FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined partition and merchandise display stand showing my new design;

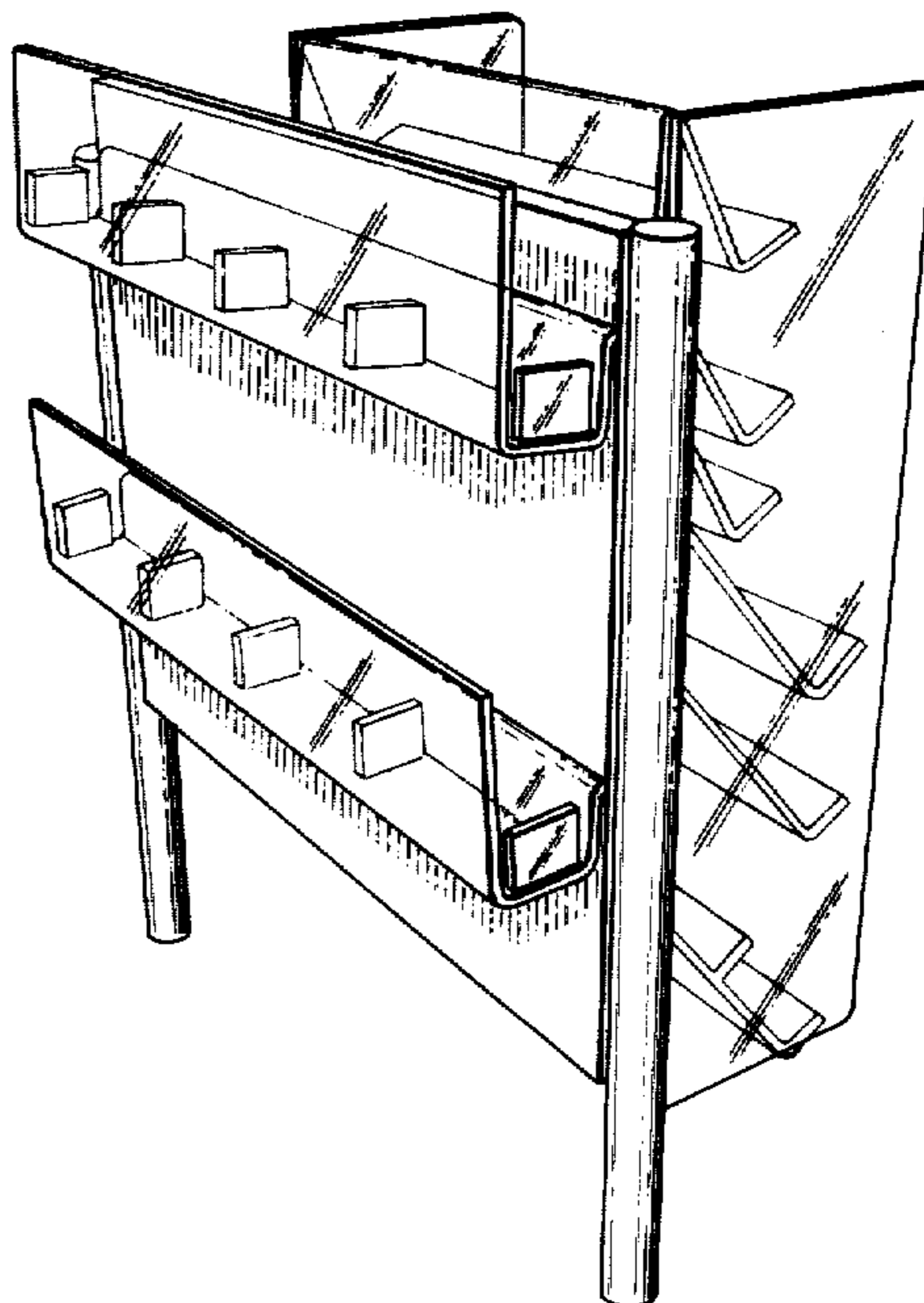
