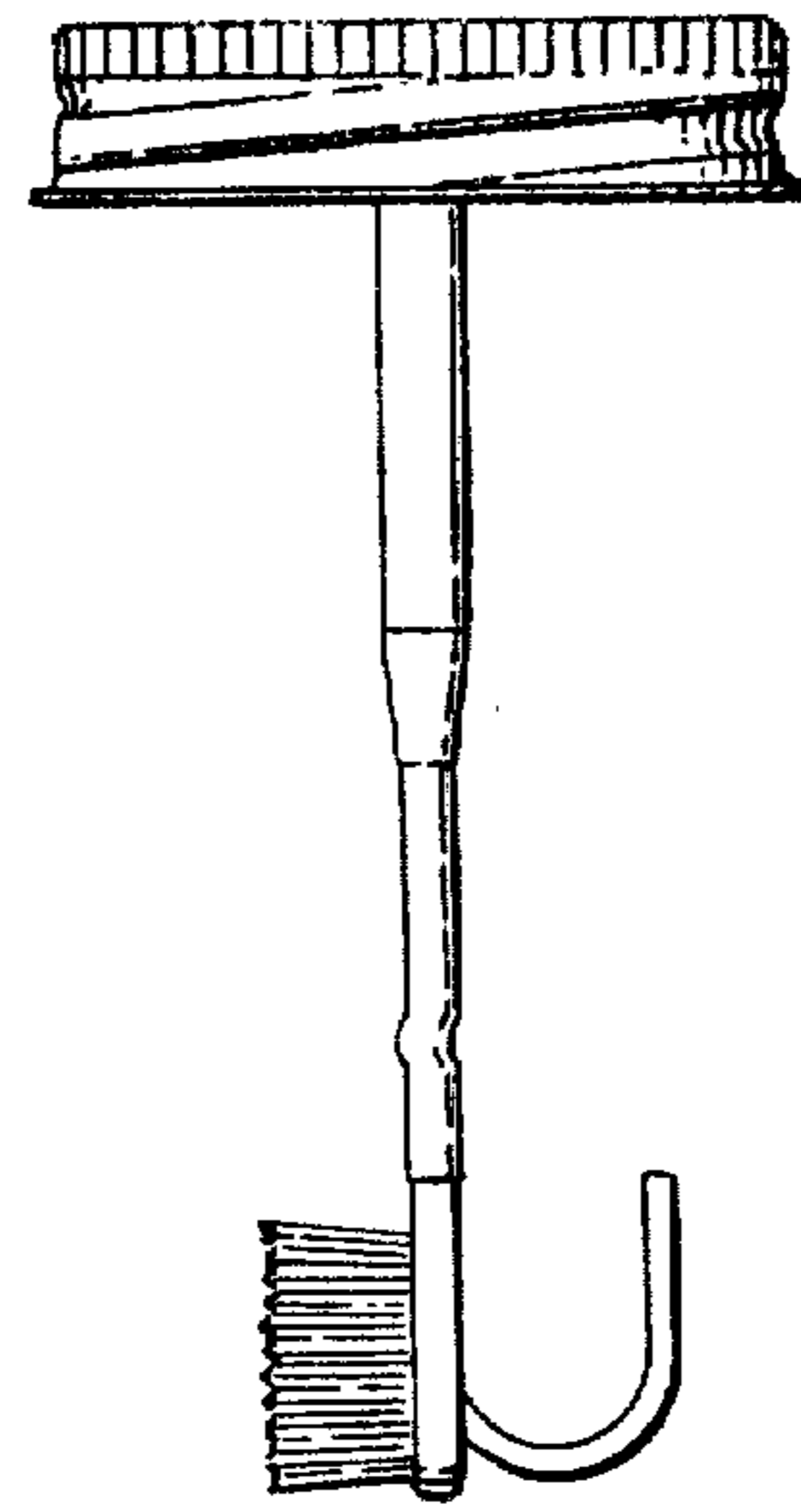

