DESCRIPTION

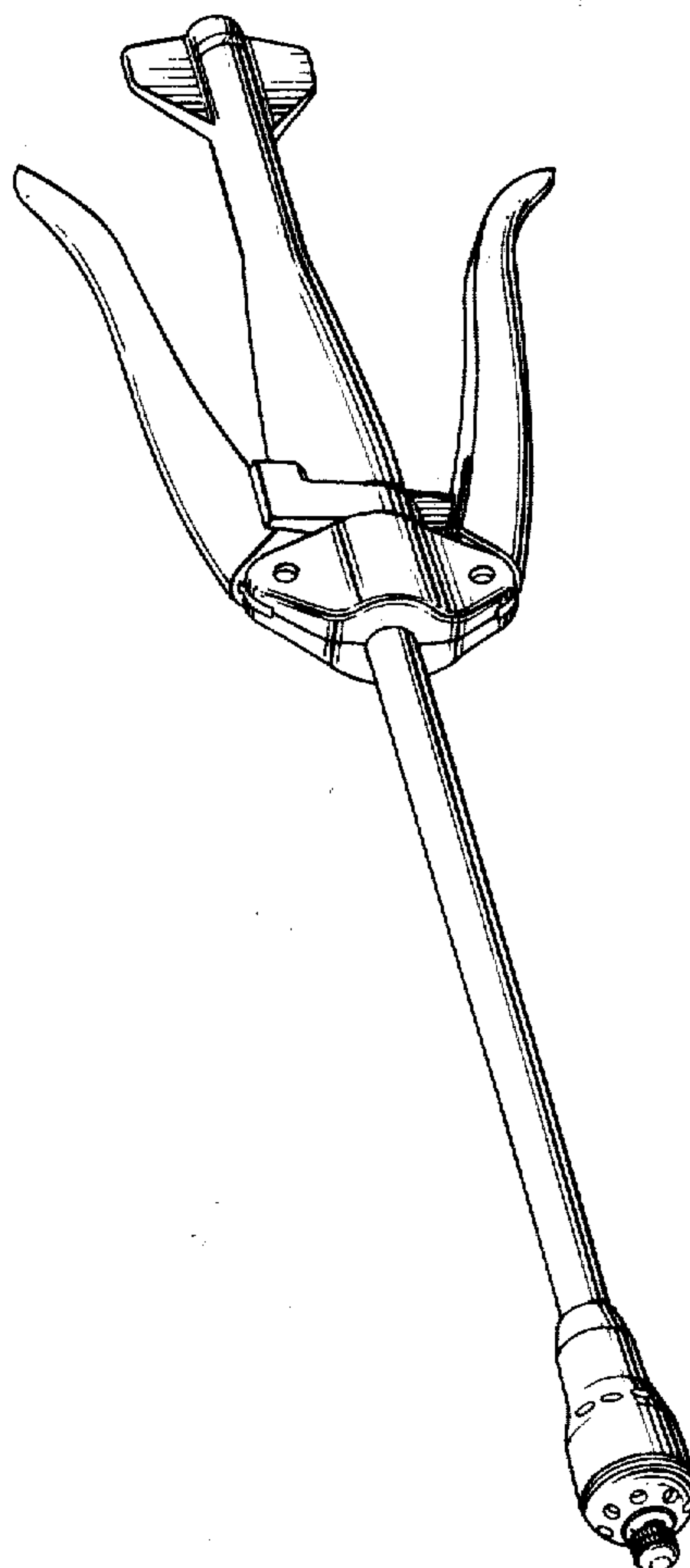
FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a circular anastomosis surgical stapler showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



