The ornamental design for a container handle, or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

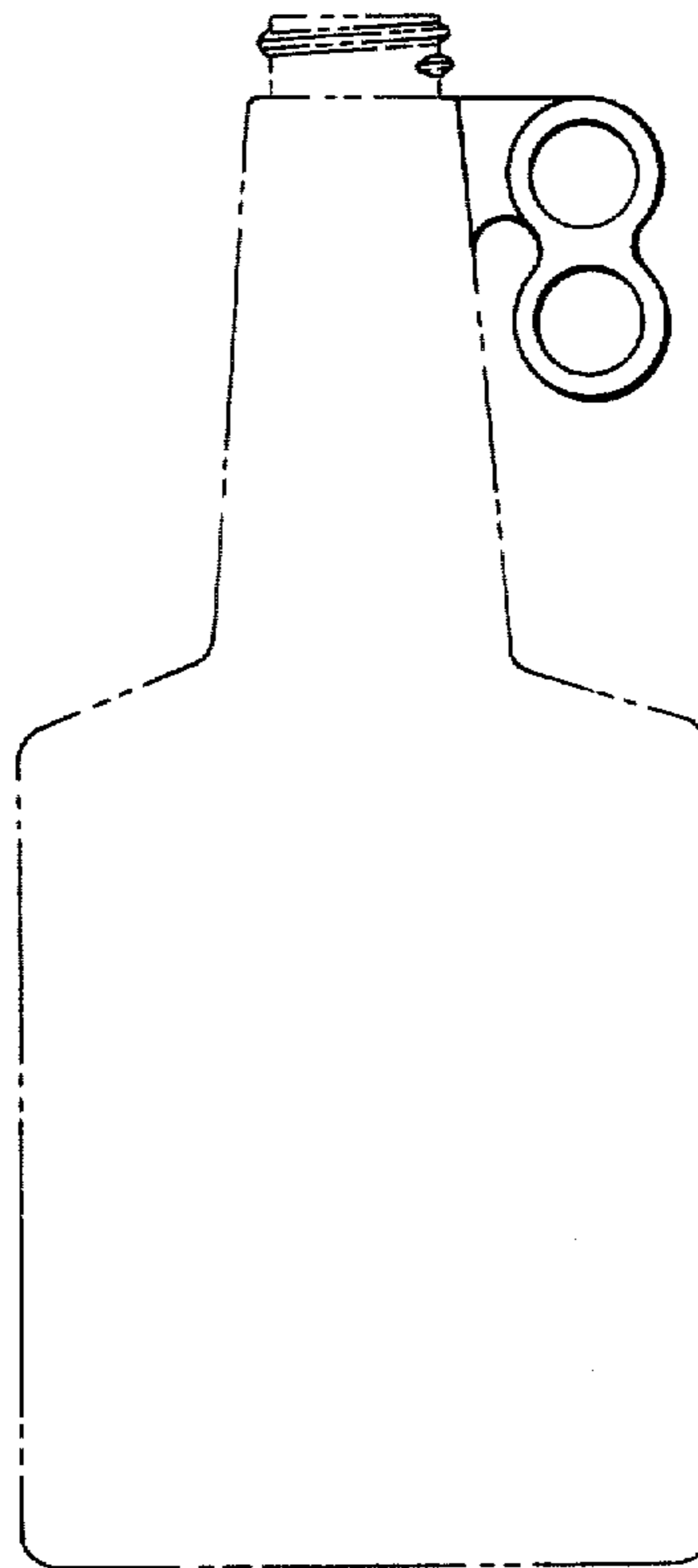
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a container handle embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary, sectional view taken on the line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

A container is shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3 to illustrate environmental use.



