The ornamental design for a computer peripheral or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a computer peripheral or similar article showing our new design; FIG. 2 a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the opposite side thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of our design, the sides, rear, top and bottom being identical to those of the first embodiment; FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of our design, the sides, rear, top and bottom being identical to those of the first embodiment; FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment of our new design, the sides, rear, top and bottom being identical to those of the first embodiment; FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment of our design, the sides being identical to those of the first embodiment as shown in FIGS. 2 and 3; FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of a sixth embodiment of our new design, the sides, rear, top and bottom being identical to those of the fifth embodiment; FIG. 15 is a front elevational view of a seventh embodiment of our new design, the sides, rear, top and bottom being identical to those of the fifth embodiment; and FIG. 16 is front perspective view of the first embodiment.

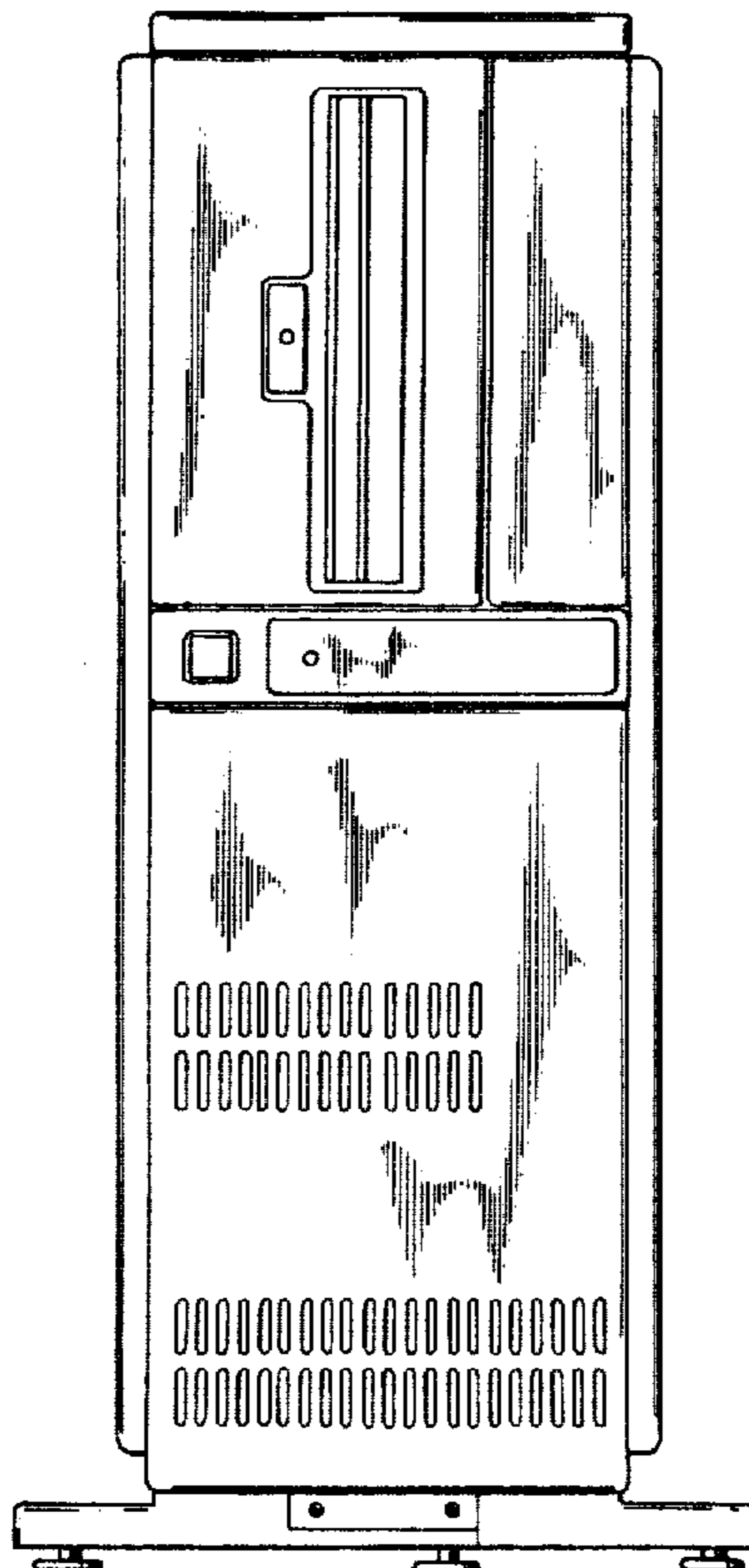

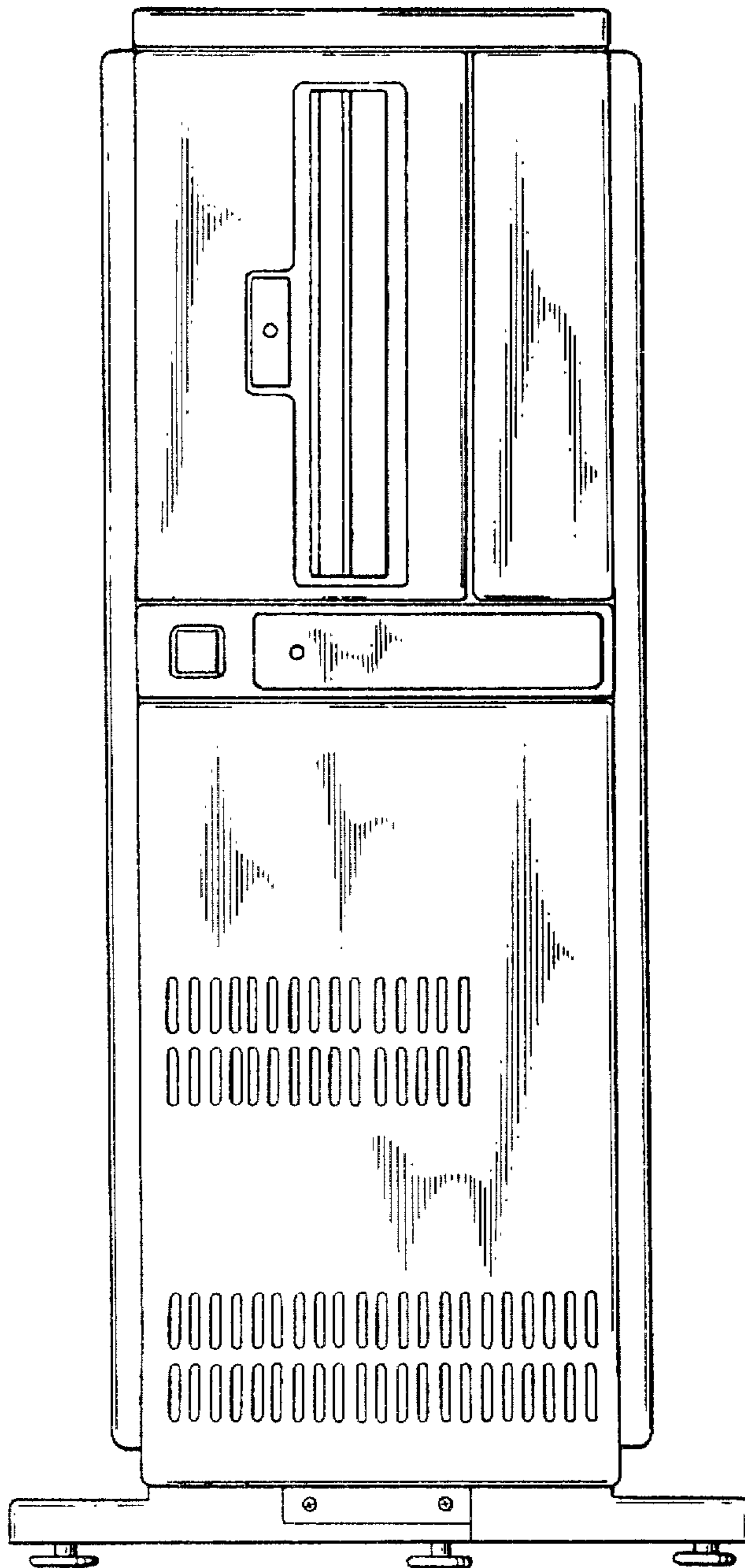

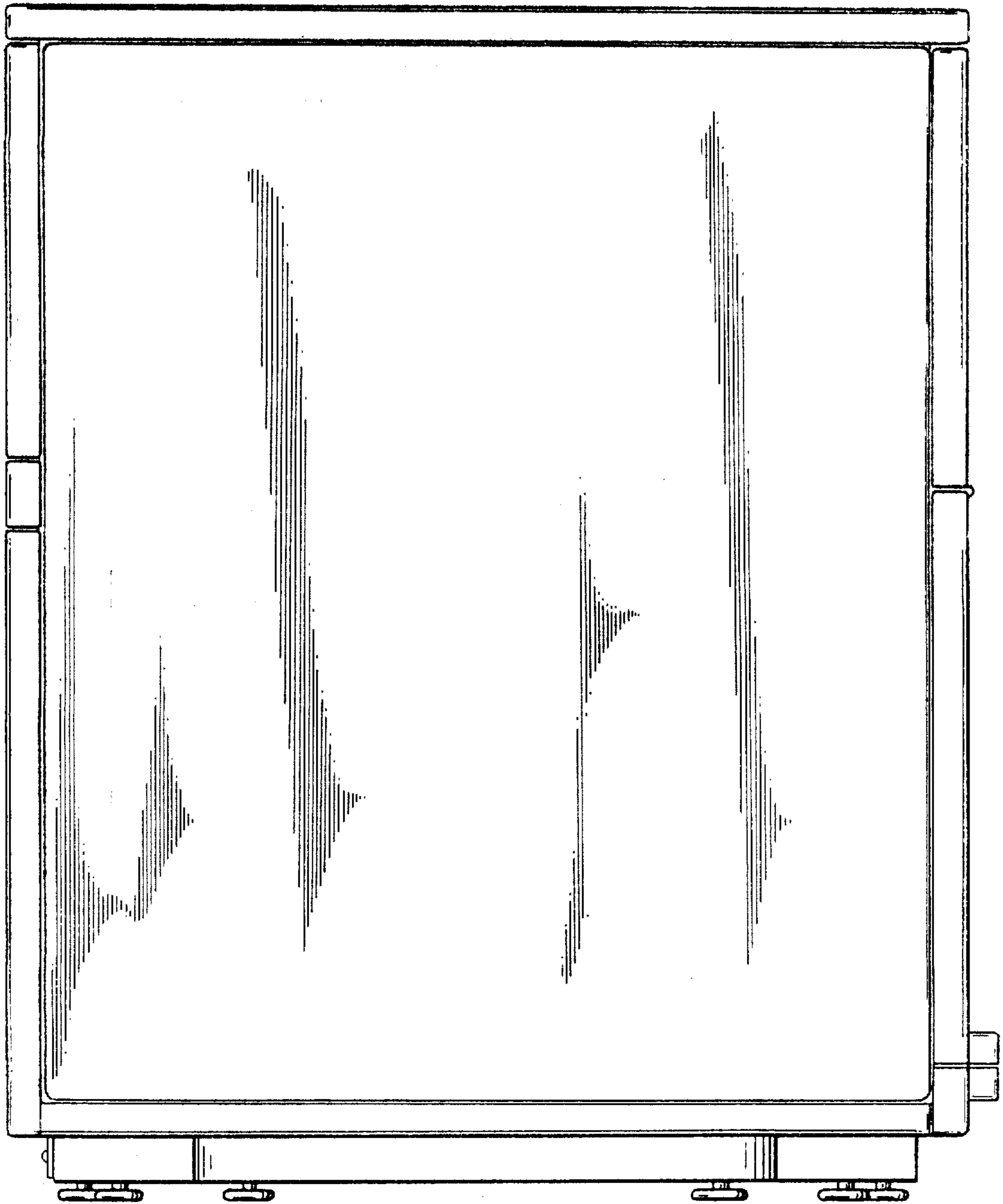

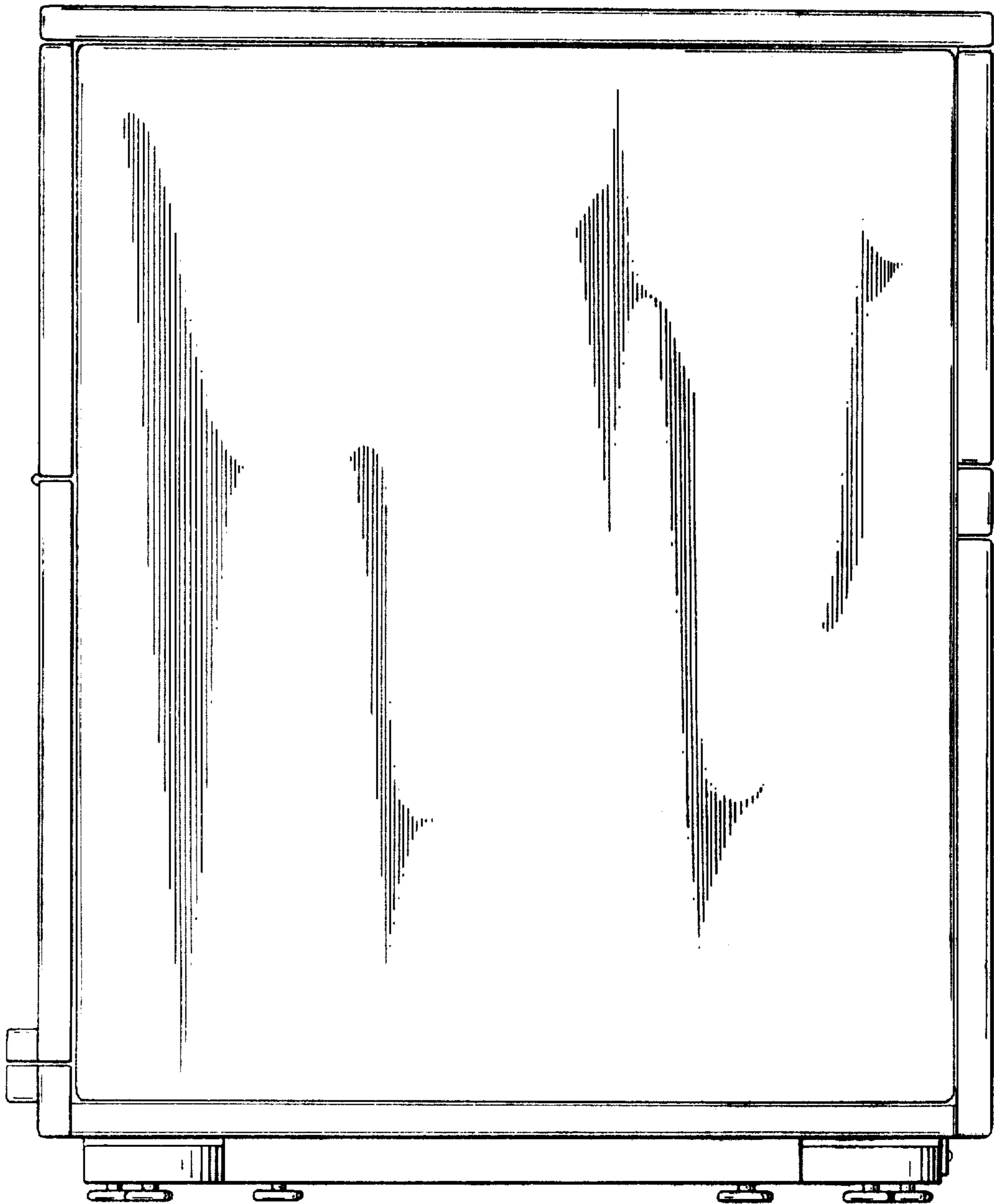

