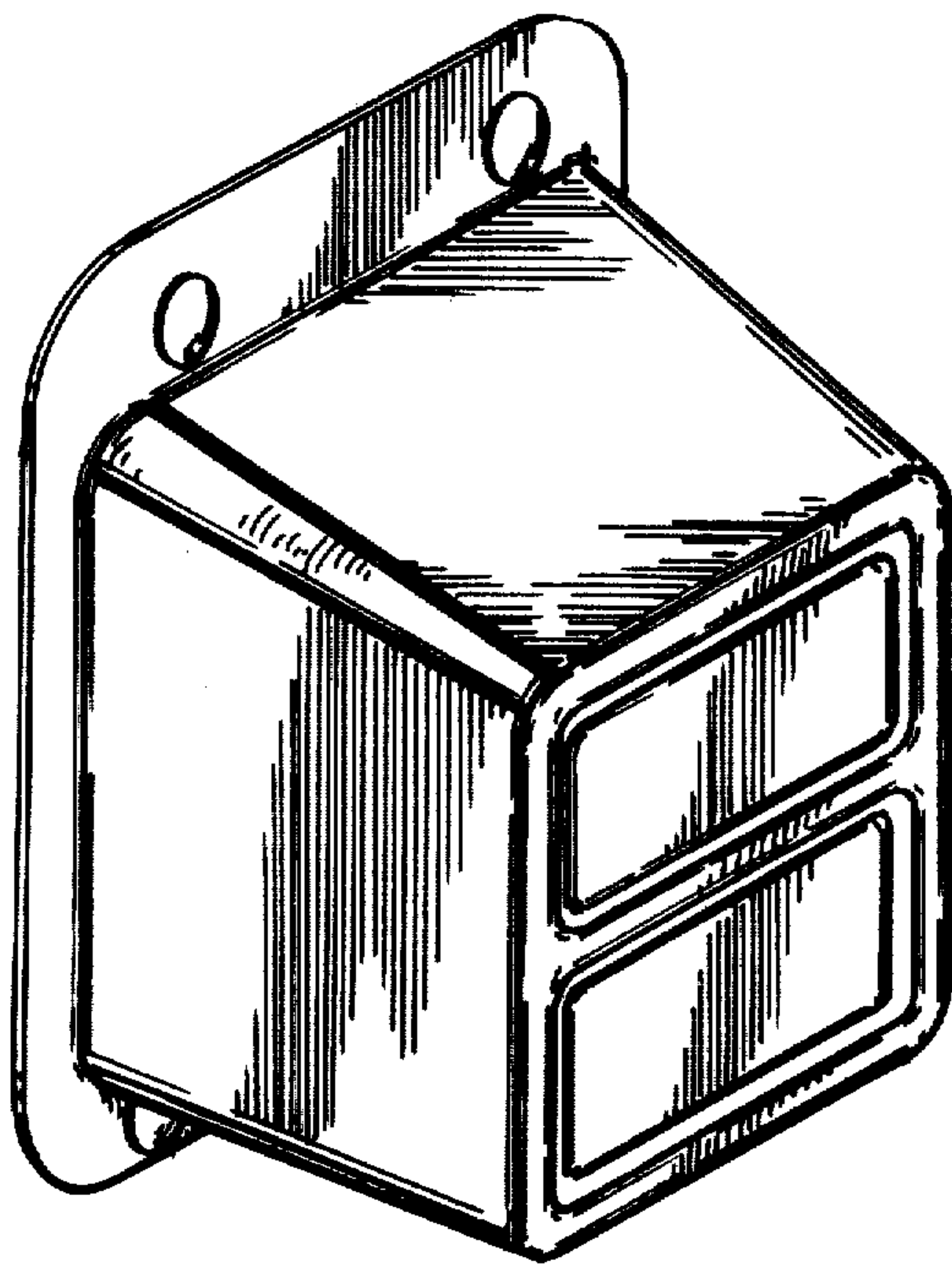

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cover for cyclic support in helicopters or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cover for cyclic support in helicopters or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side view taken from the left of FIG. 1, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top view thereof.