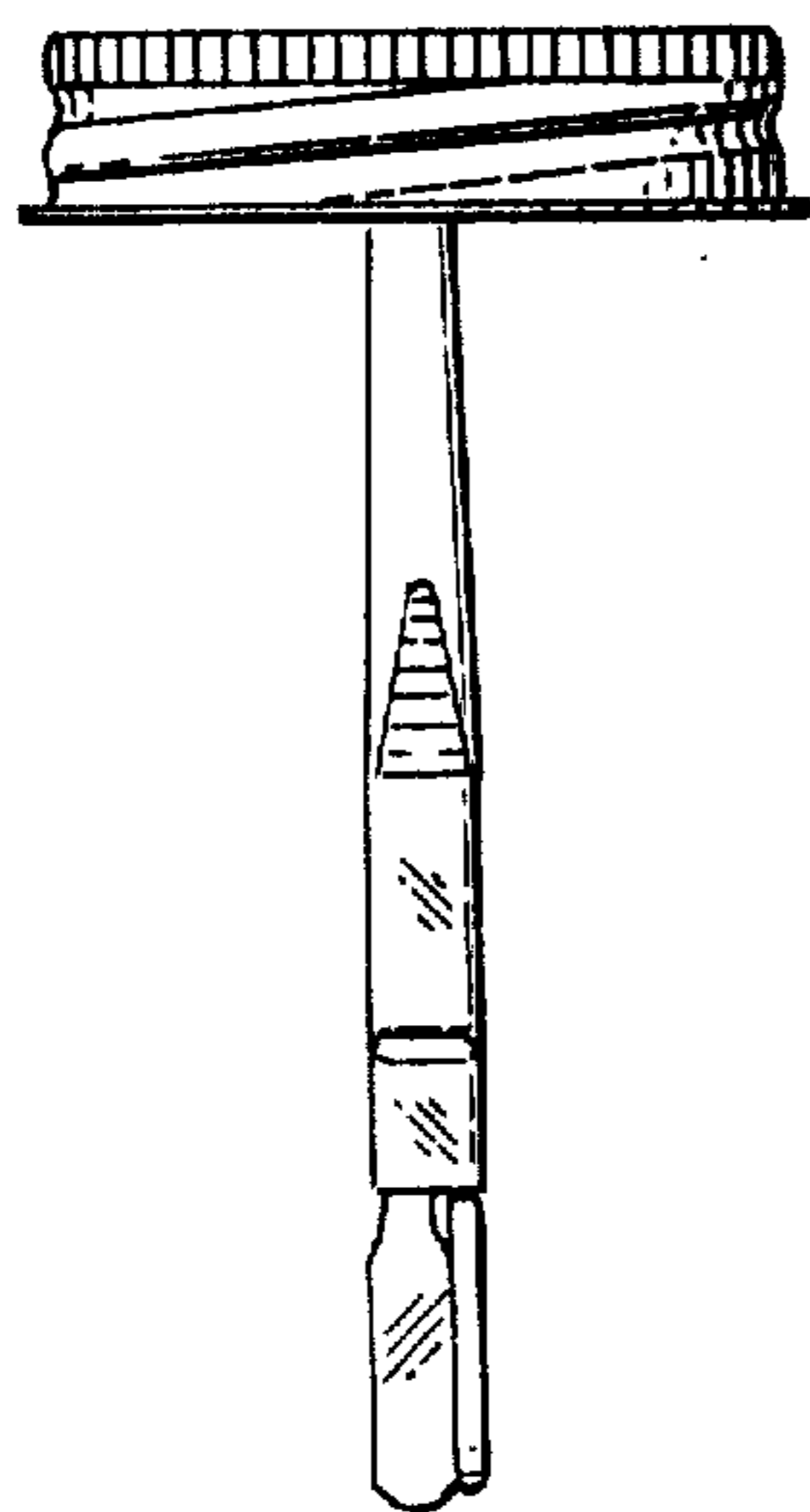

