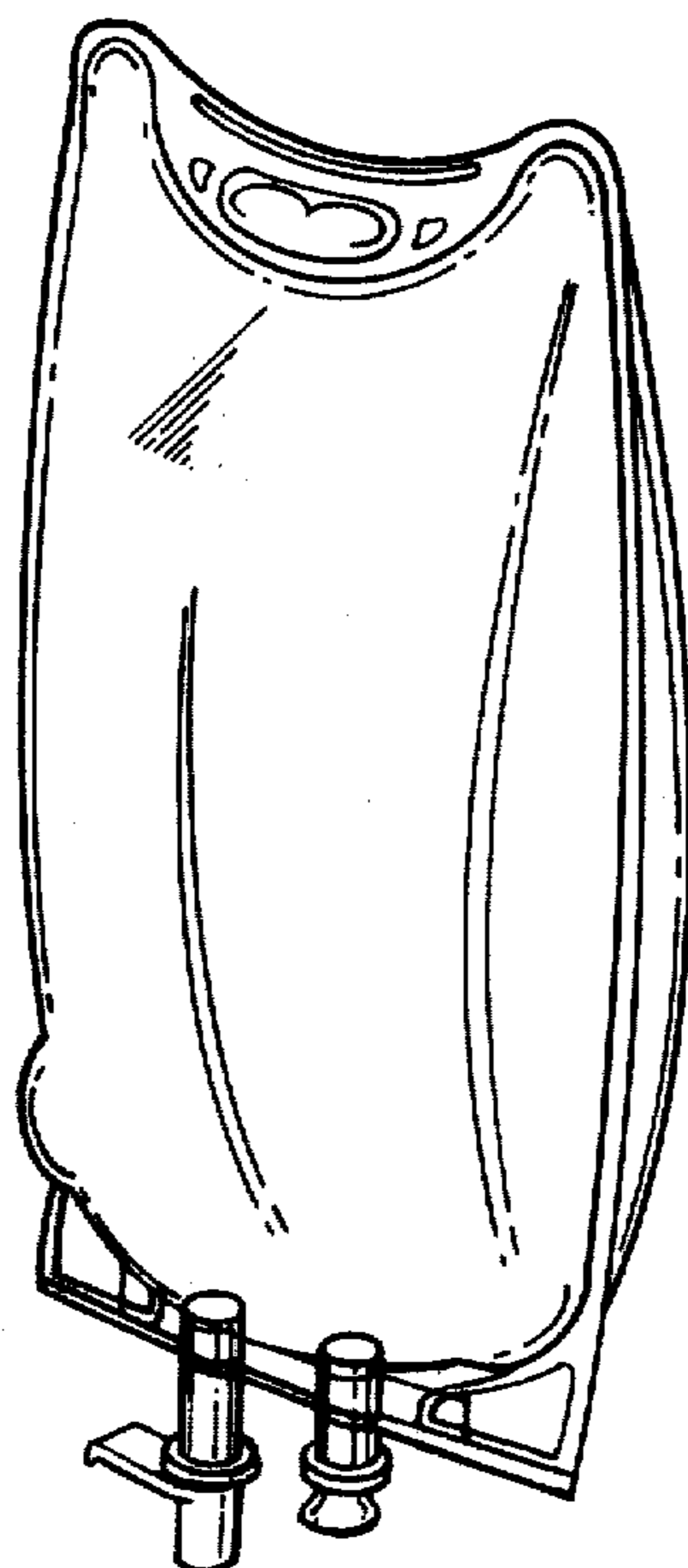

The ornamental design for a container for medical liquids, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a container for medical liquids showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.