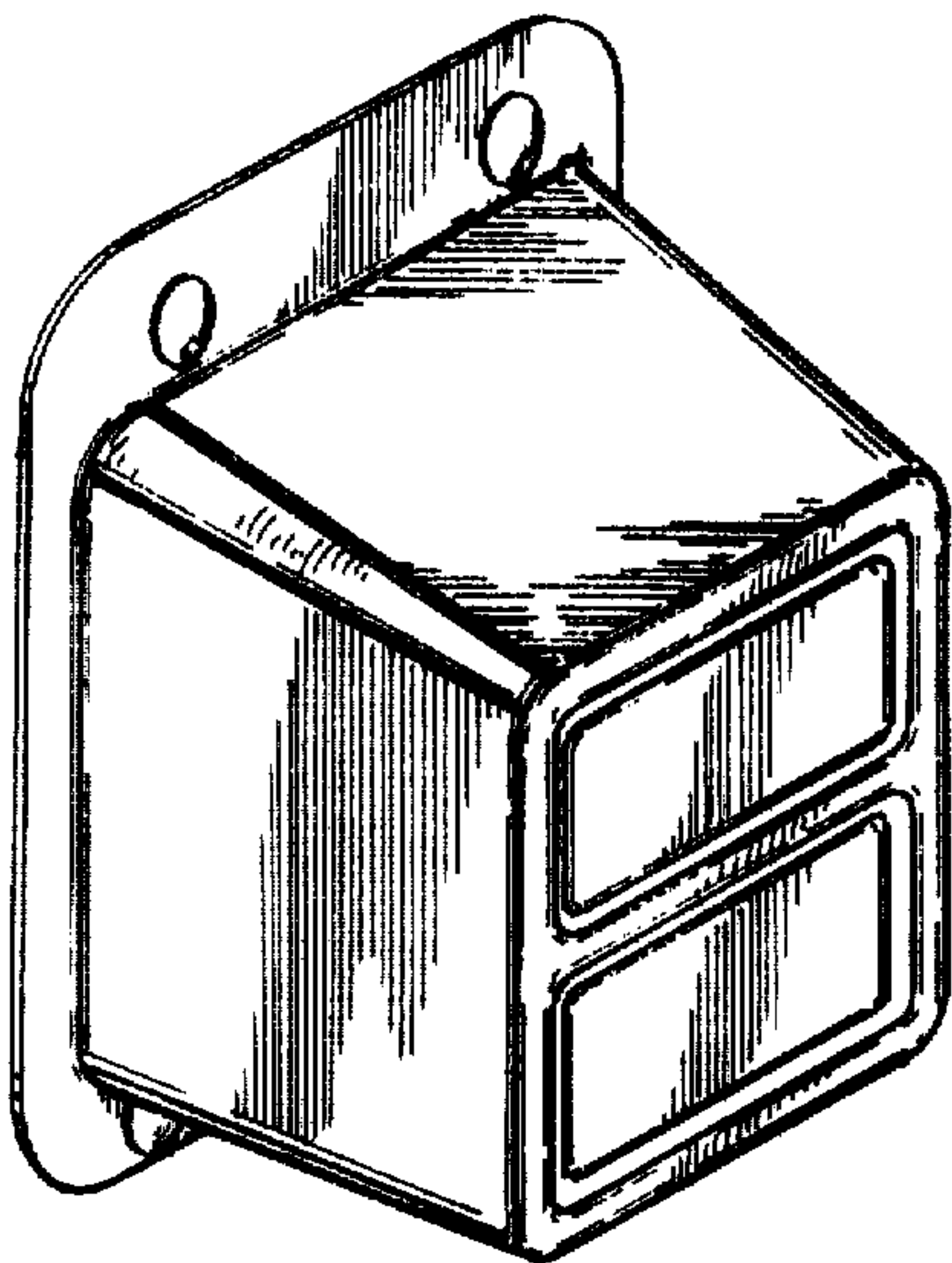

