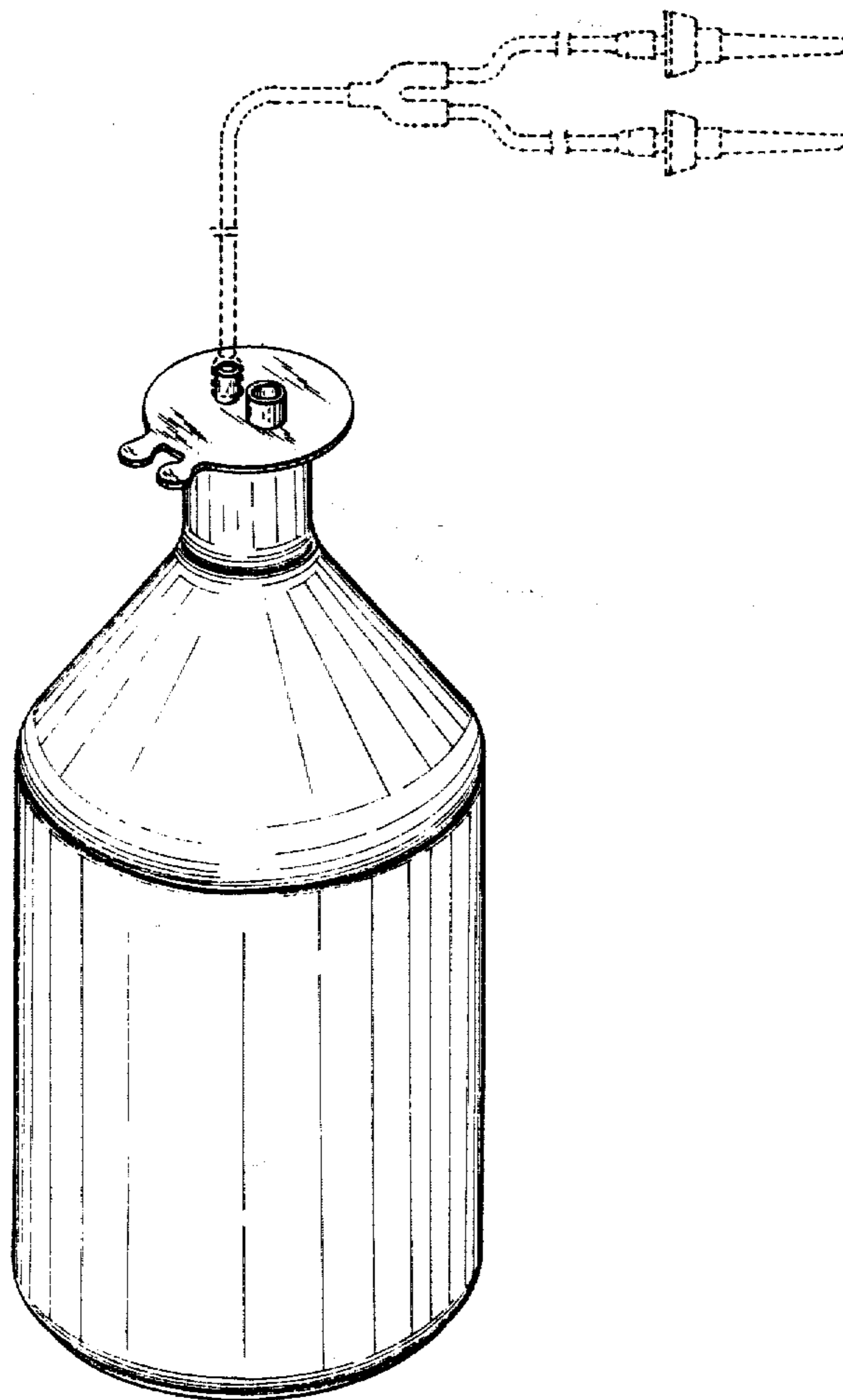

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle for retaining blood, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a bottle for retaining blood showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top front perspective view of a modified embodiment of the bottle illustrated in FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a broken plan view thereof. The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only.