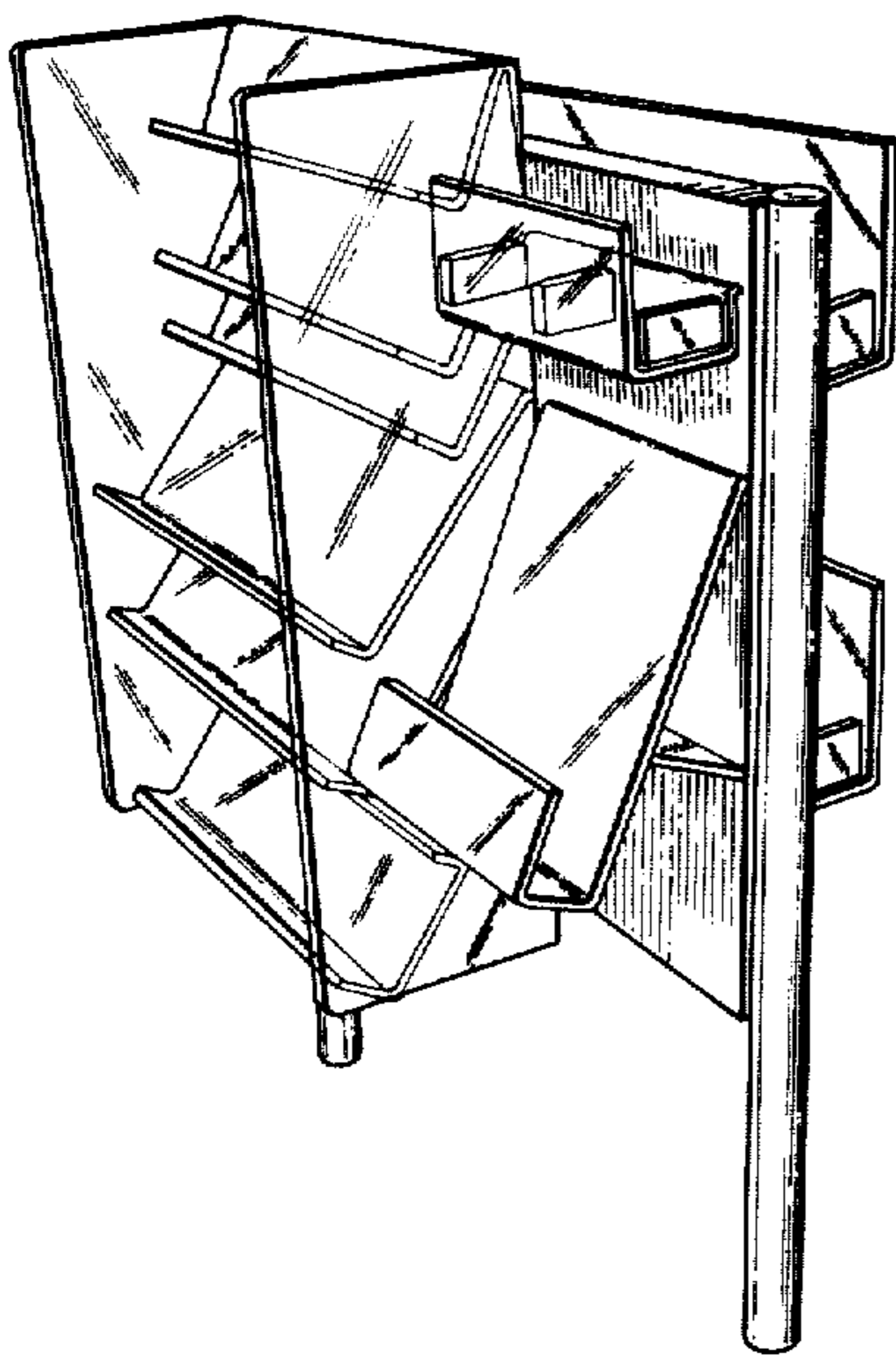
FIG. 2 is a right