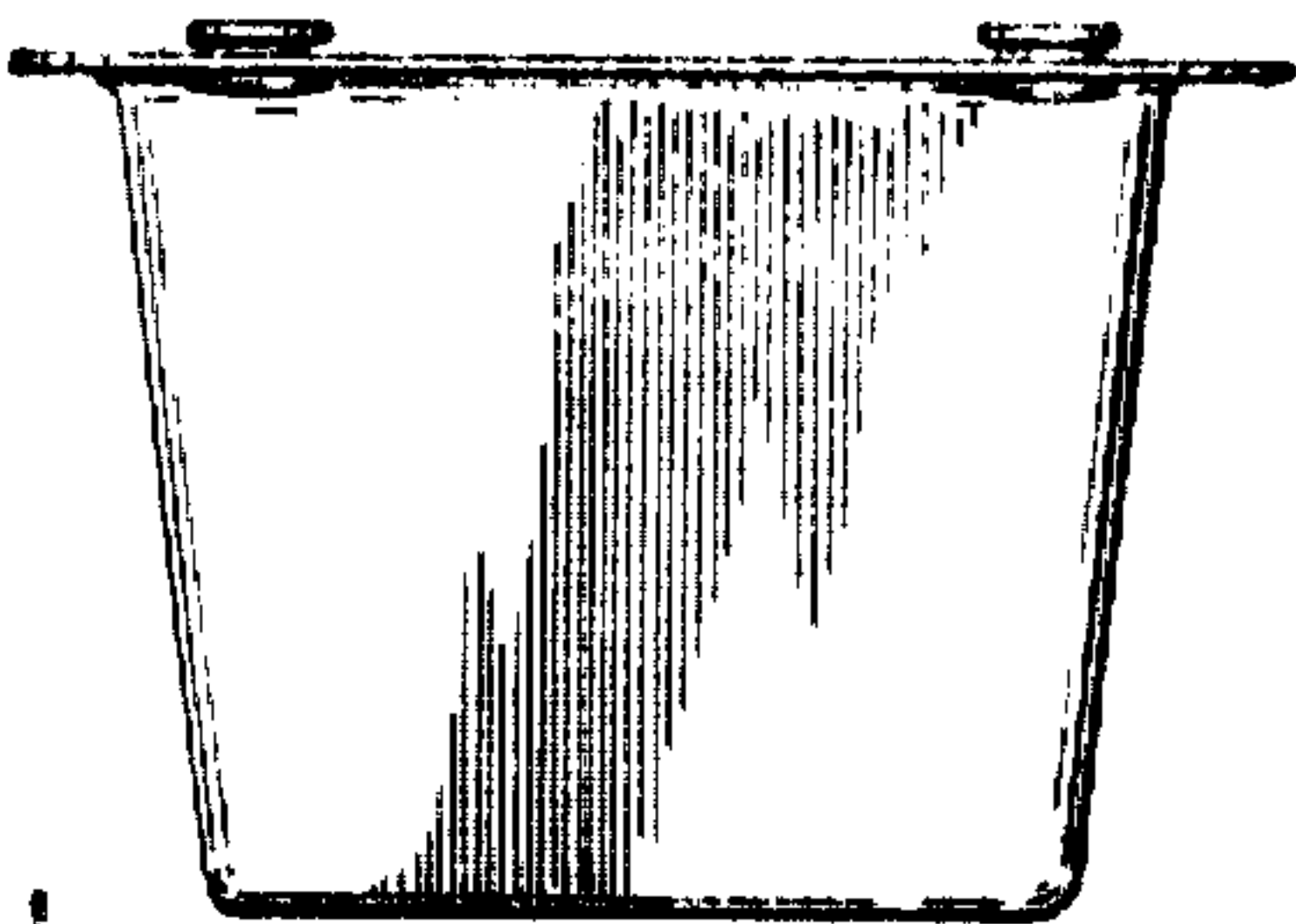