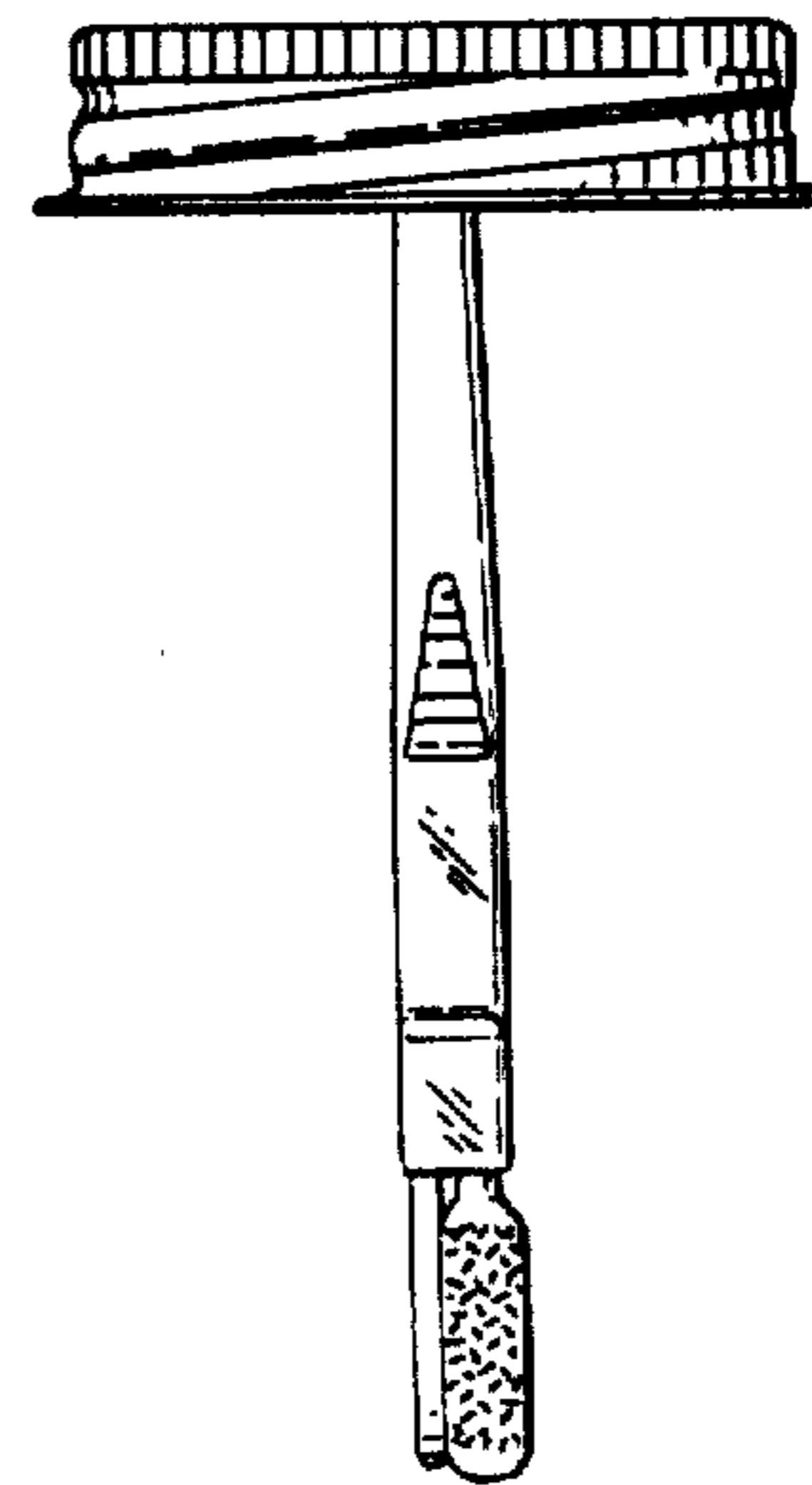

