The ornamental design for a portable two-way radio or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

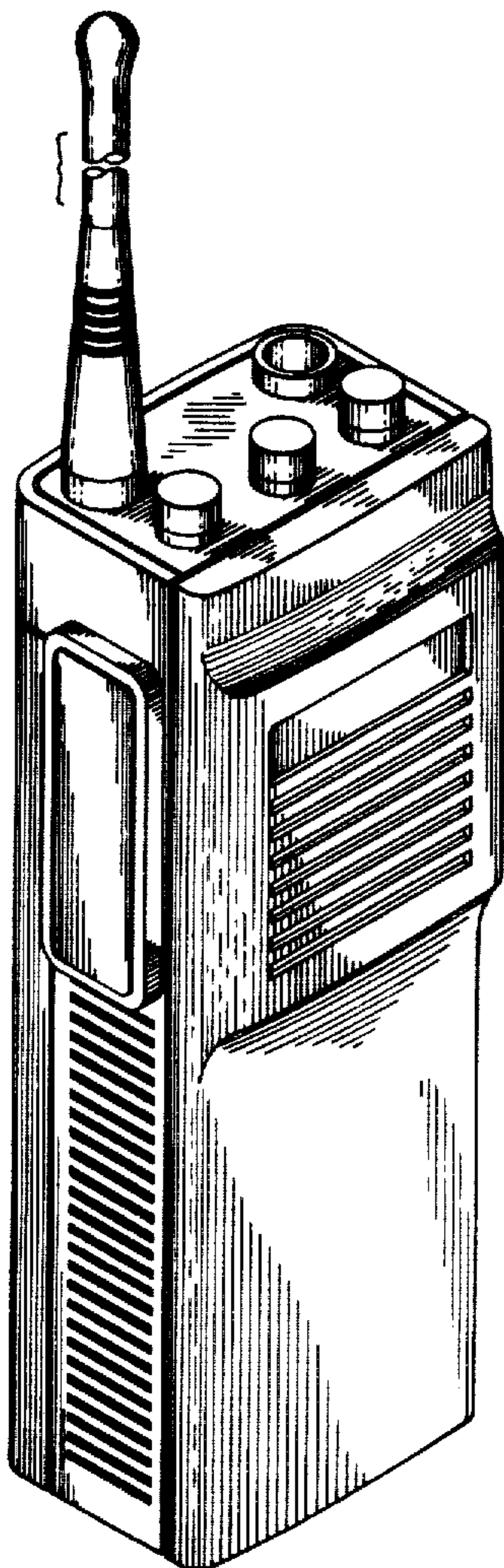
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a portable two-way radio or similar article showing our new design with the antenna shown as broken for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.



