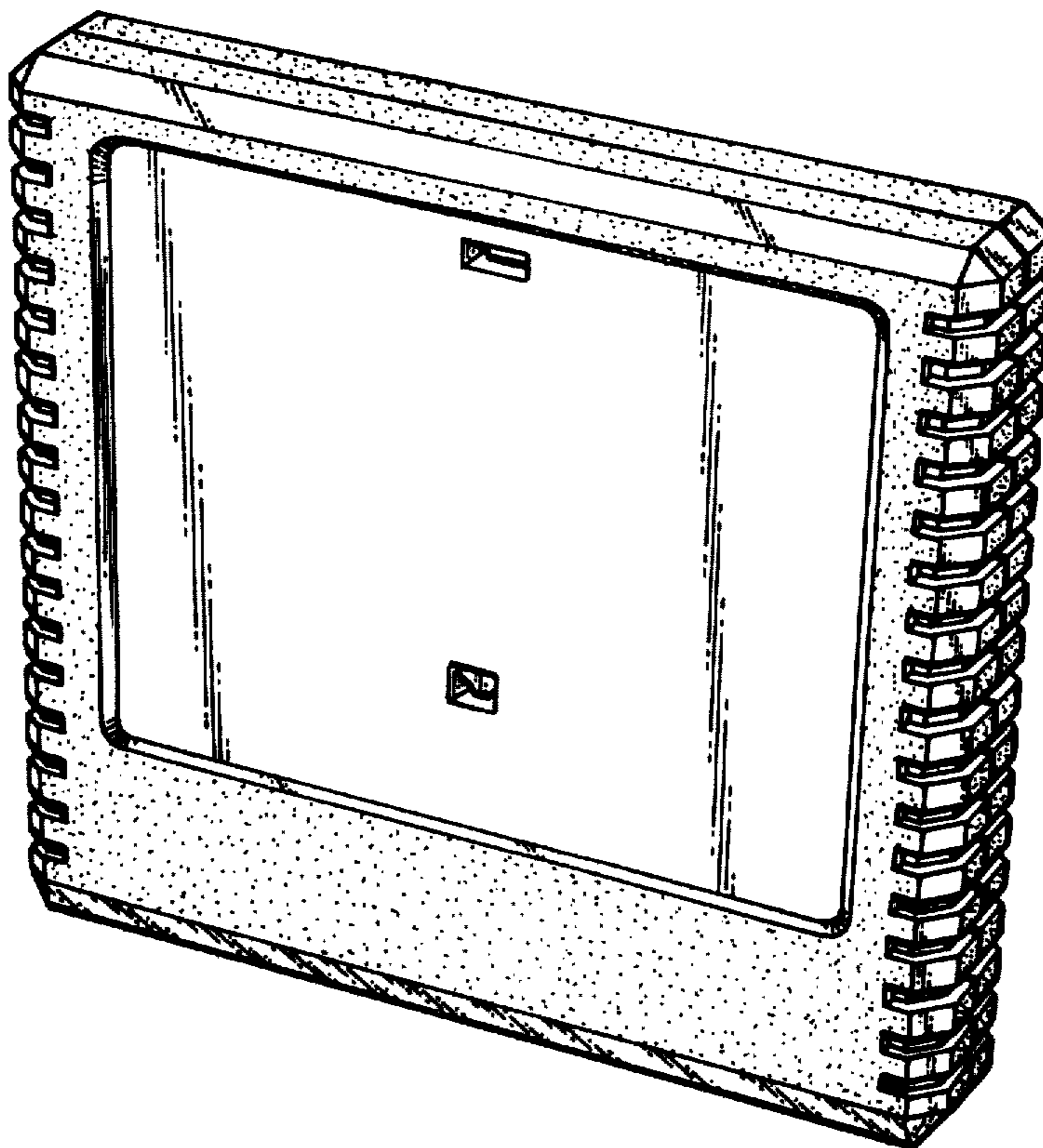

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