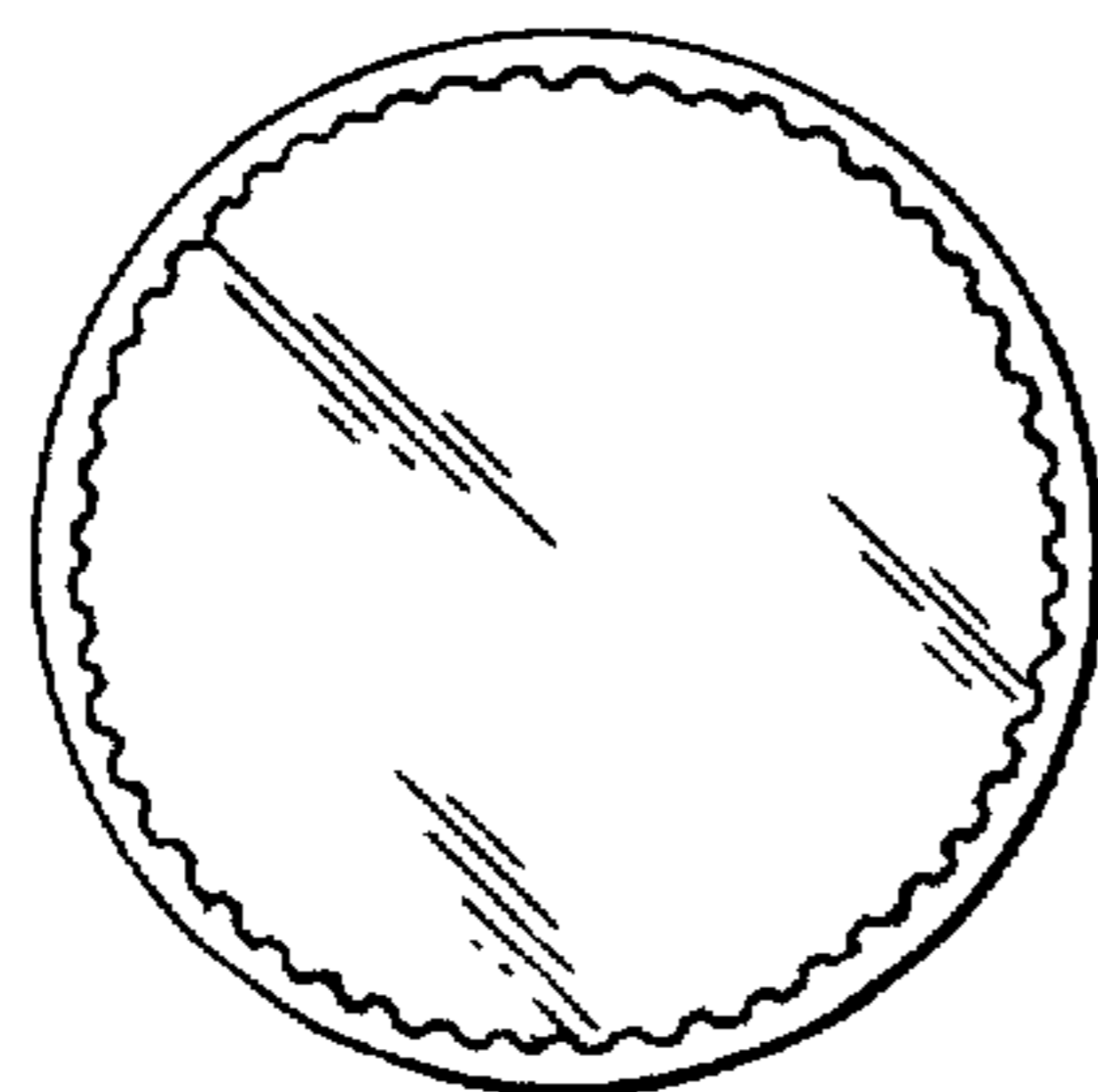