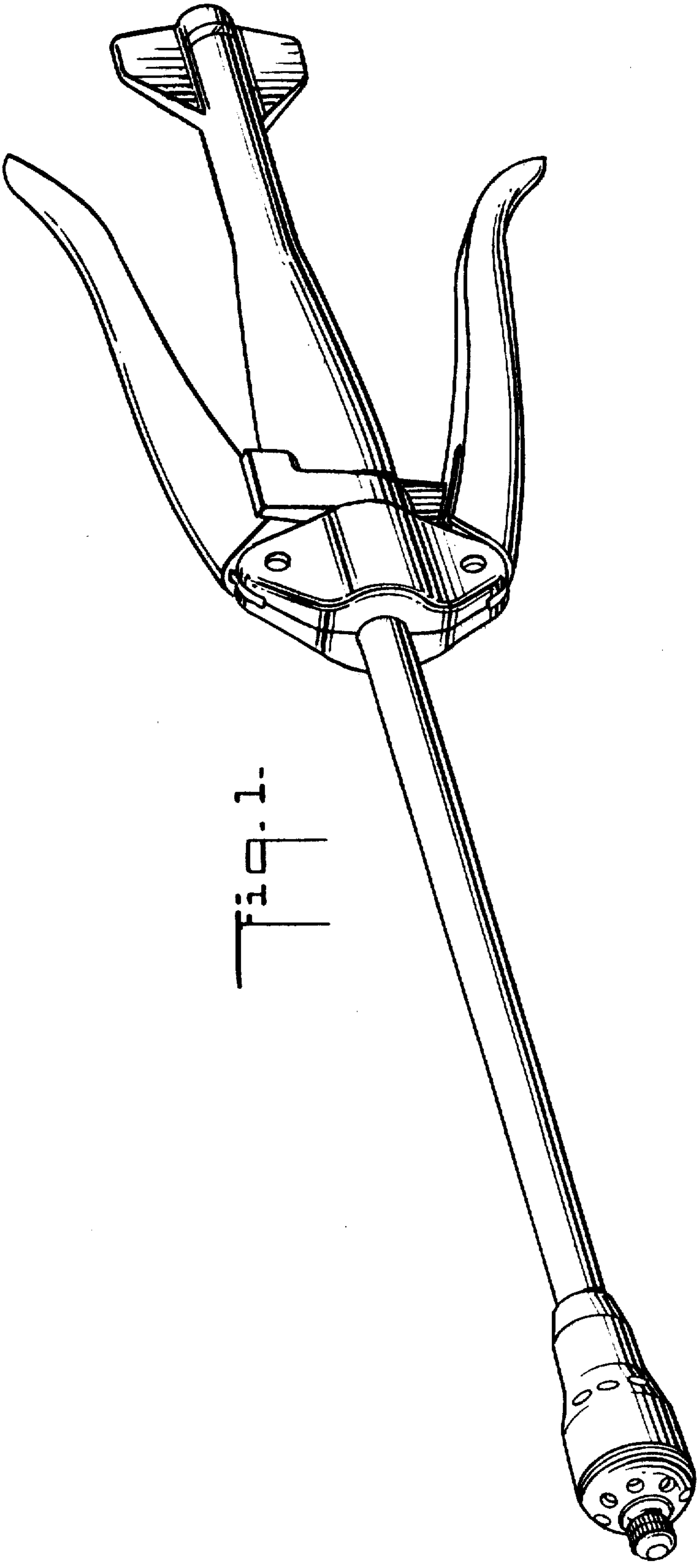
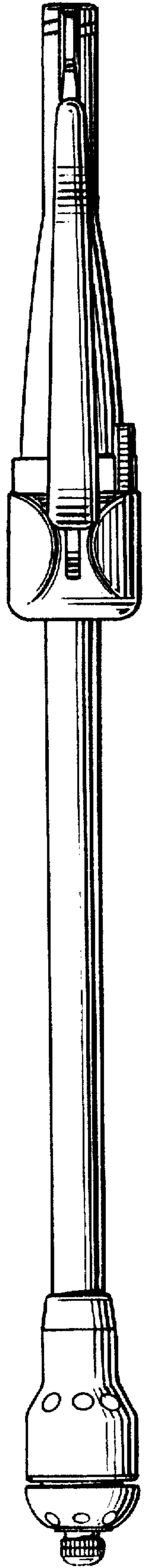

