[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a collapsible stroller, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a collapsible stroller showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a side perspective view thereof in a reclined condition;
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a collapsible stroller showing a second embodiment of our new design, the sole difference being in the addition of a canopy;
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 11 is a perspective view of FIG. 7 in a collapsed condition.

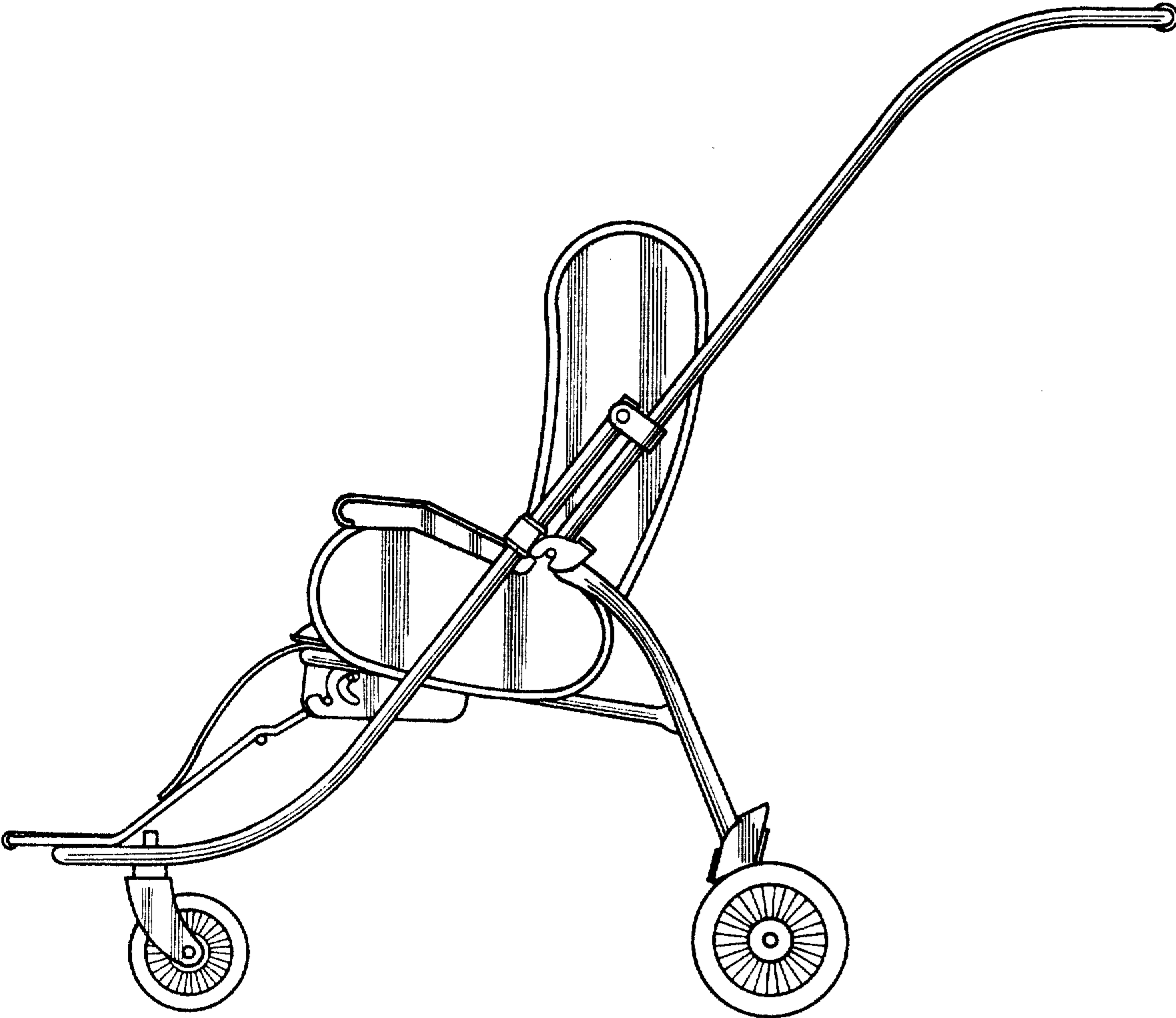