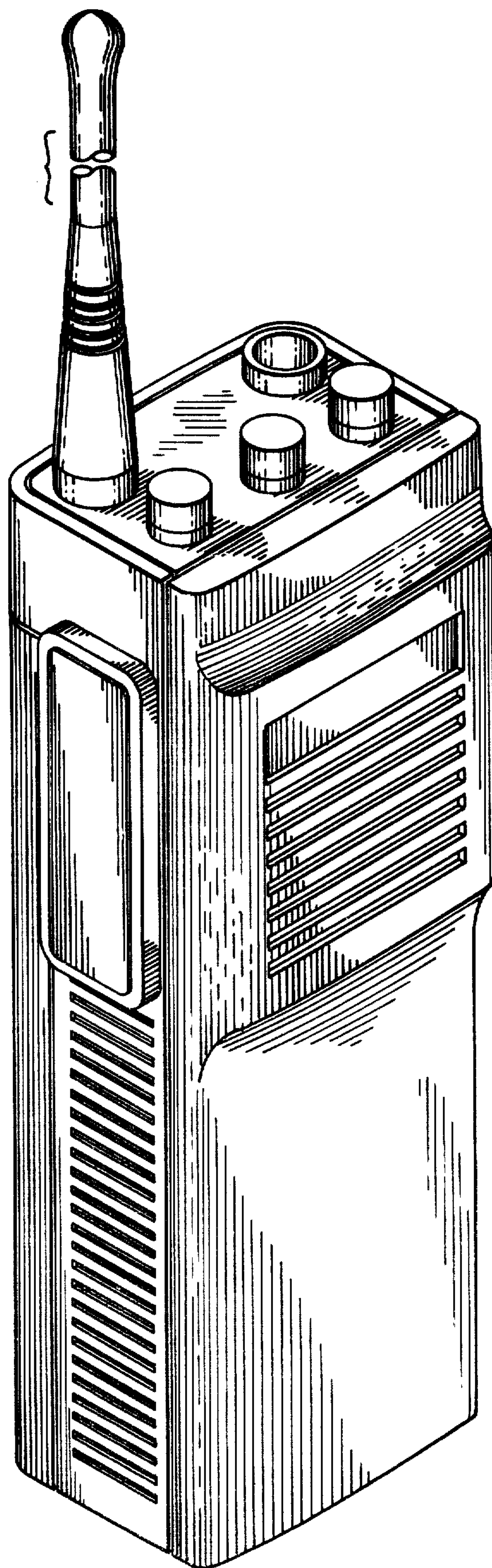

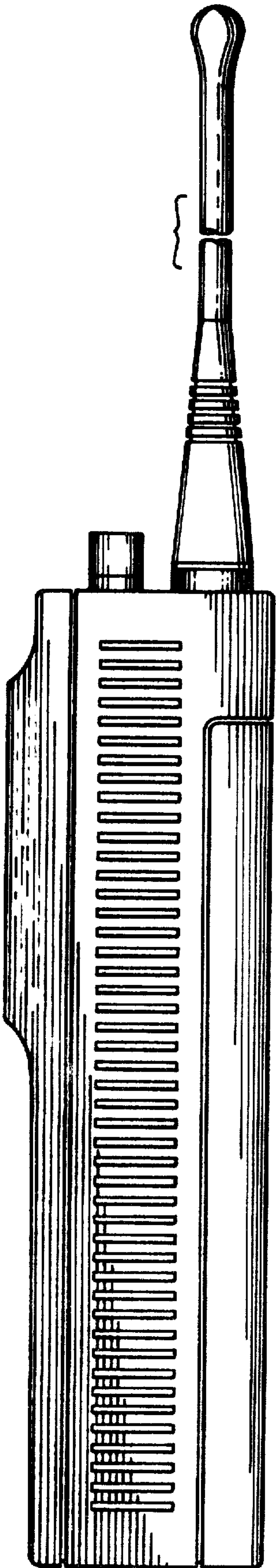

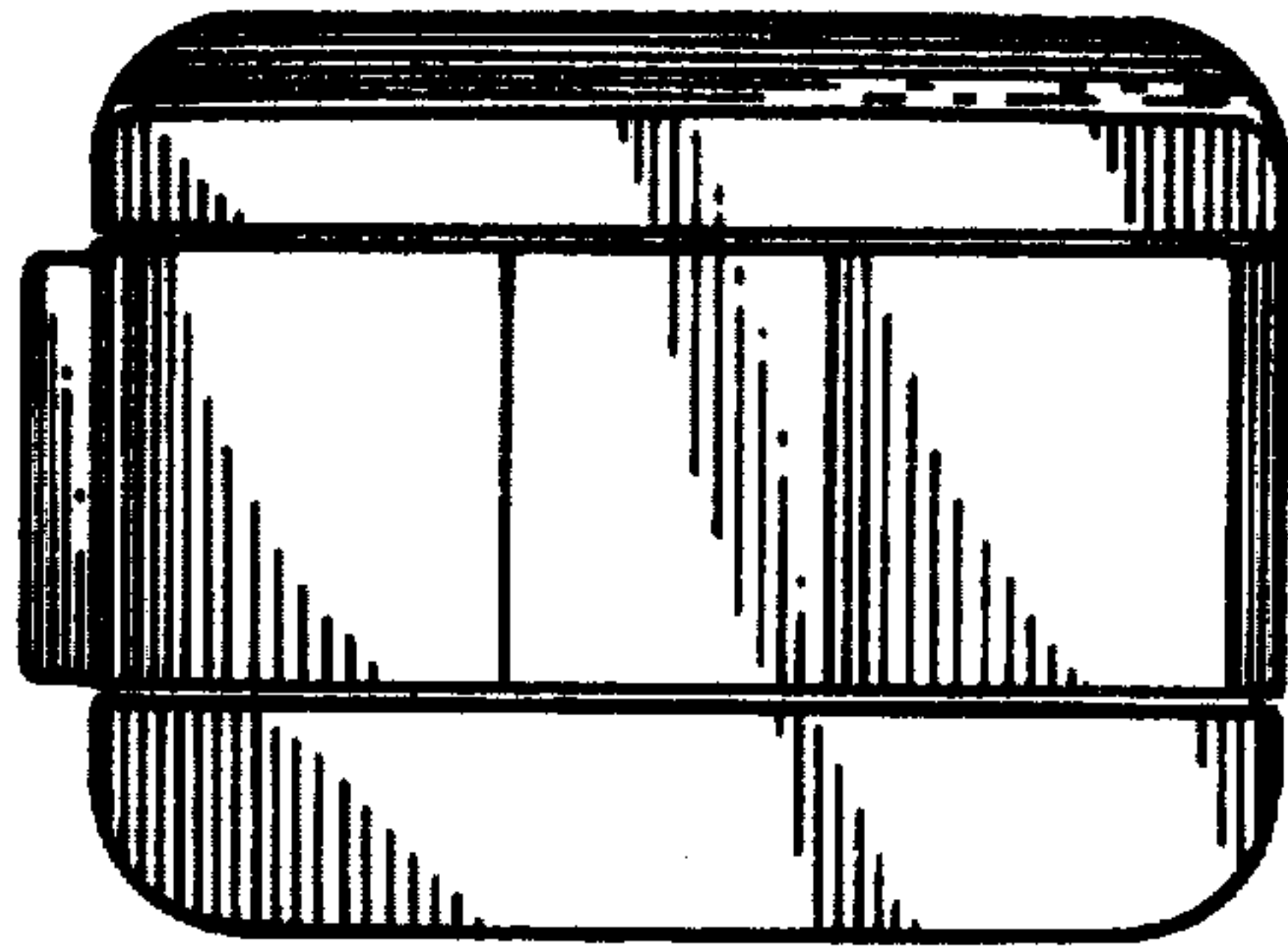
