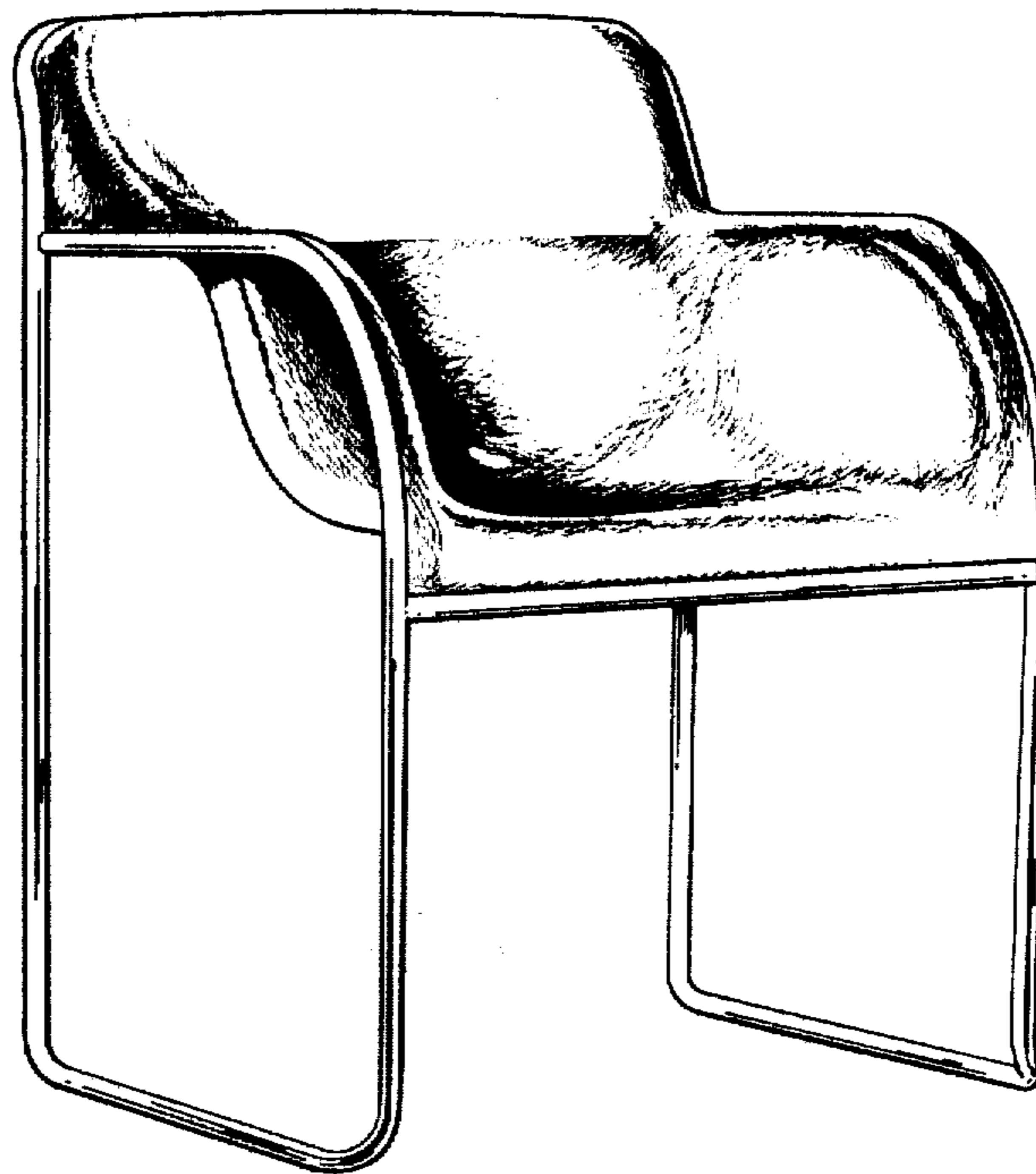

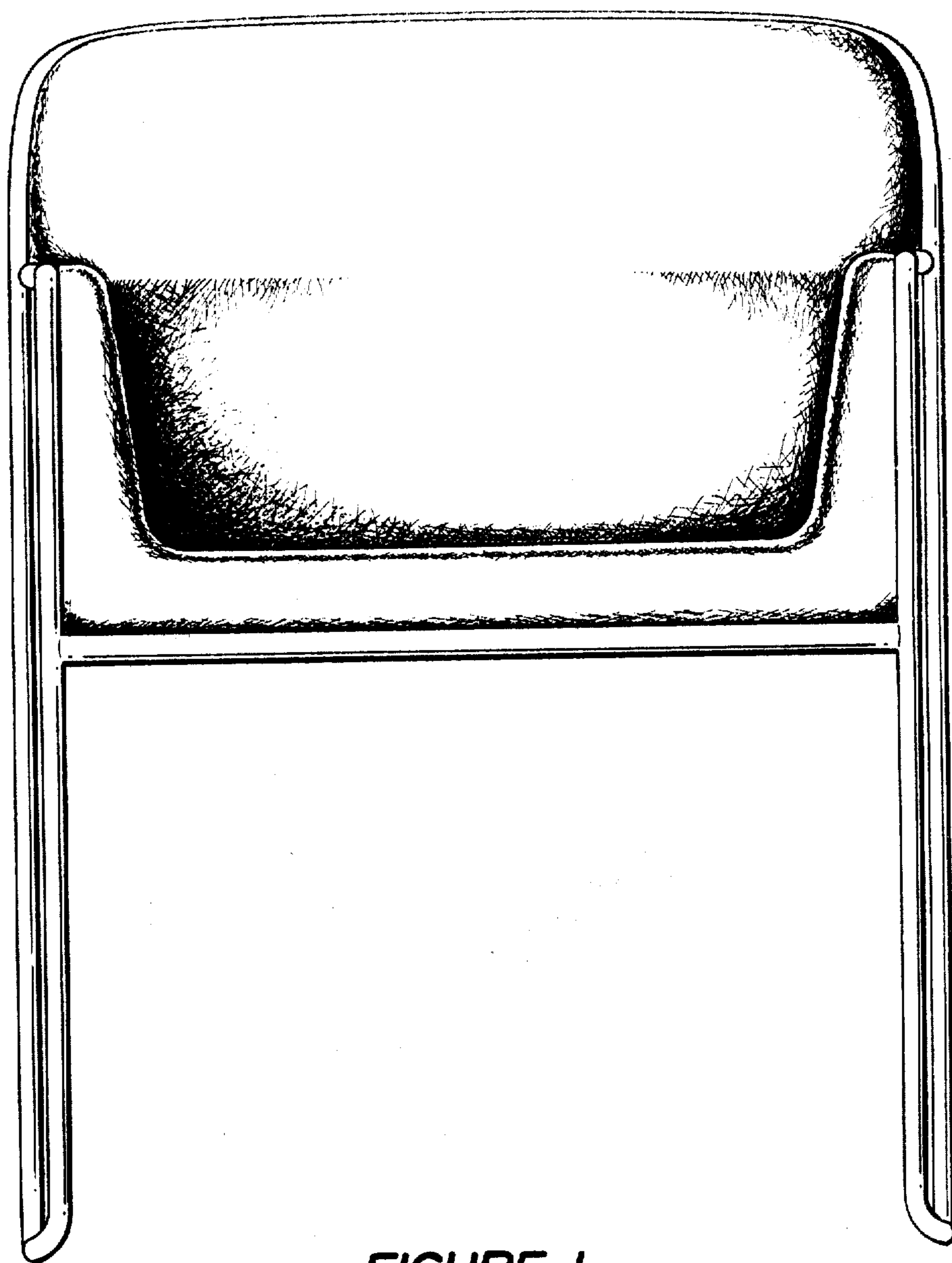

