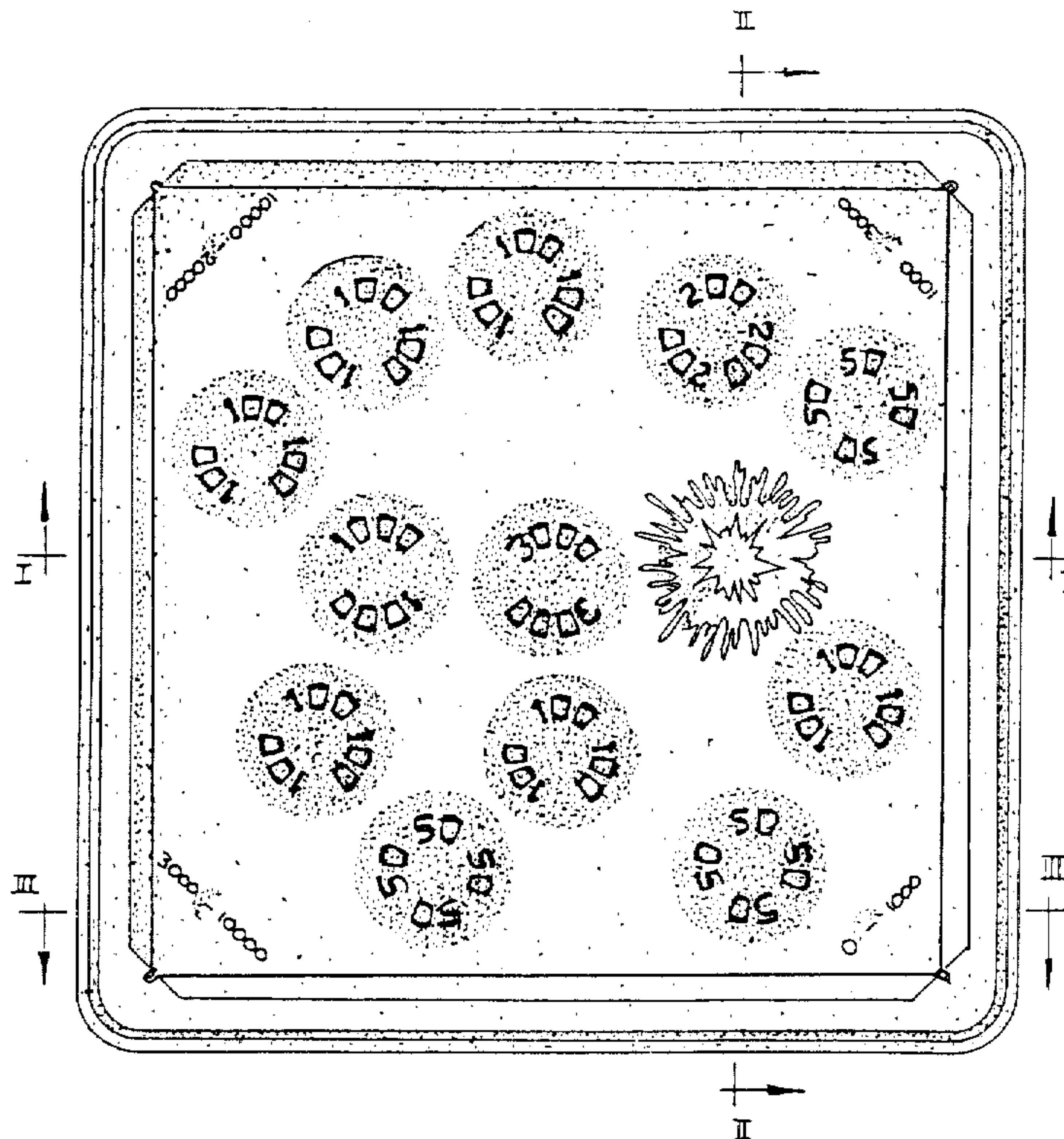

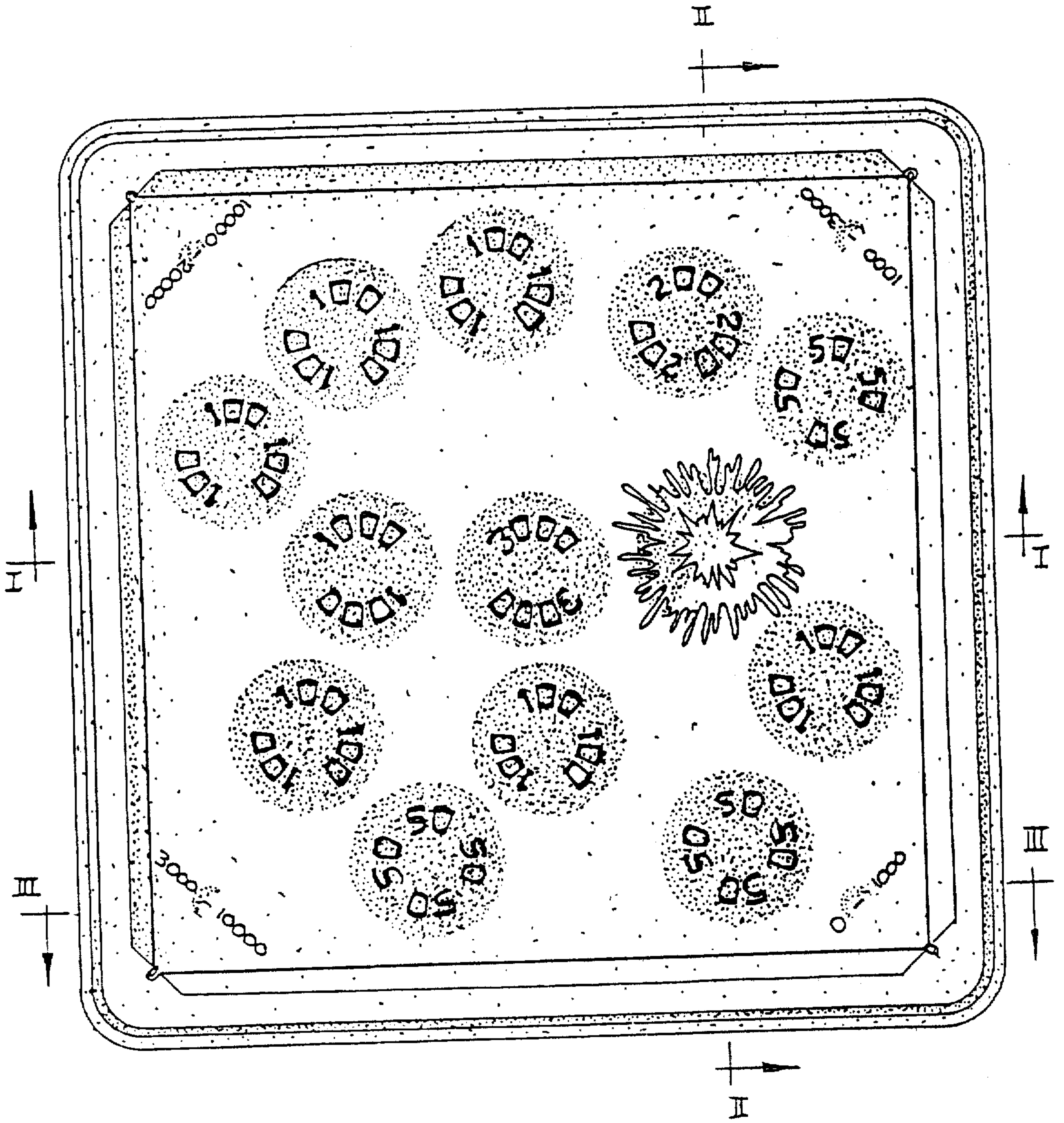
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a game board, as shown and described.

