The ornamental design for a windshield wiper products cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

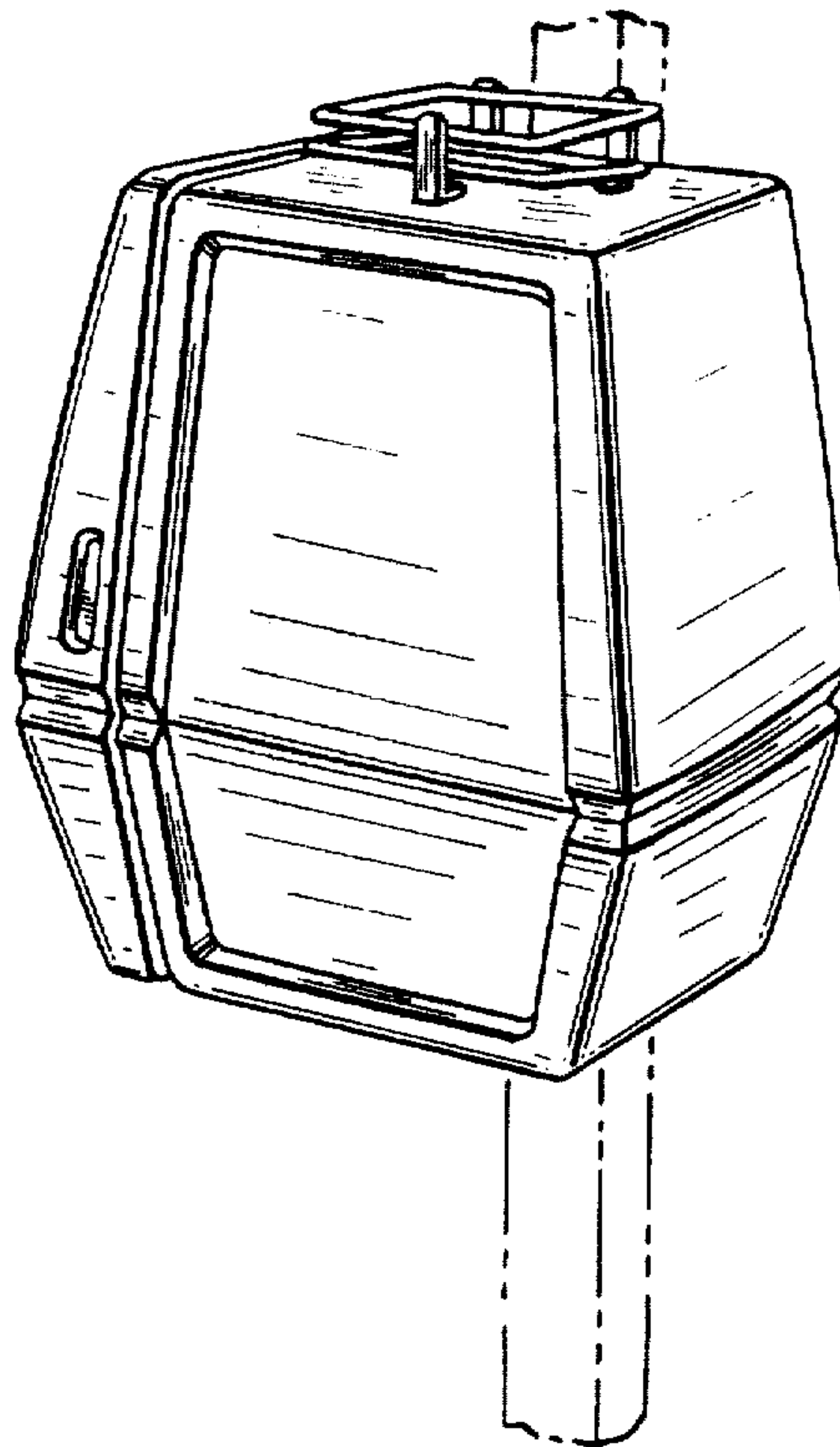
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a windshield wiper products cabinet showing my new design, the portion of a mounting post being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being unornamented; and

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1; the side opposite being a mirror image thereof.