**DESCRIPTION**

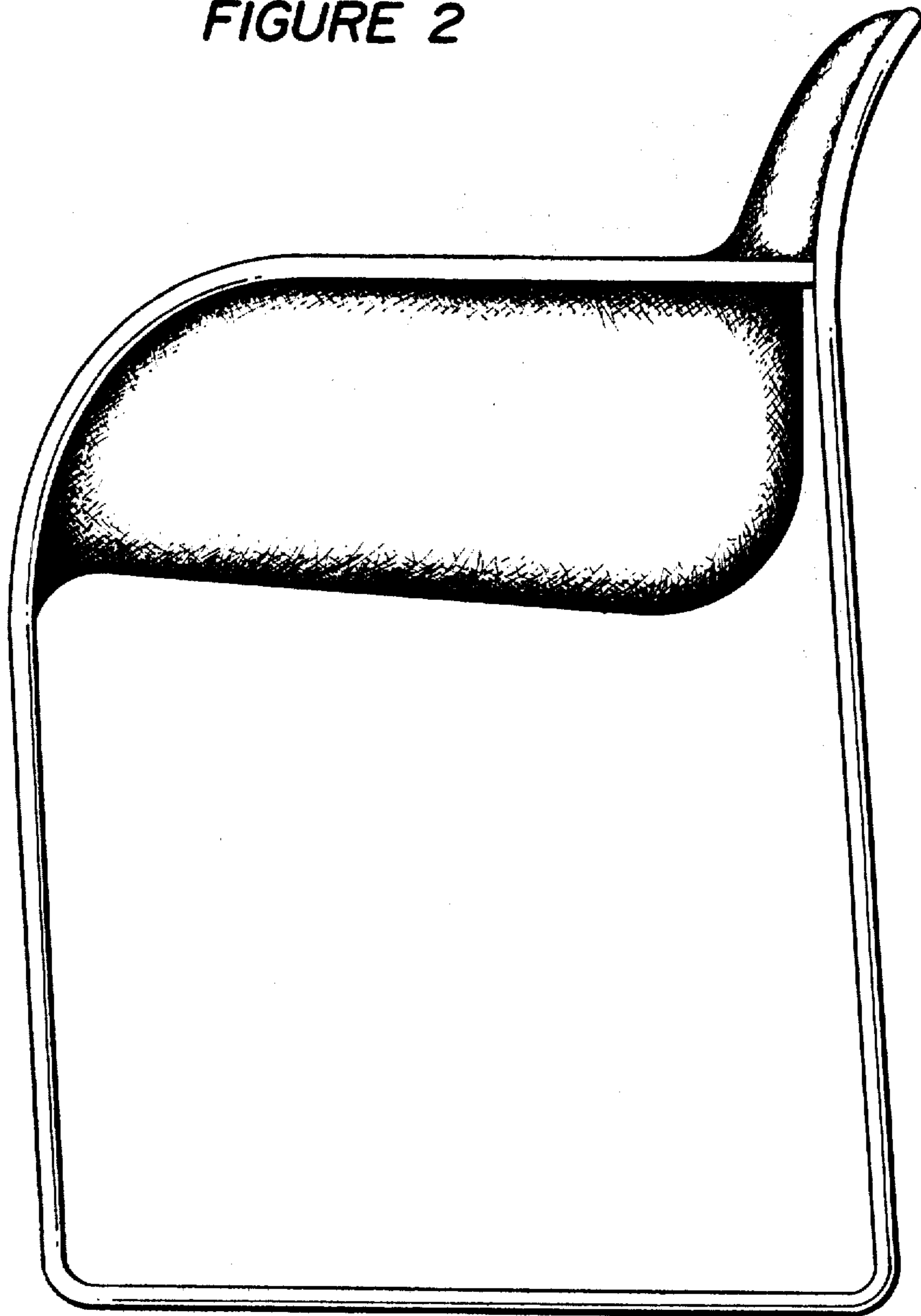
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair embodying my new design;

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof.

