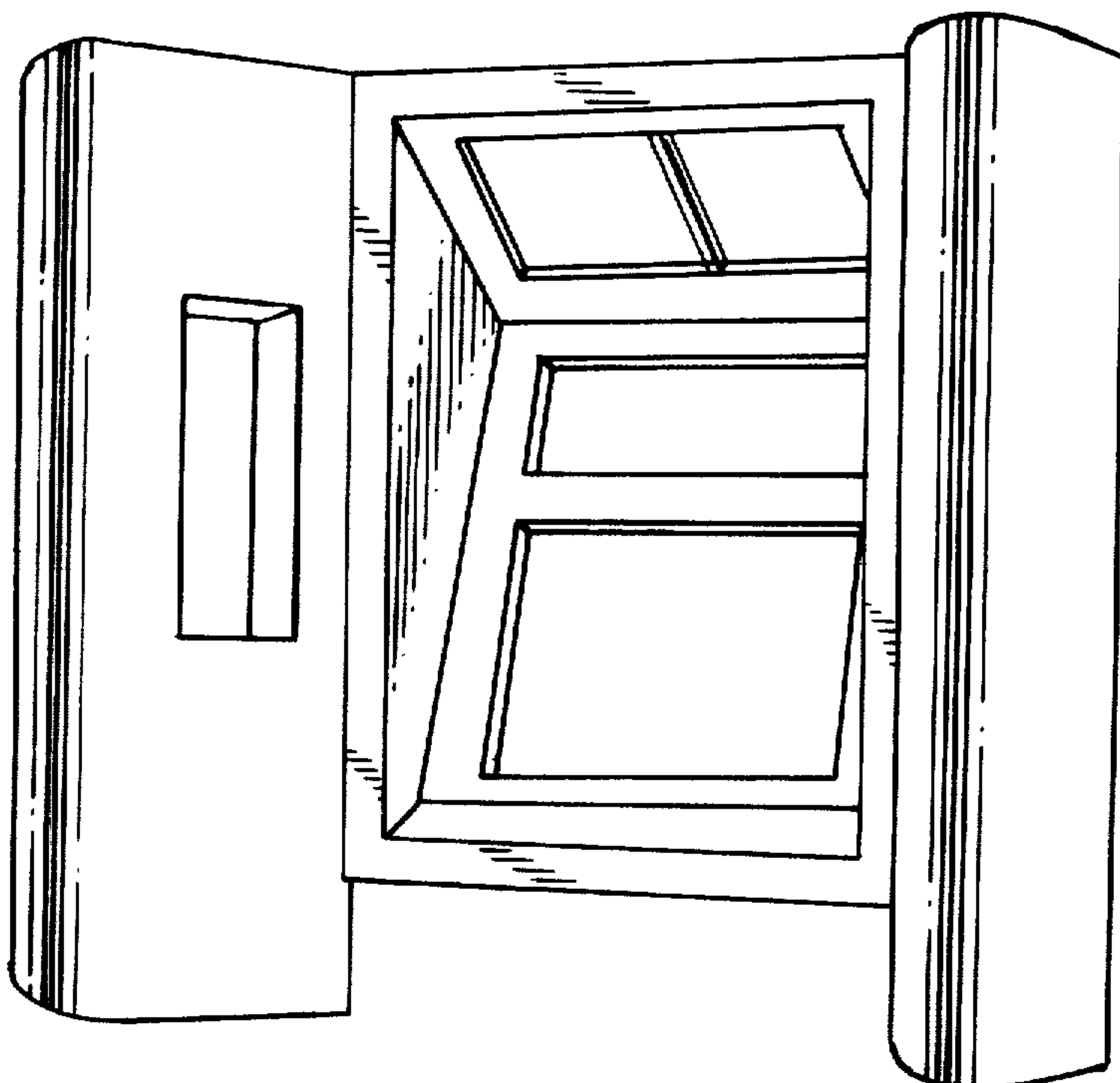

DESCRIPTION

teller machine booth showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.