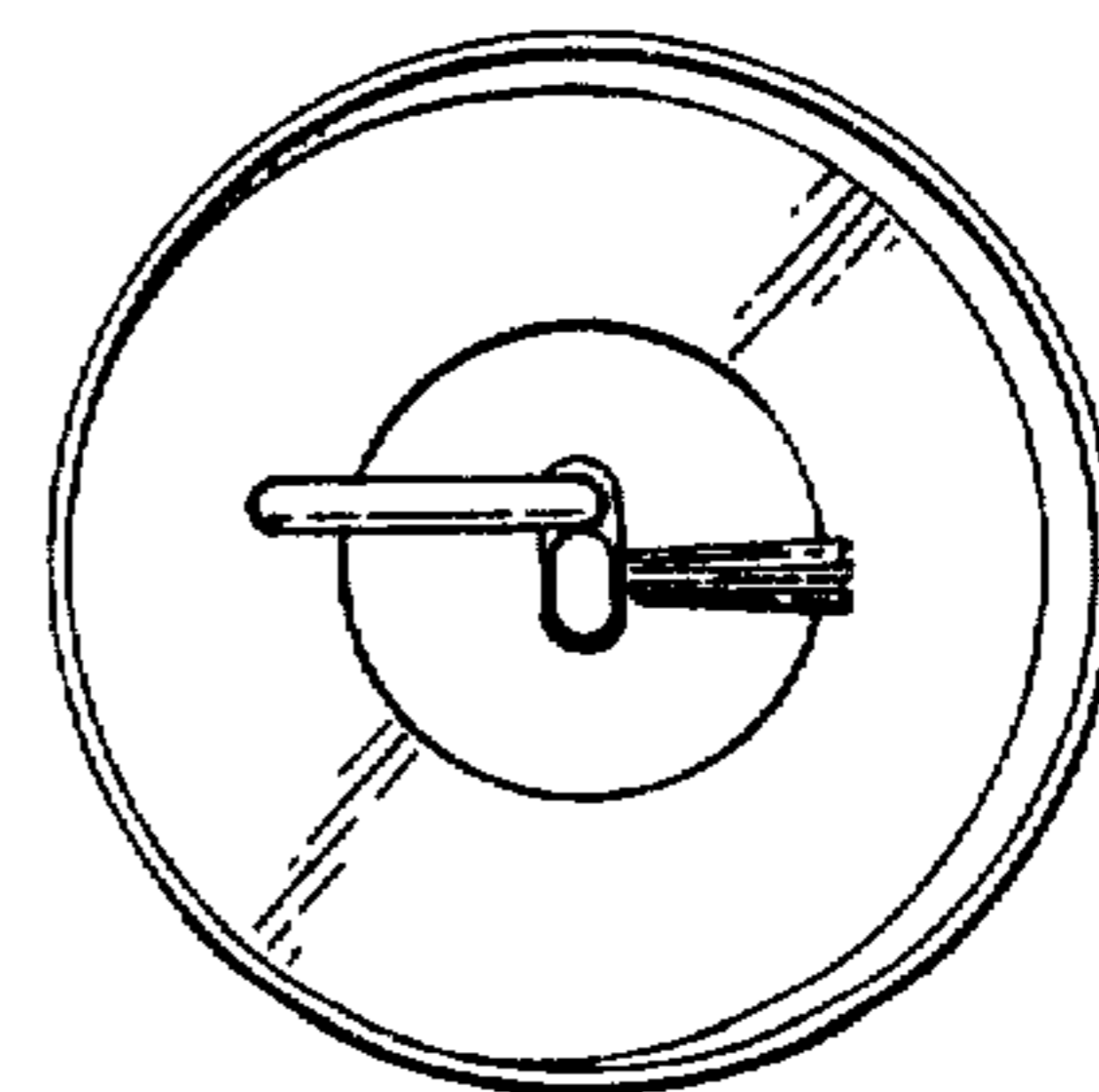
