FIG. 1 is a front, left side perspective view of a smoke detector showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof with the hanger in its extended position.

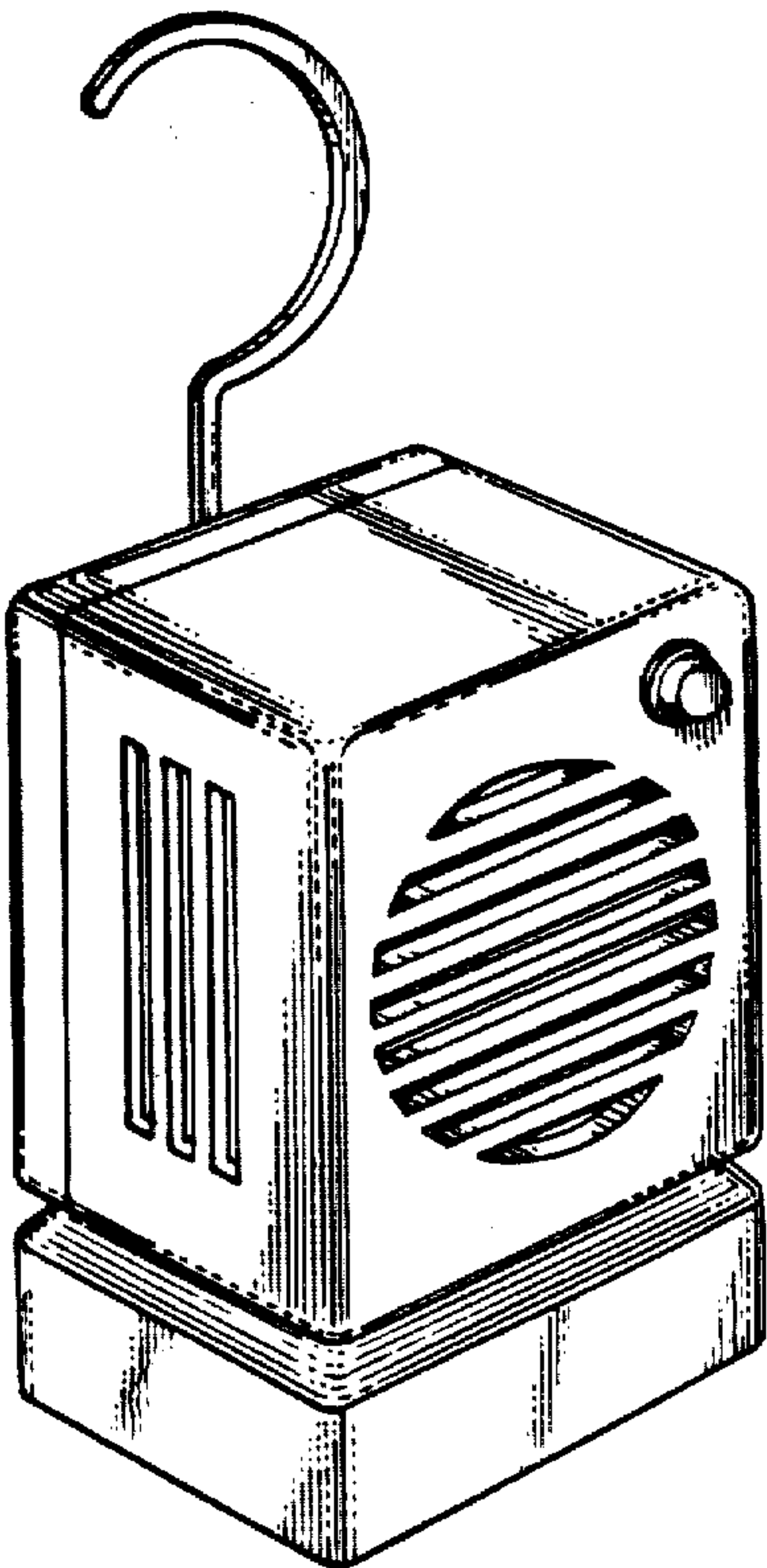

