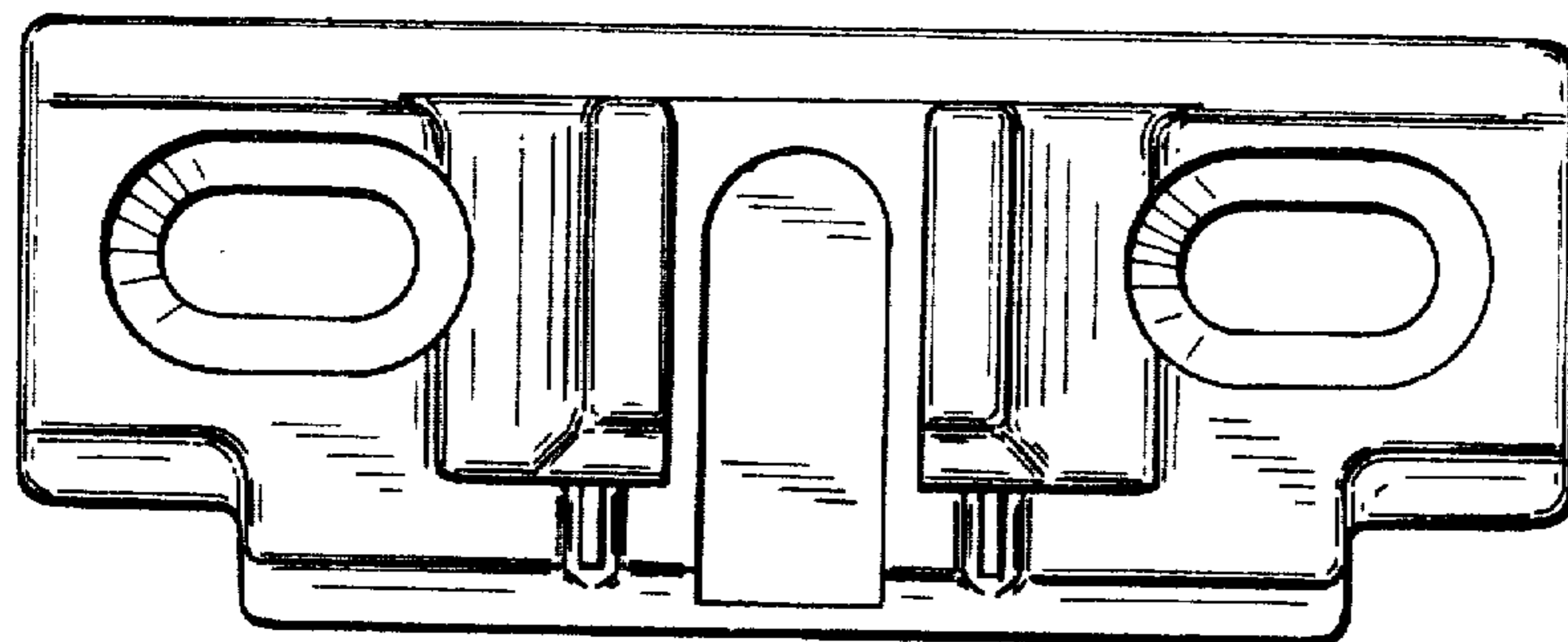

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a mounting plate for a hinge, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the novel mounting plate for a hinge according to our new design, the bottom thereof being substantially planar and unornamented; FIG. 2 is an elevation view thereof, taken from the bottom of FIG. 1; and FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, taken from the right side of FIG. 1.