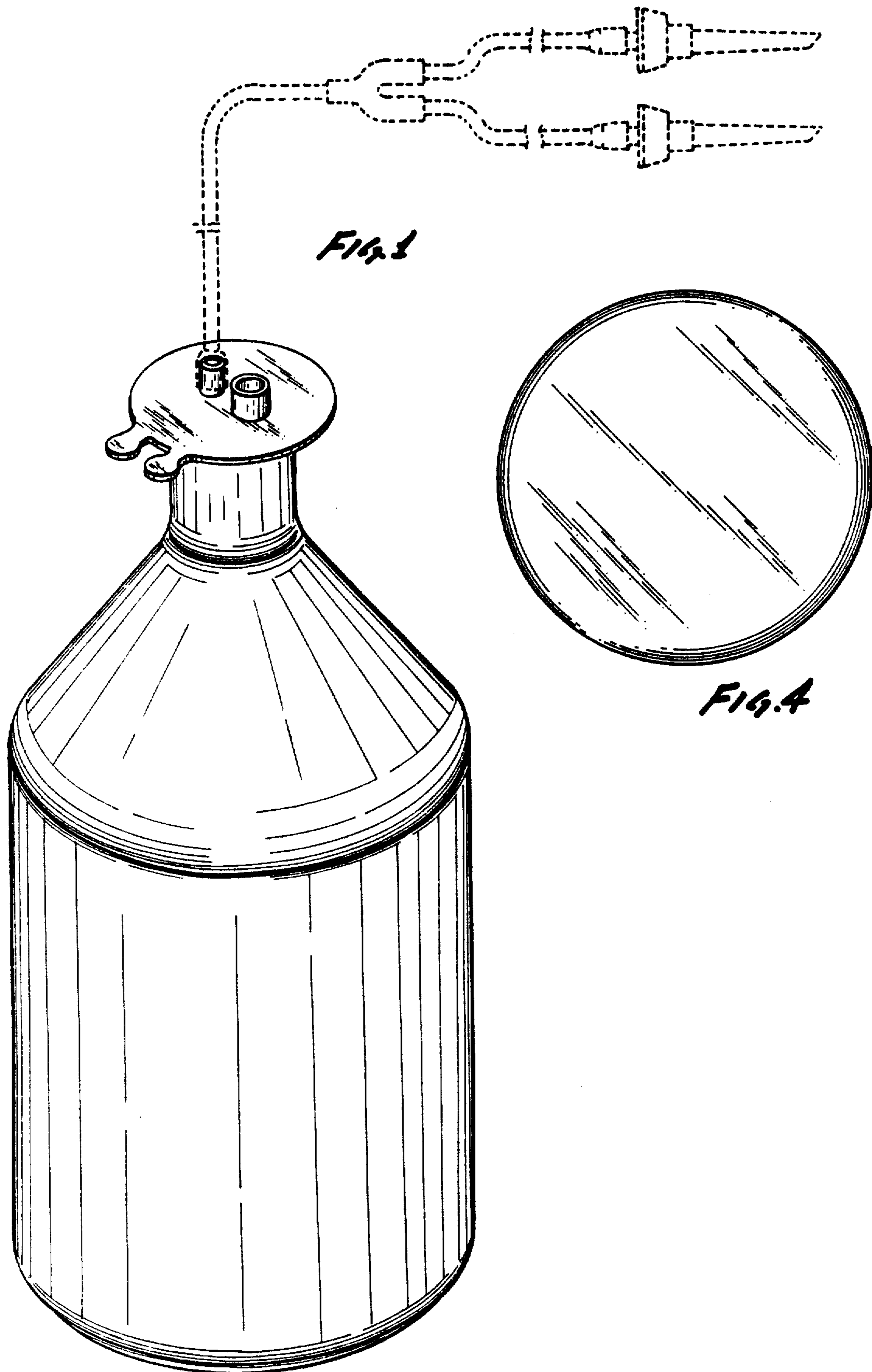