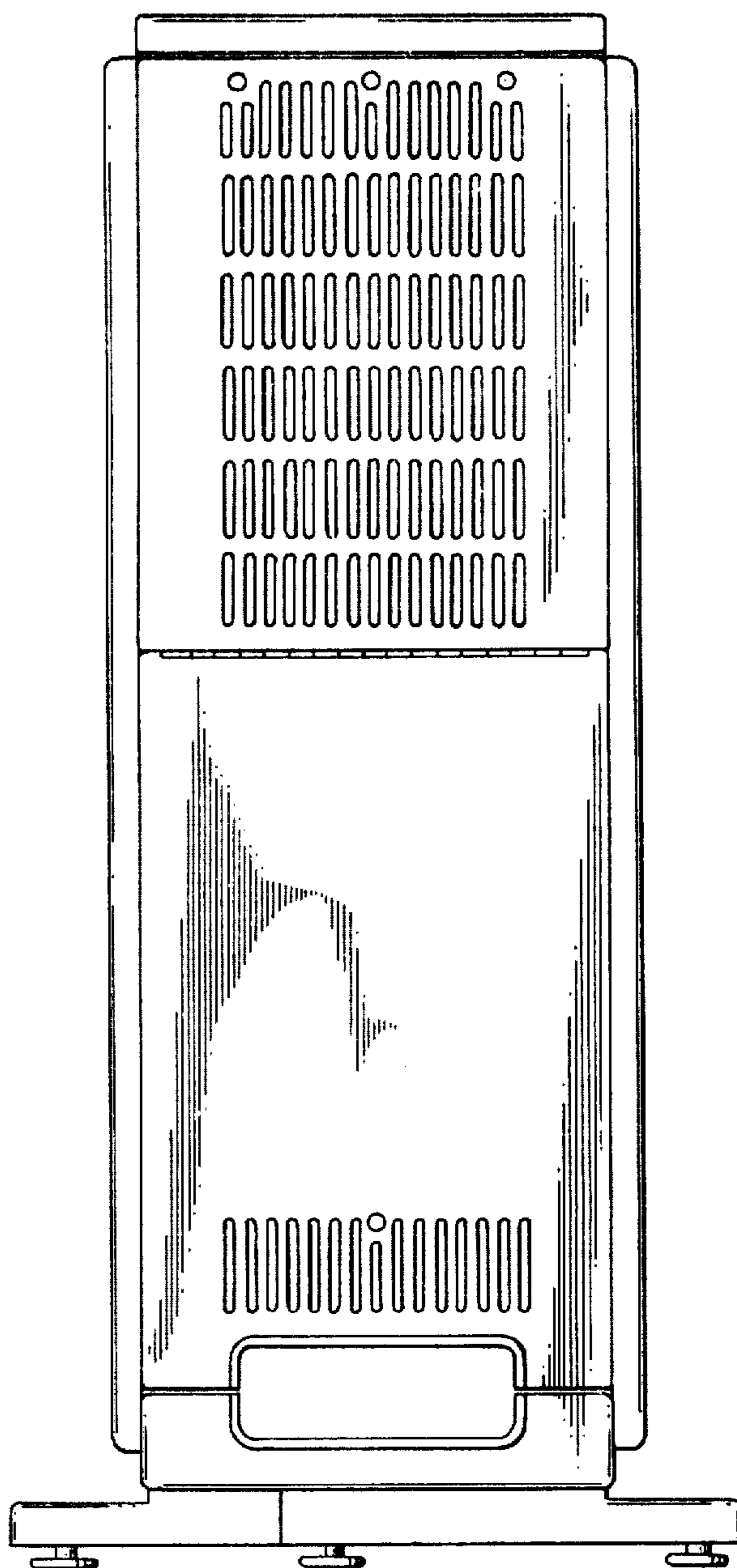

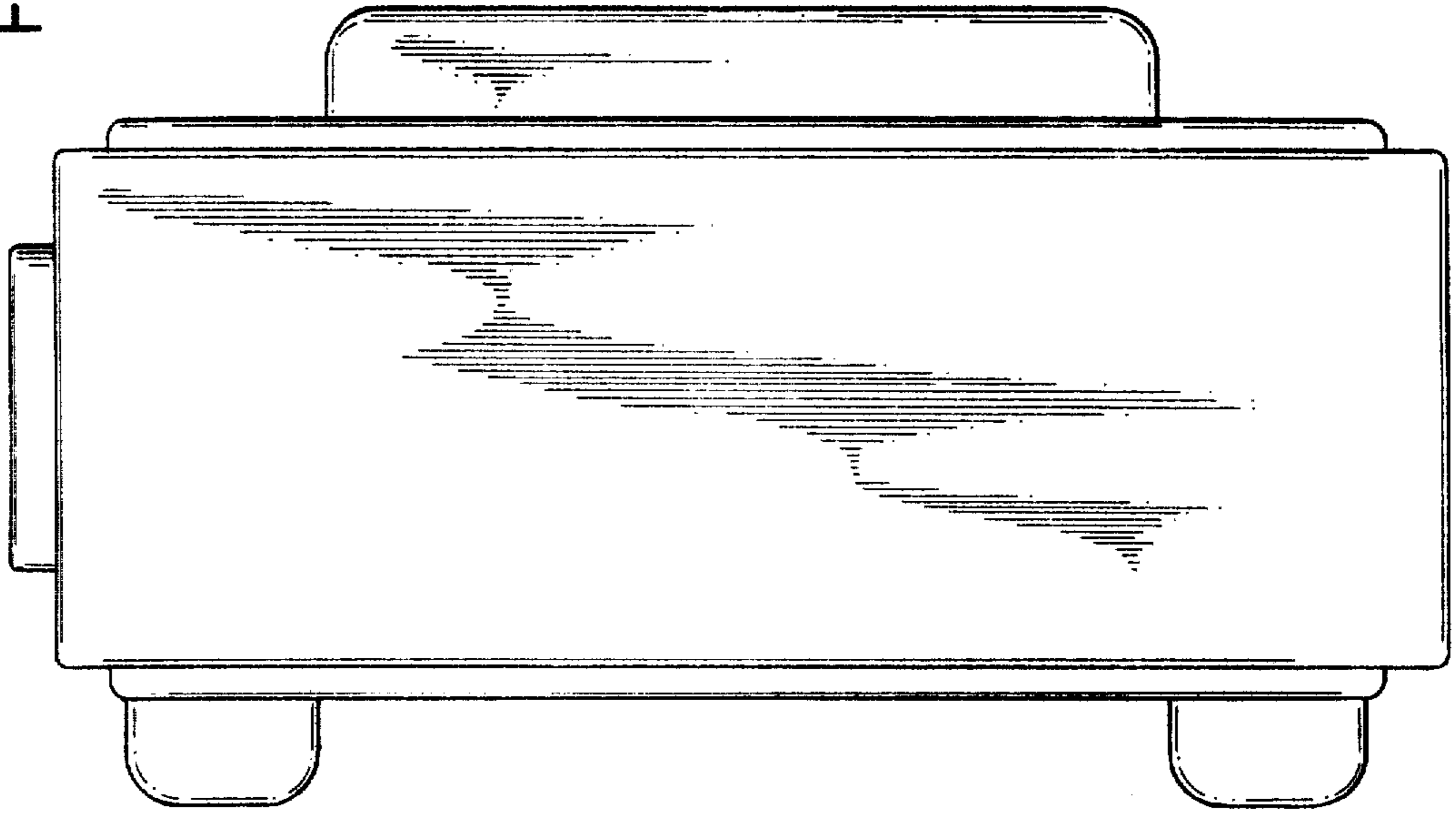

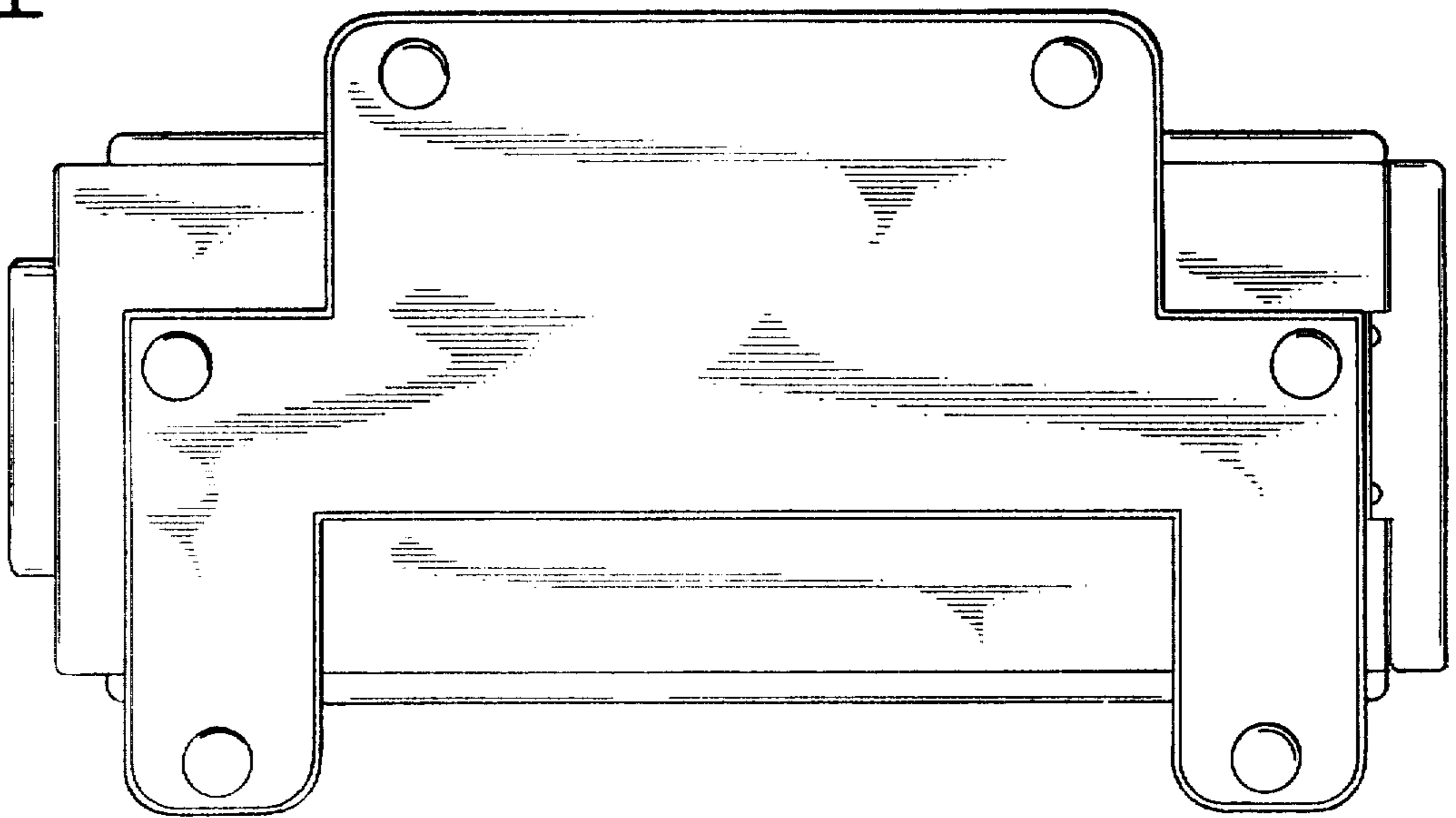

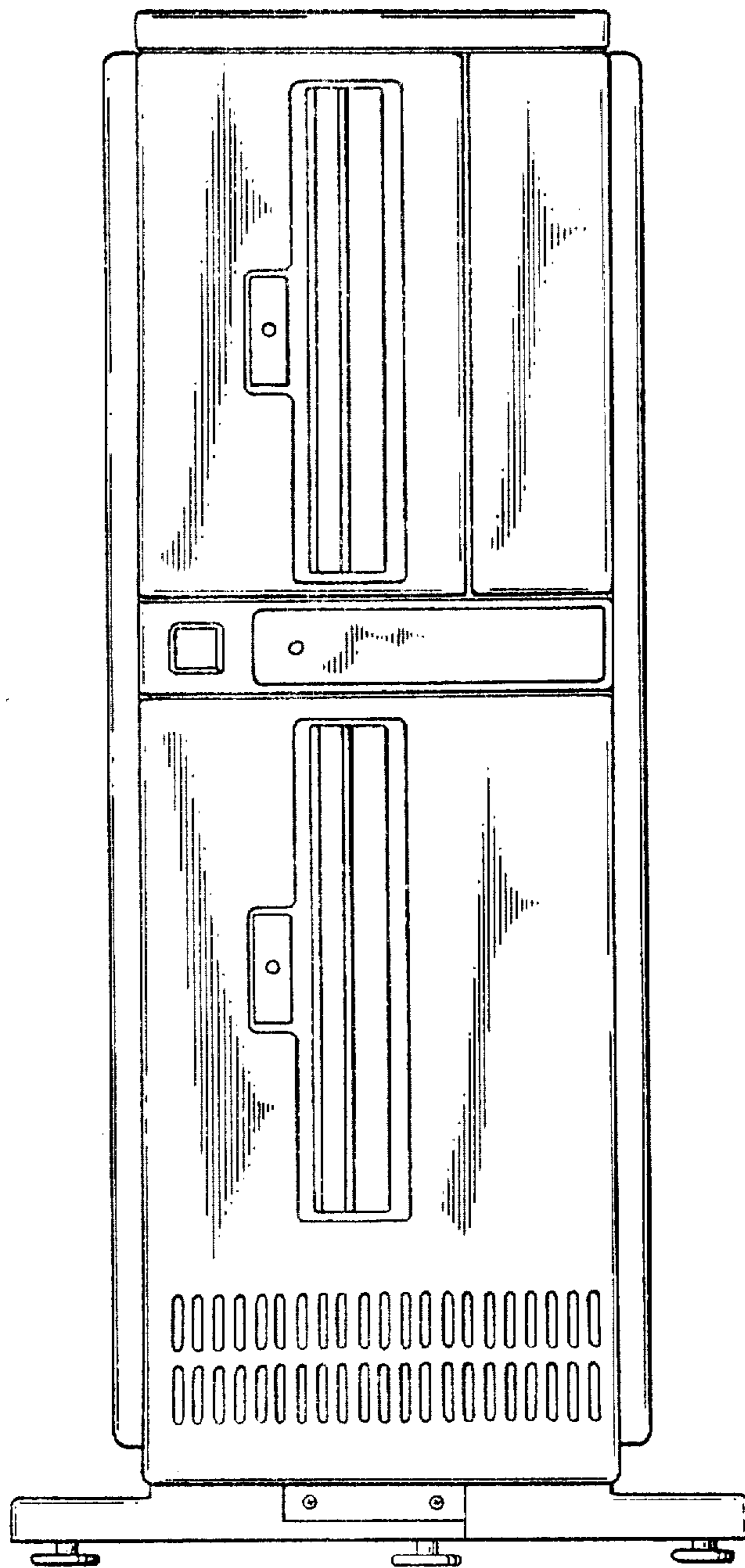

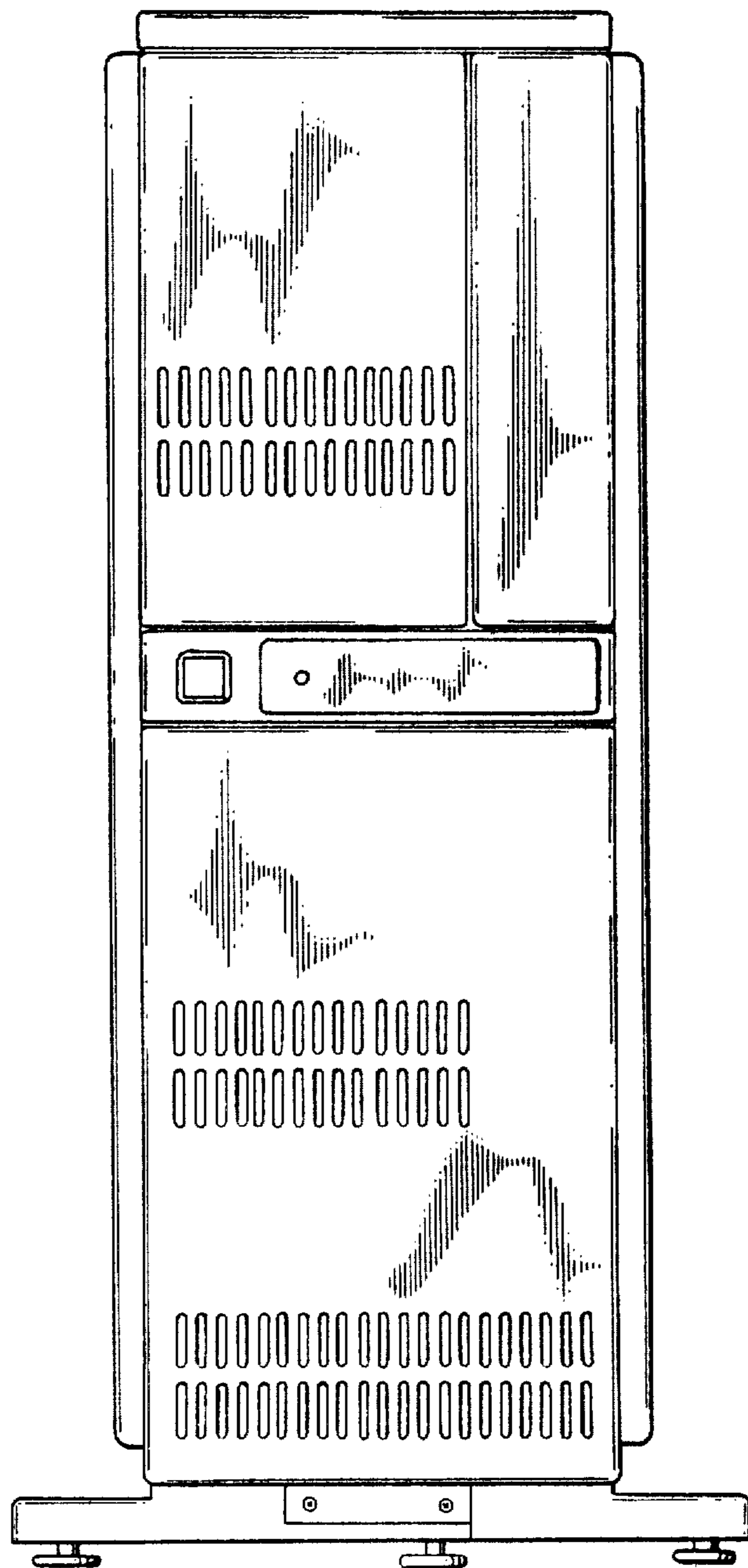

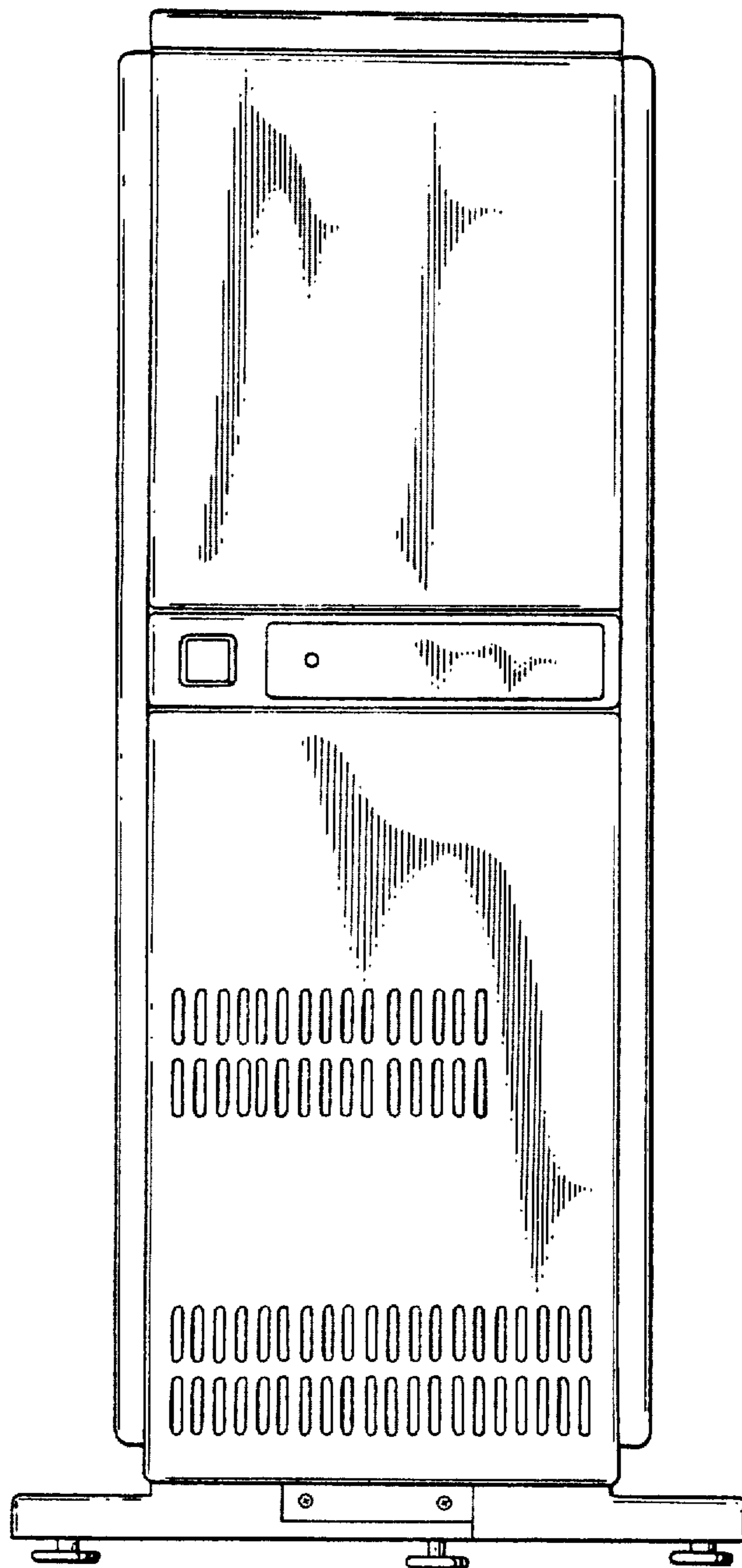

