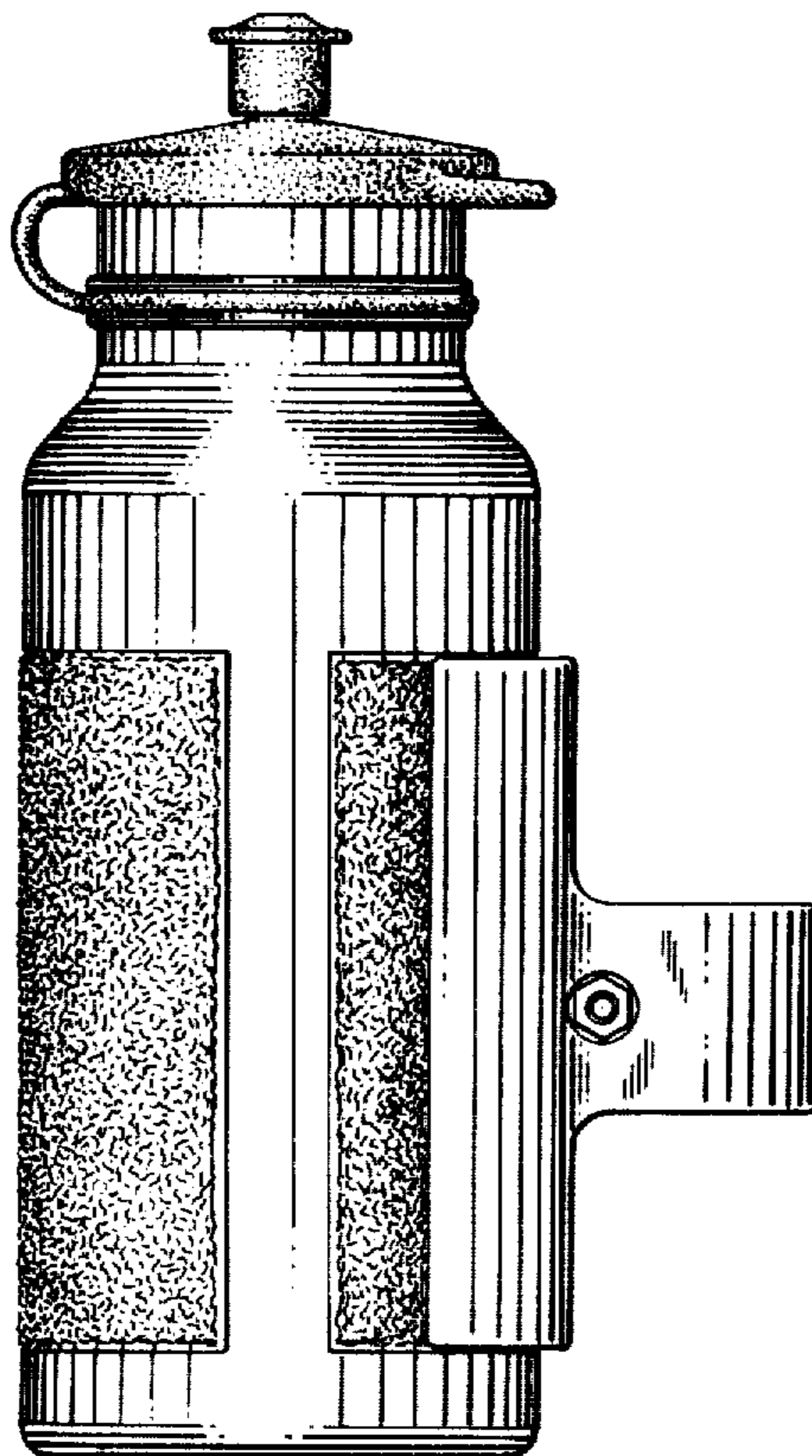

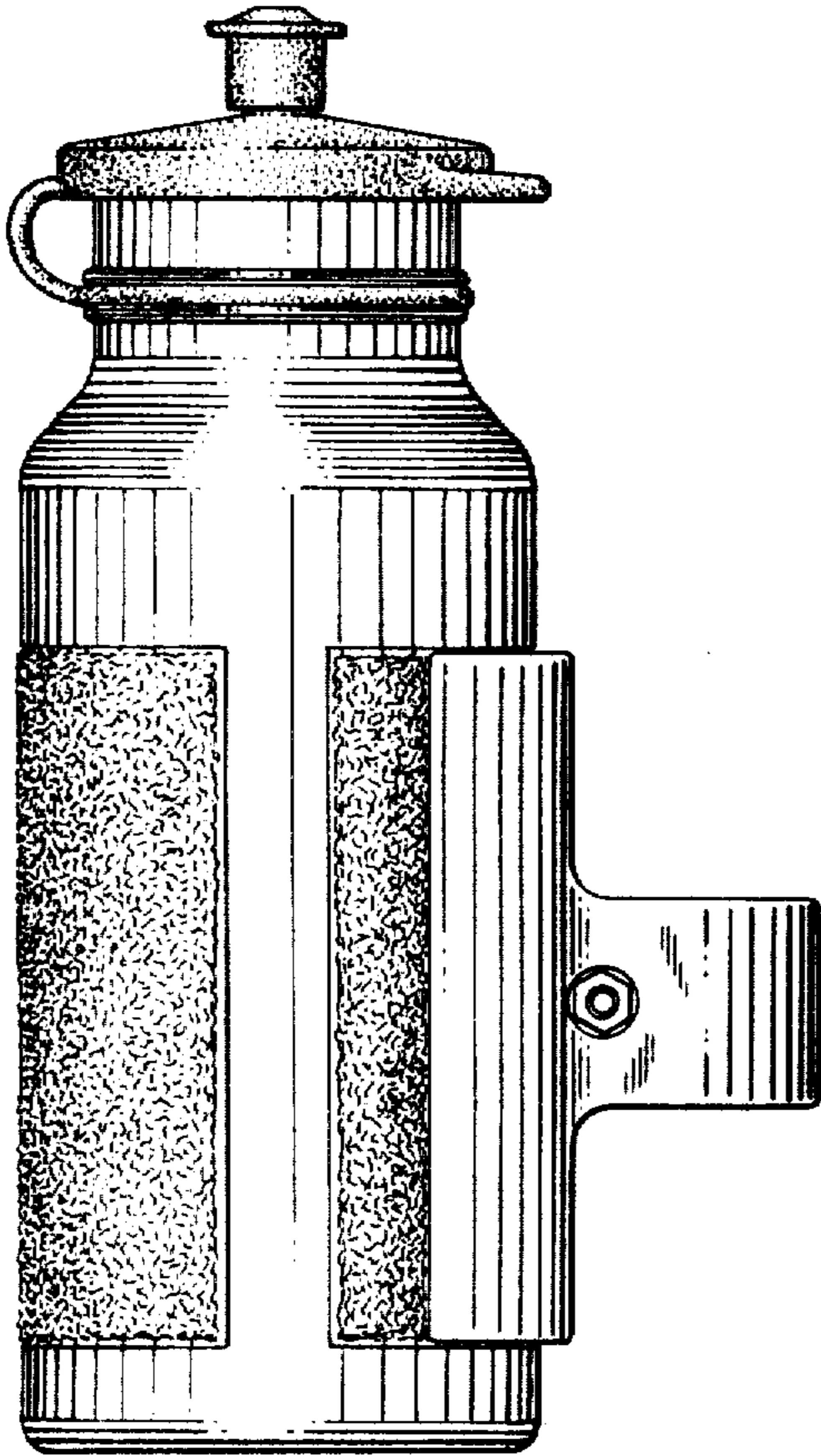