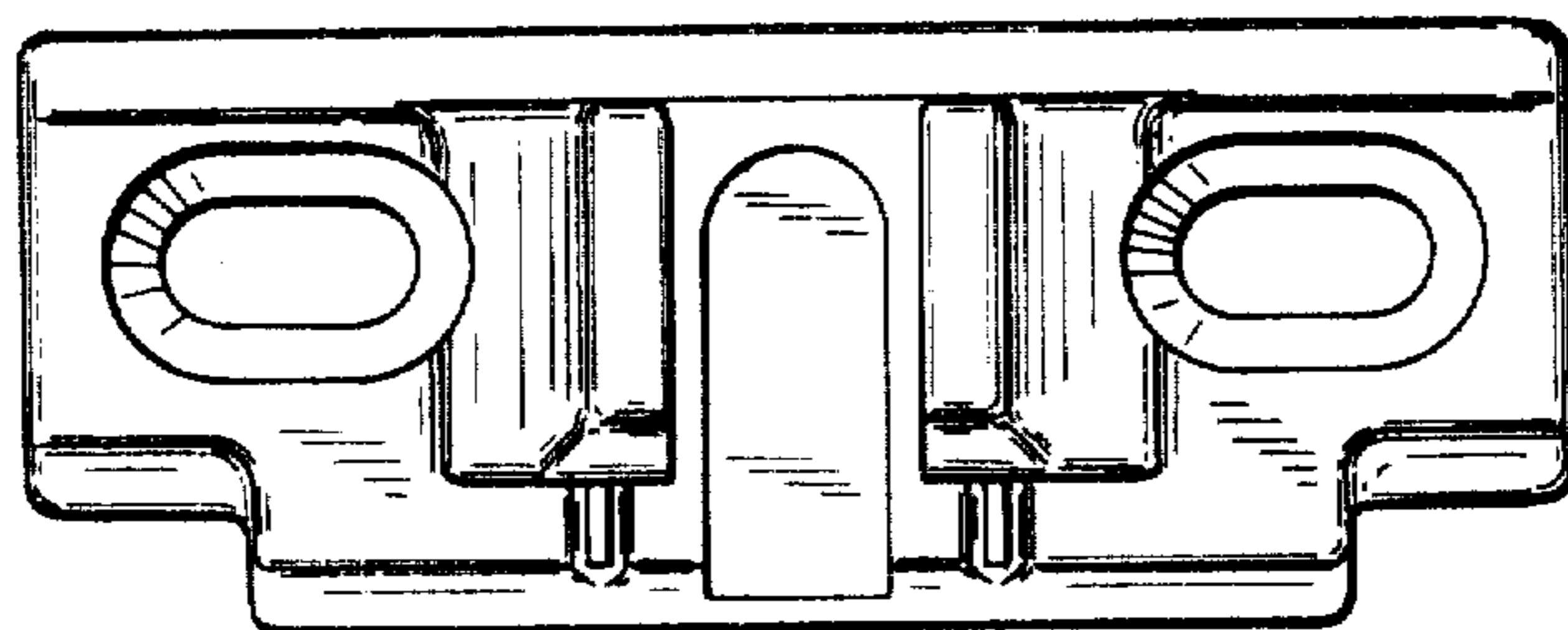

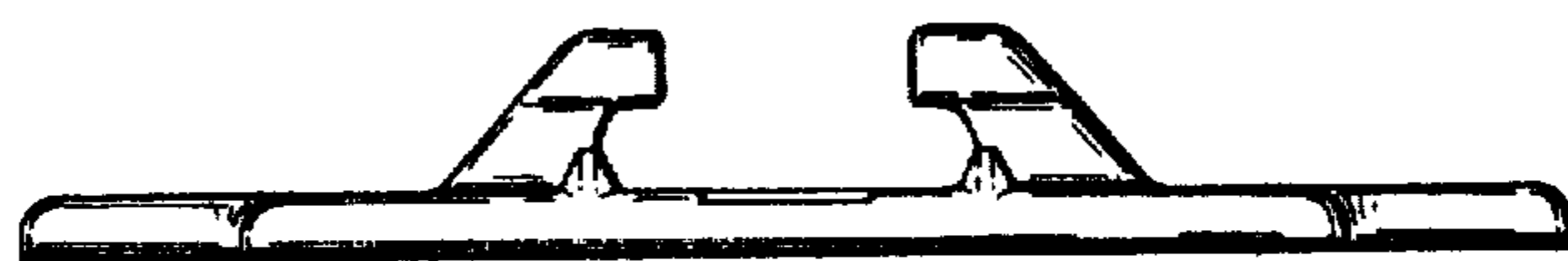

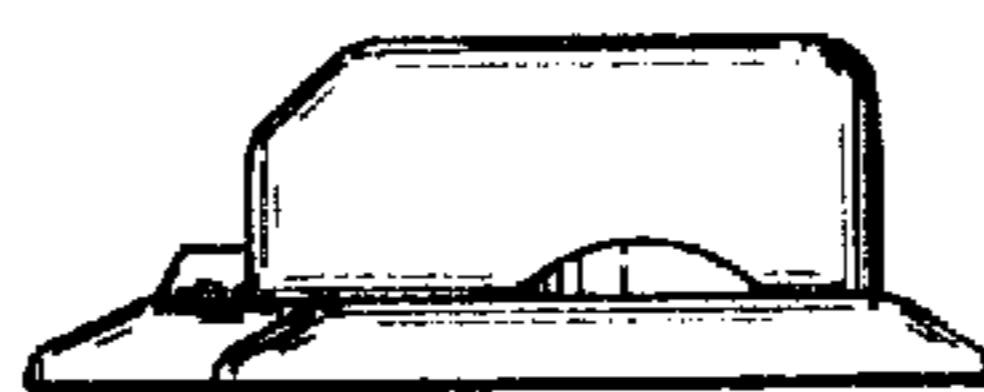