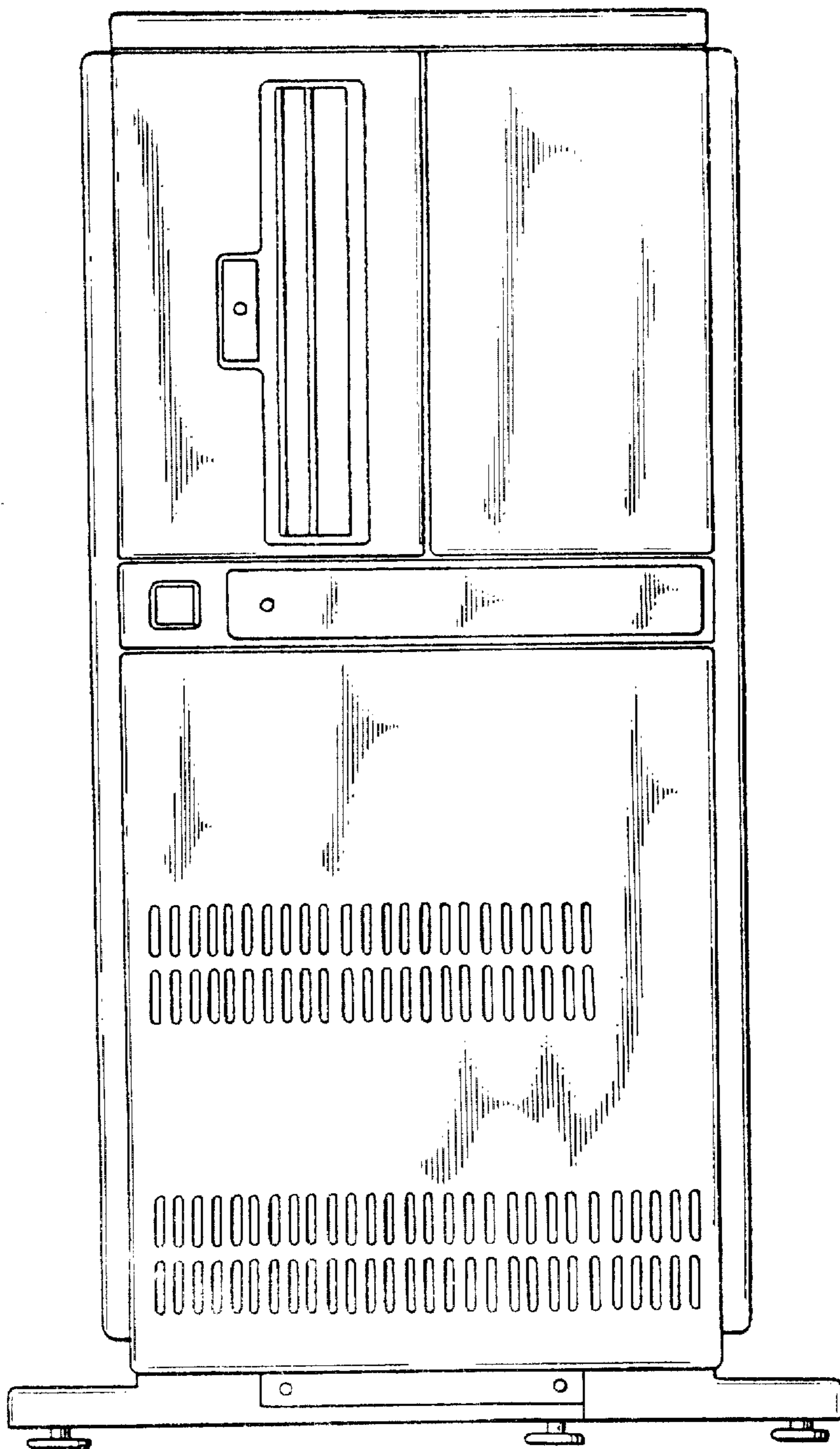

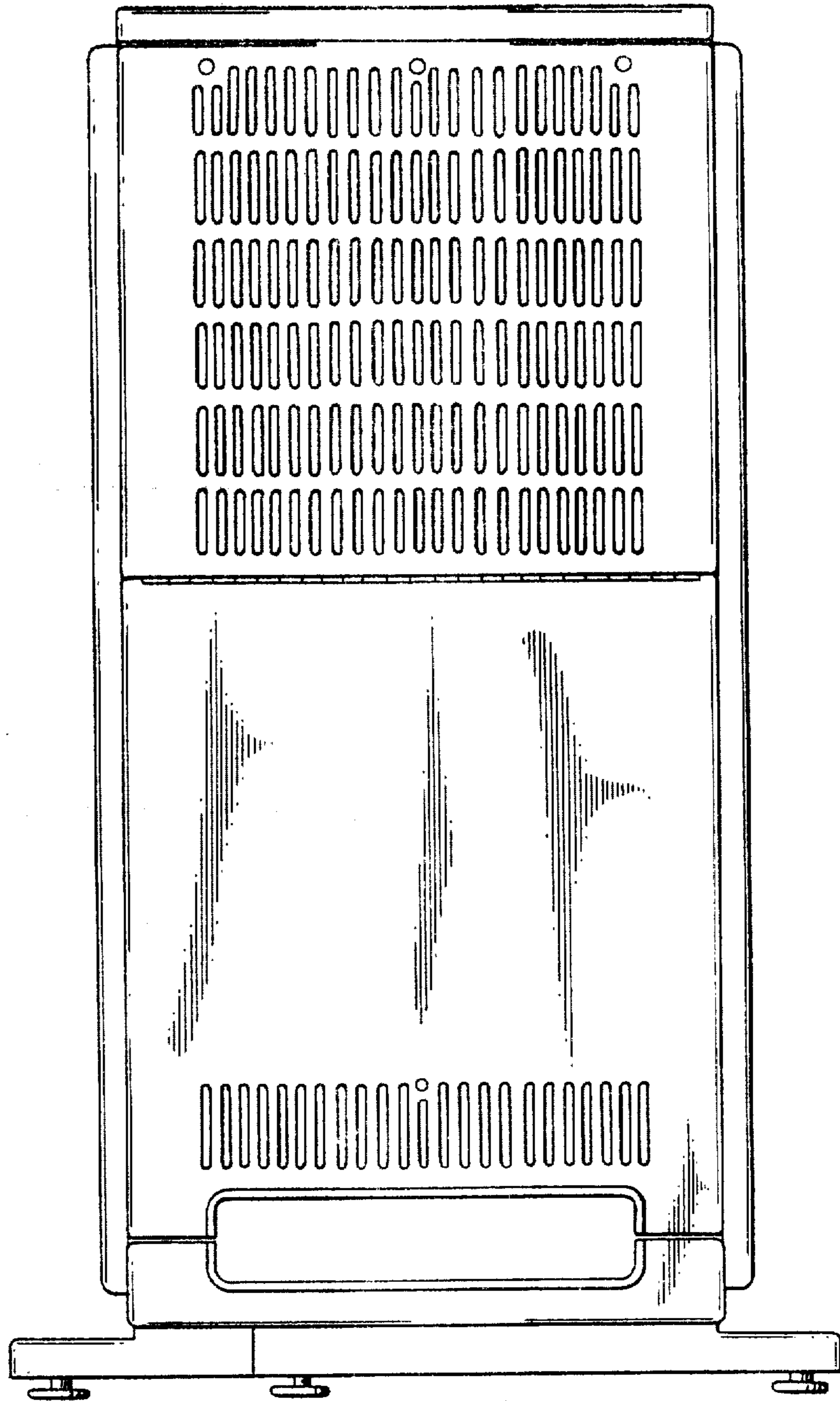

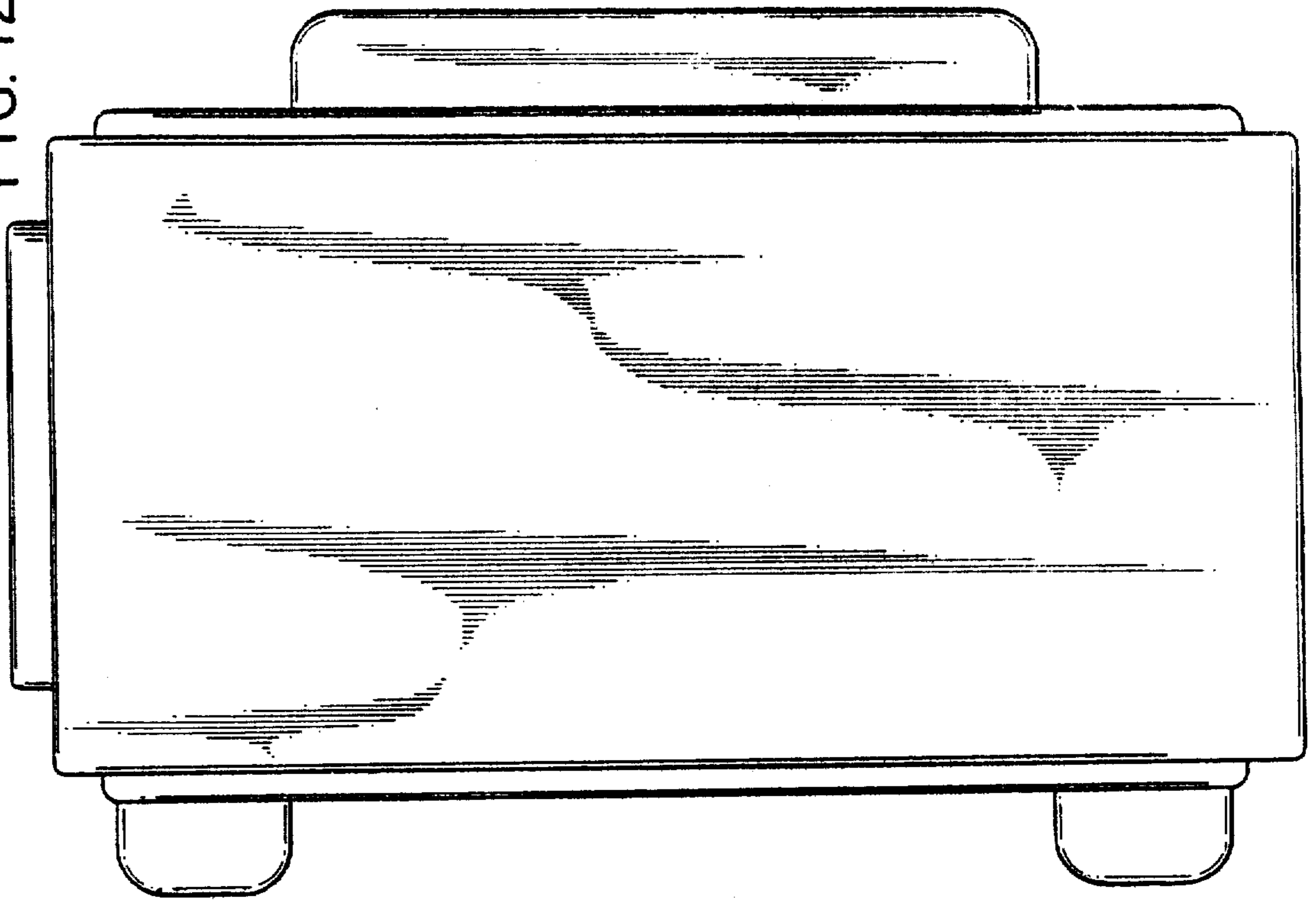

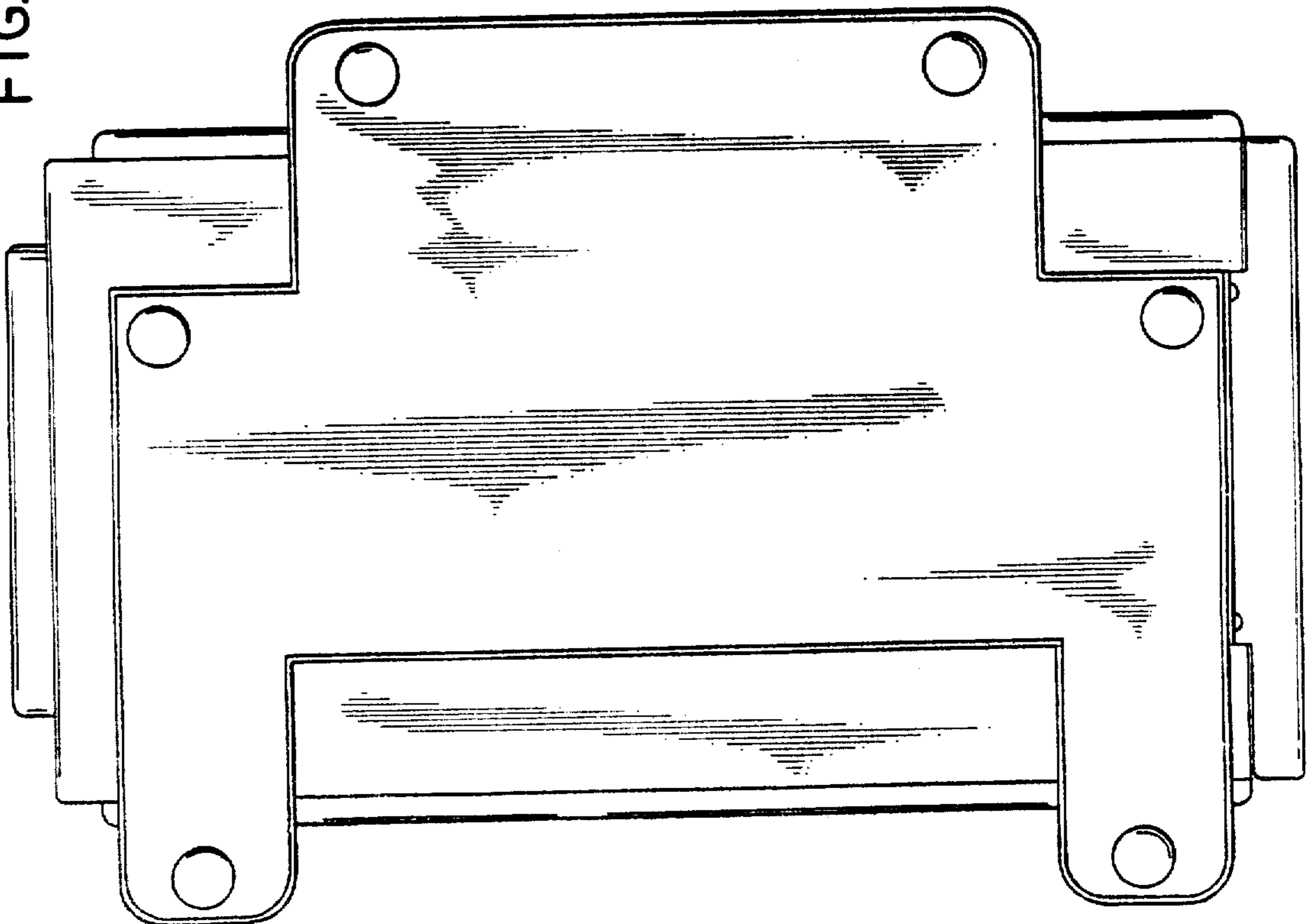

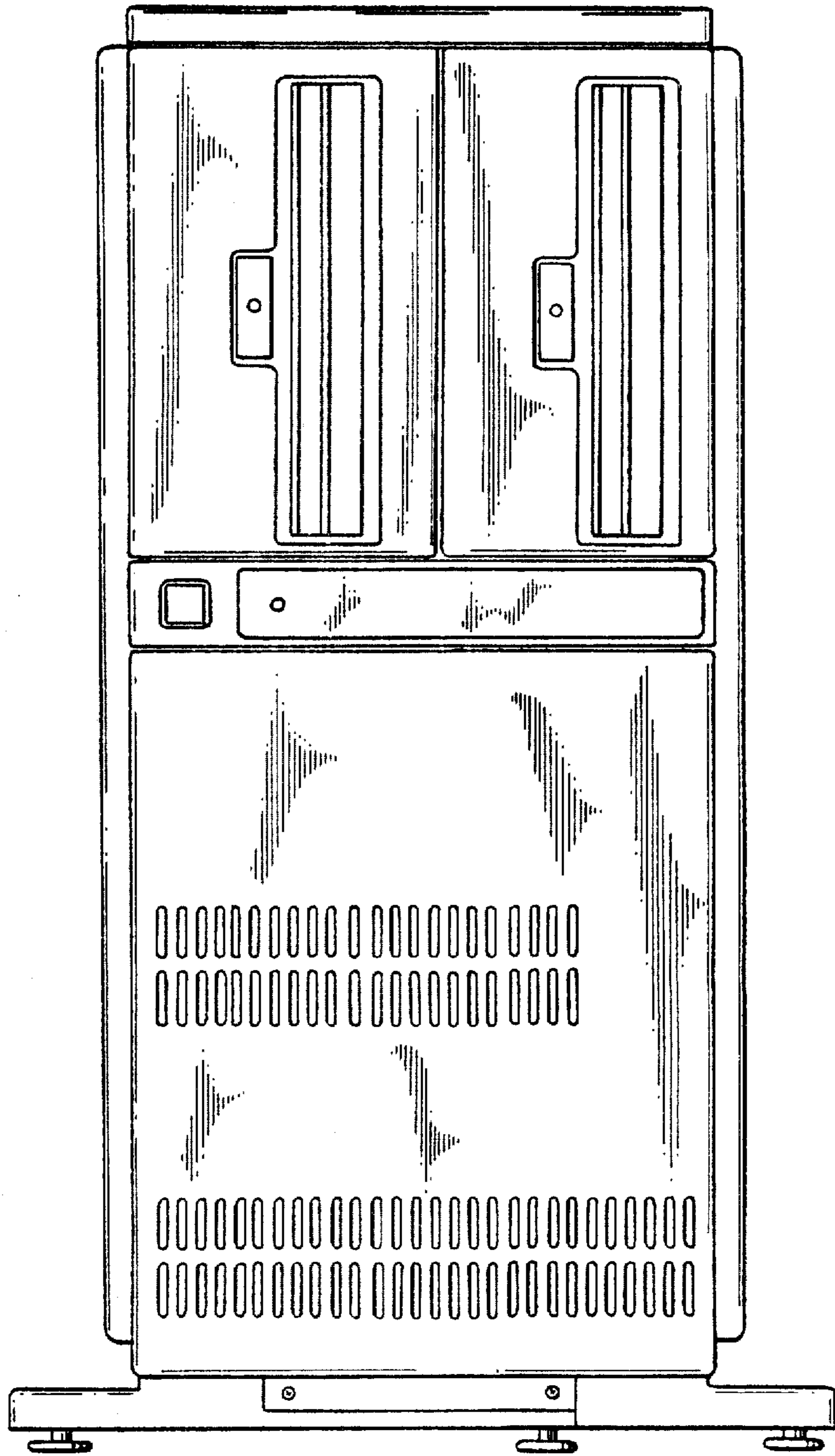

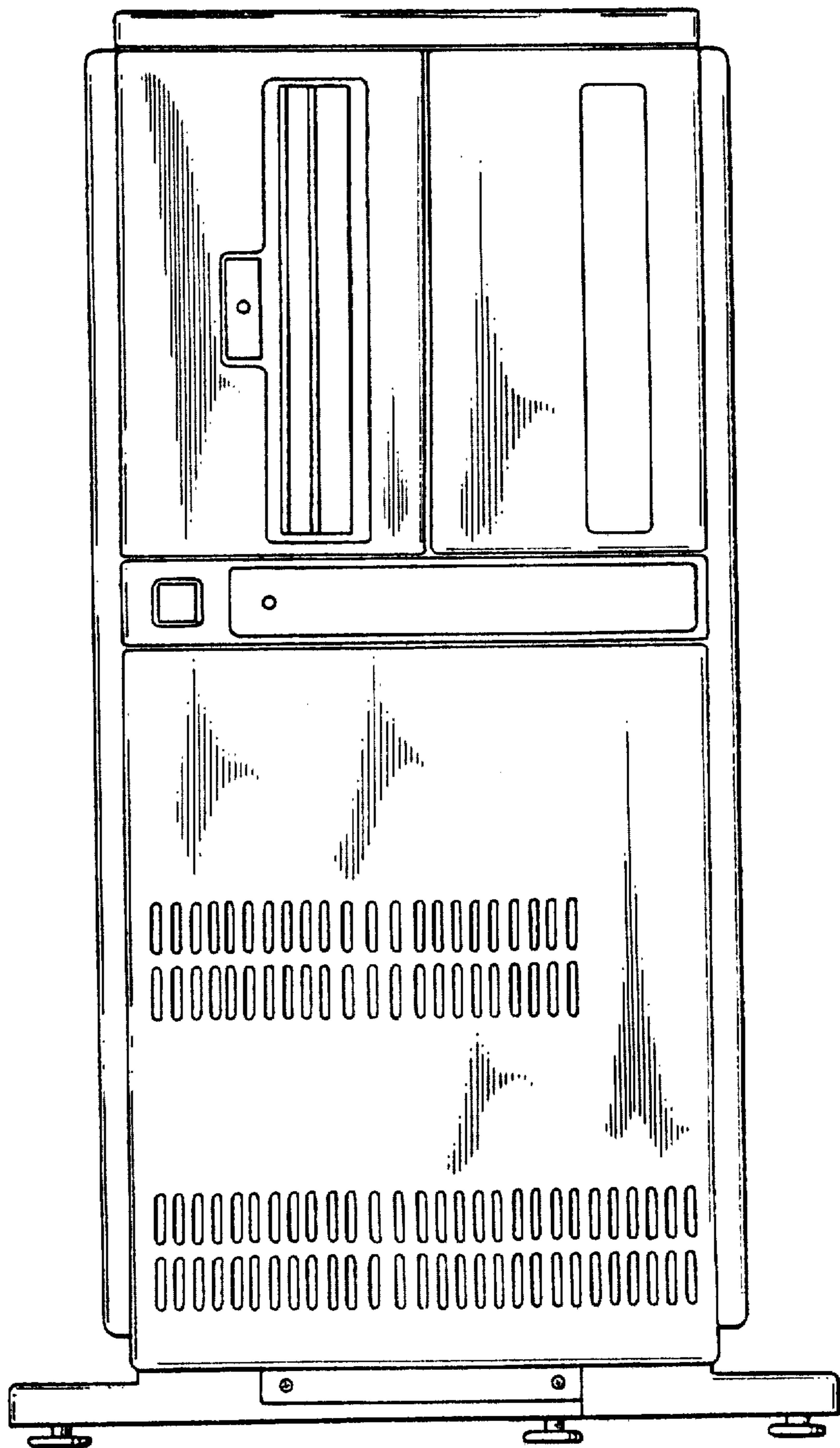