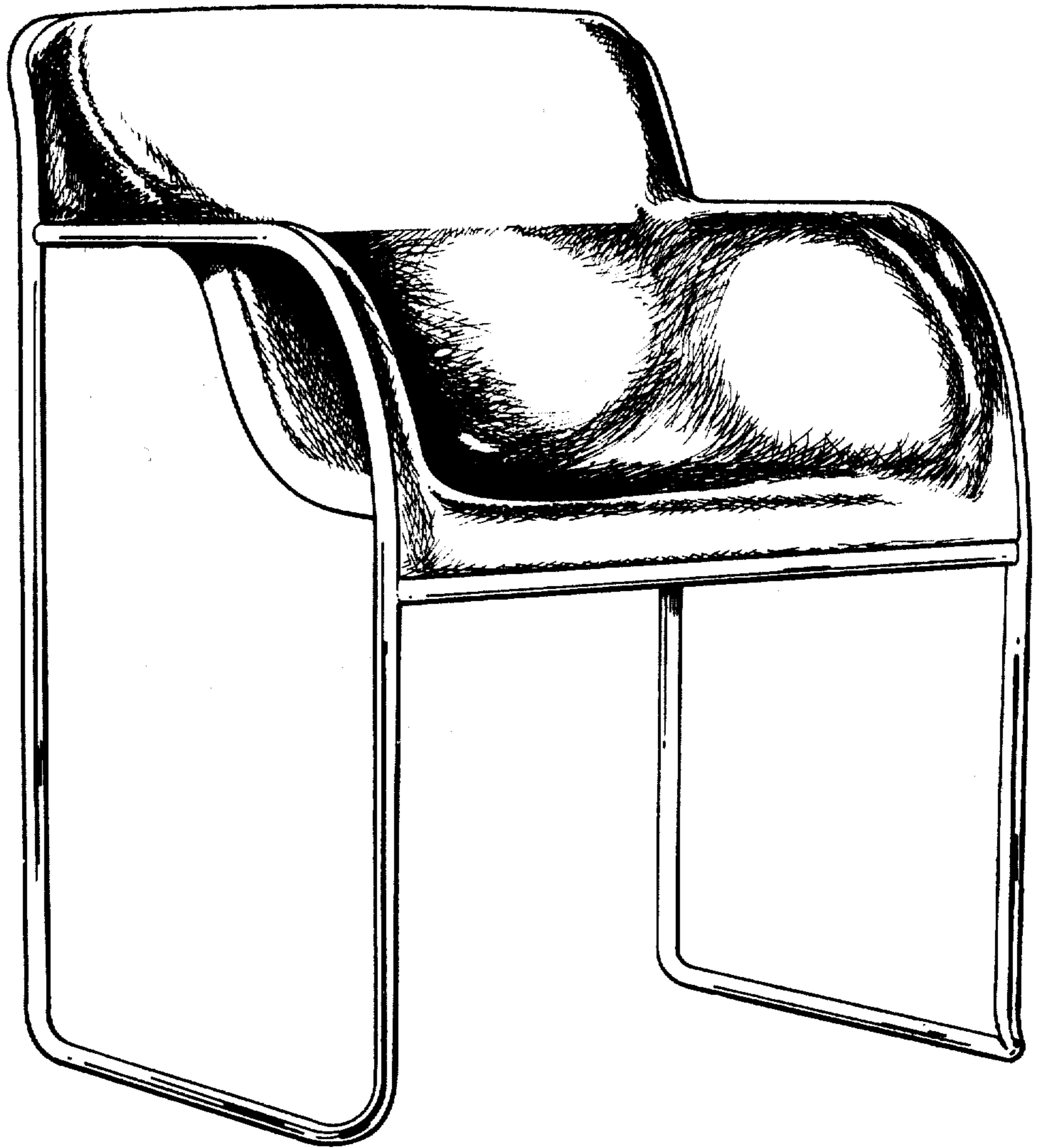




