

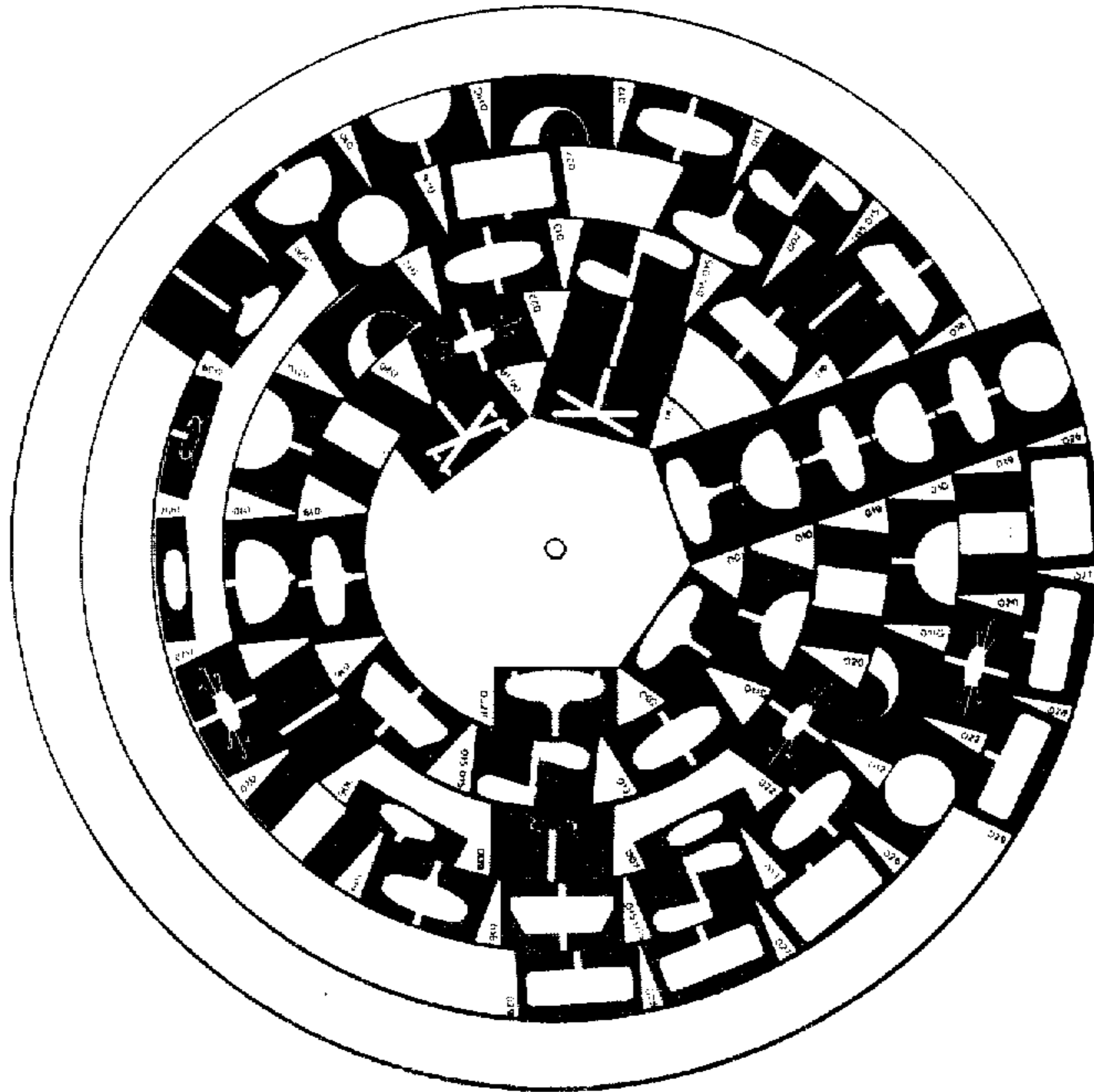

[57] **CLAIM**
 The ornamental design for a visualization disc for selecting elements of display stands, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
 FIG. 1 is a plan view of a visualization disc for selecting elements of display stands, showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a side elevational view showing the stacked arrangement of the discs such that different elements are combined by rotating concentric disc units.