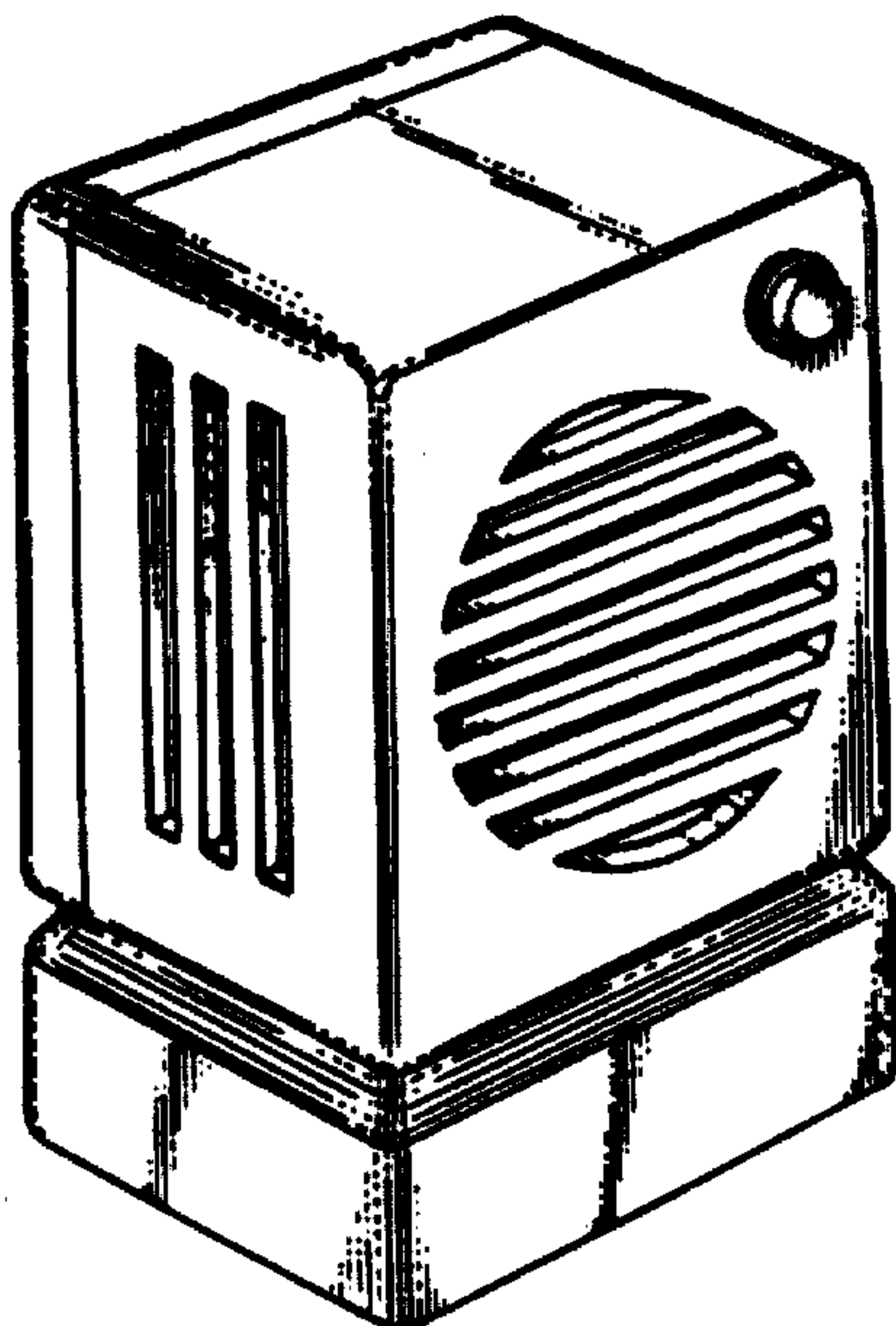

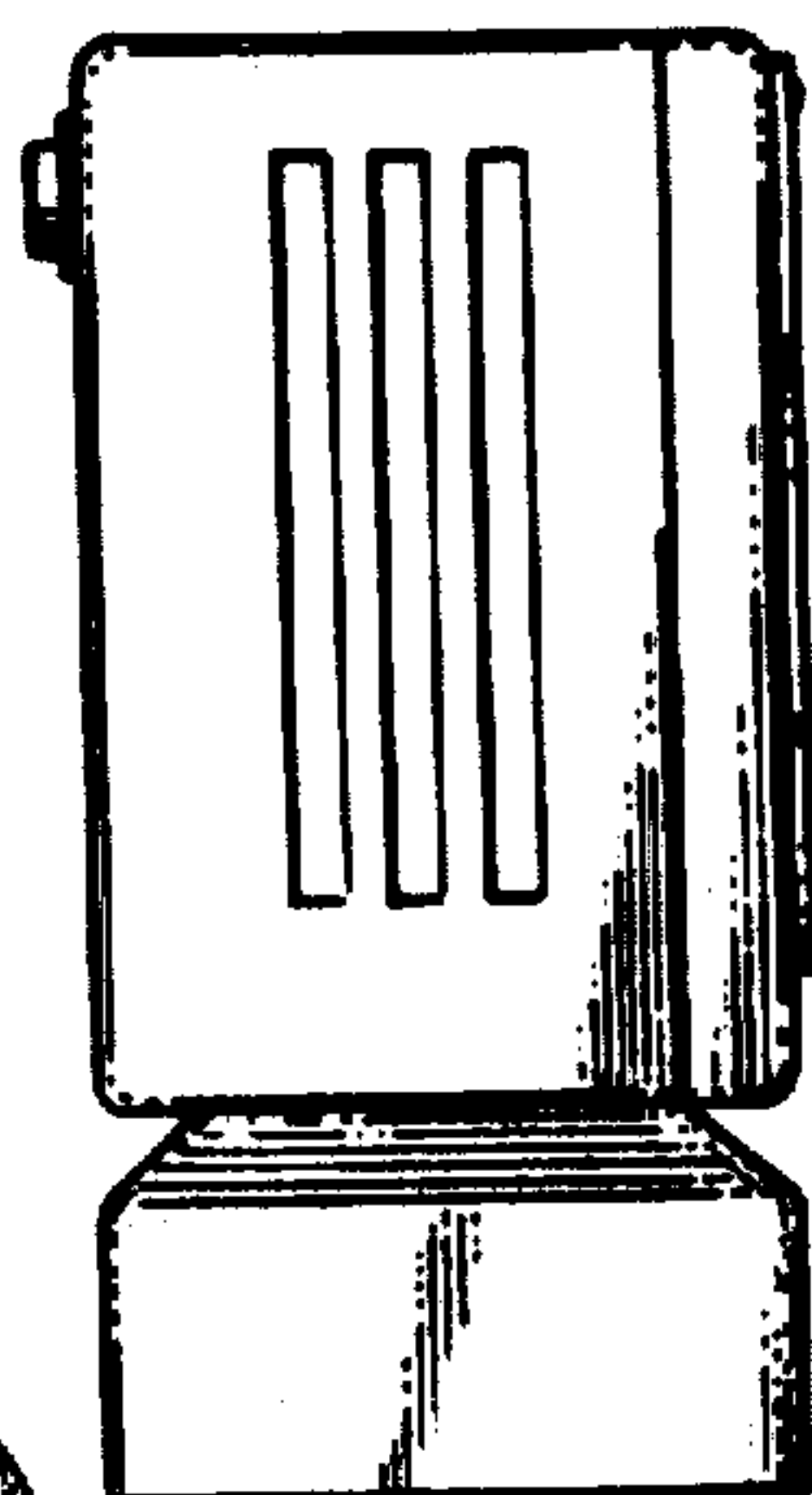