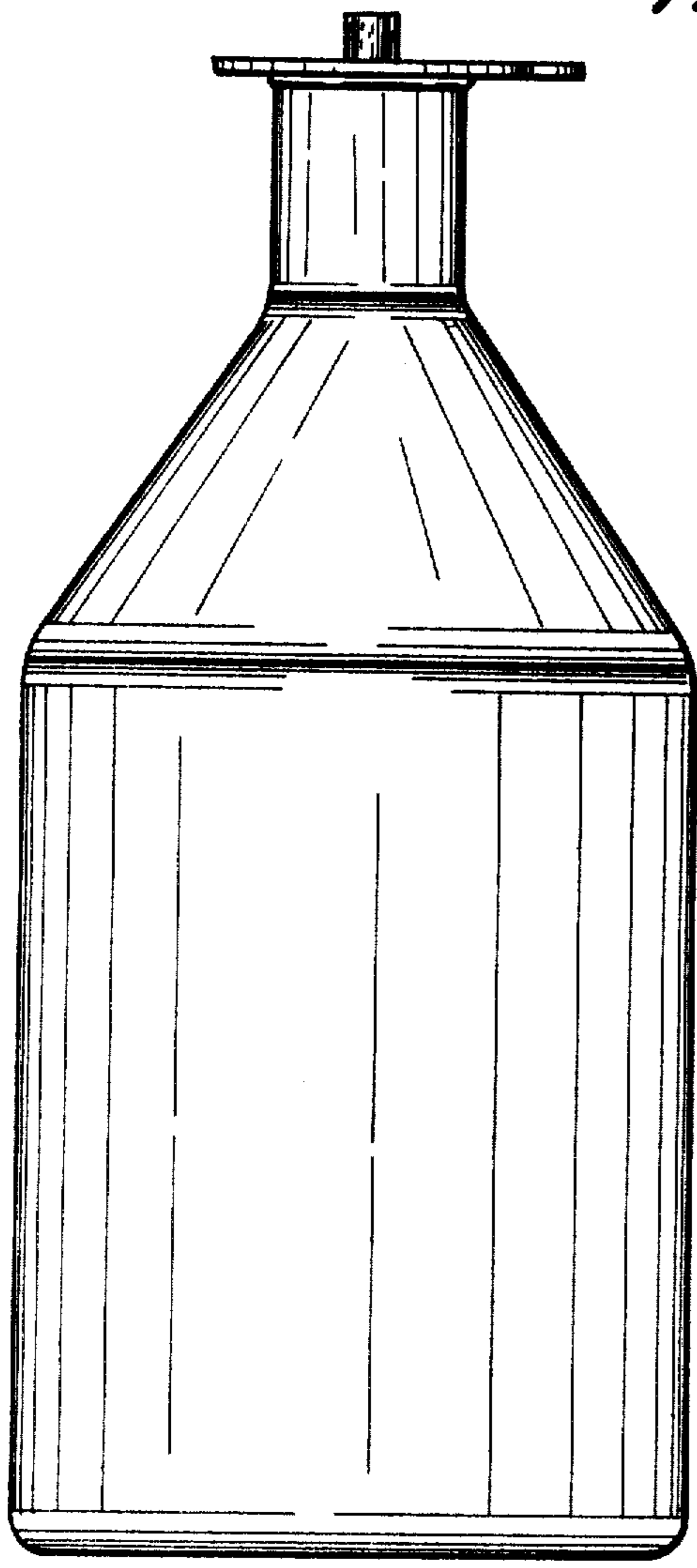