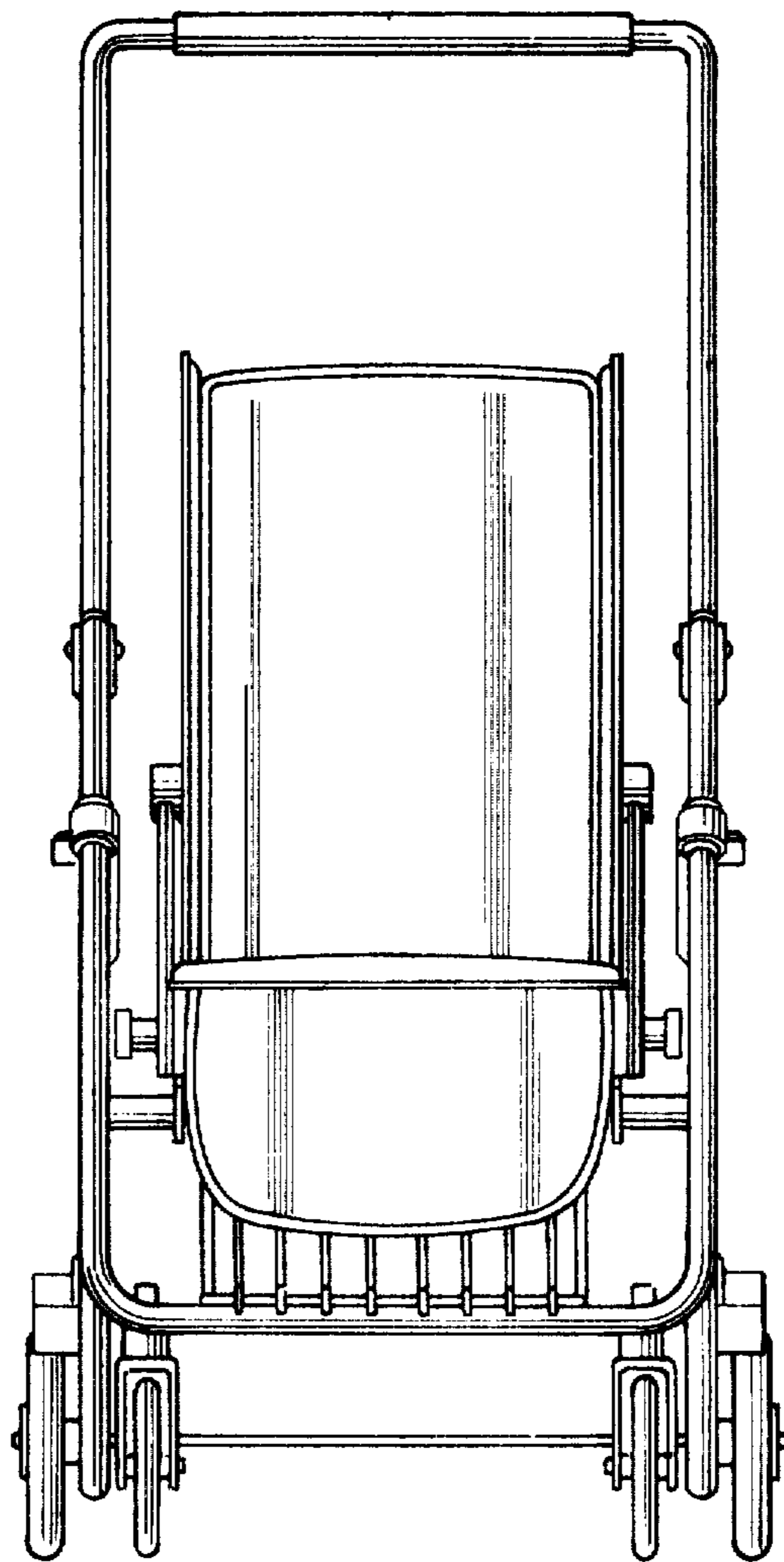

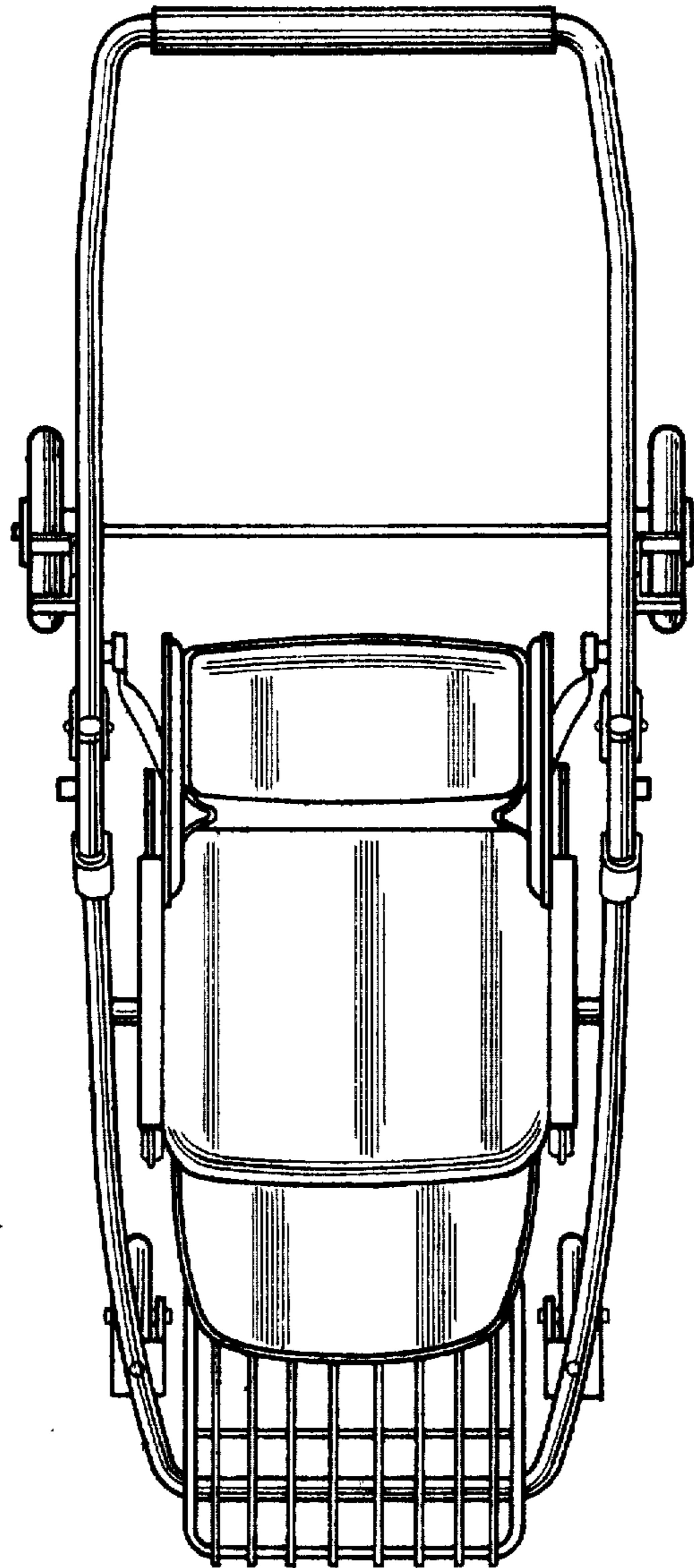