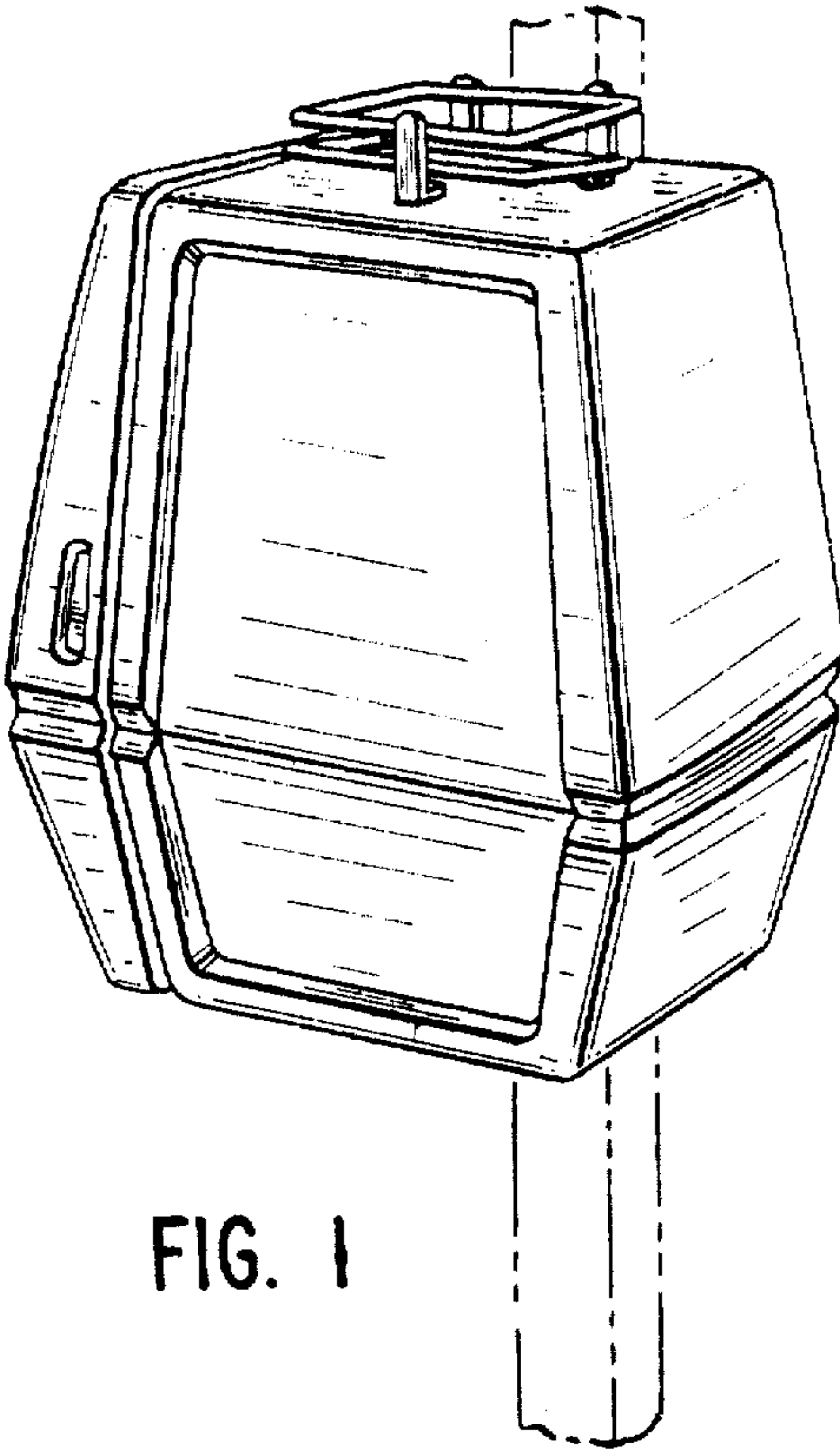