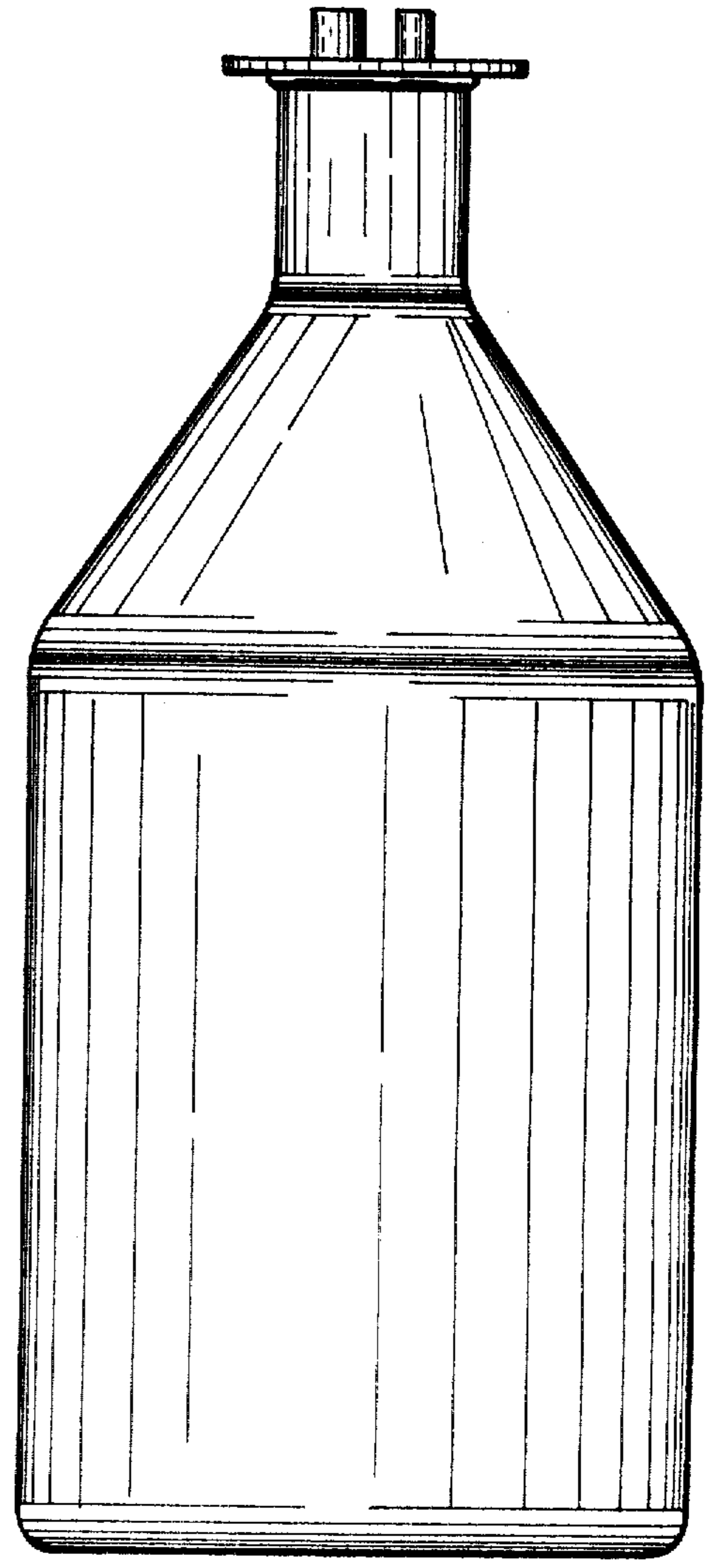

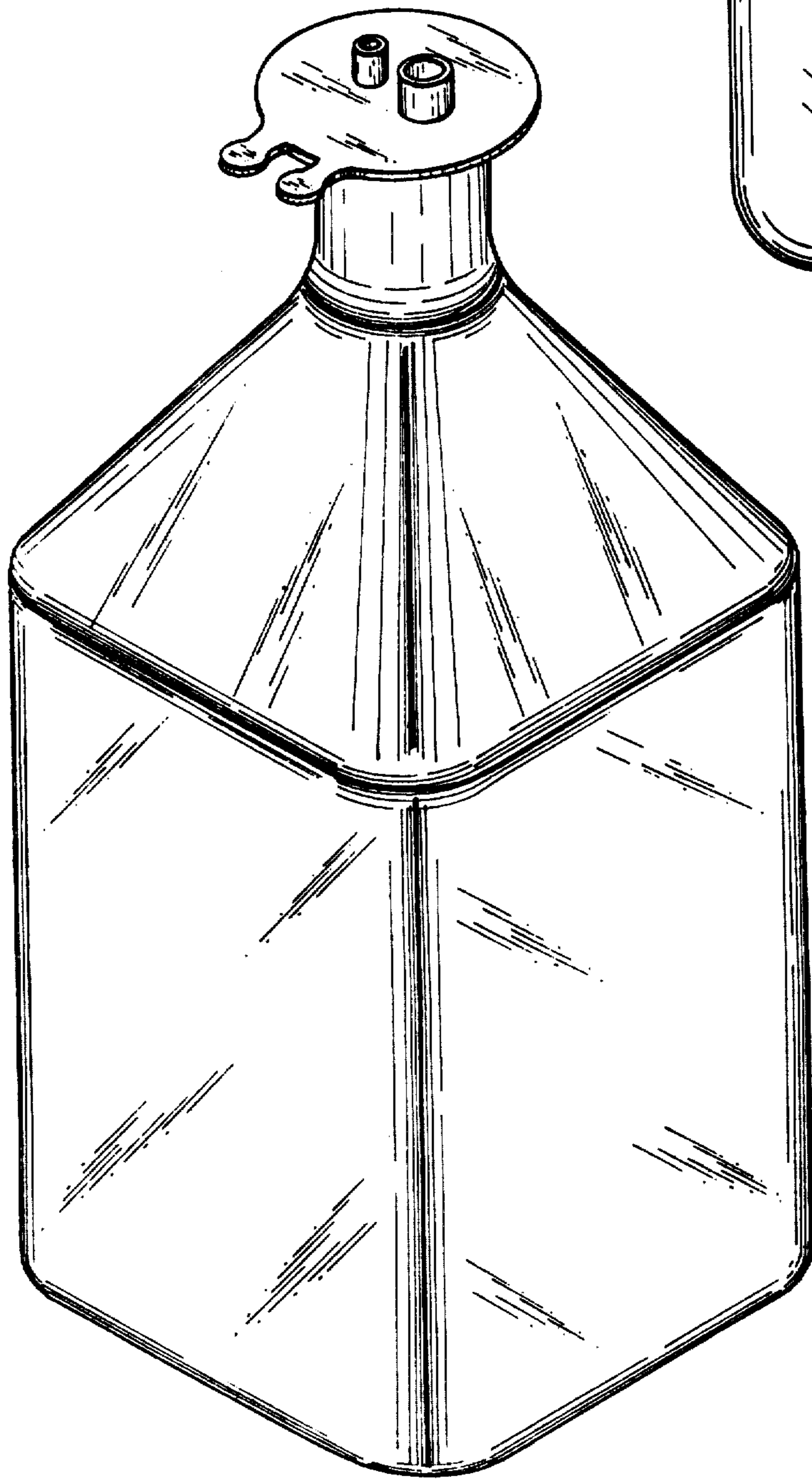