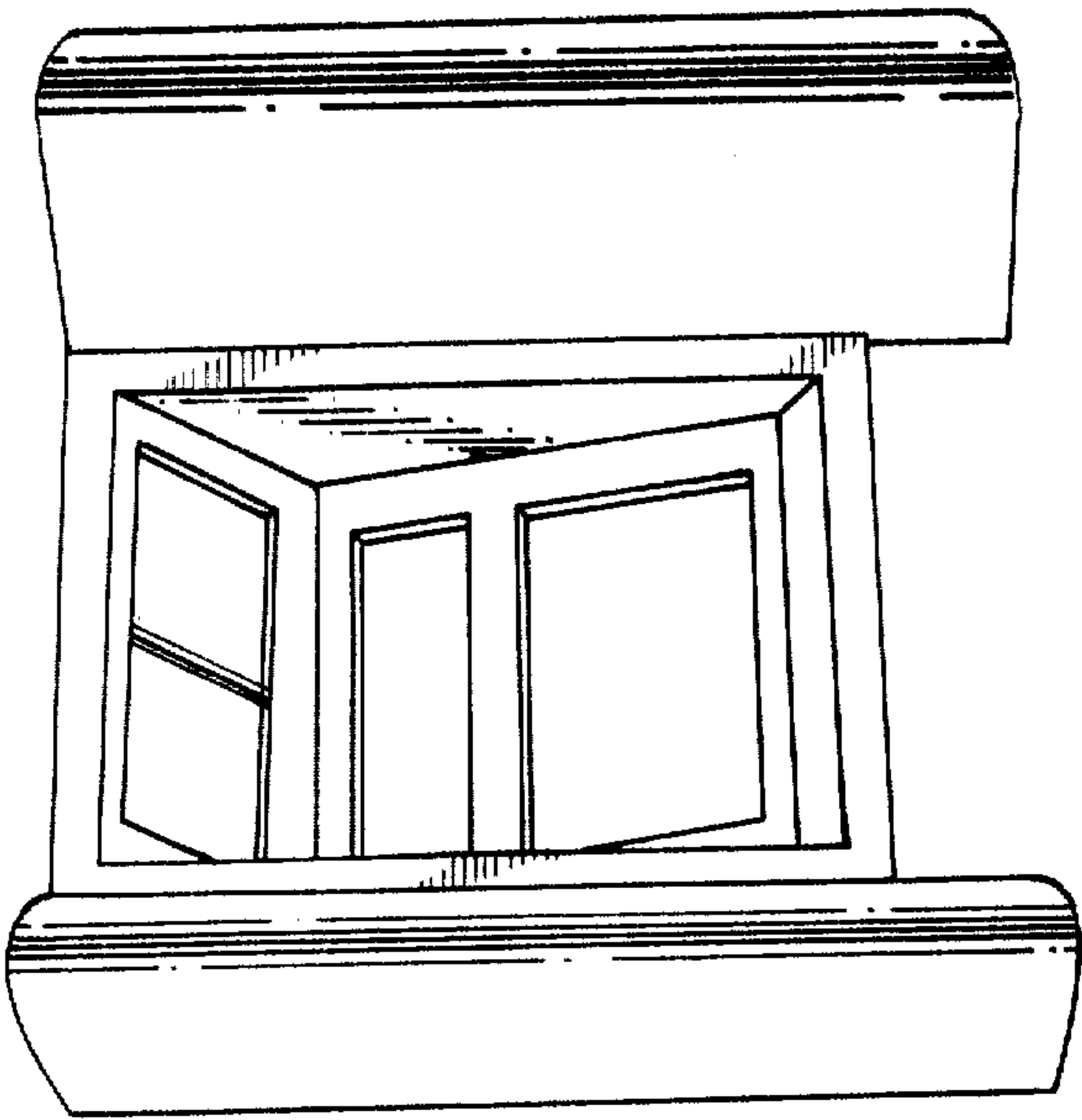