end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



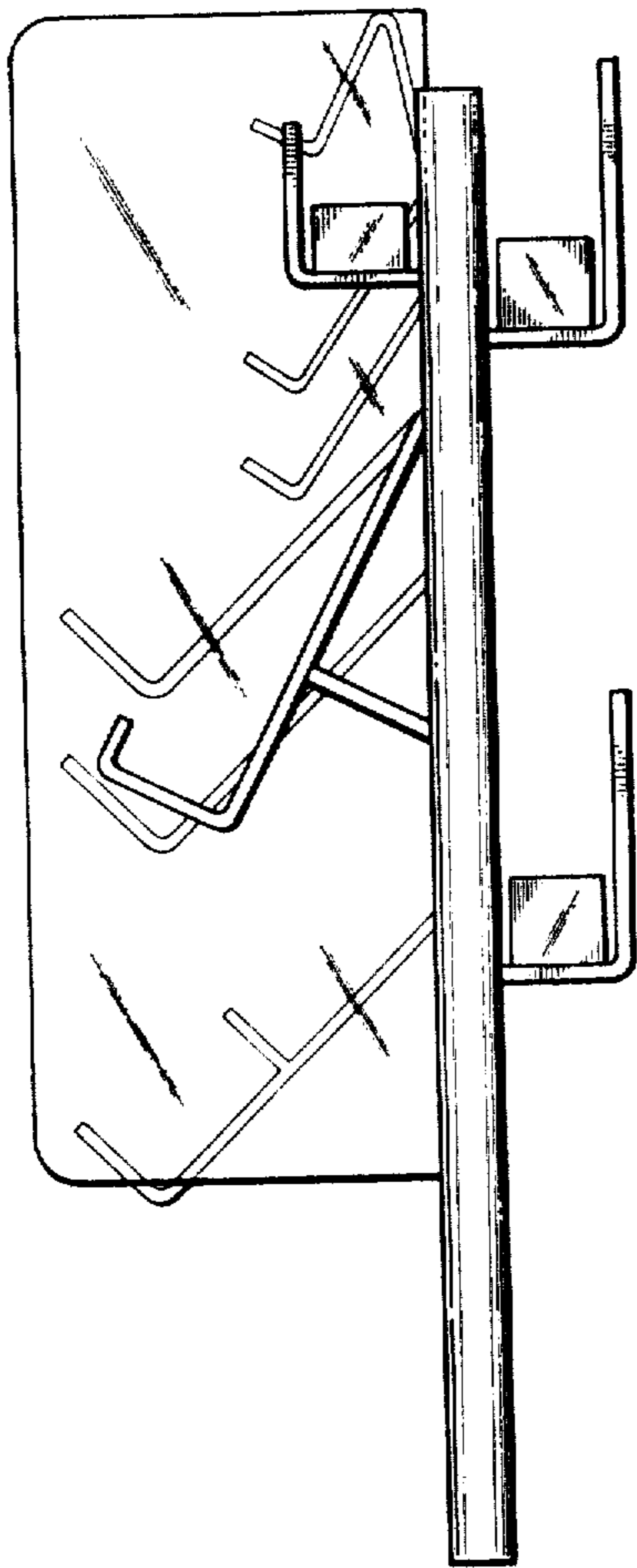