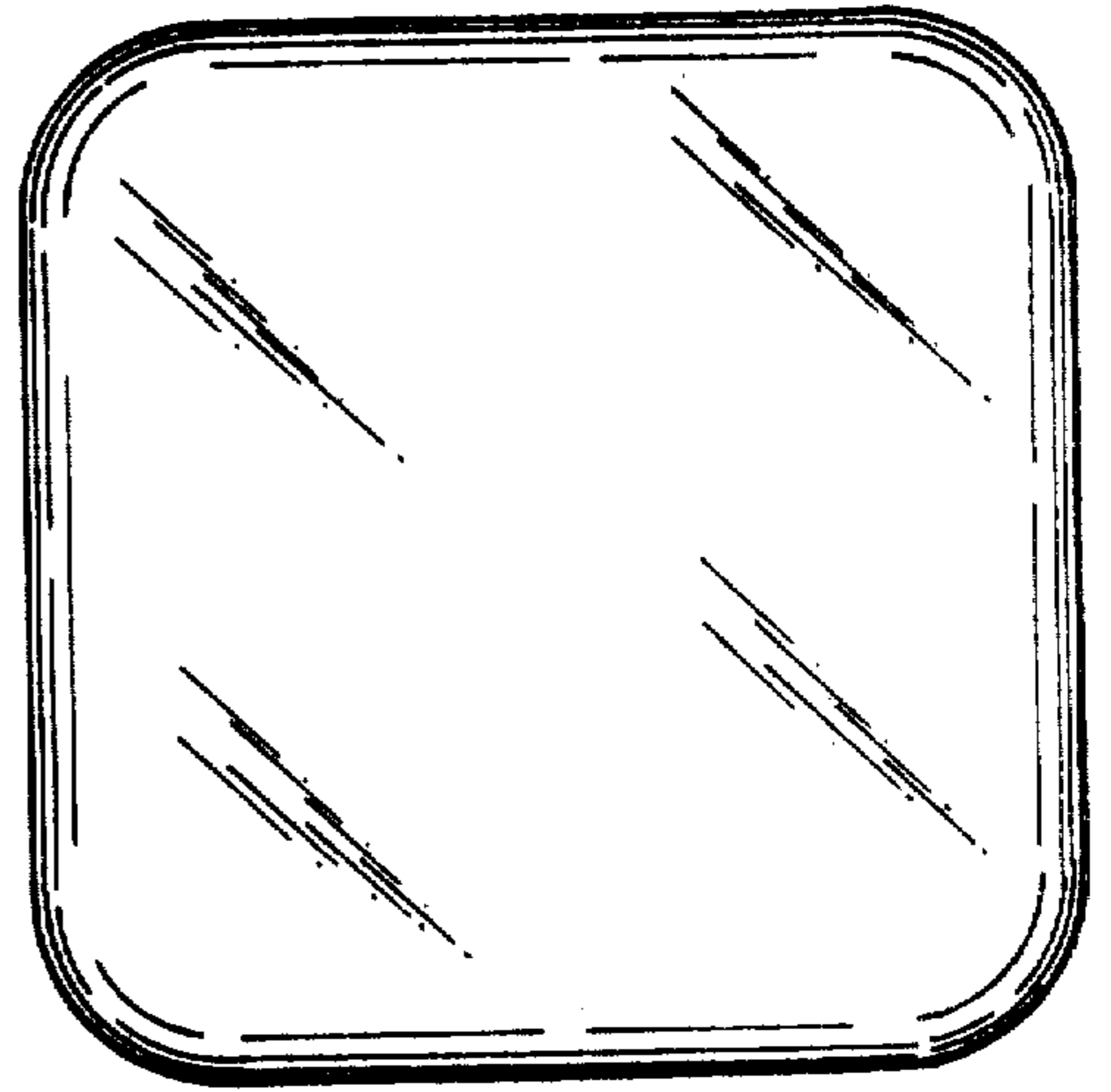