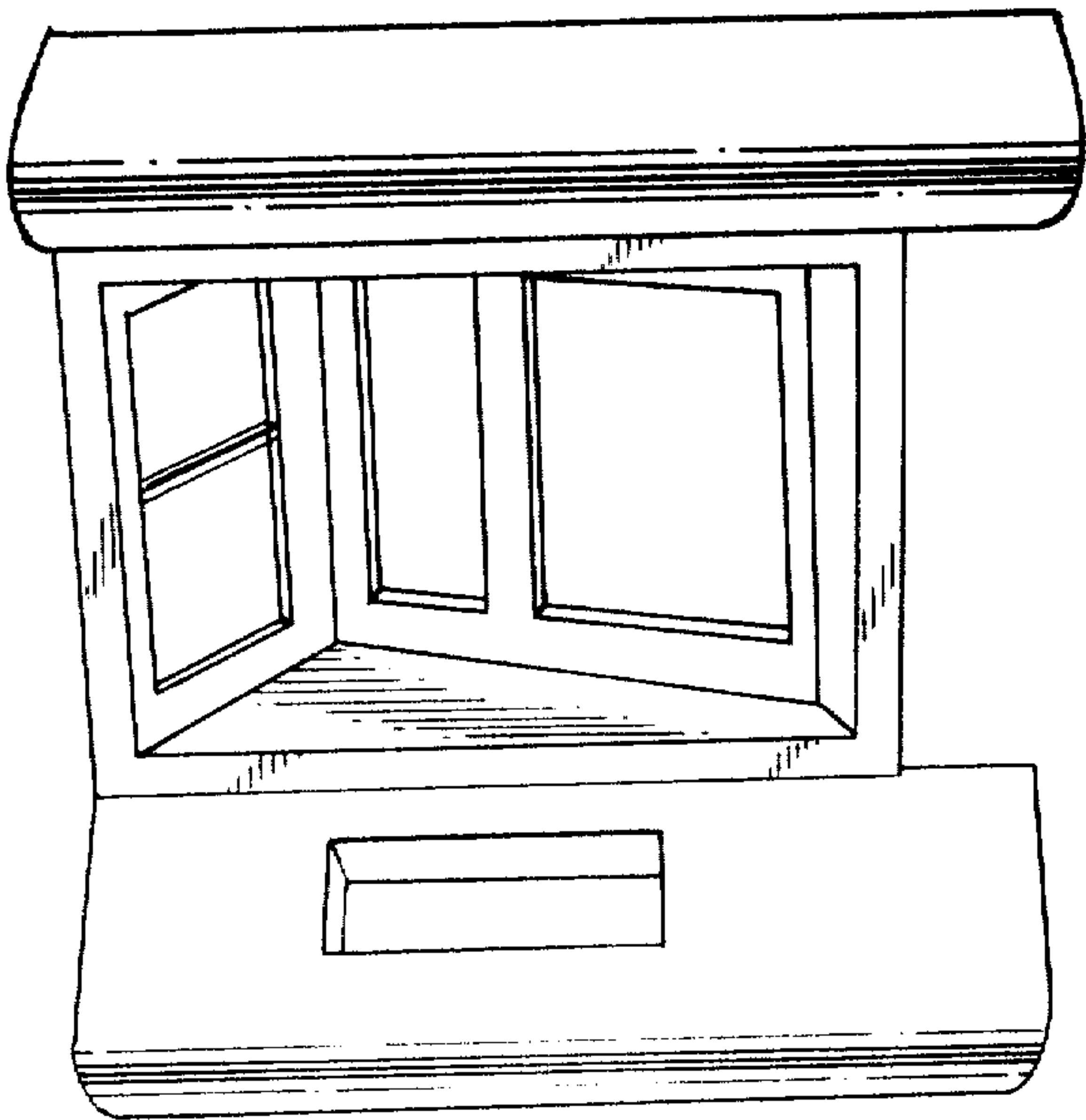