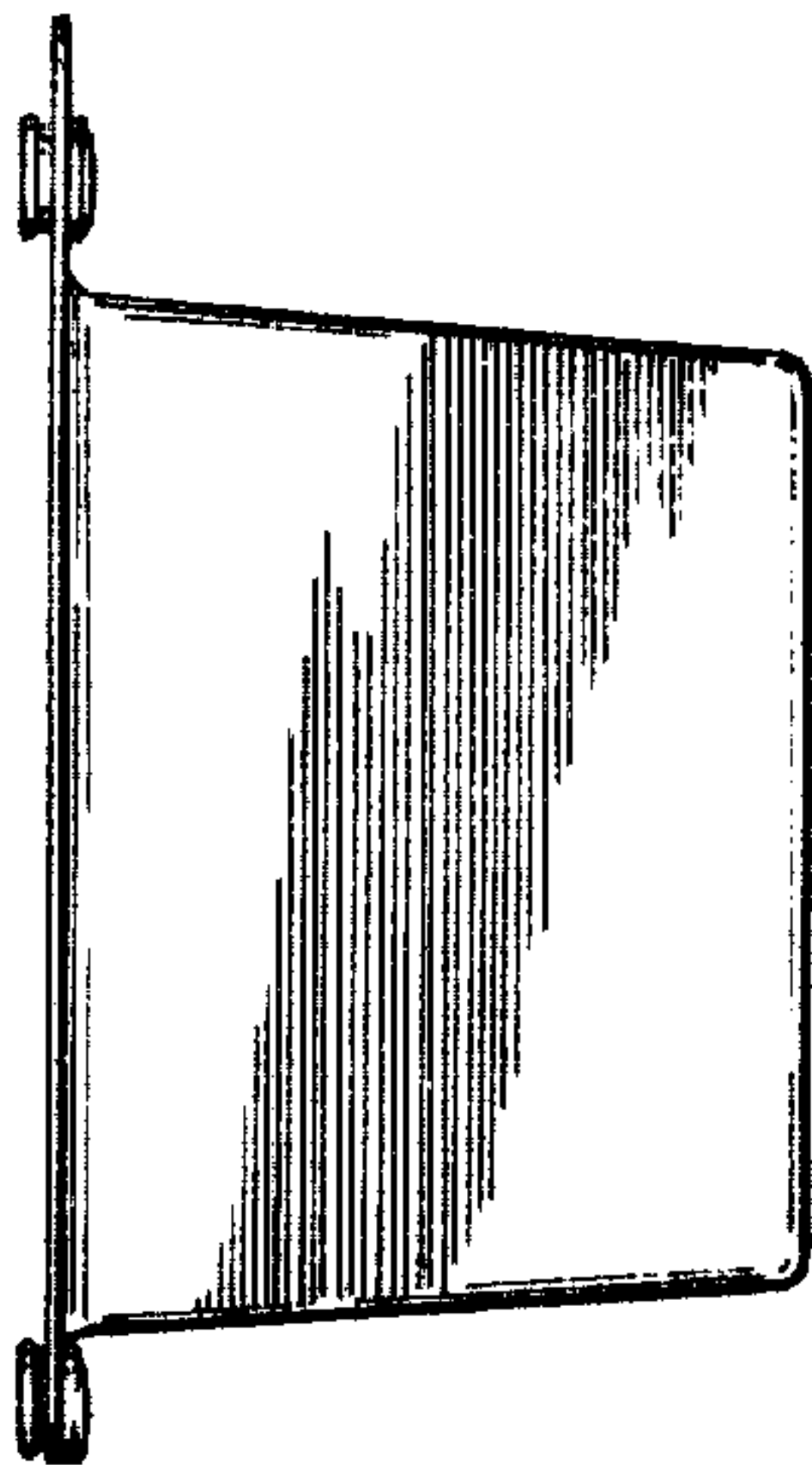