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined bottle mount and bottle for bicycles, as shown.

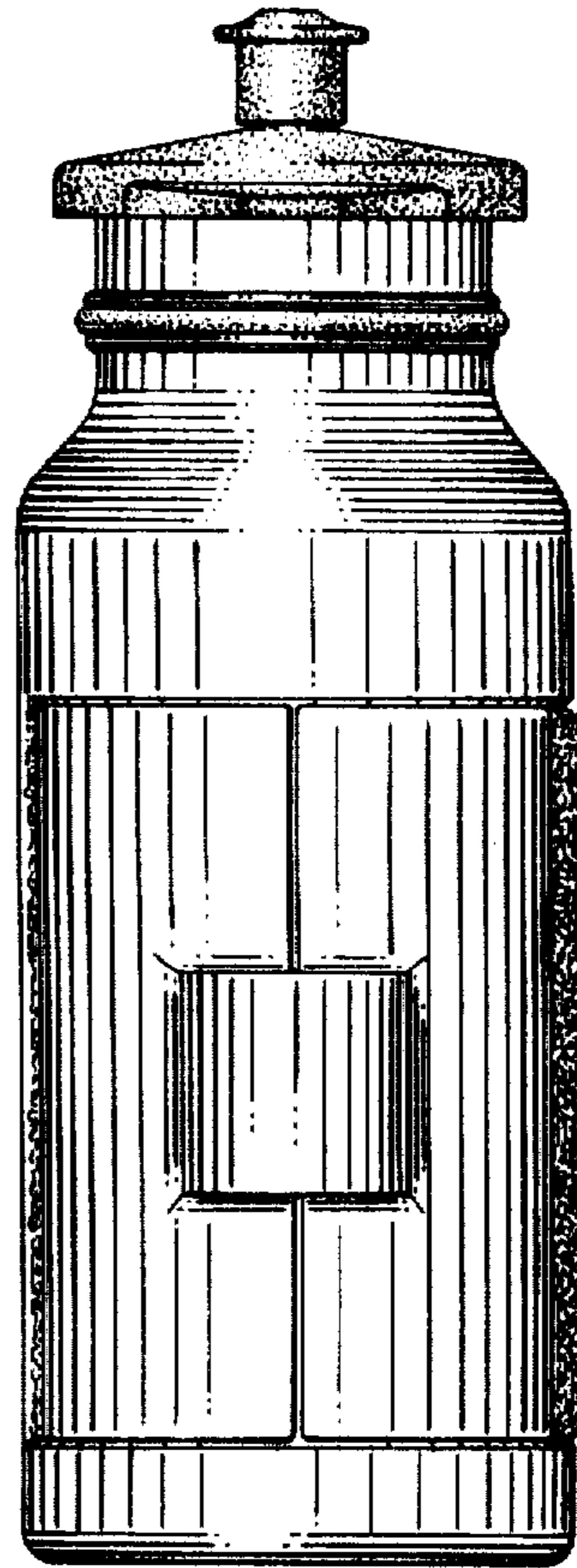
**DESCRIPTION**