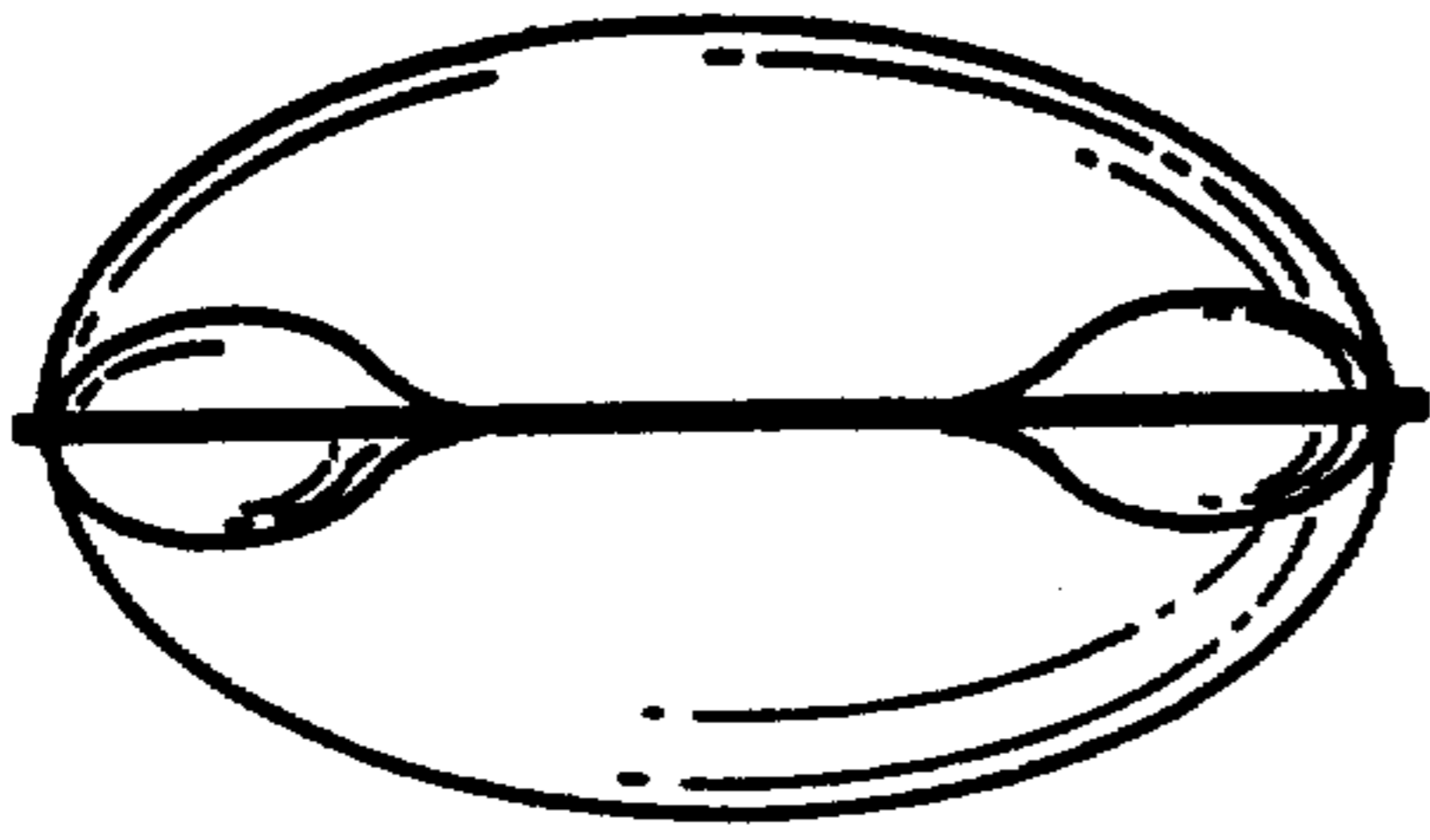