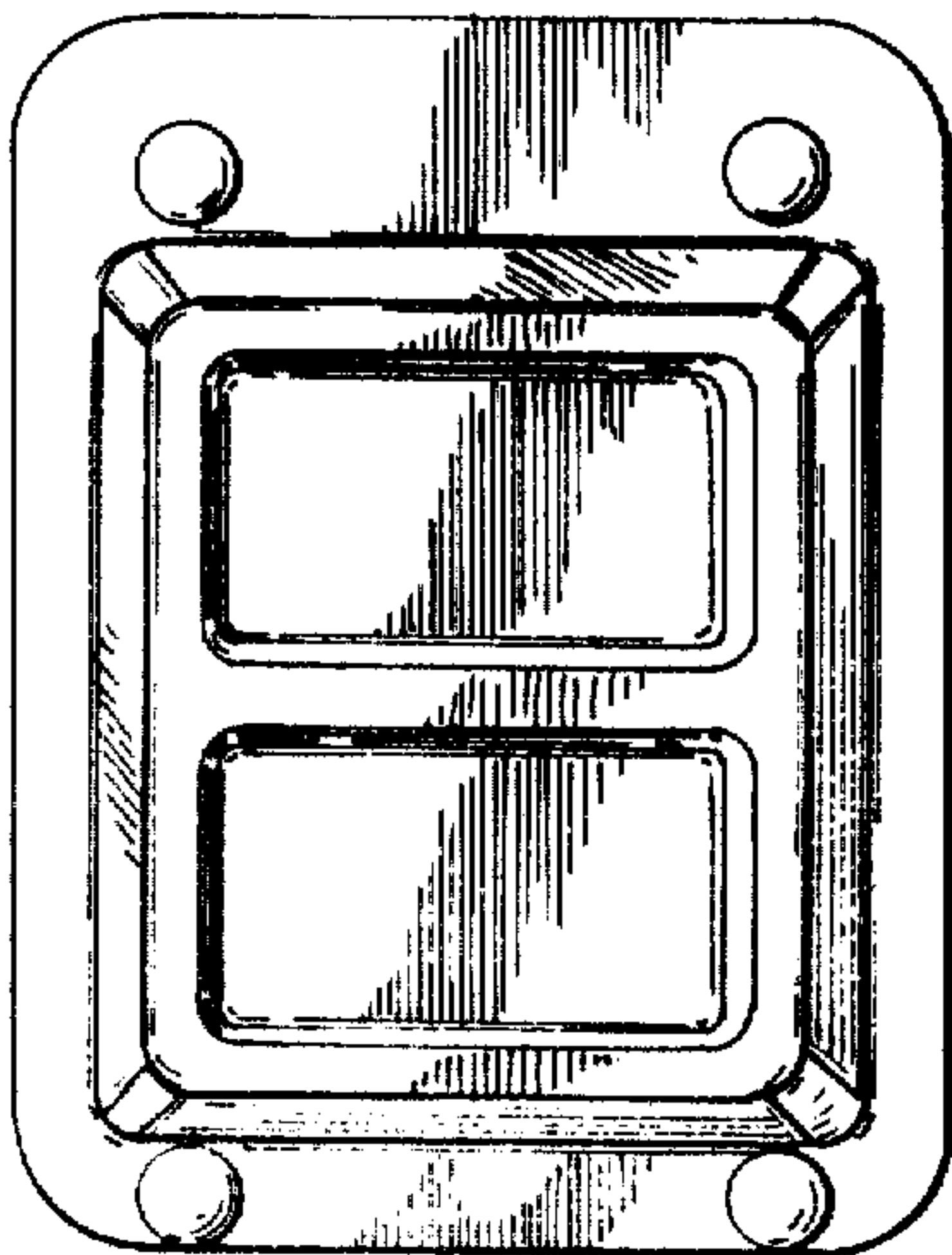