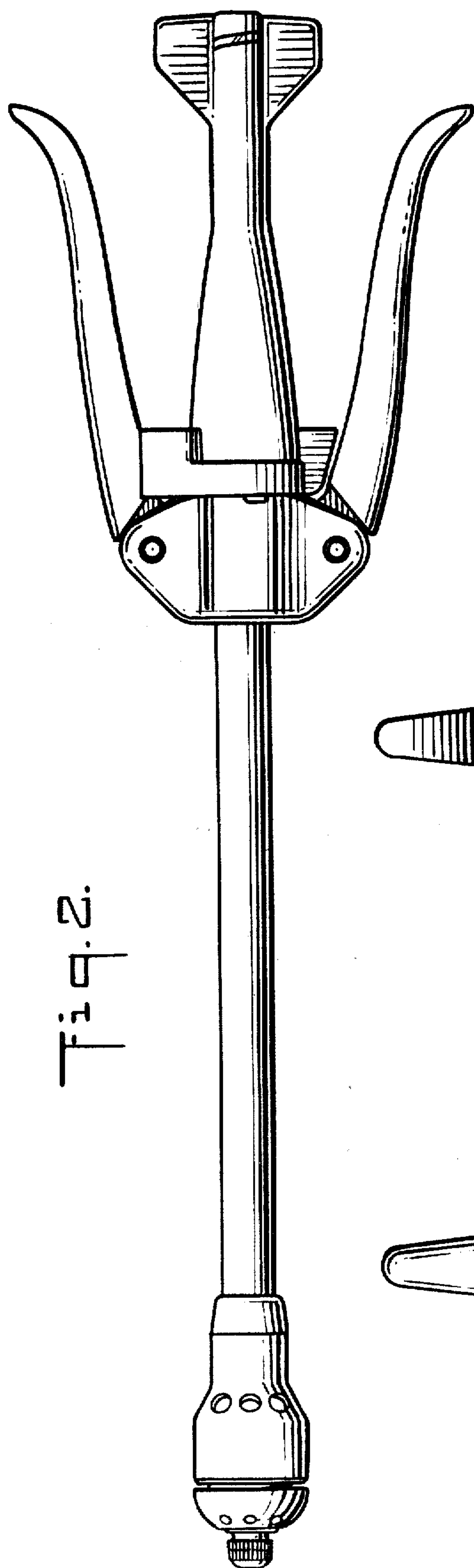

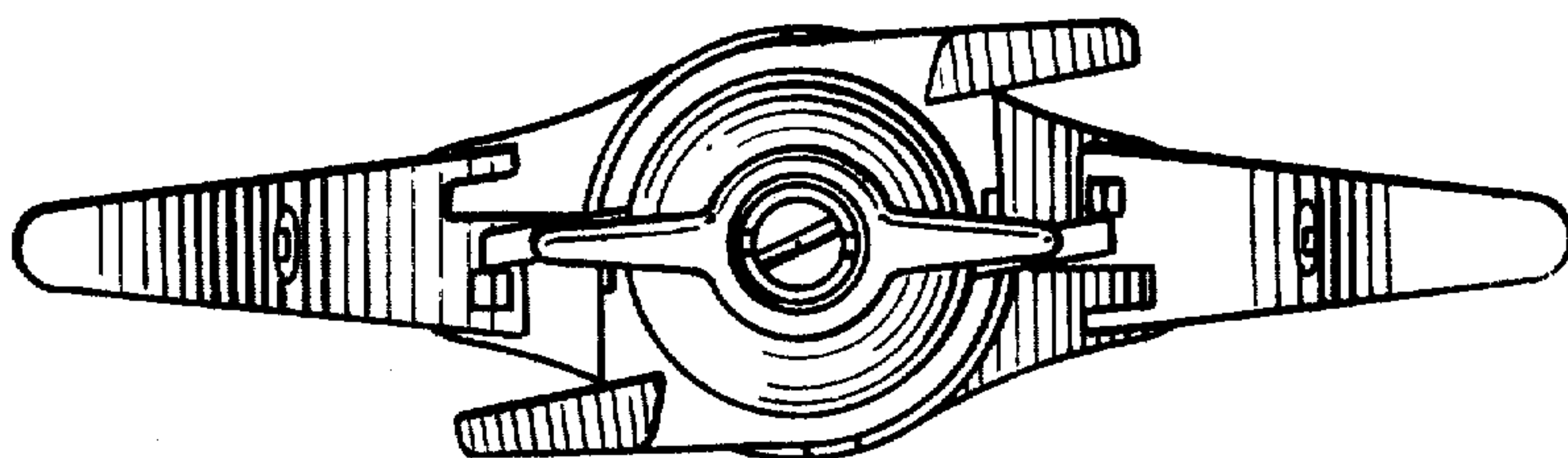

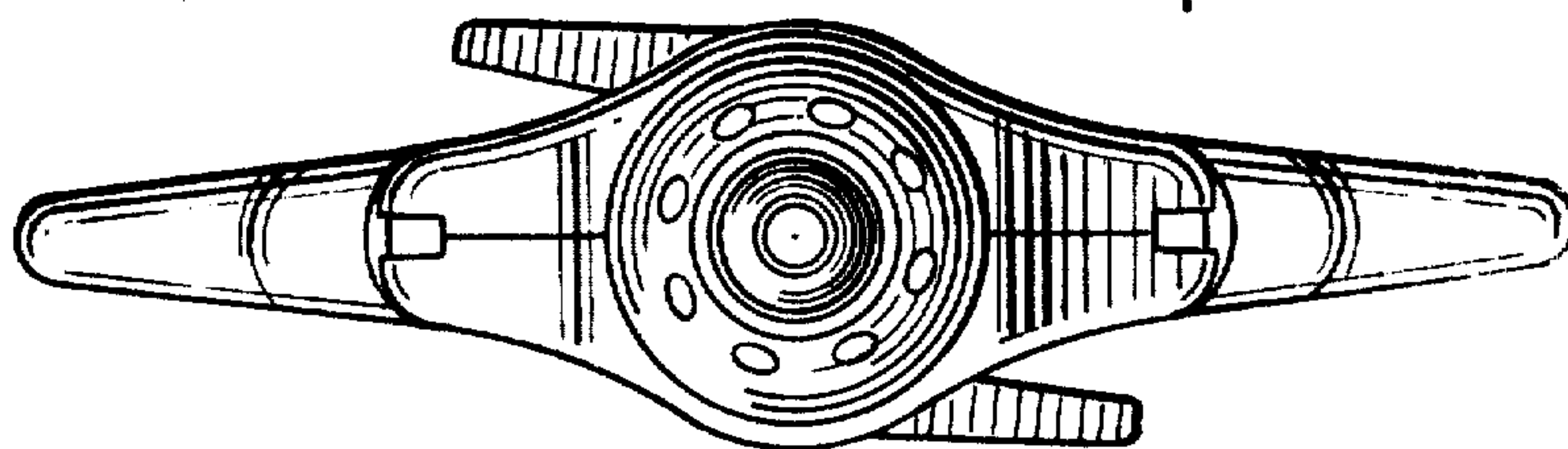