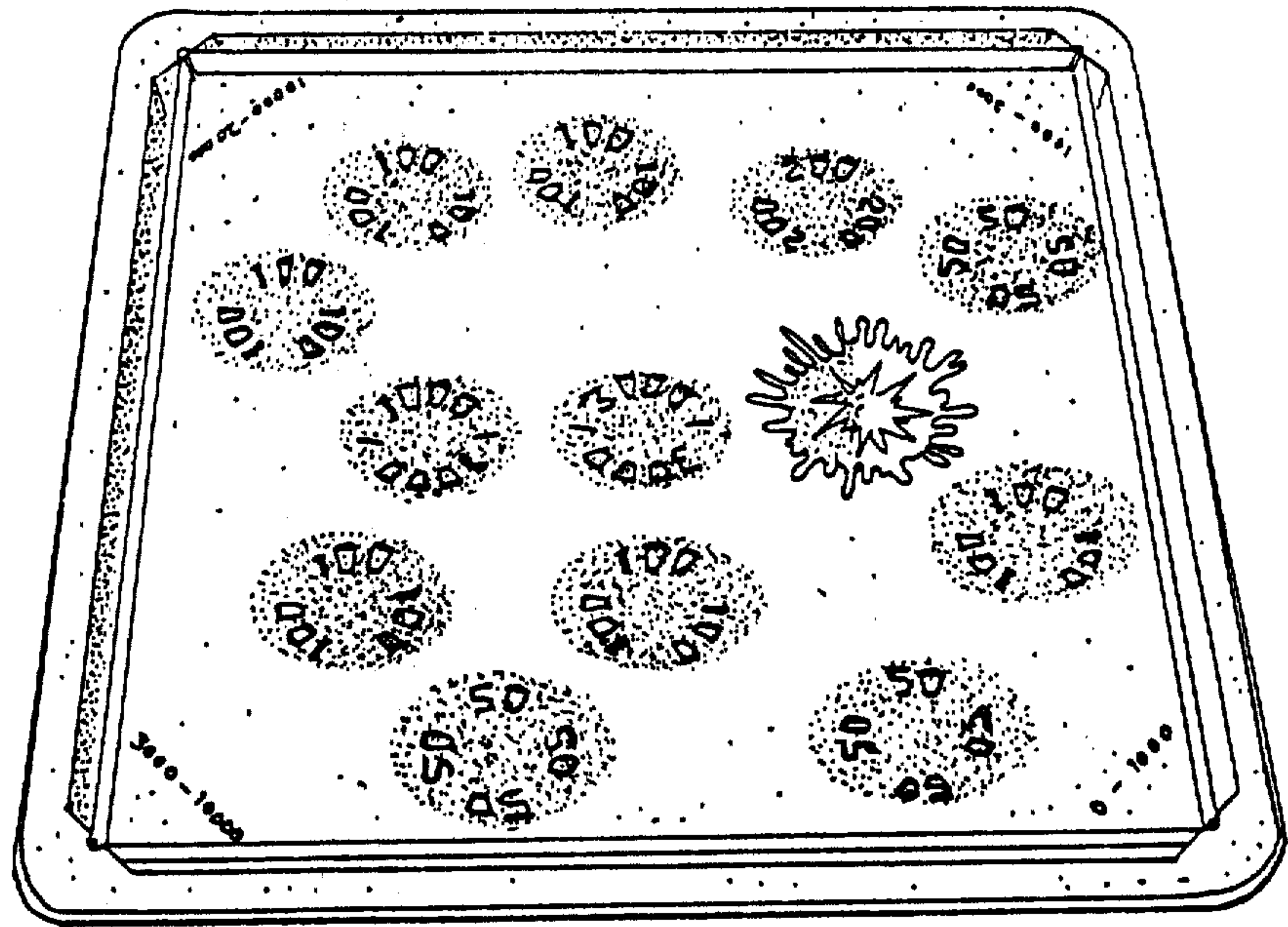
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 shows a section on line III—III of FIG. 1.