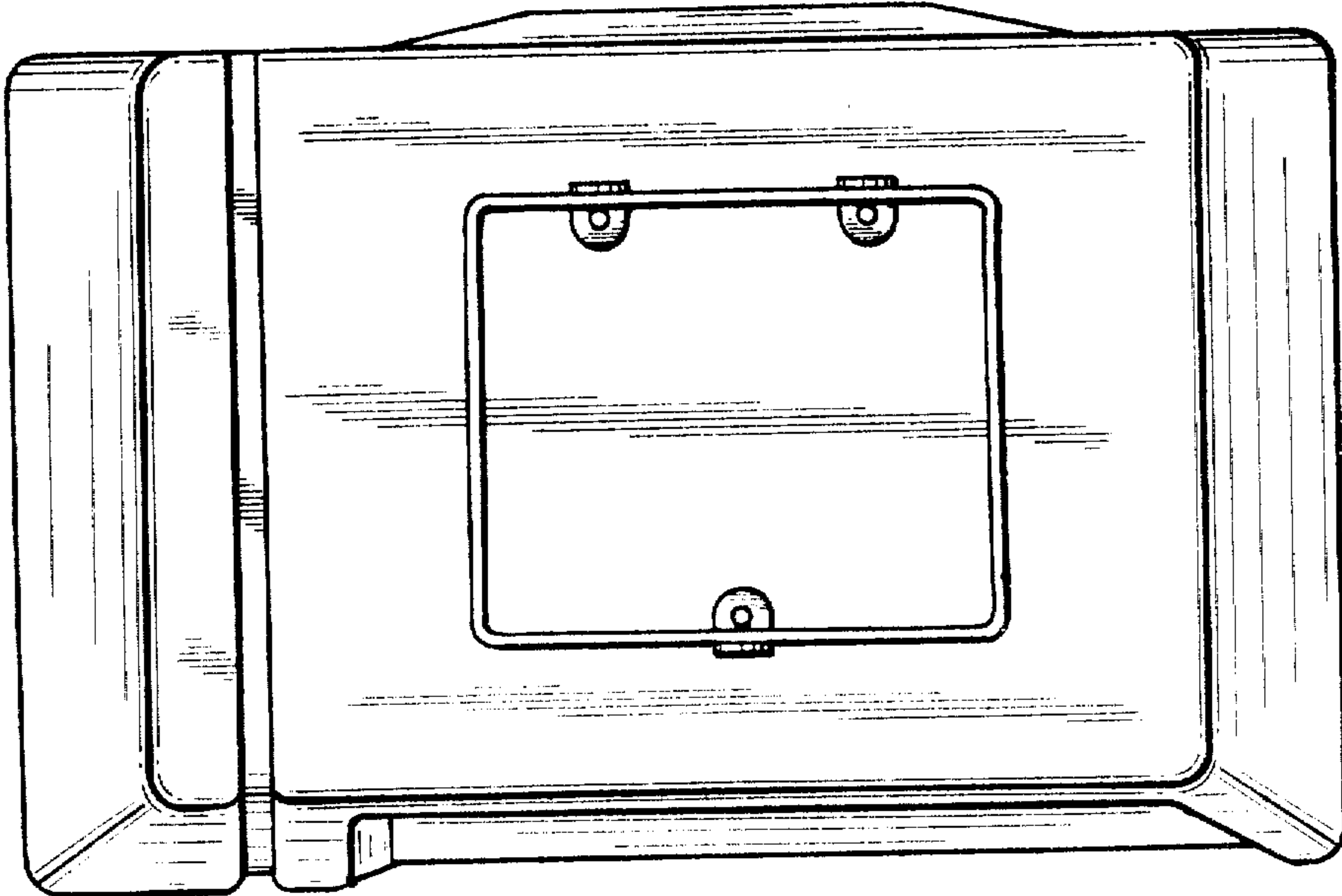