cartridge for video game unit showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



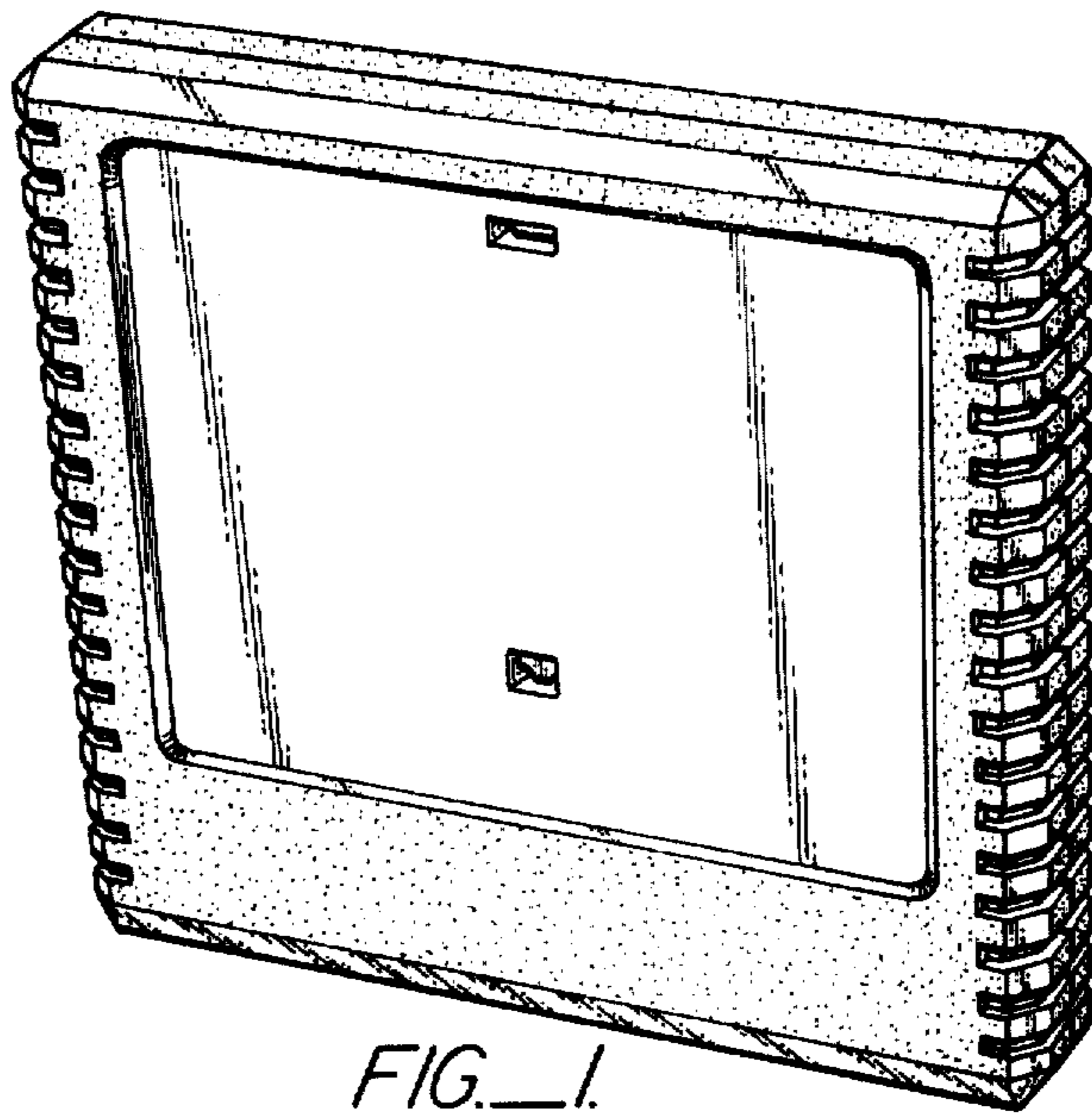

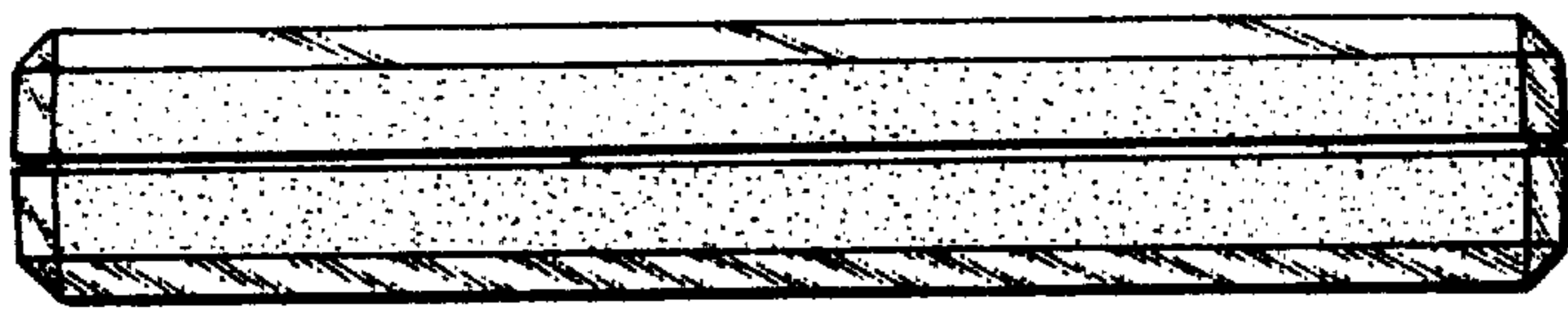