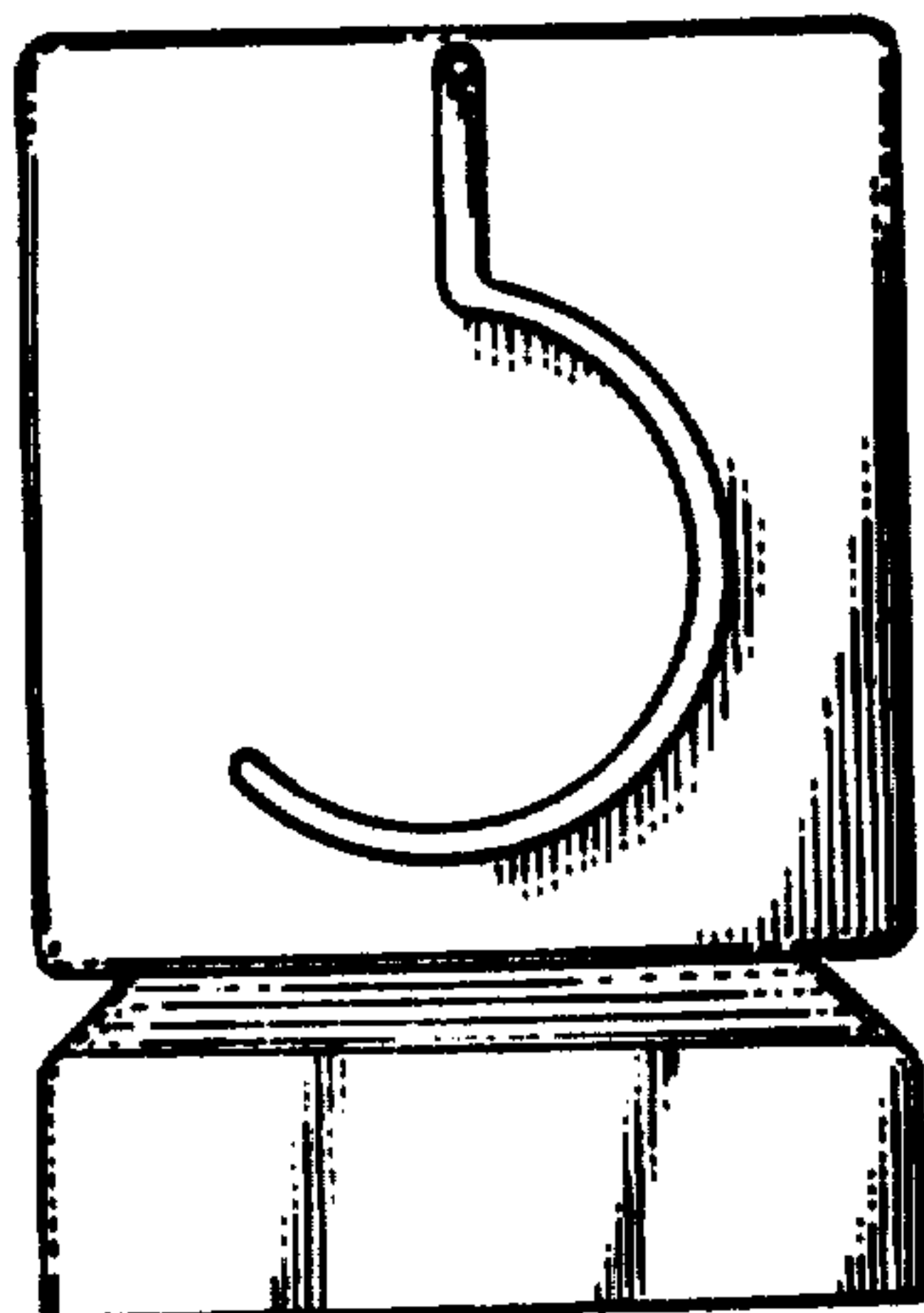

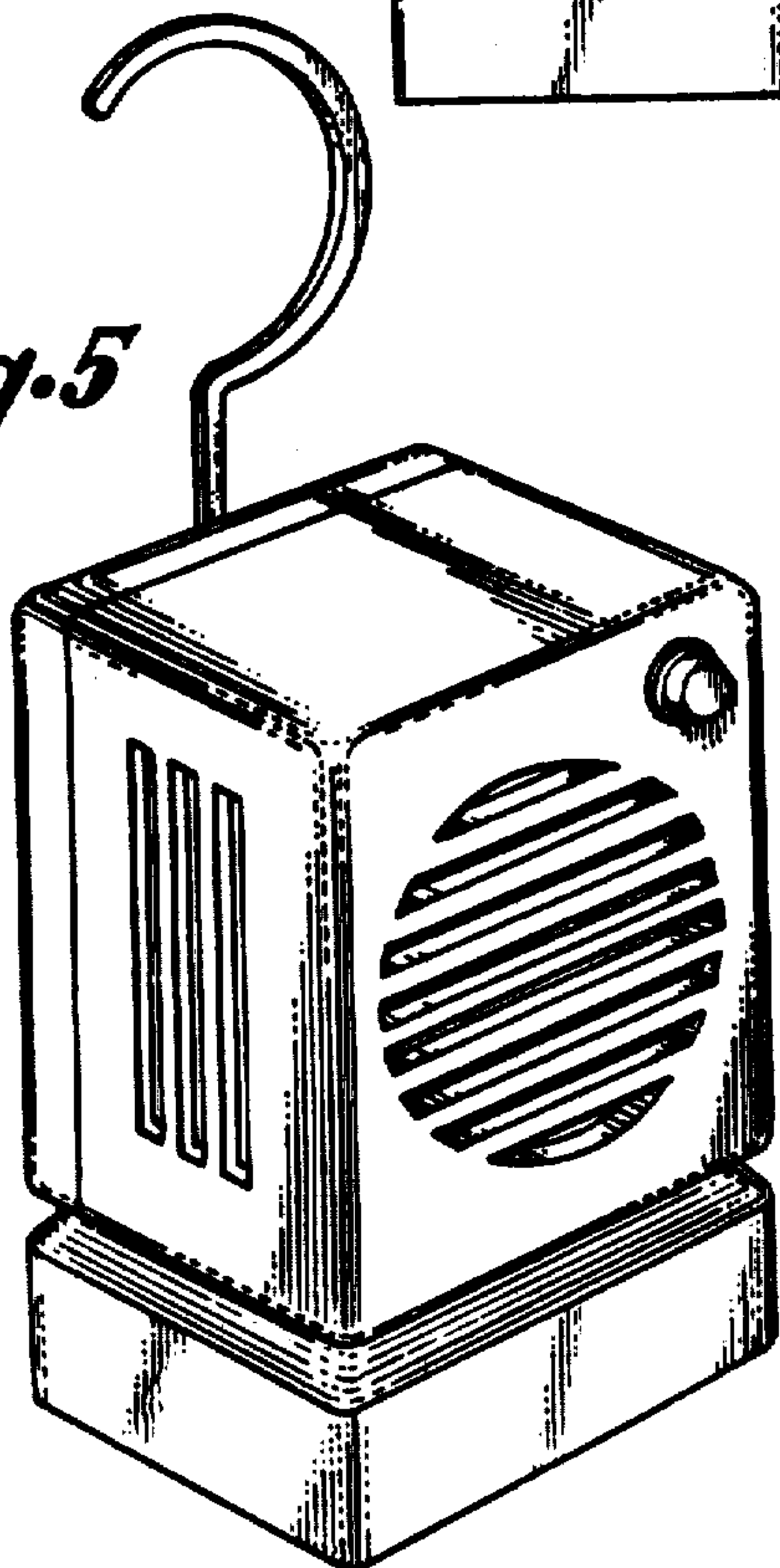