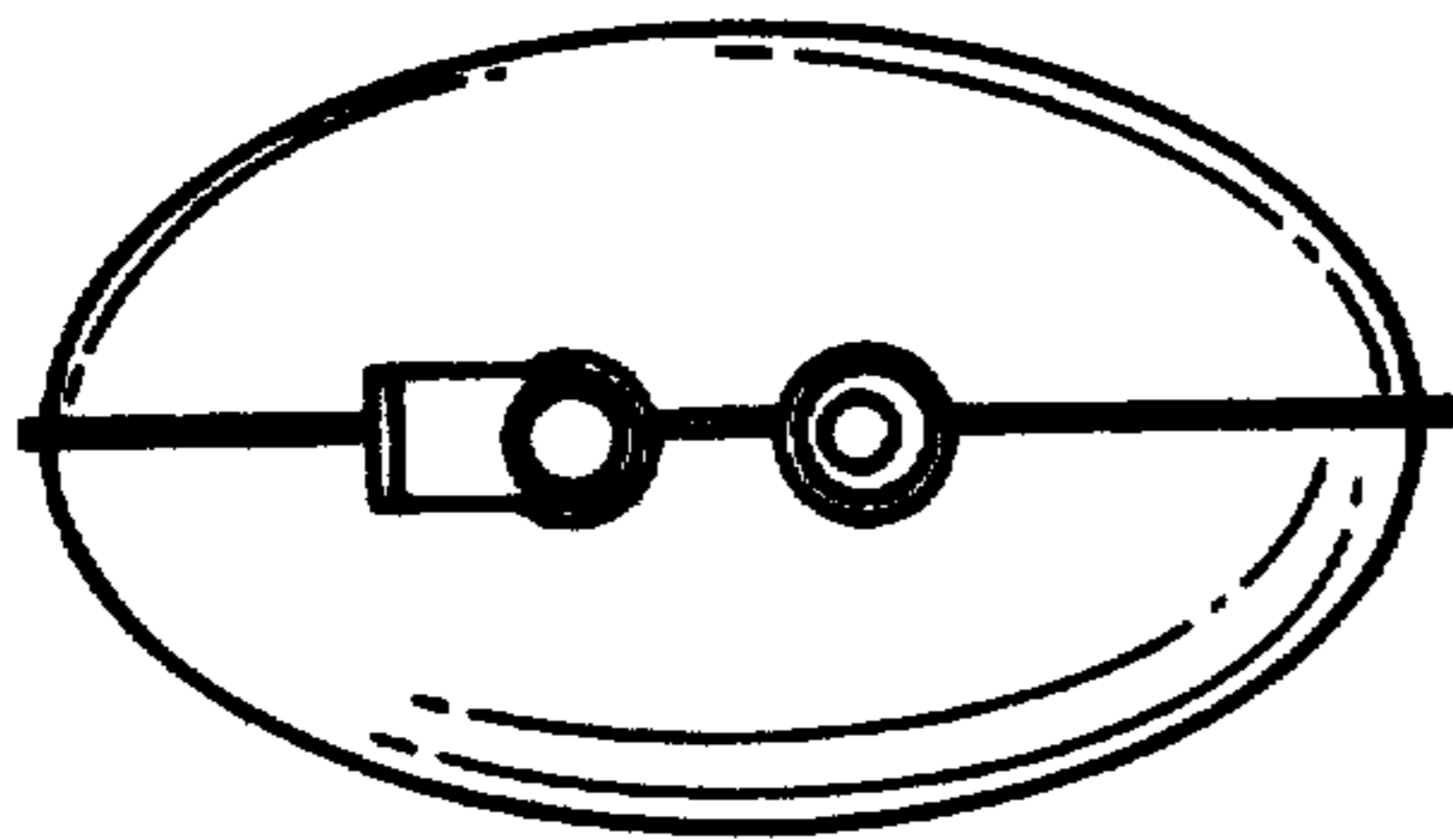