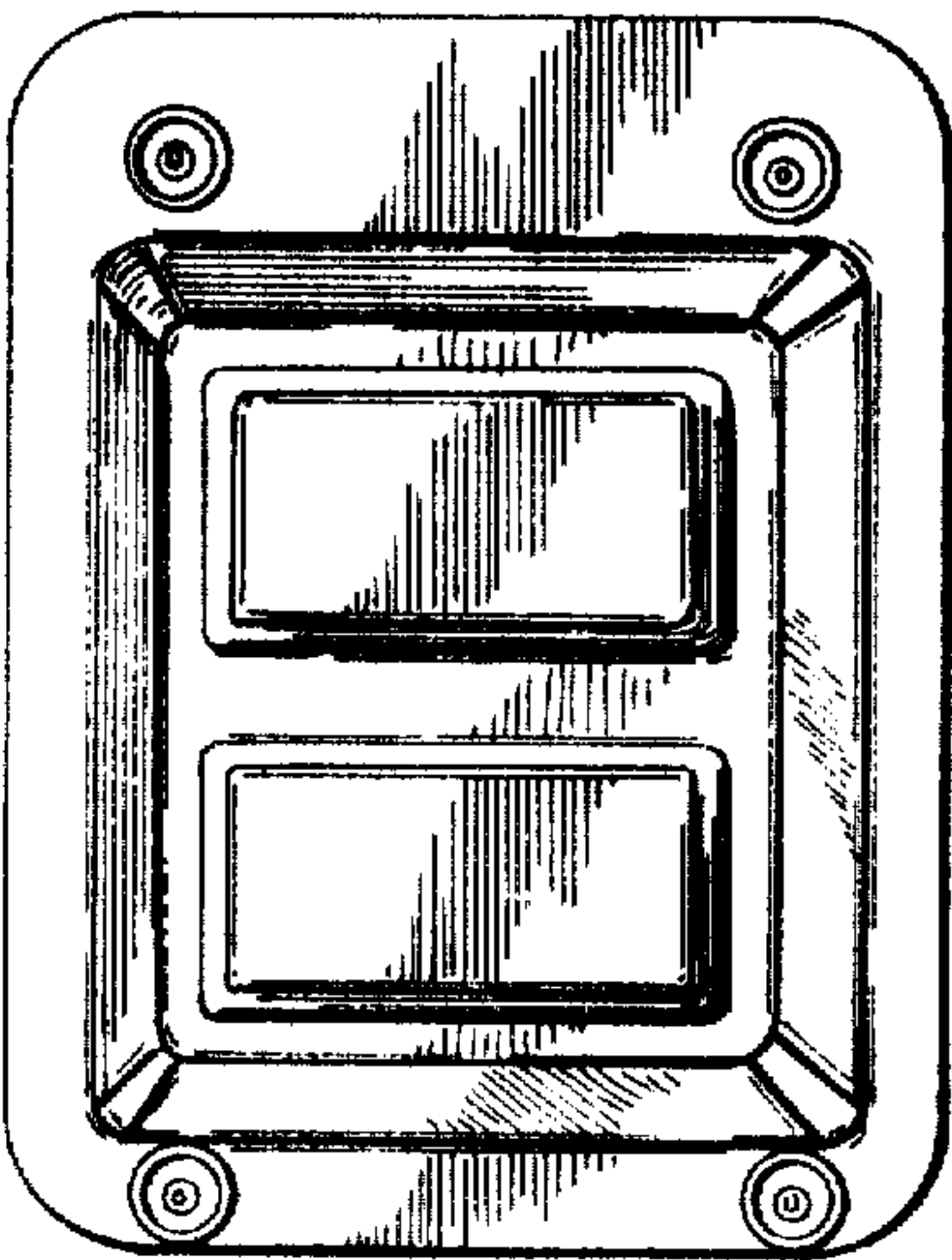