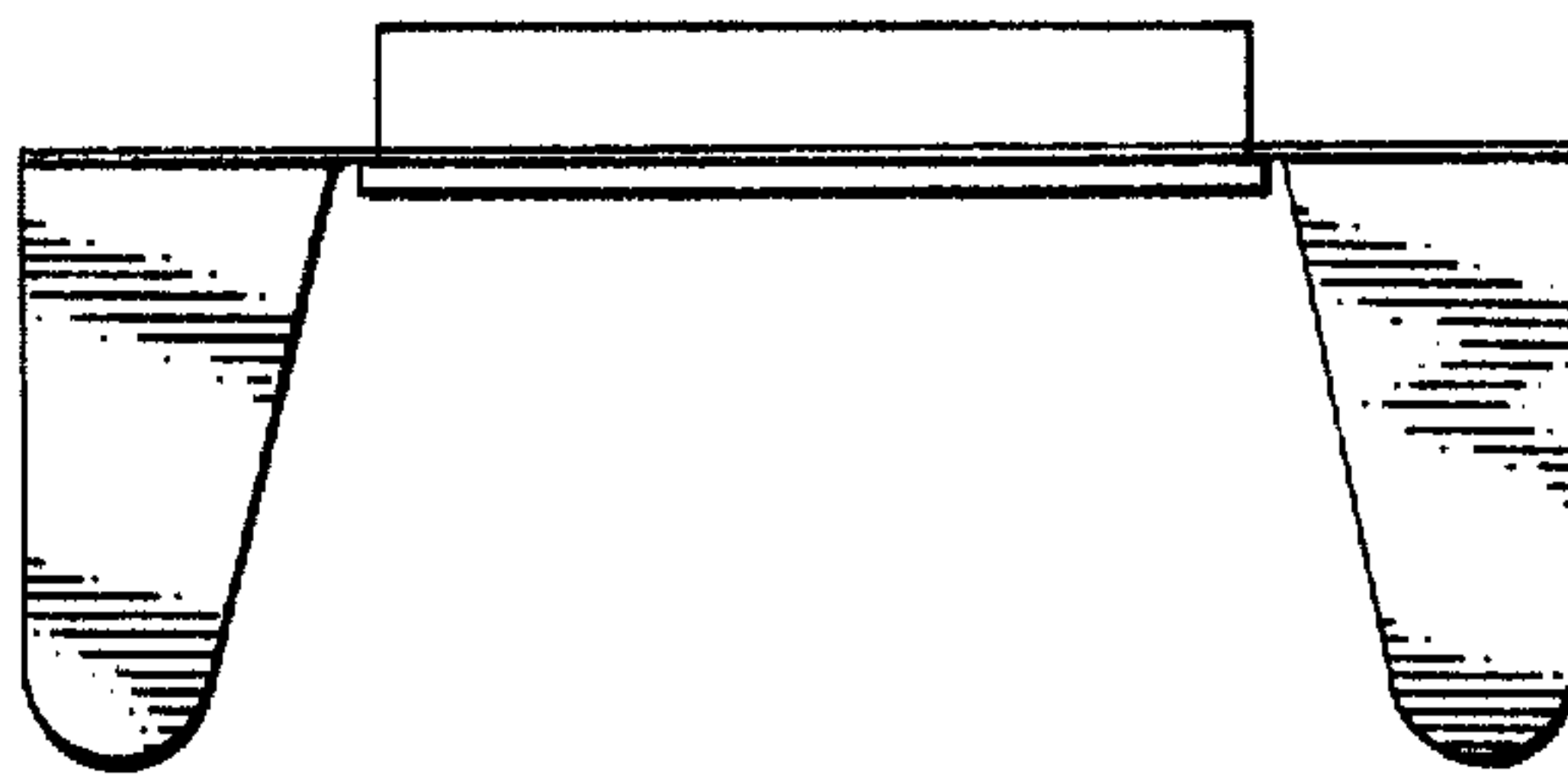