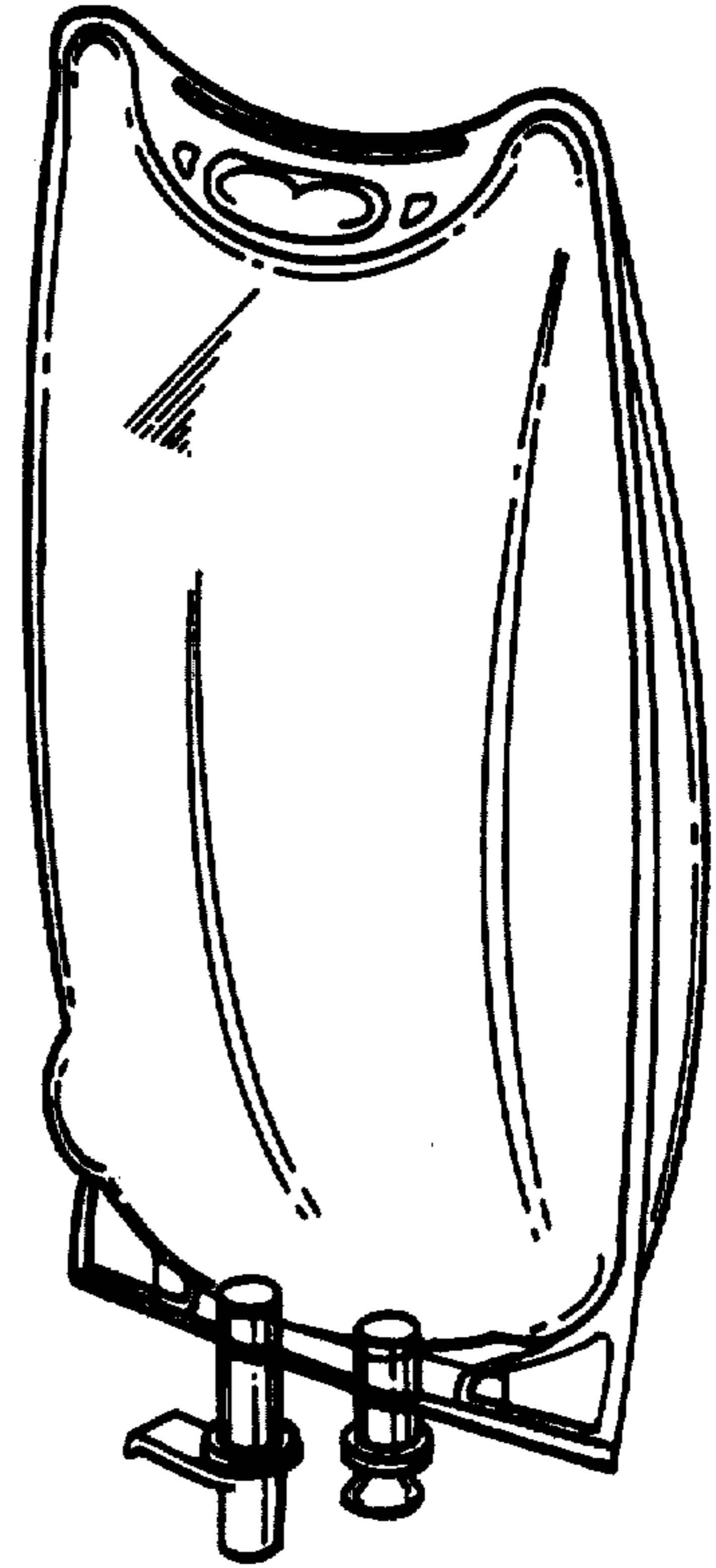

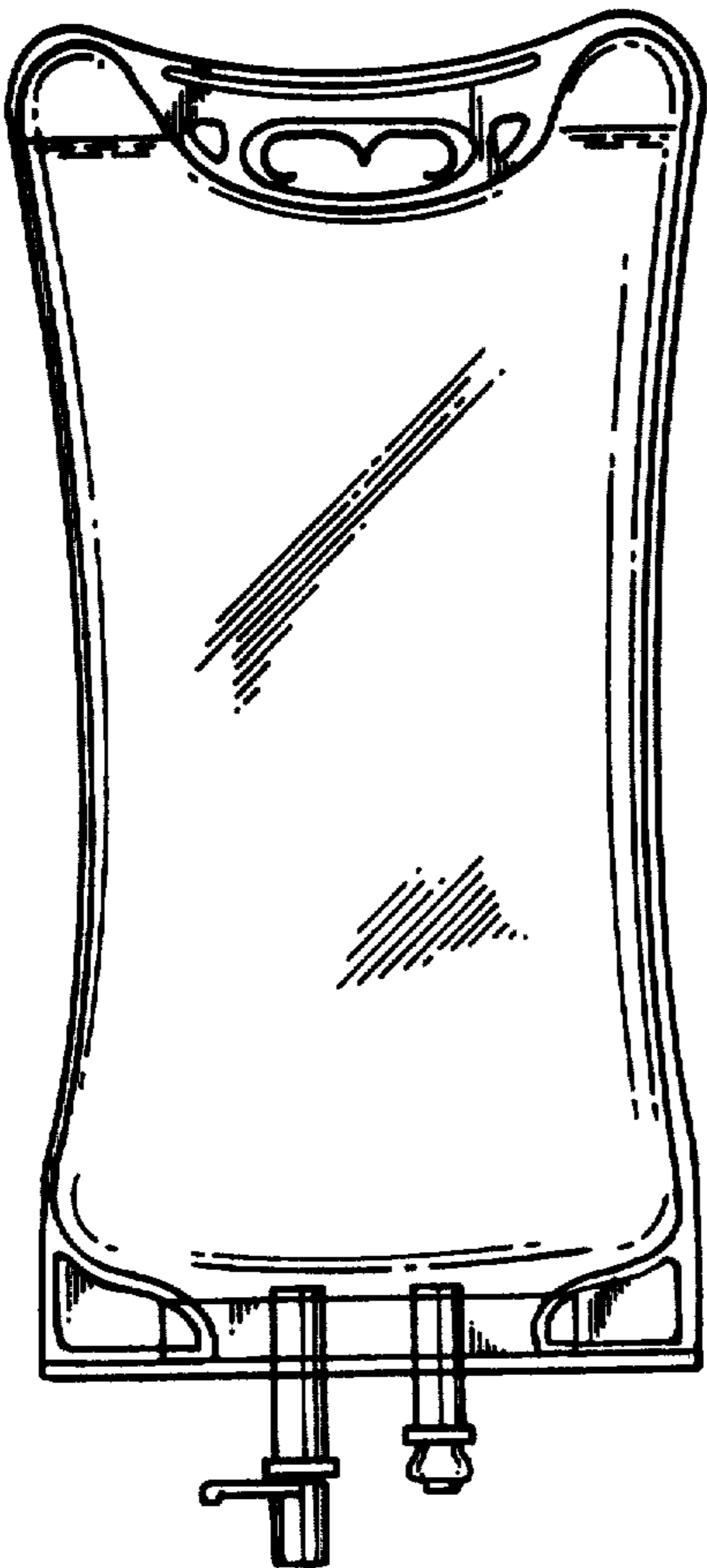