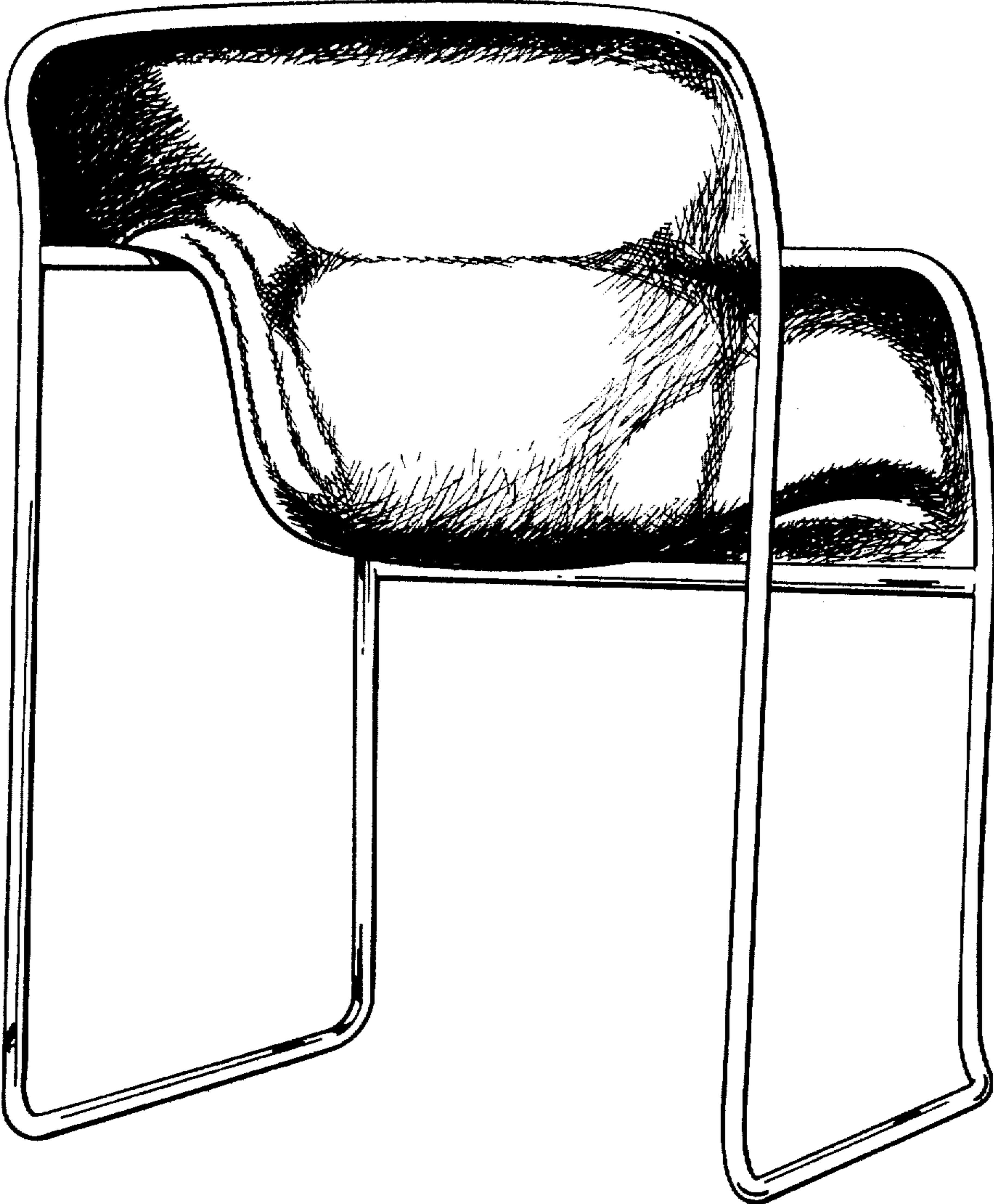