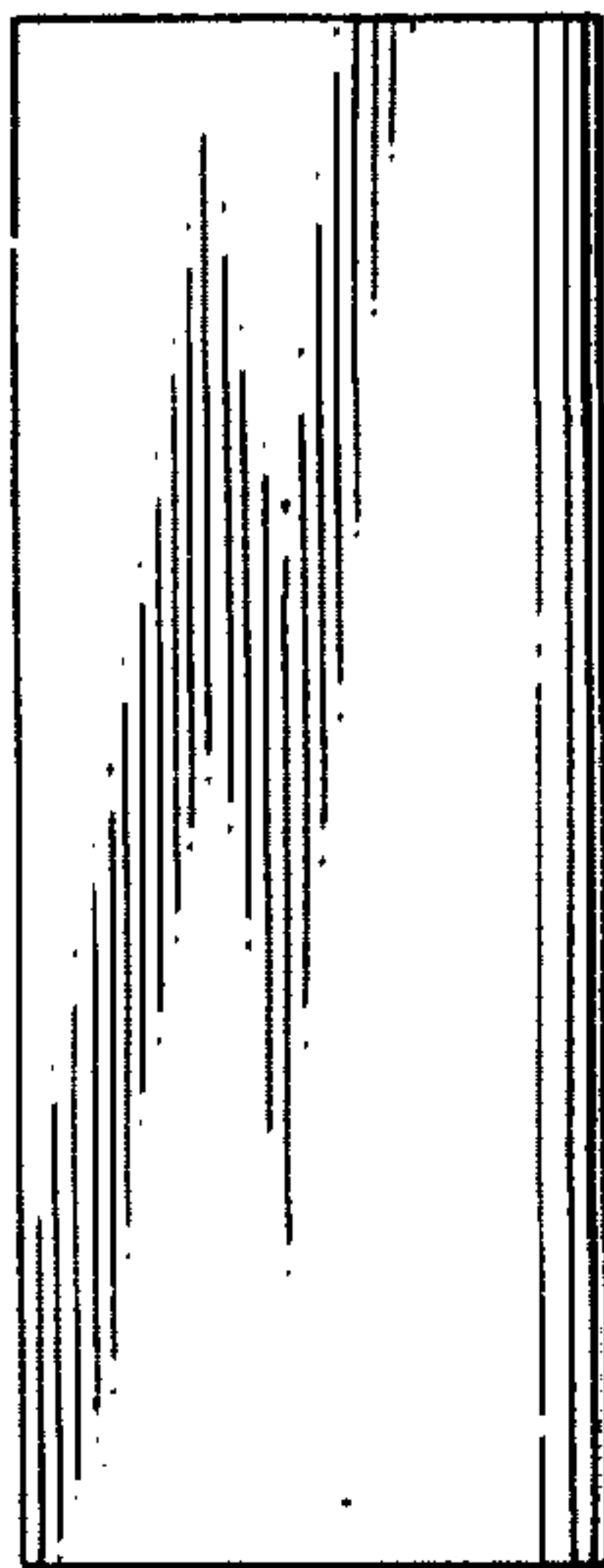

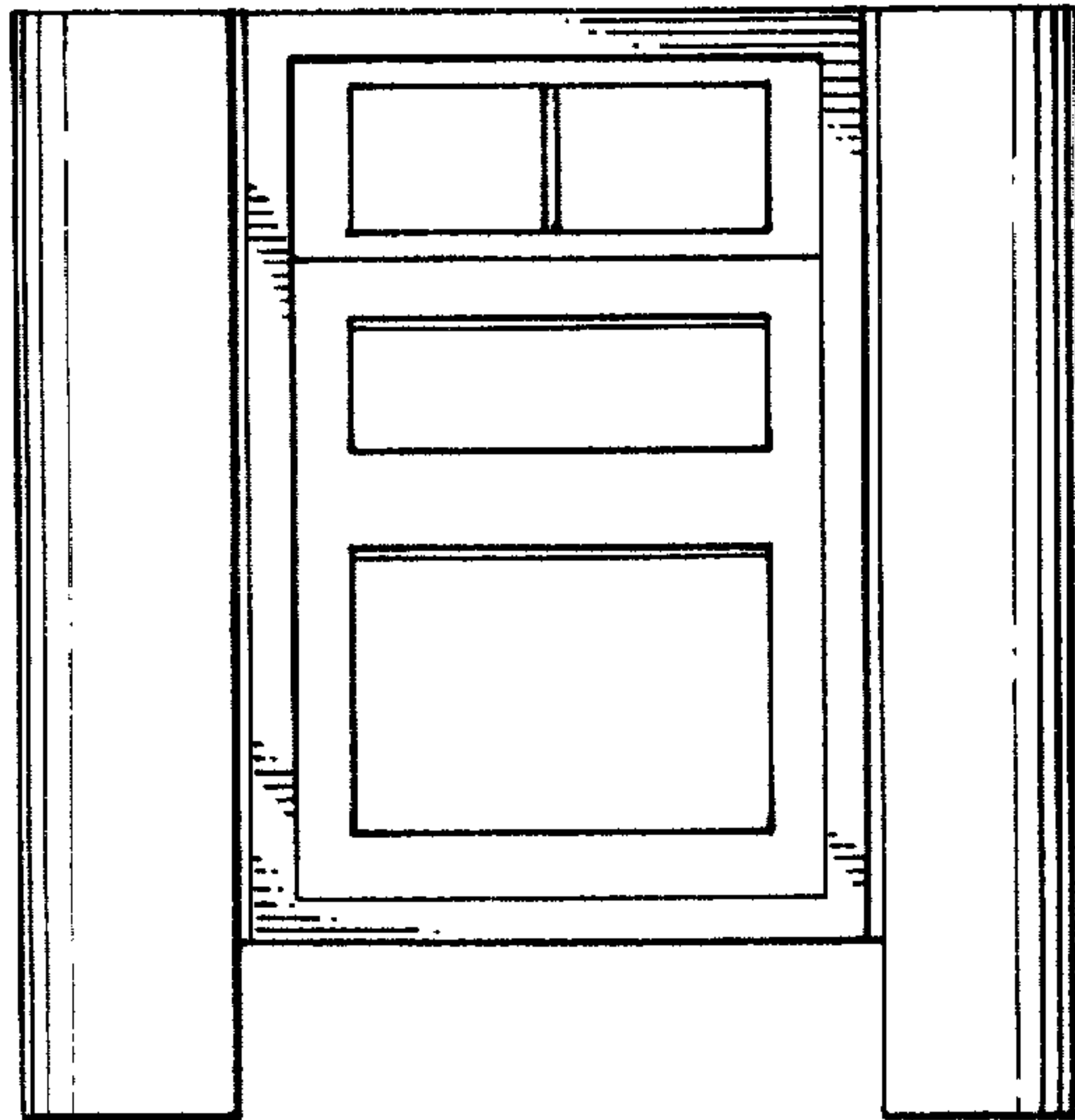