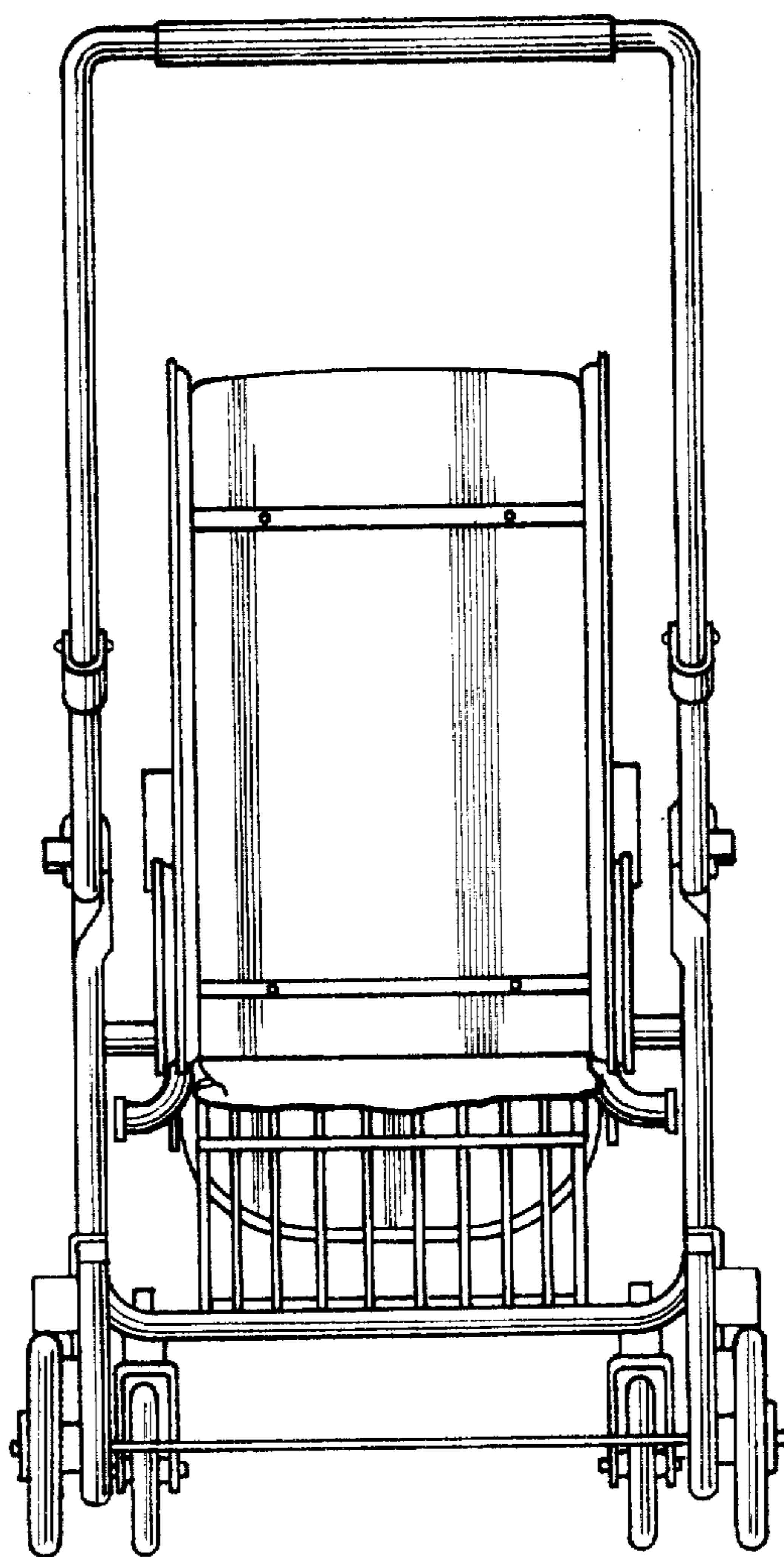

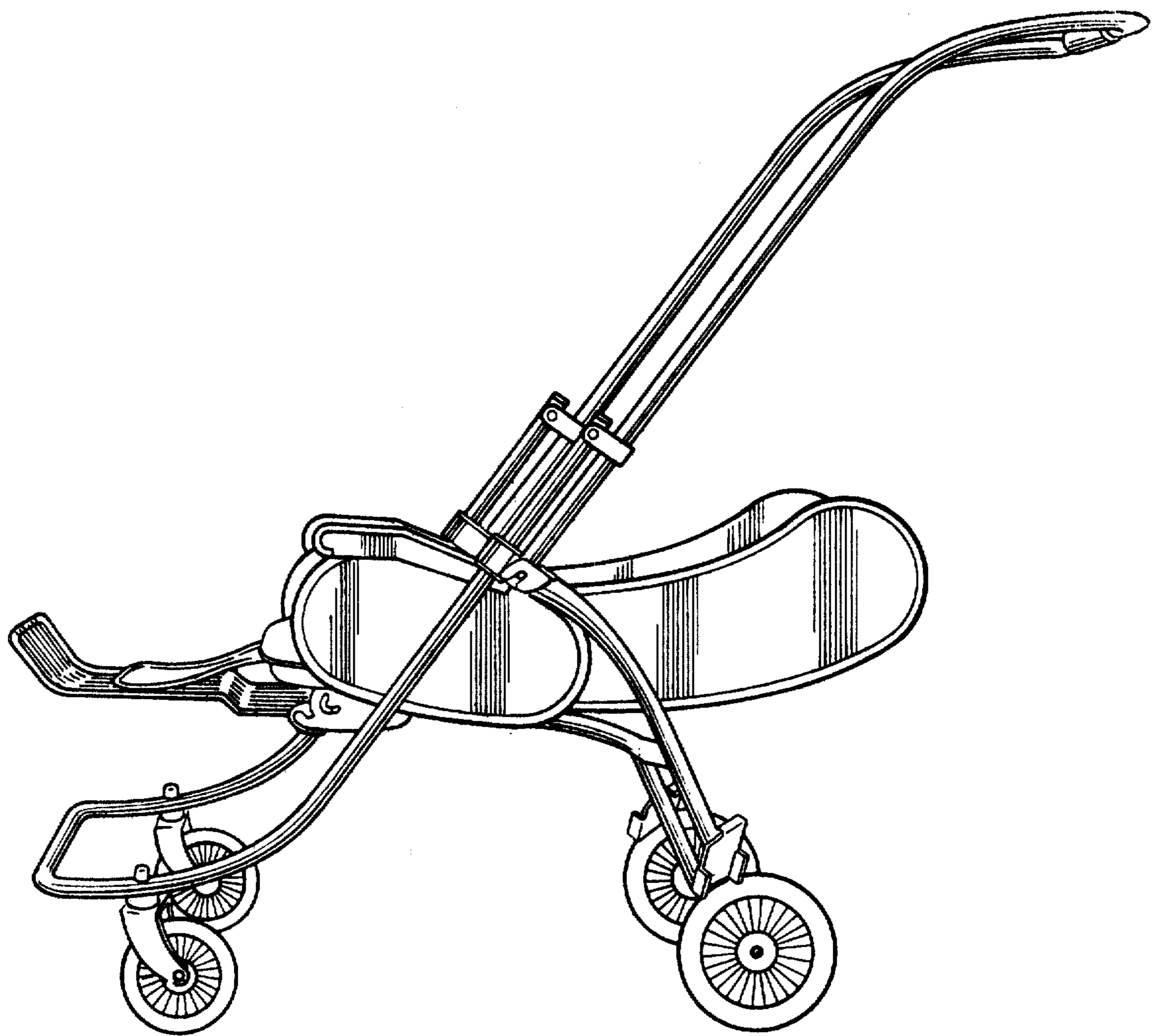

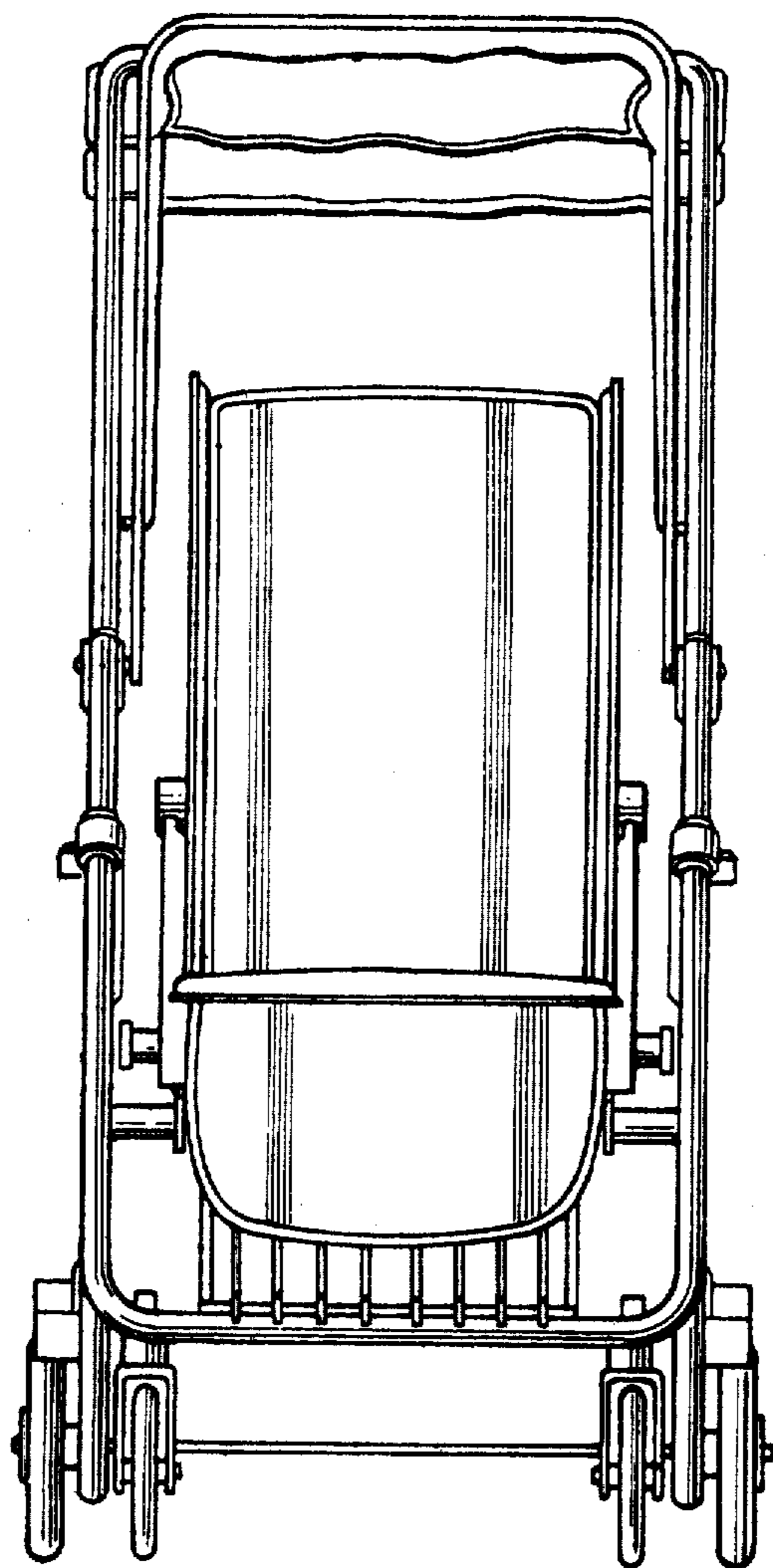