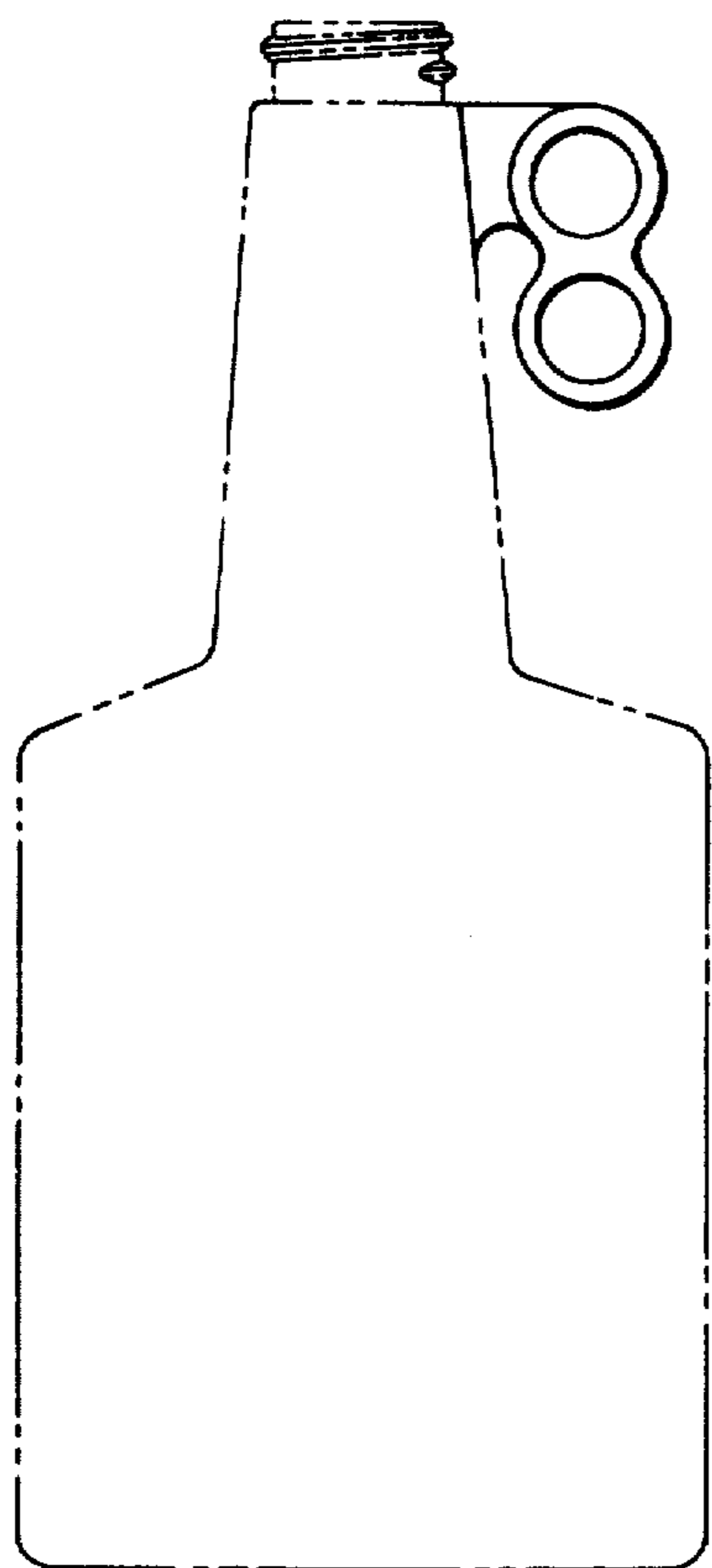