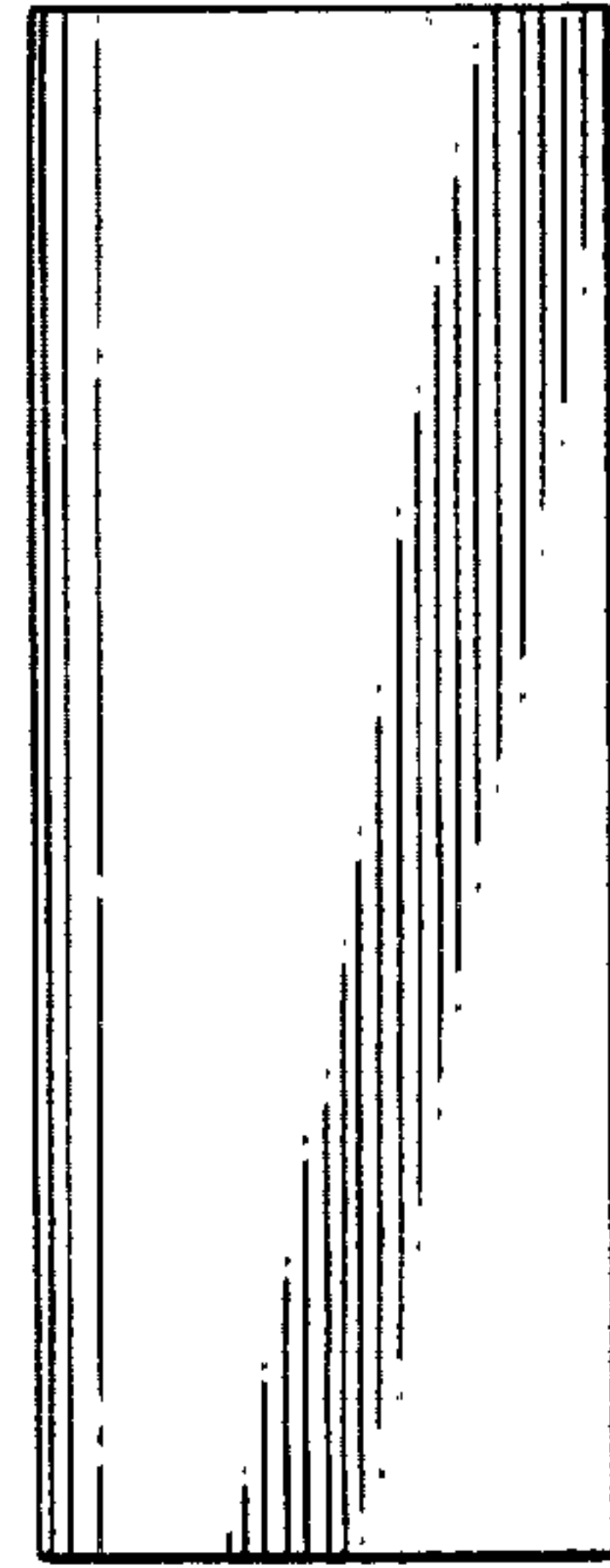