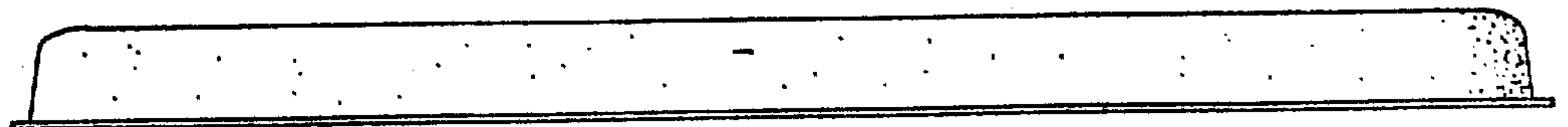




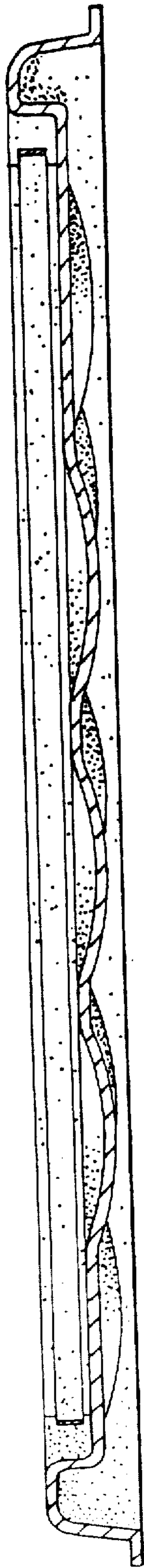

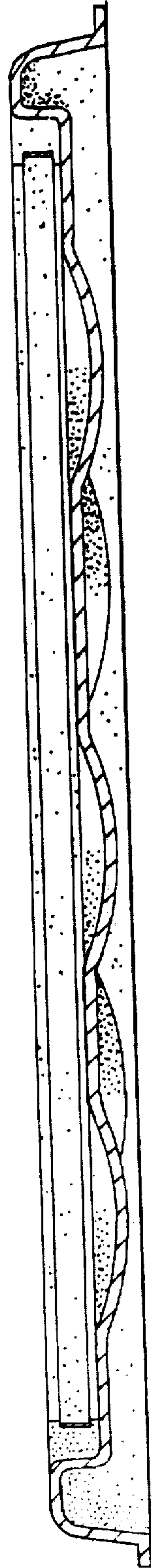

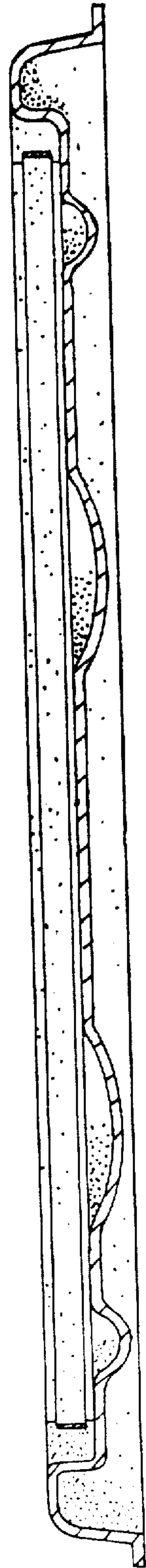