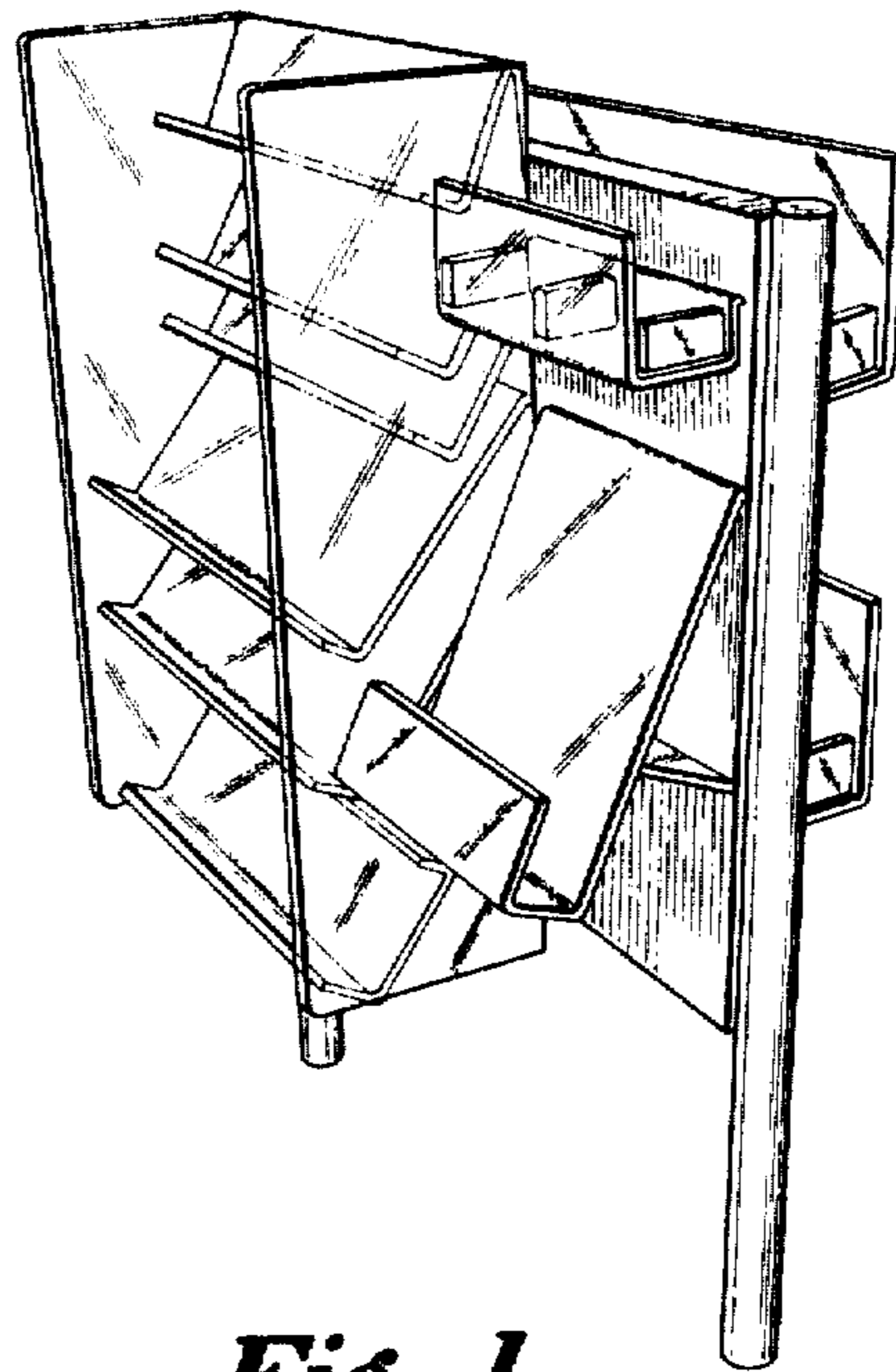