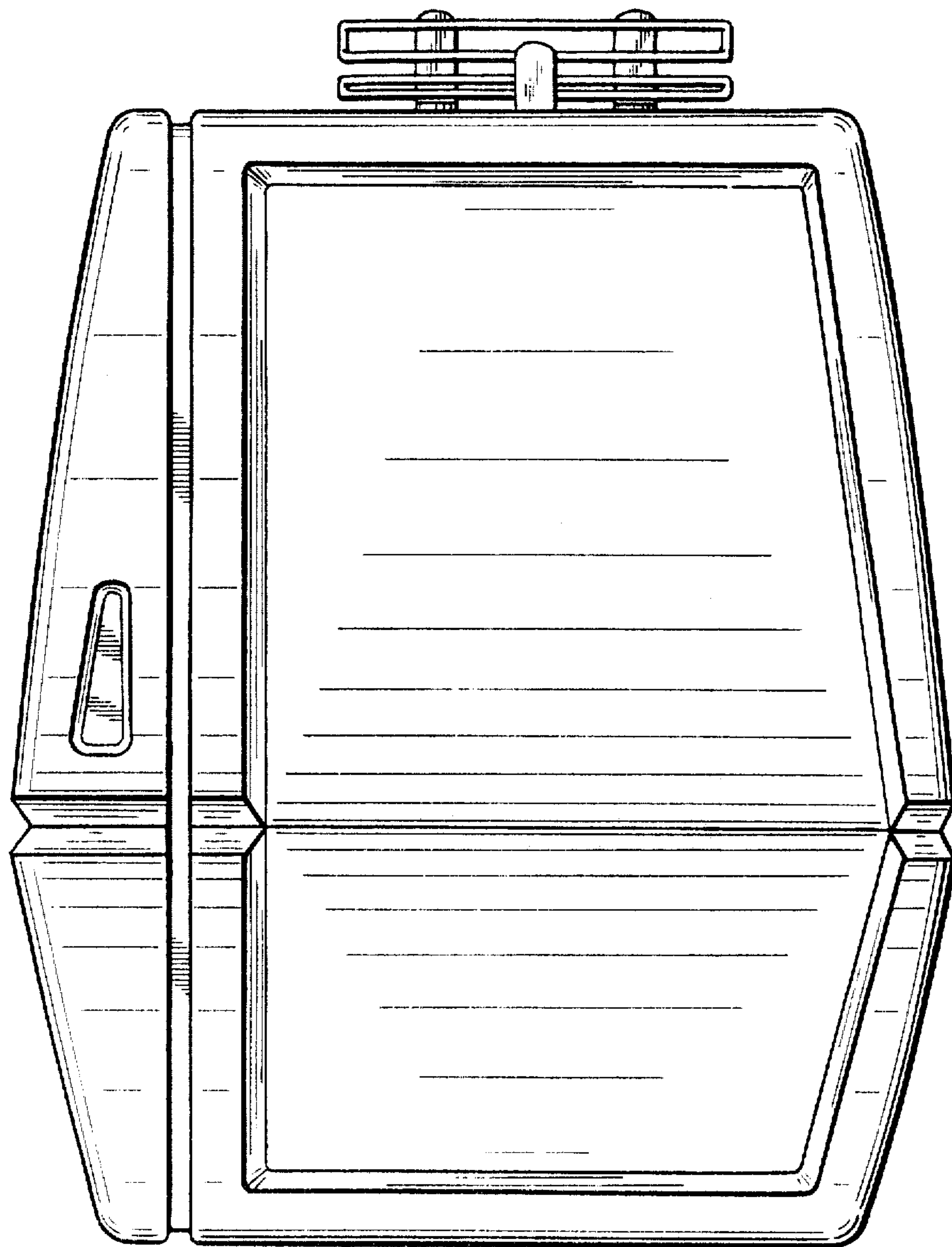