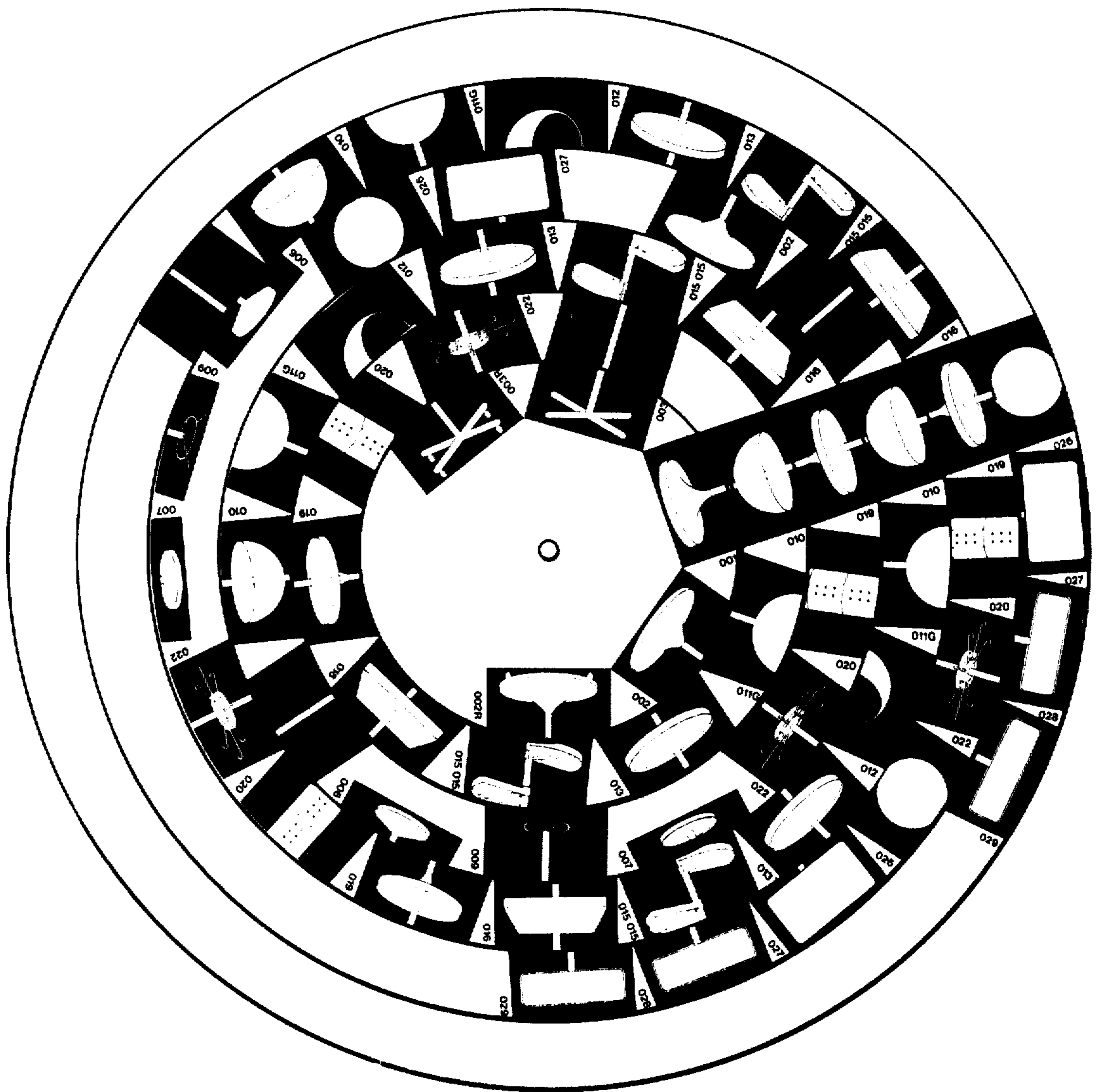