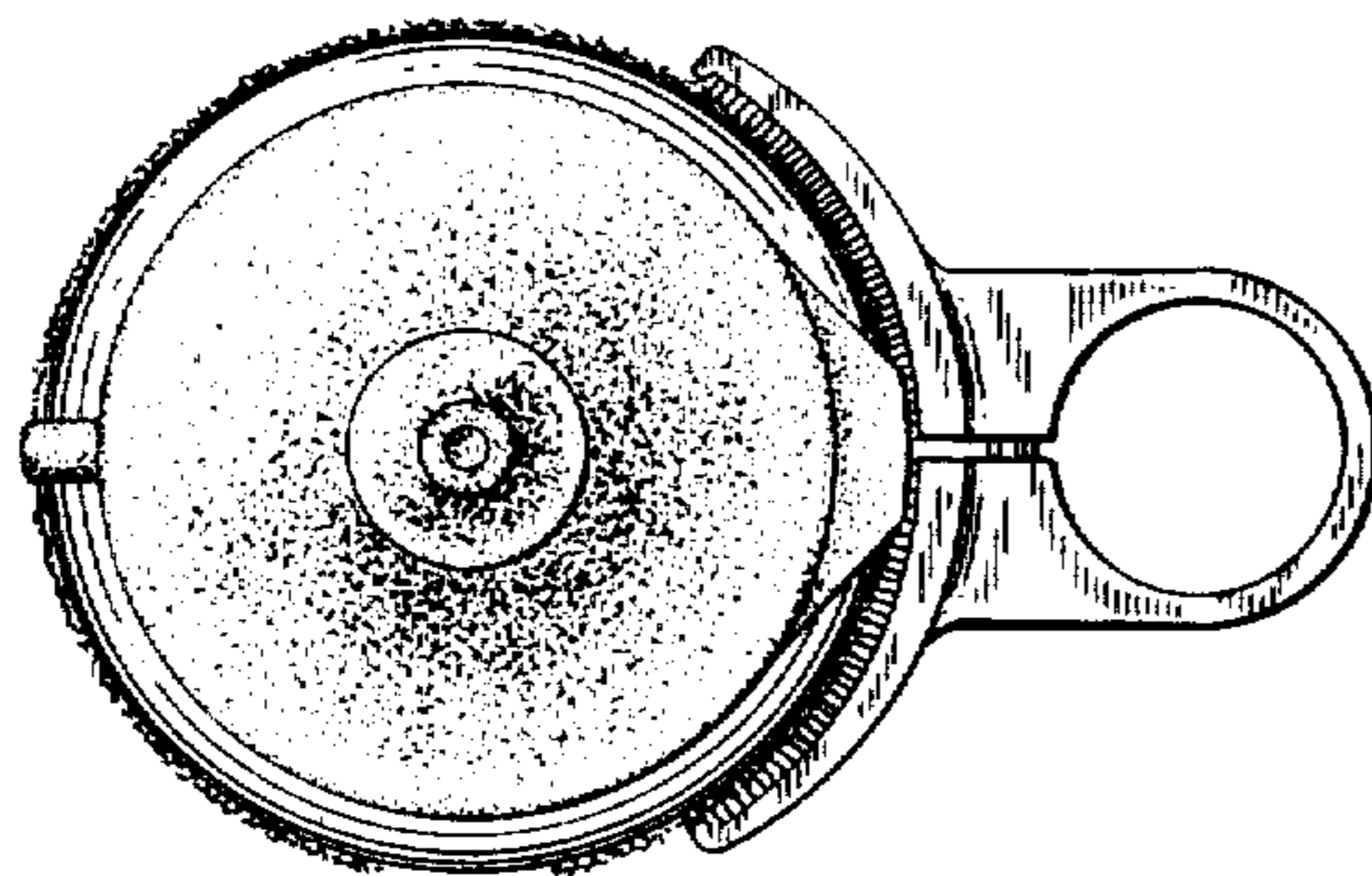




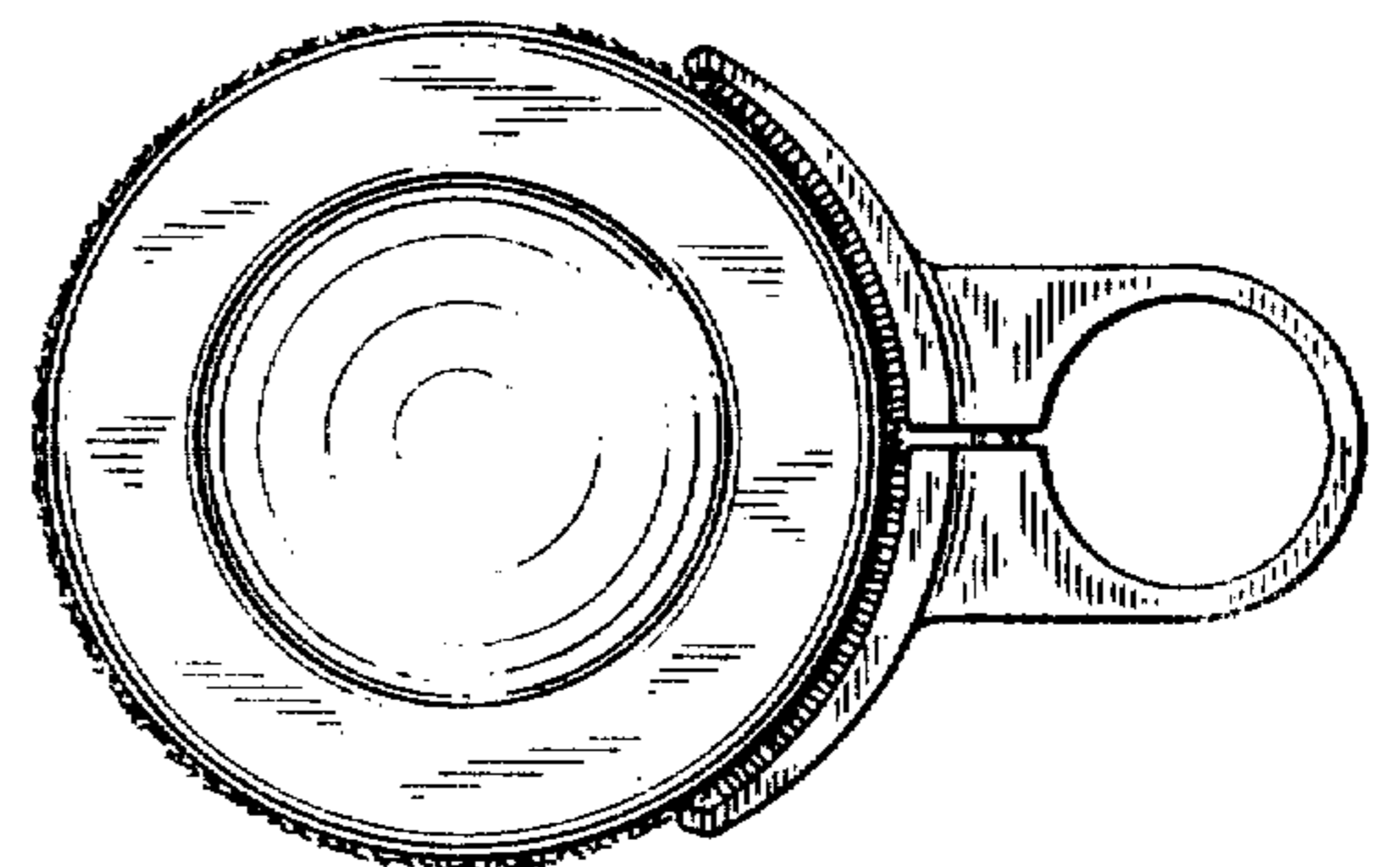