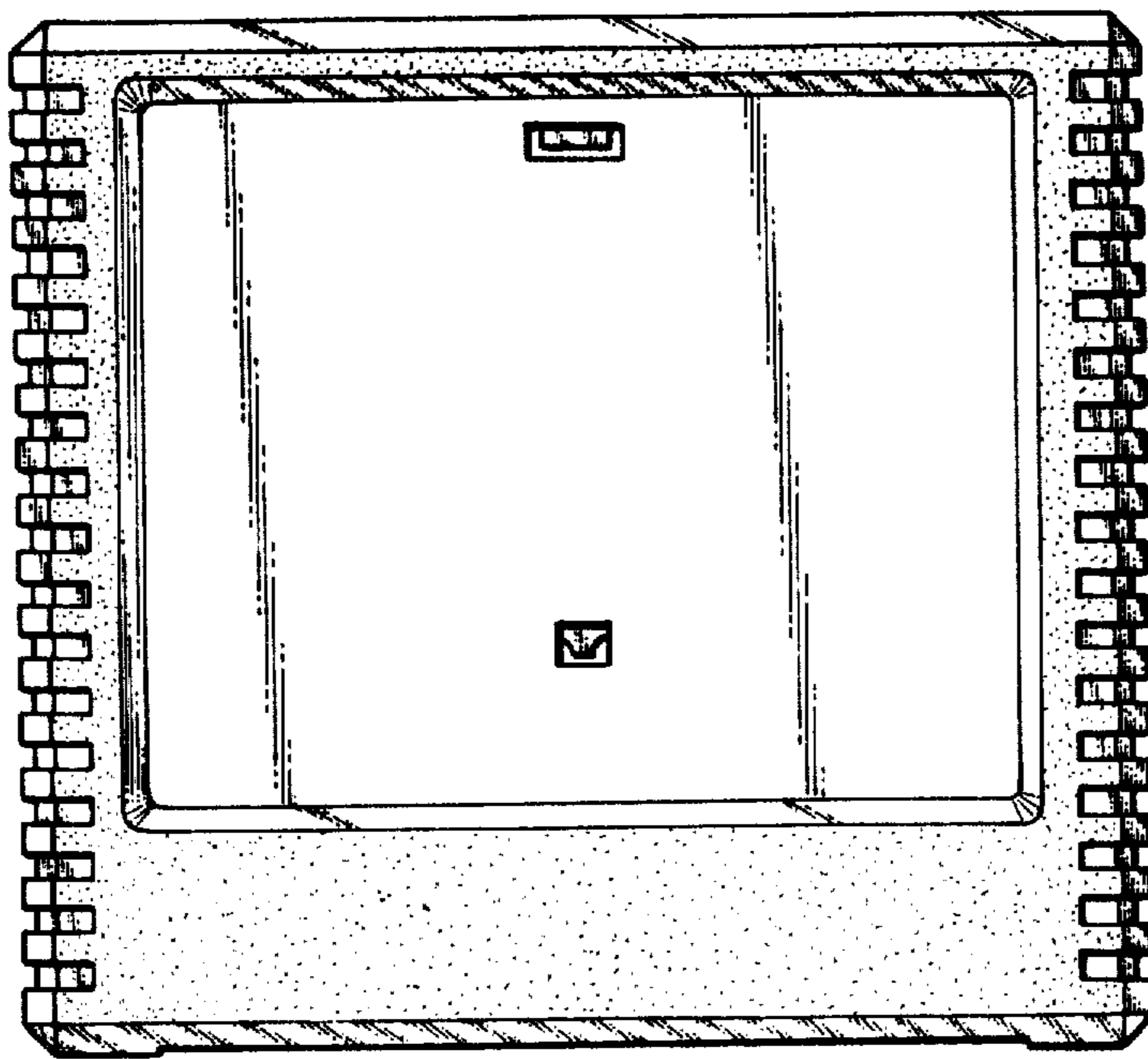

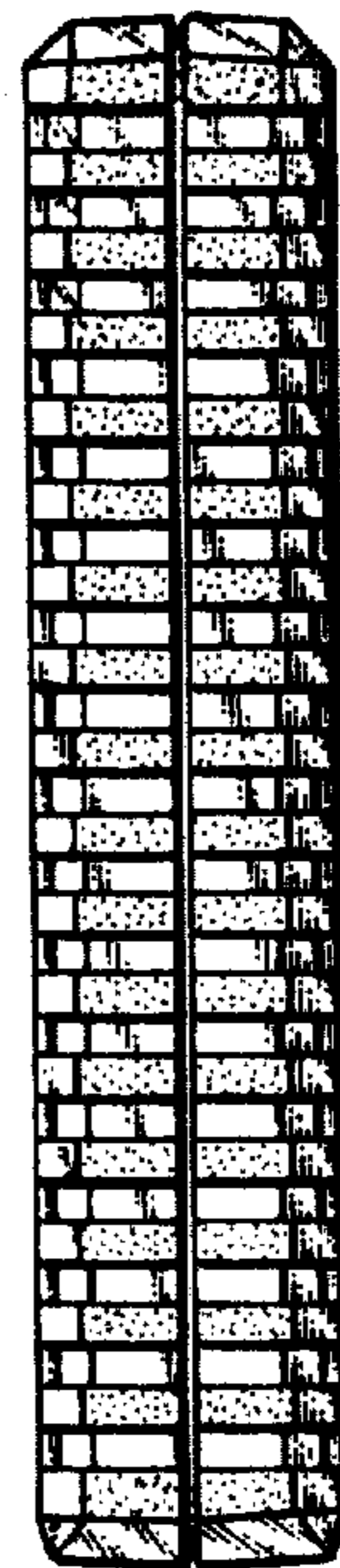