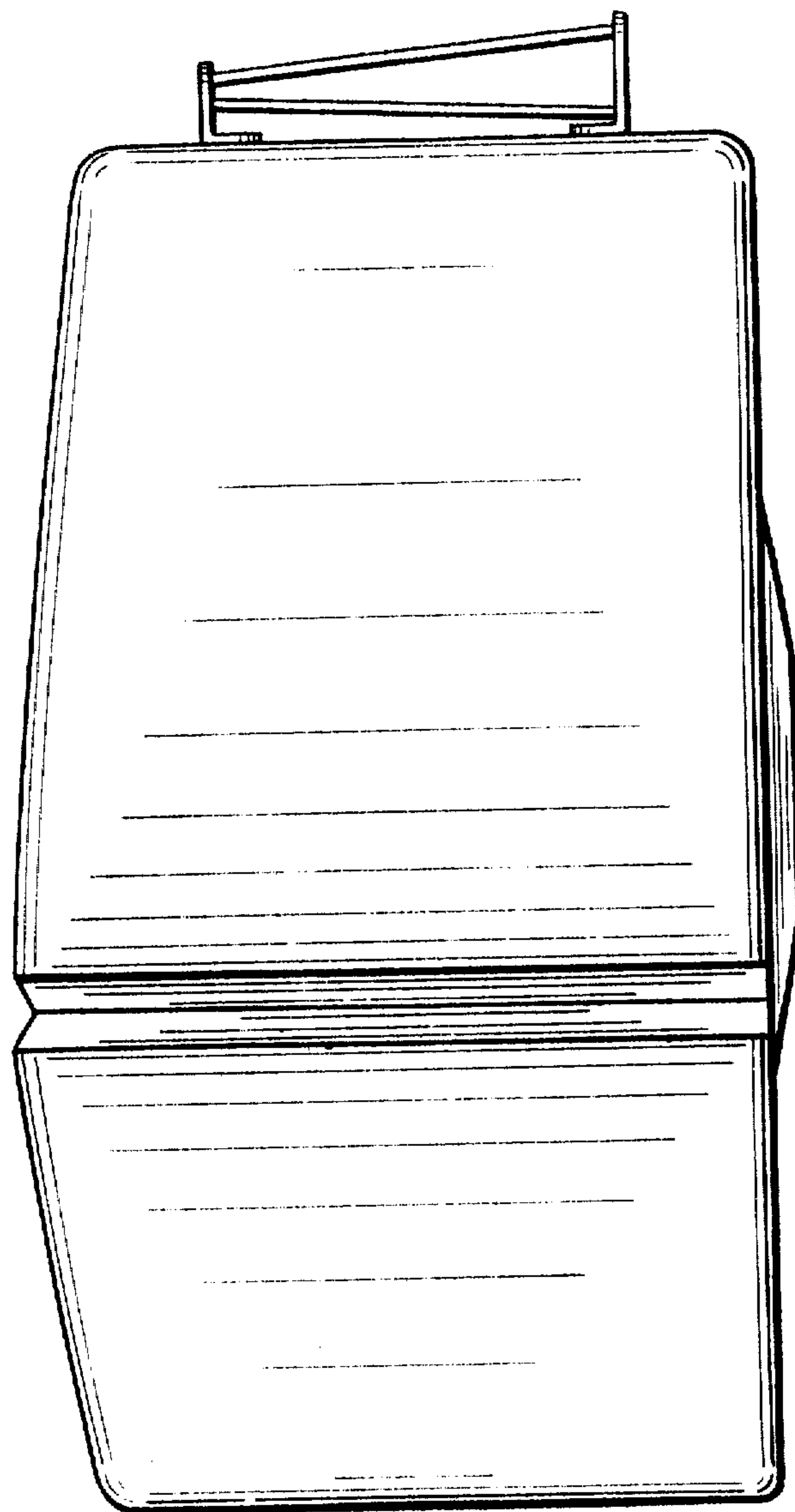
