[57] CLAIM

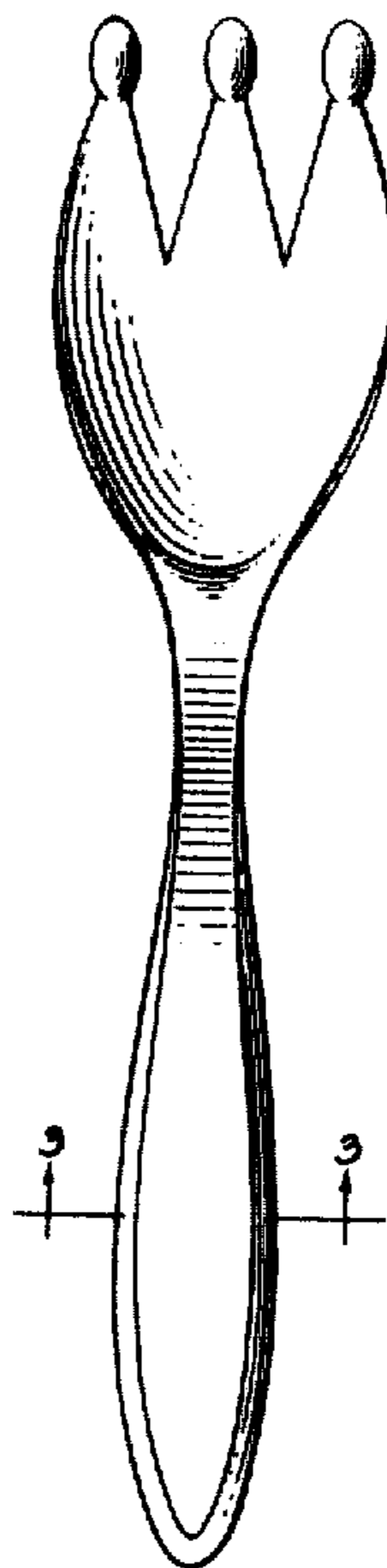
The ornamental design for a baby's fork, as shown and described.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the other side being identical; and

FIG. 3 is a cross-section on an enlarged scale taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1.



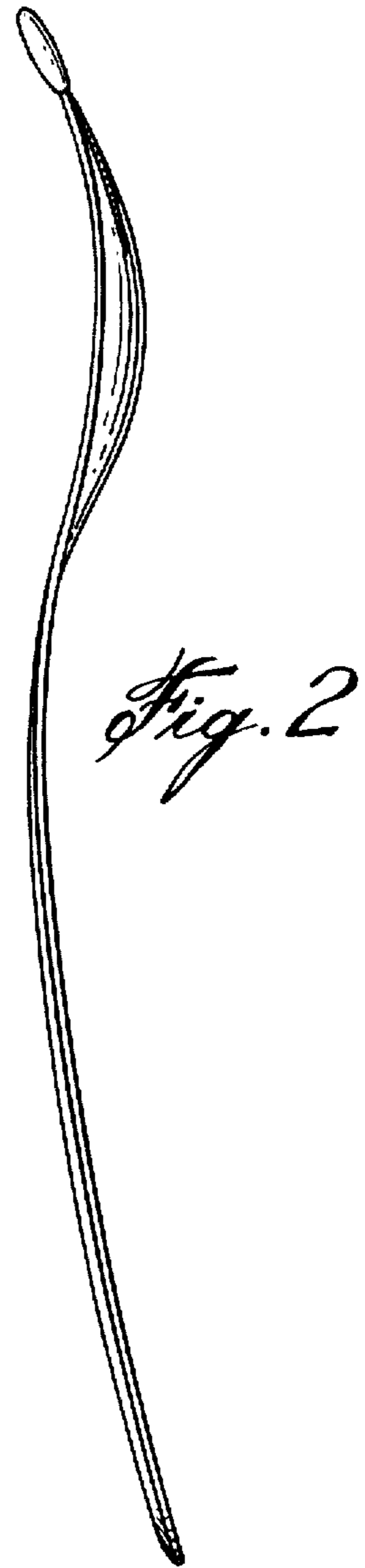
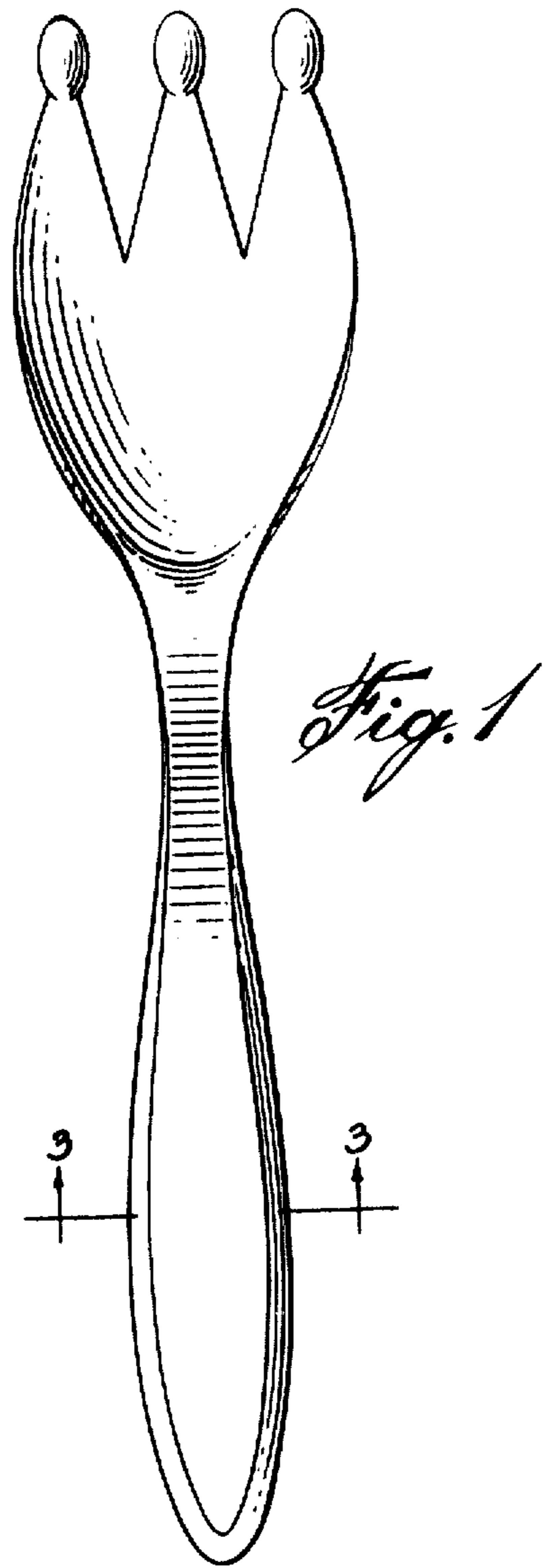