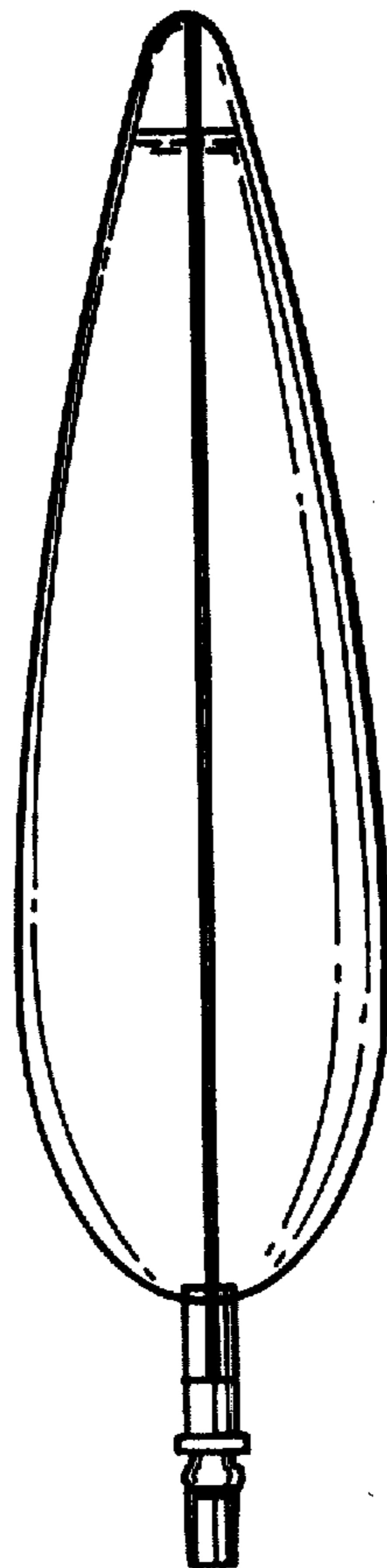