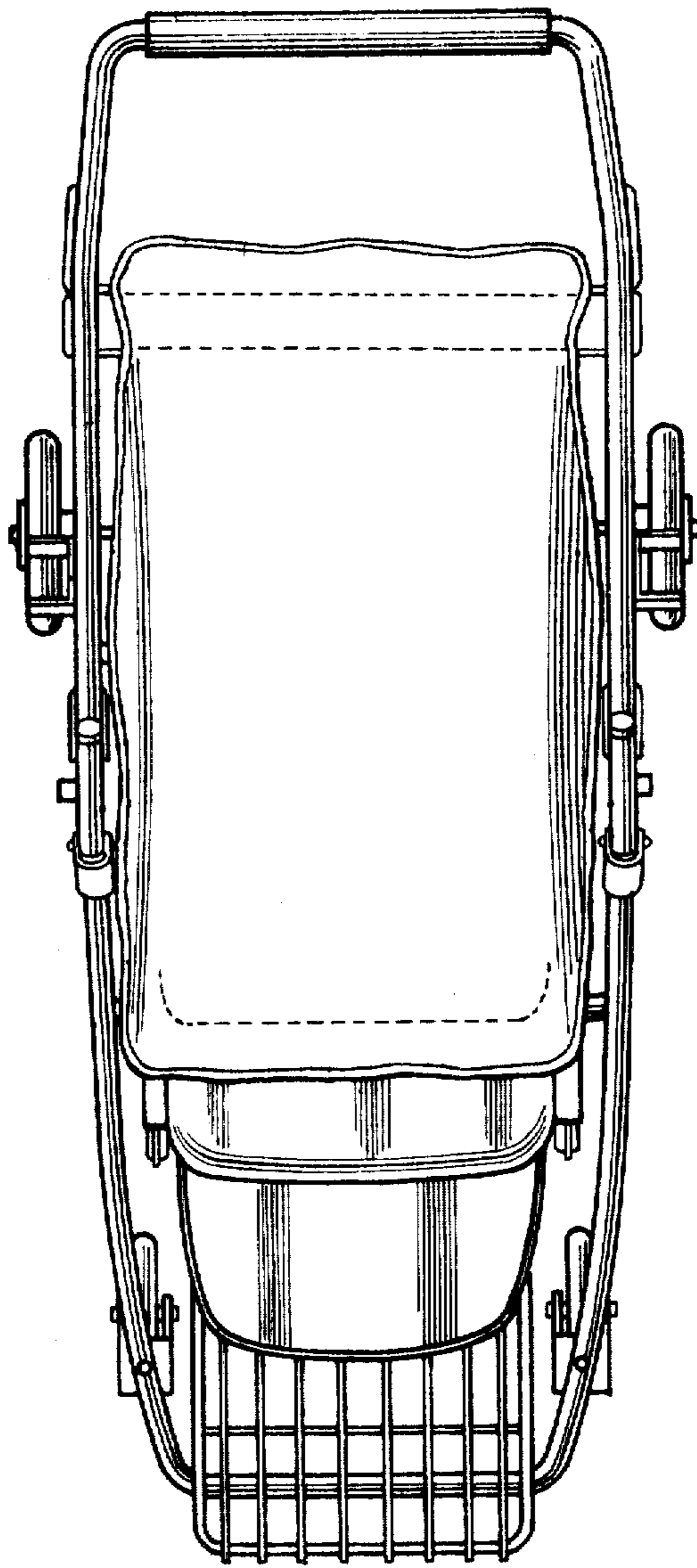

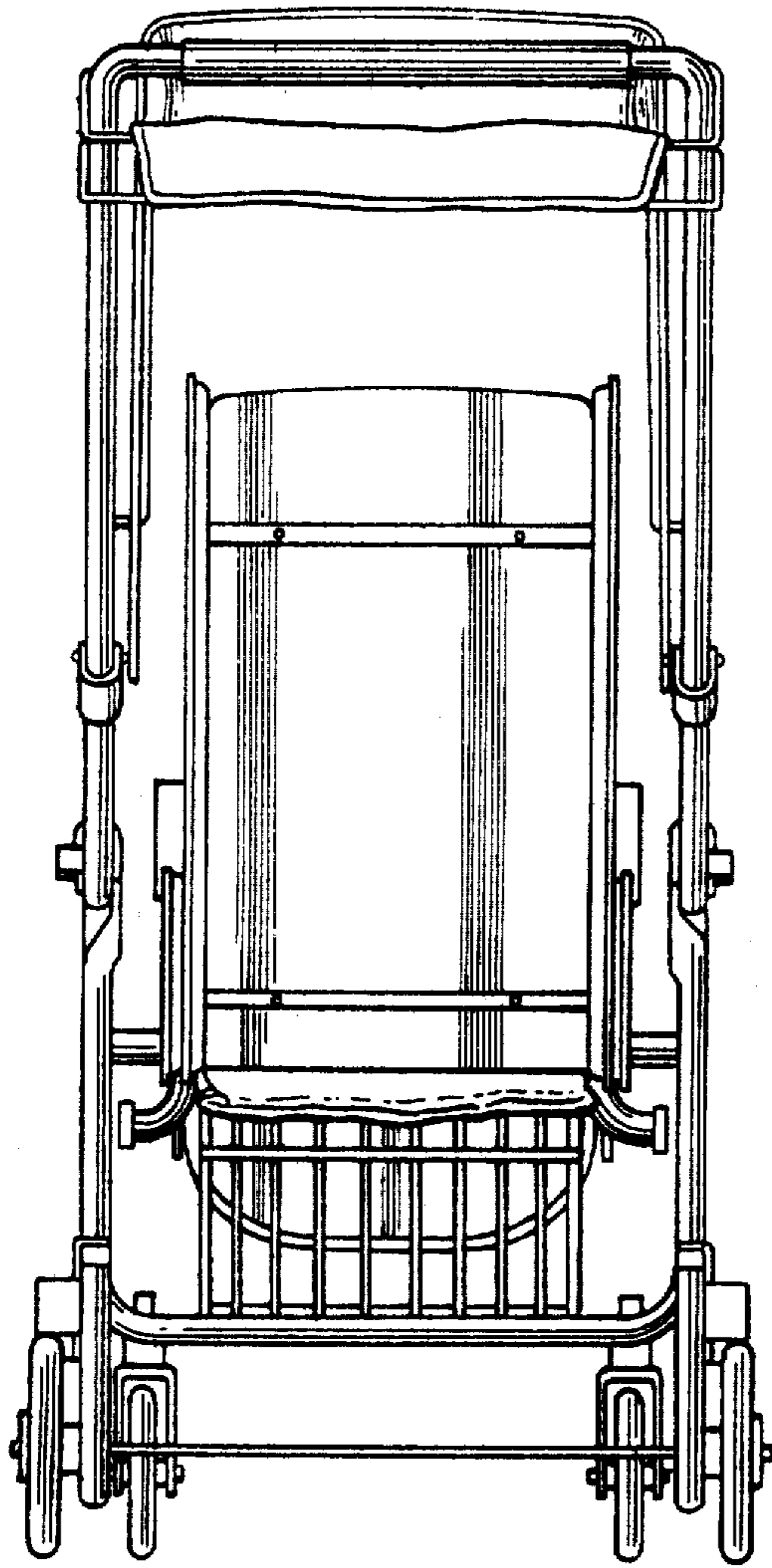

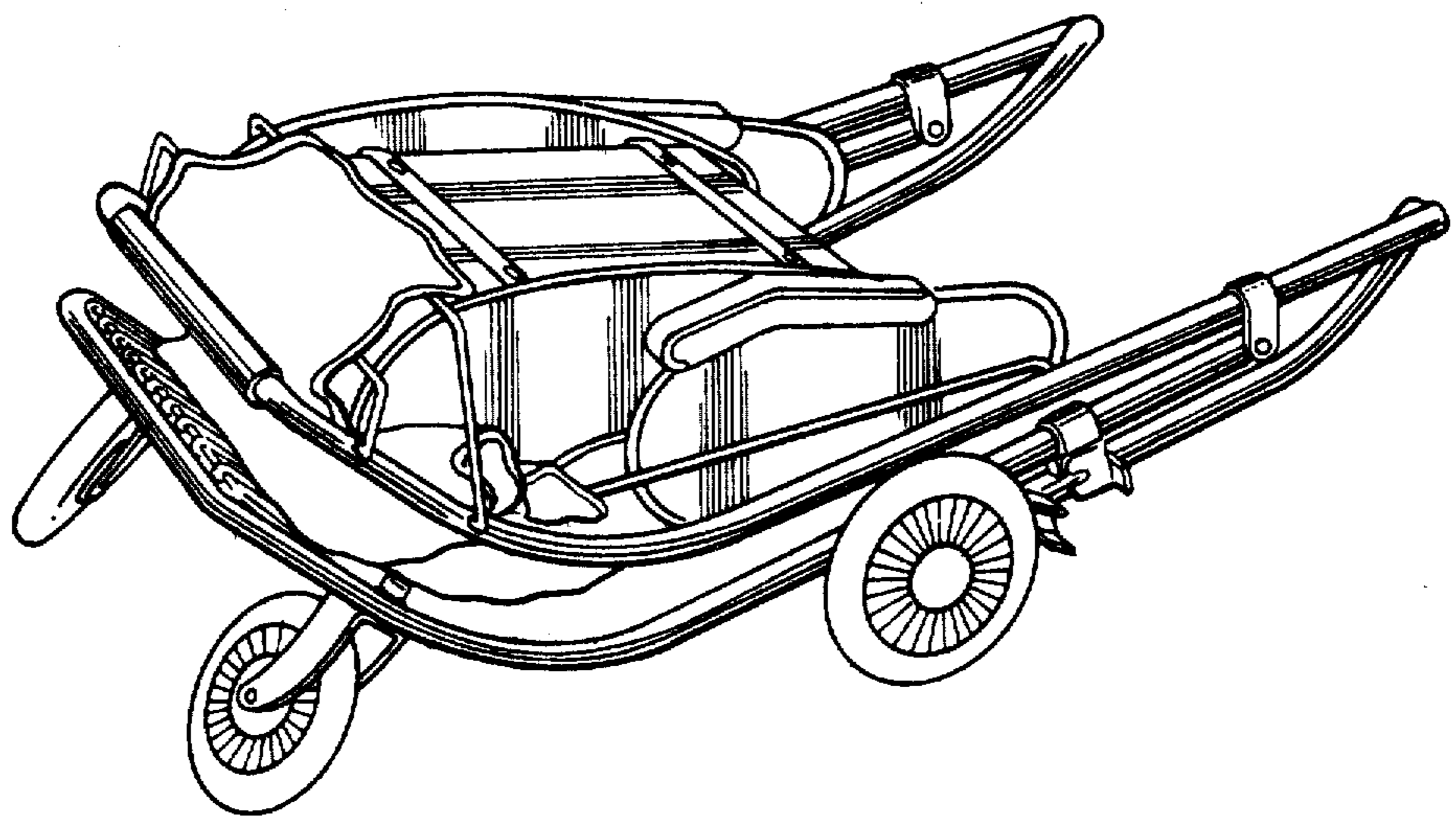