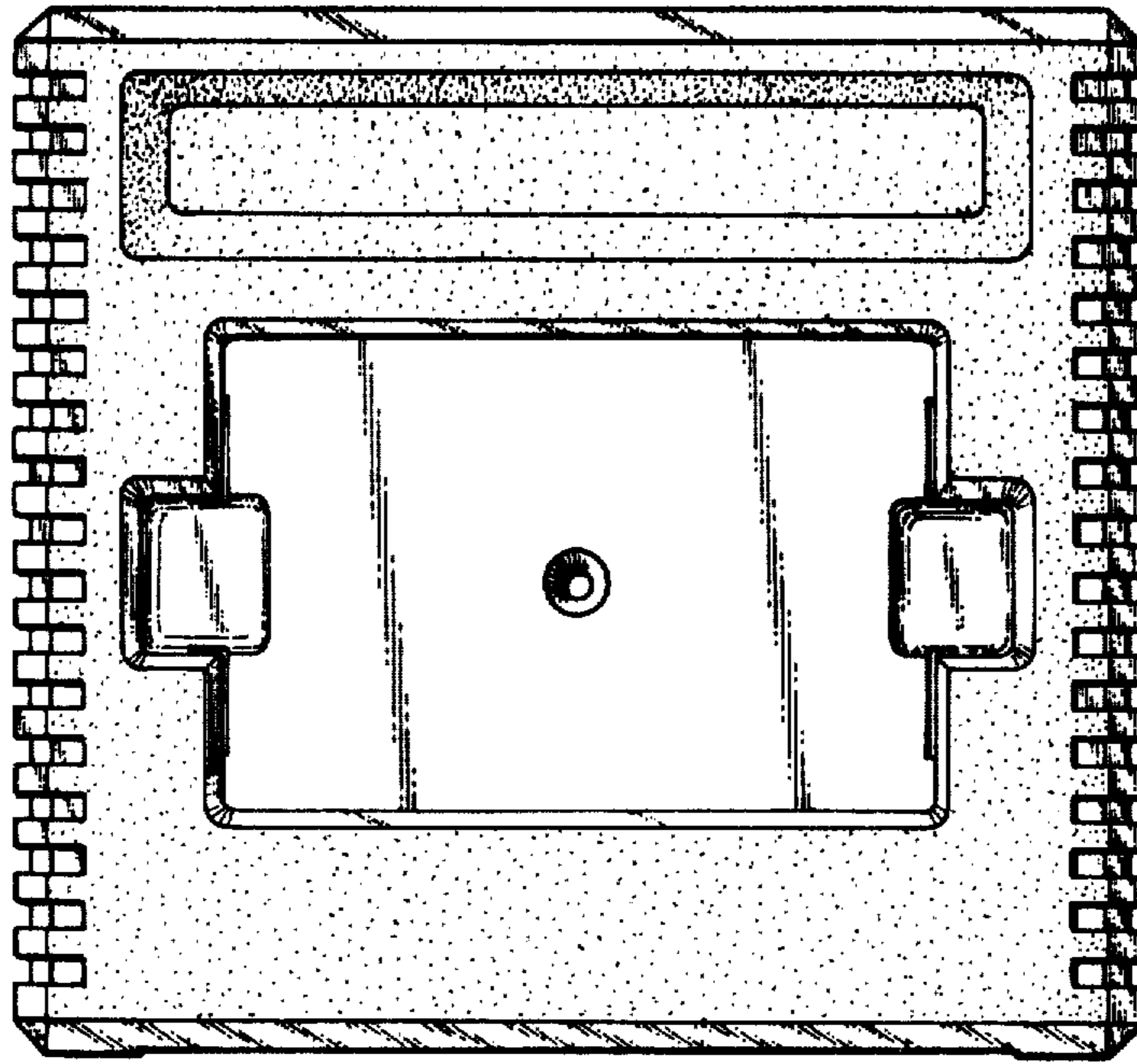

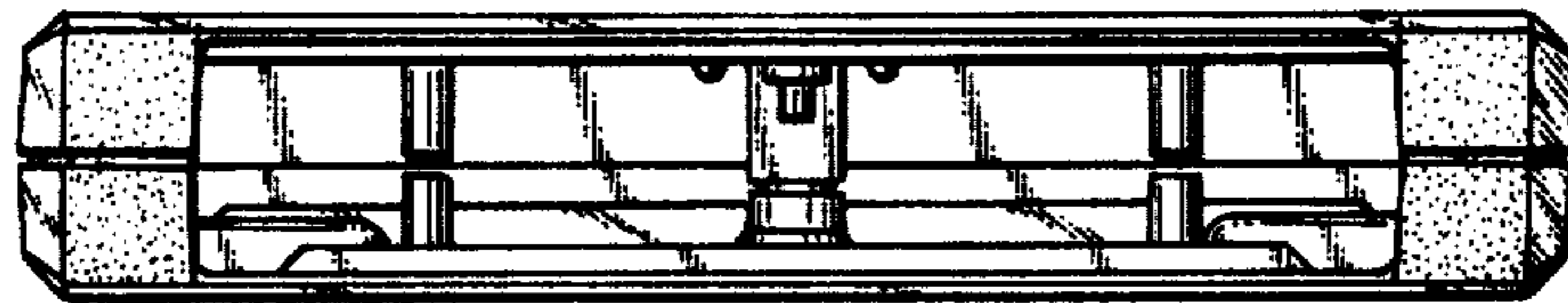