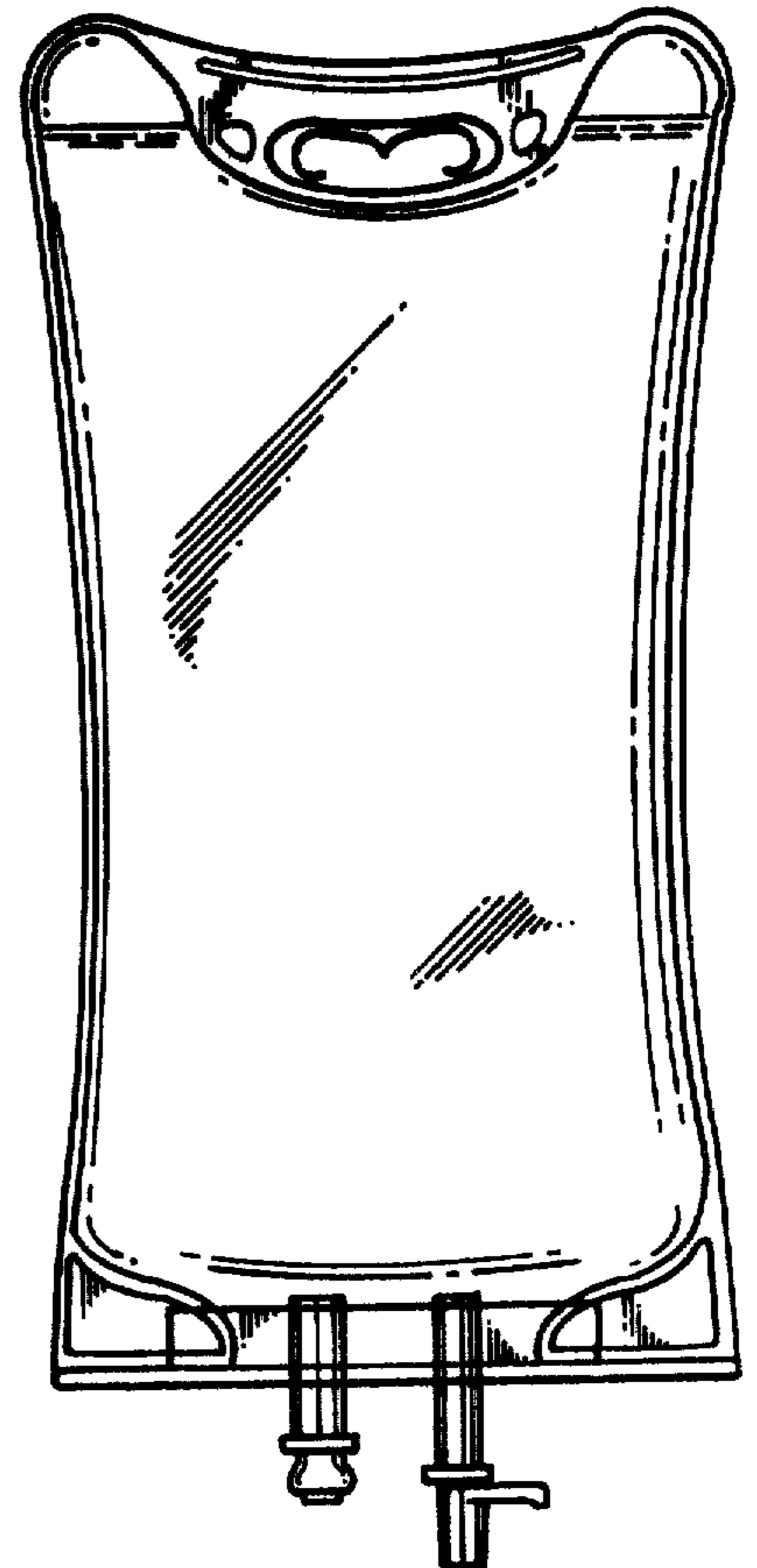