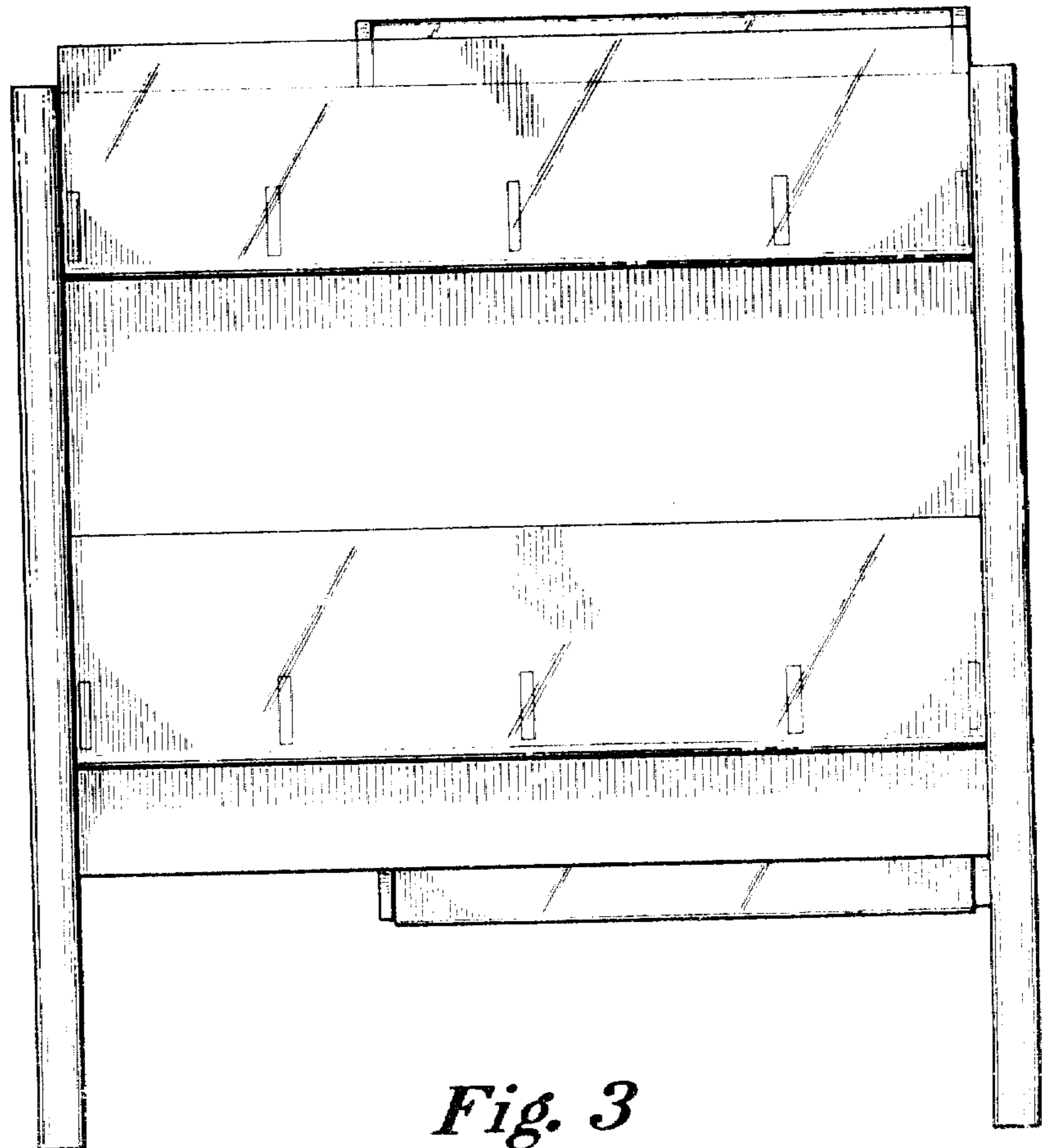

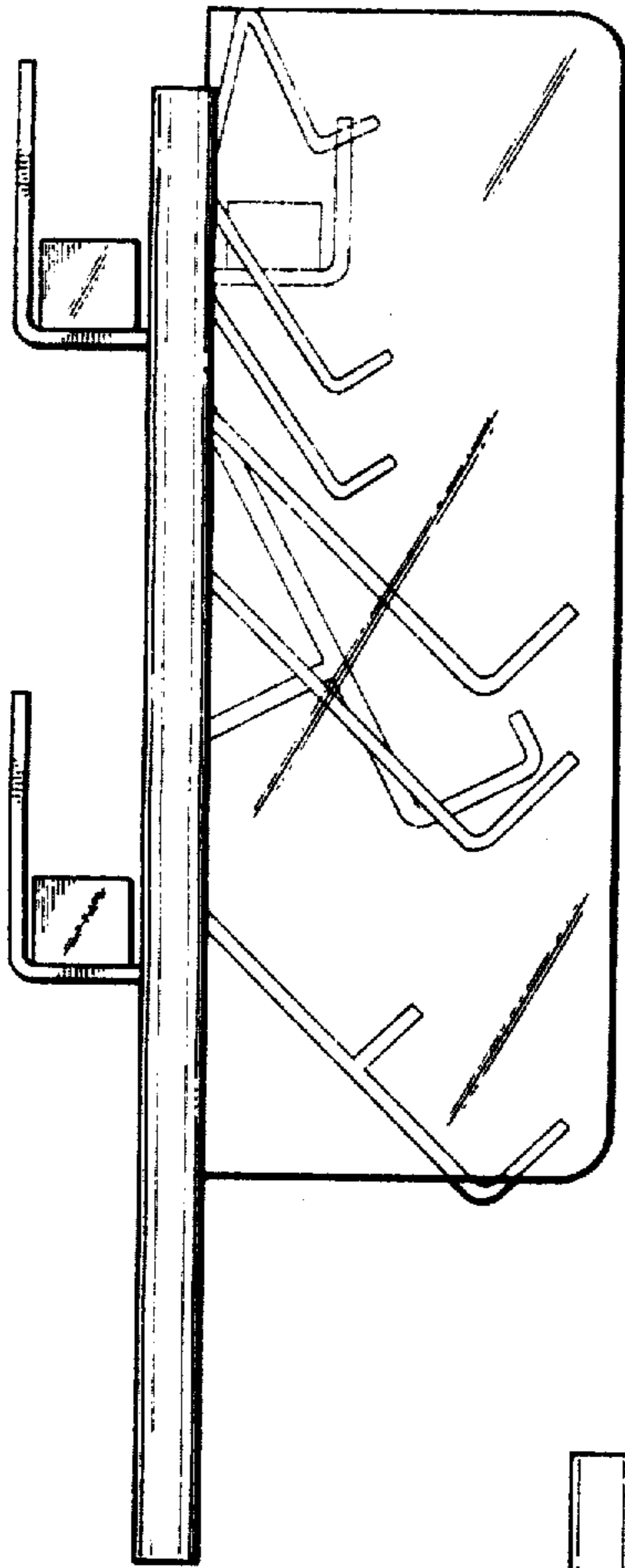