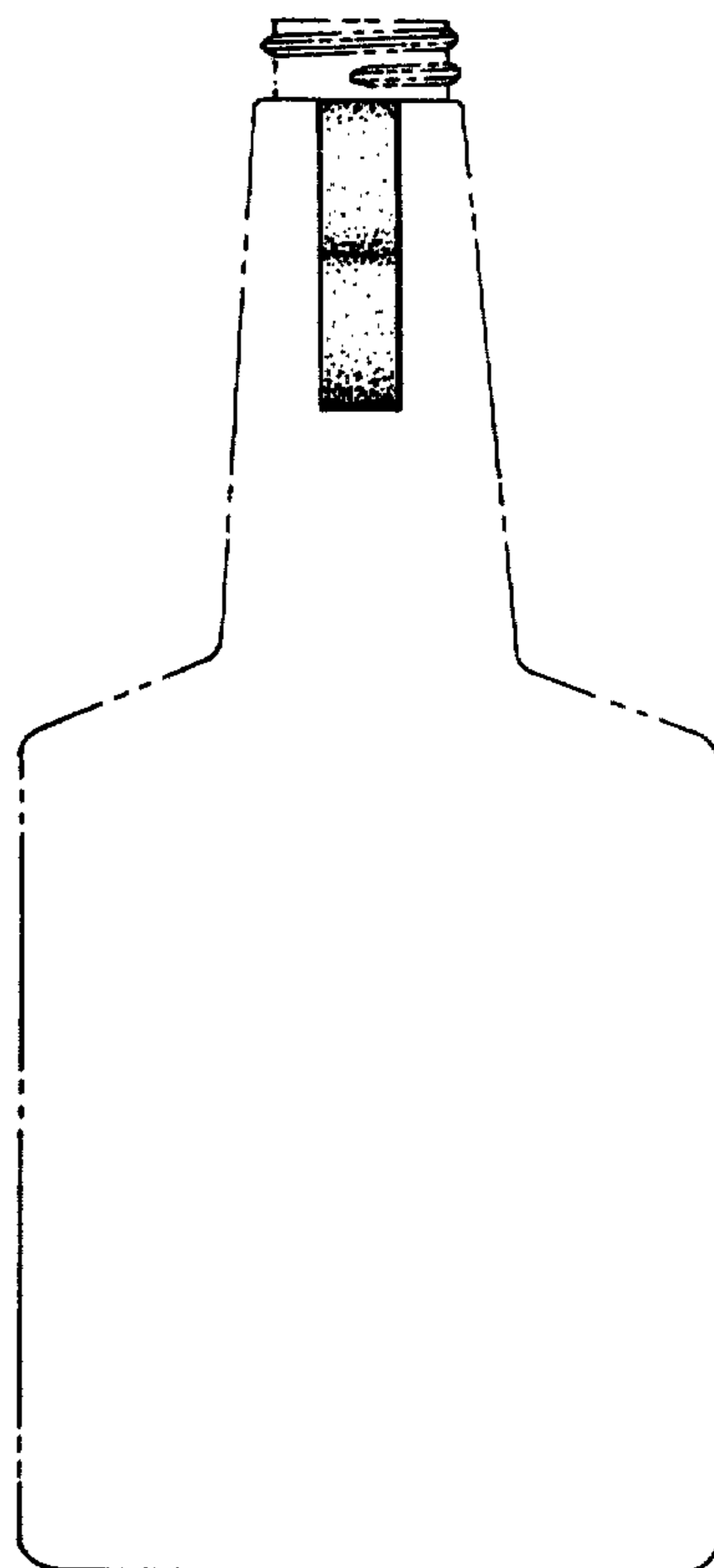

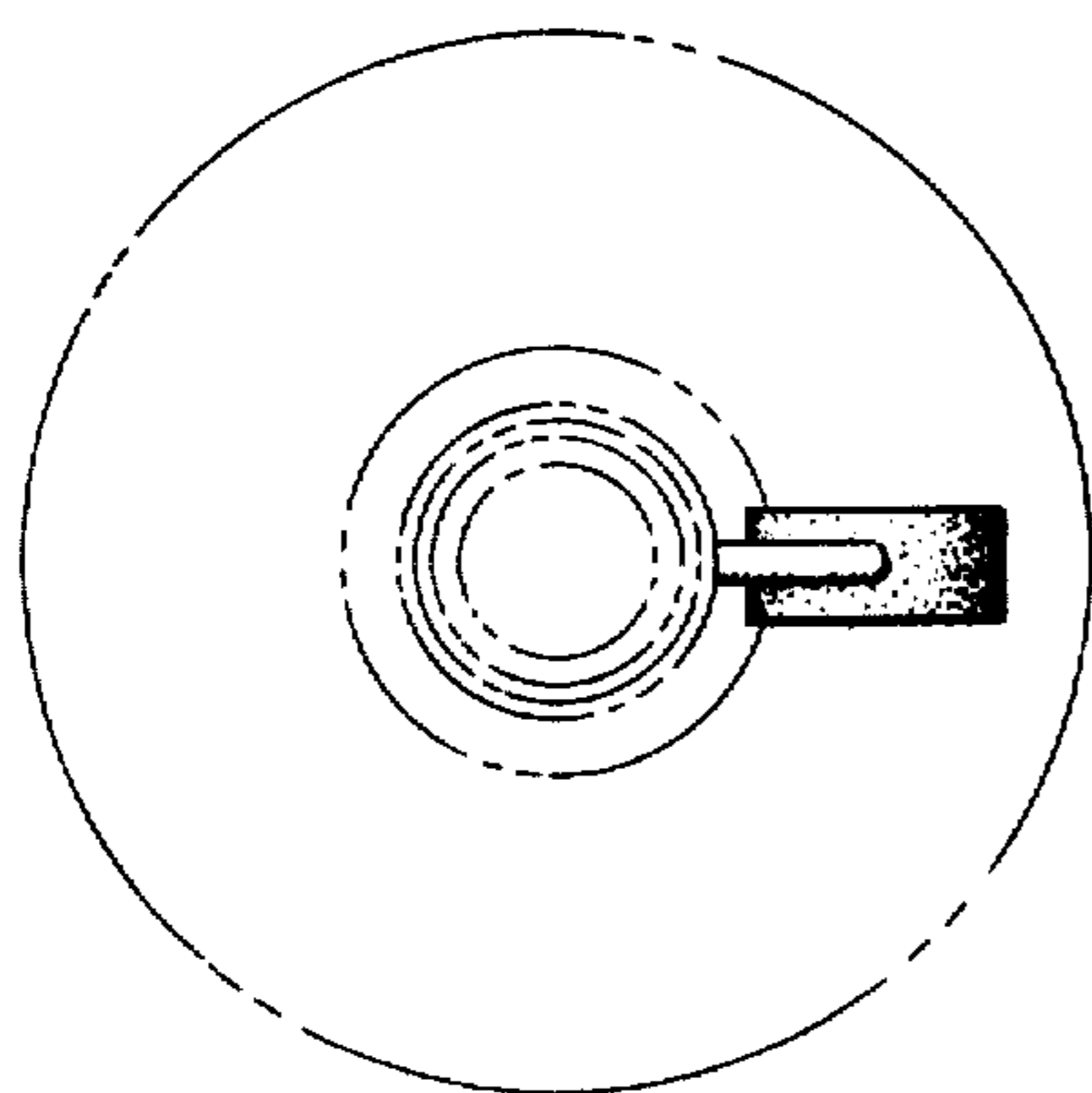
