[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a medical service emblem, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a medical service emblem showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the medical service emblem;

FIG. 3 is a back elevational view of the medical service emblem;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

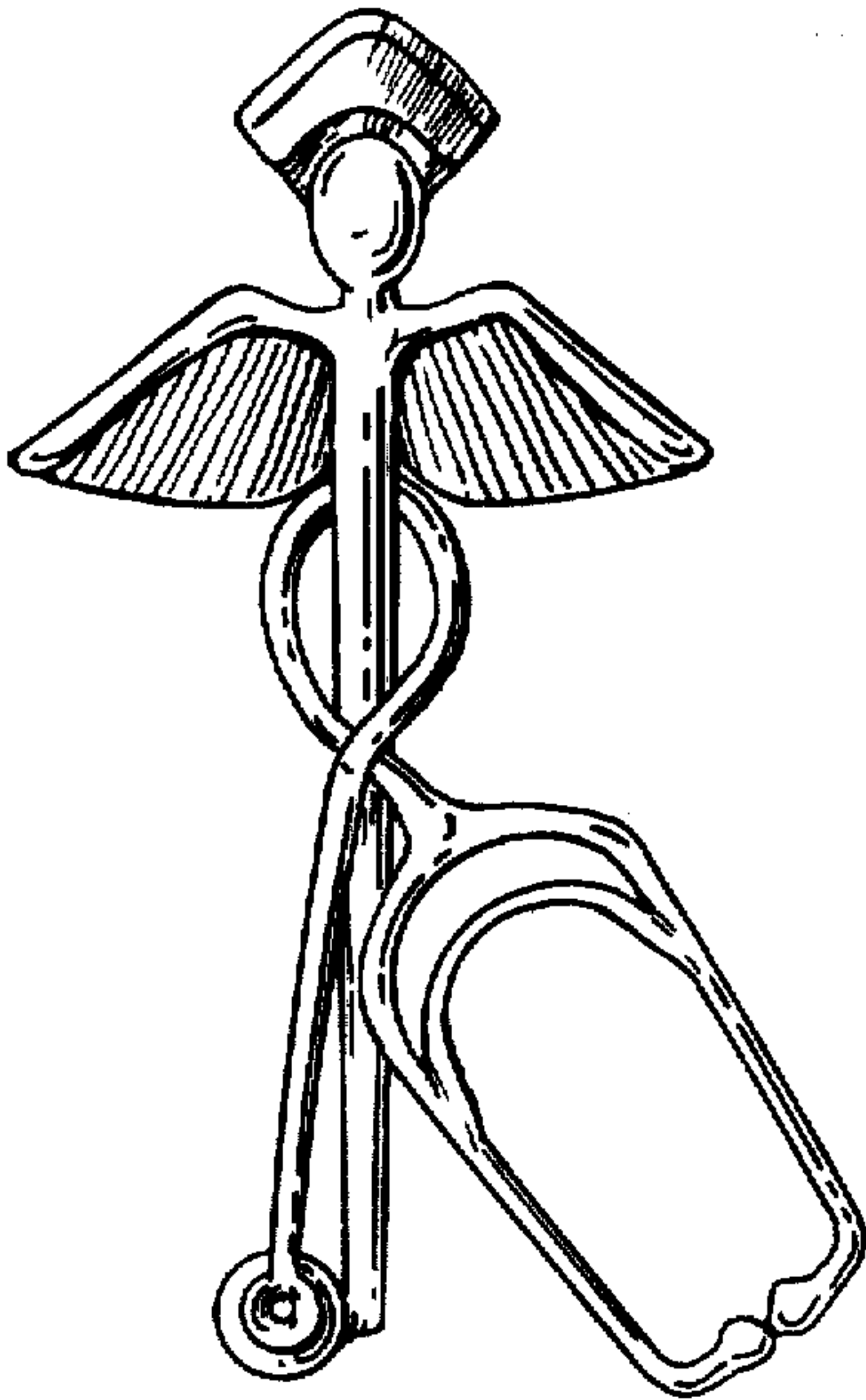

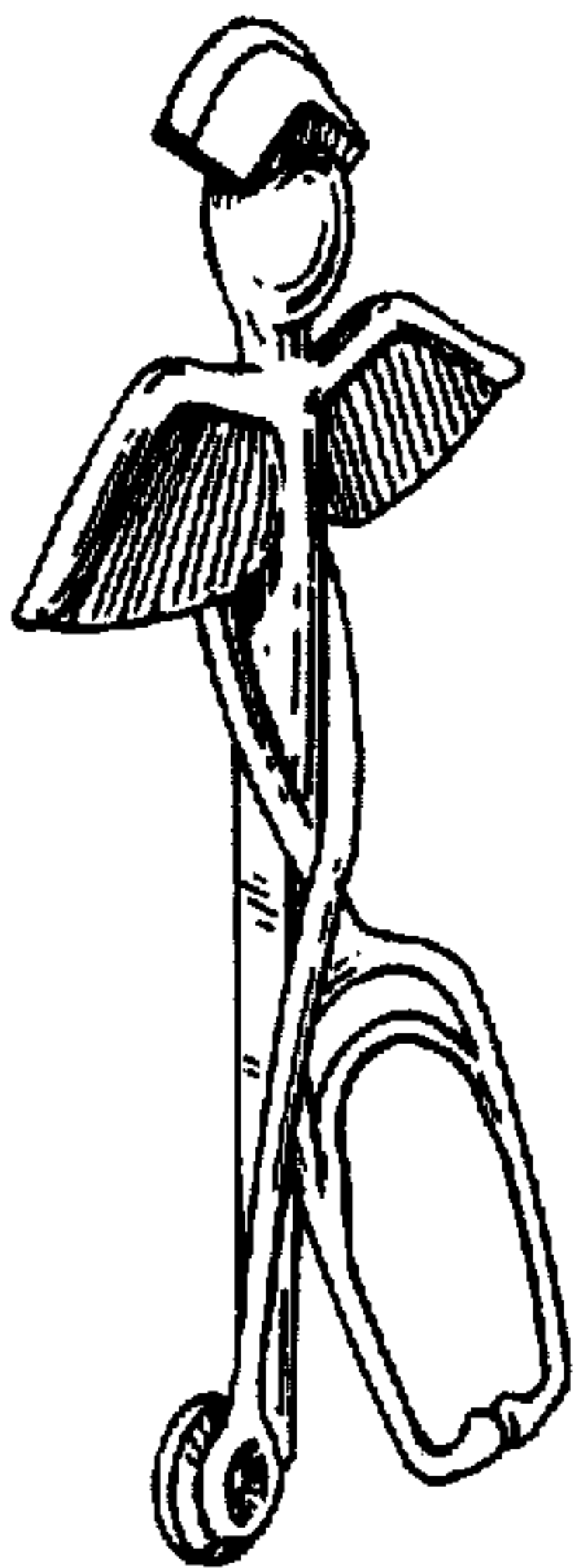

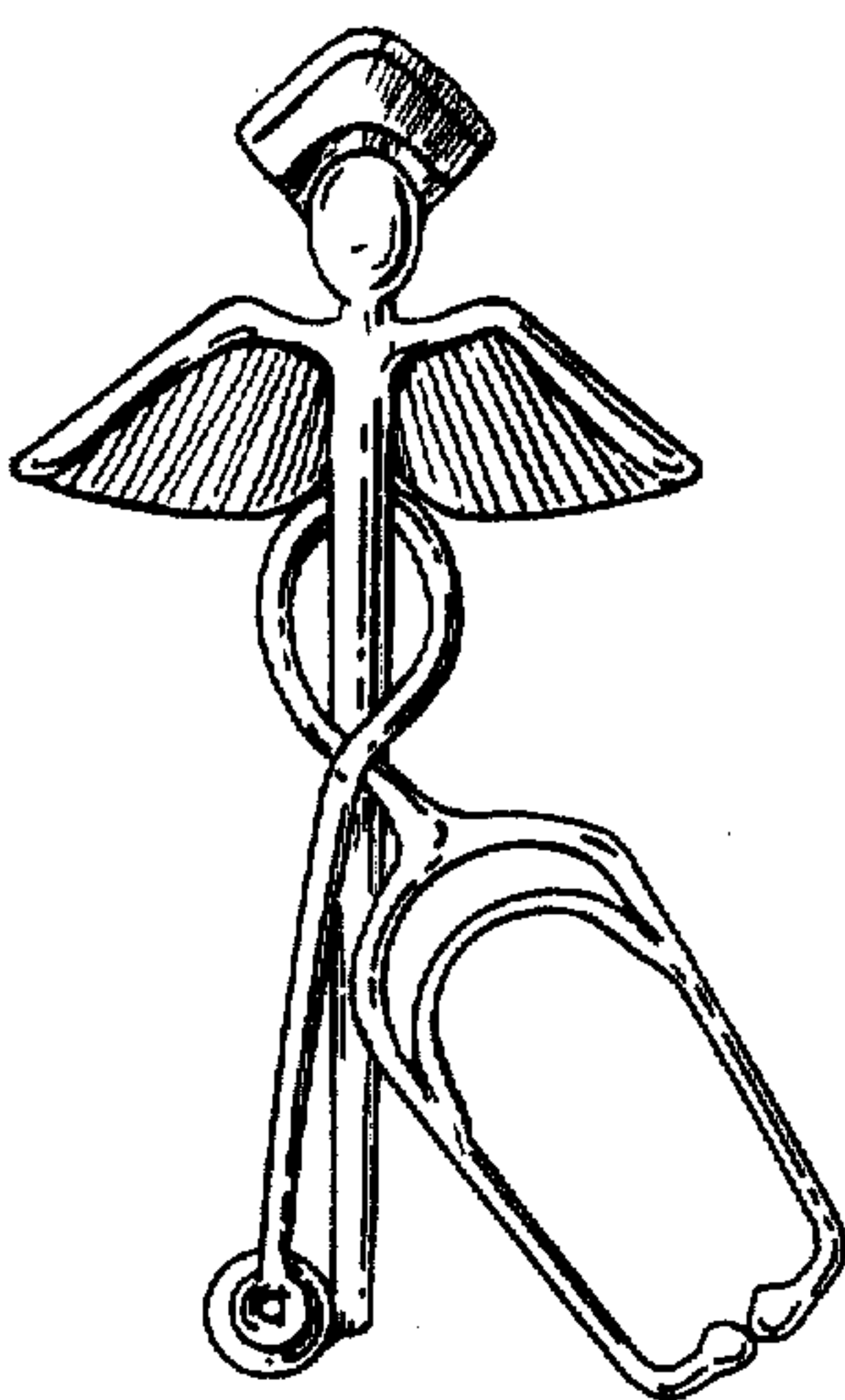

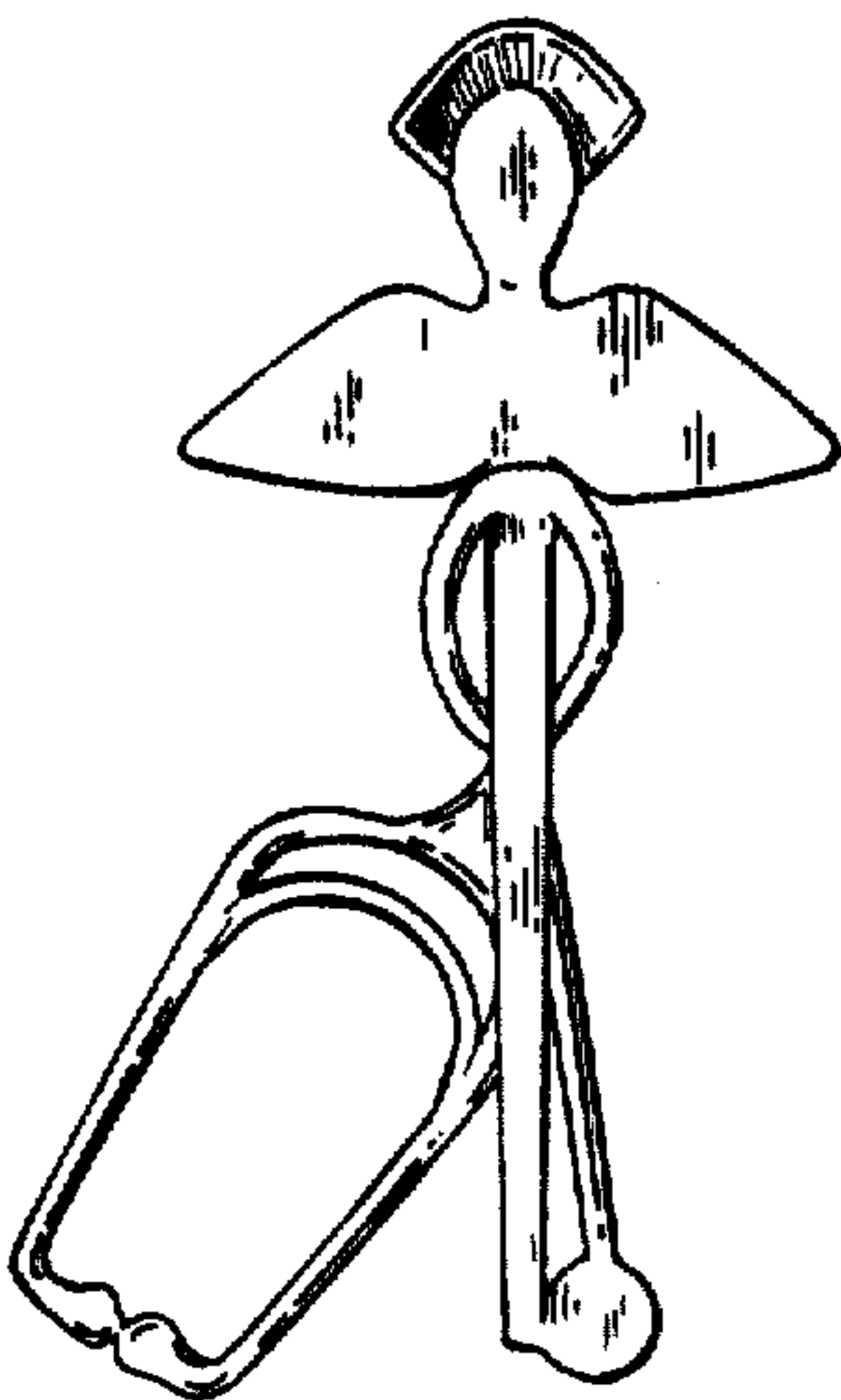