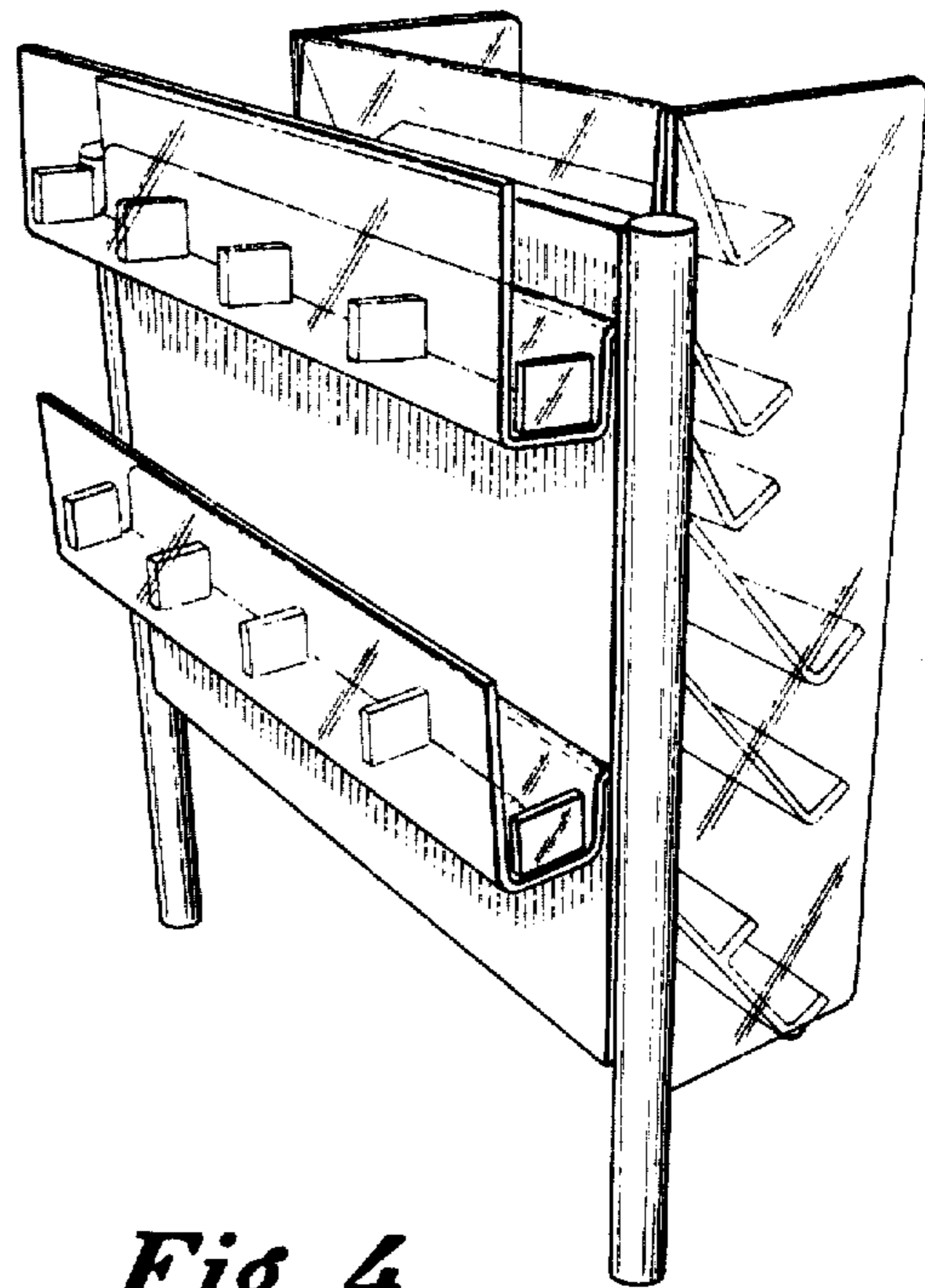

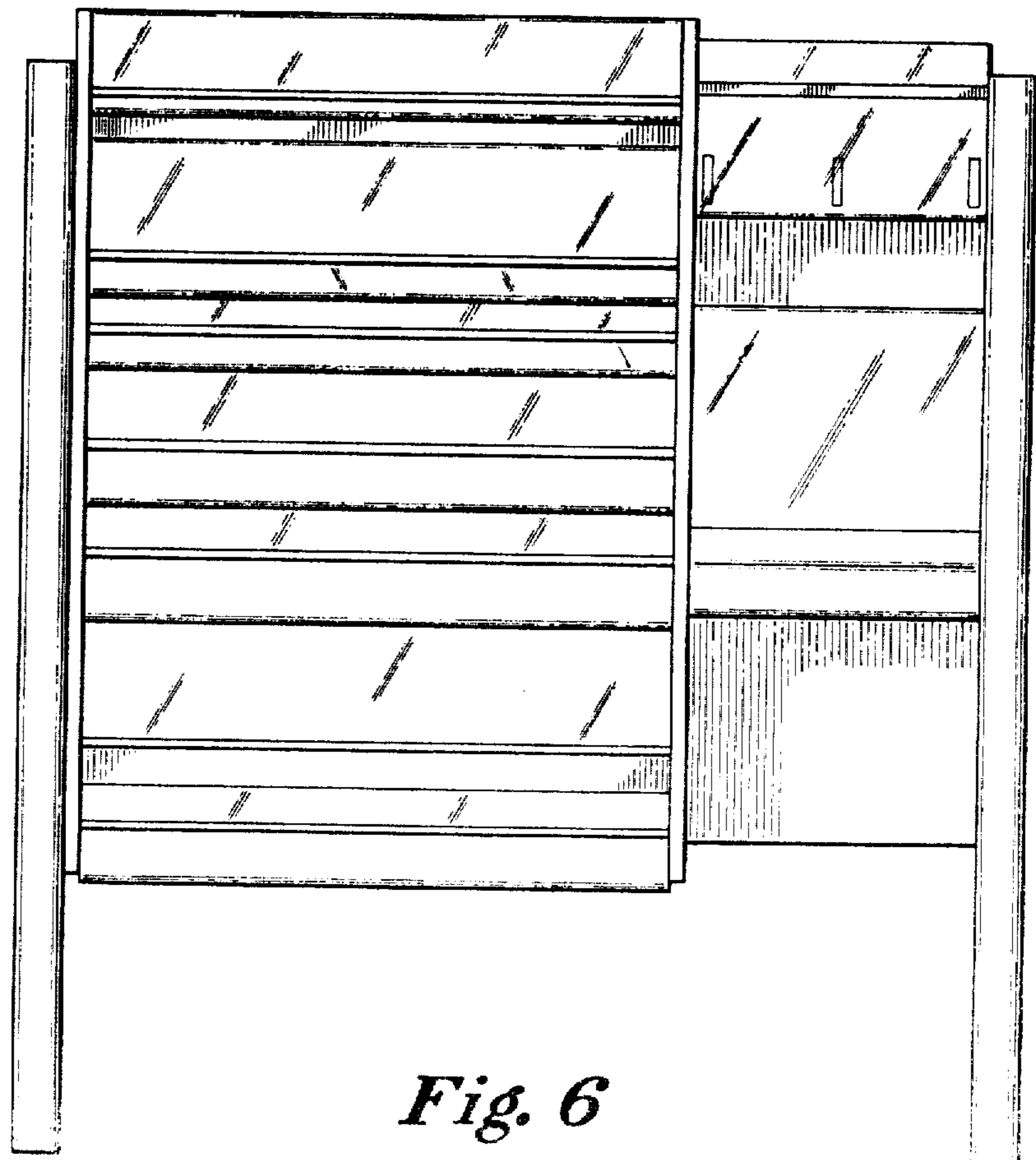