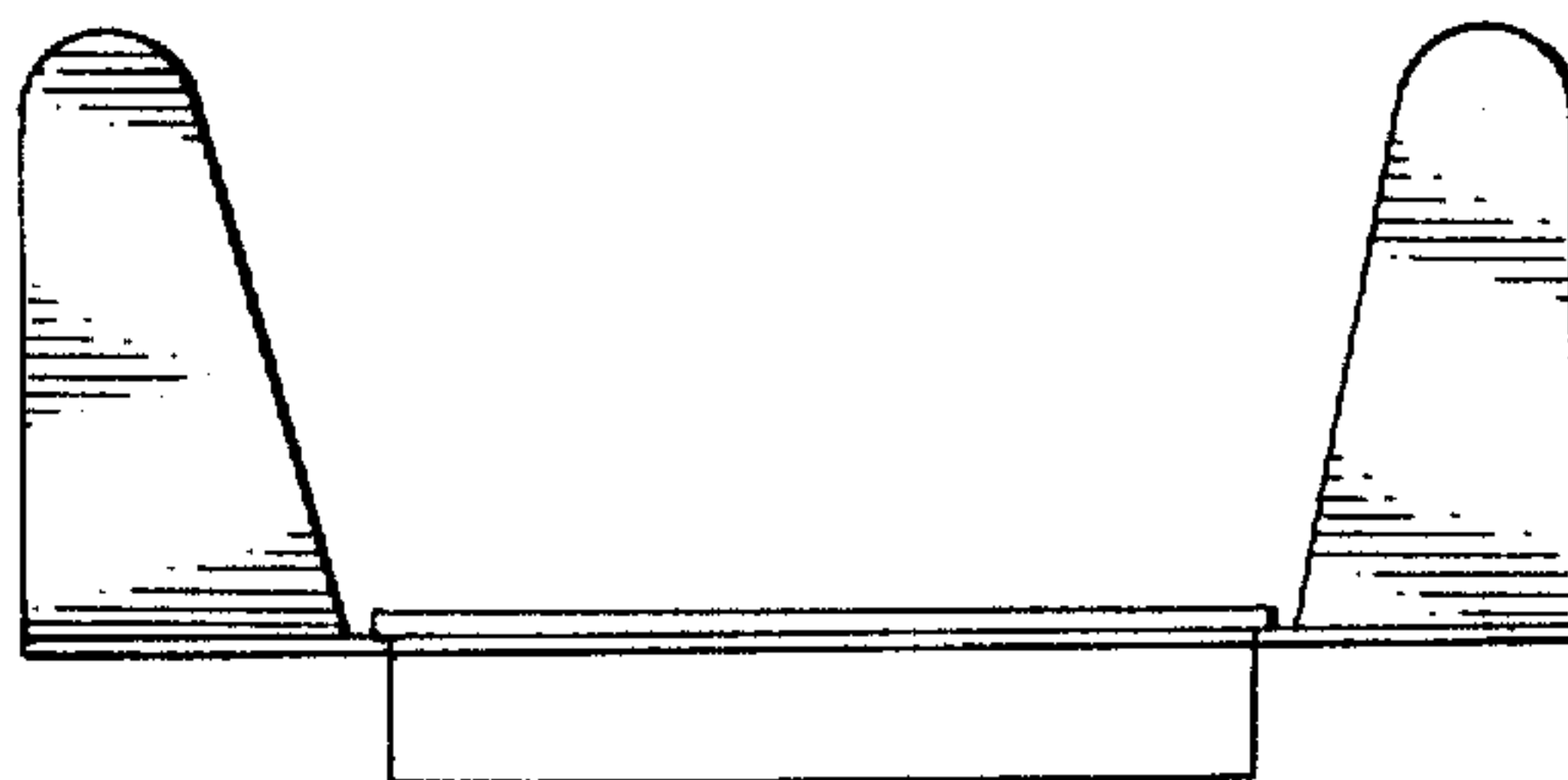
