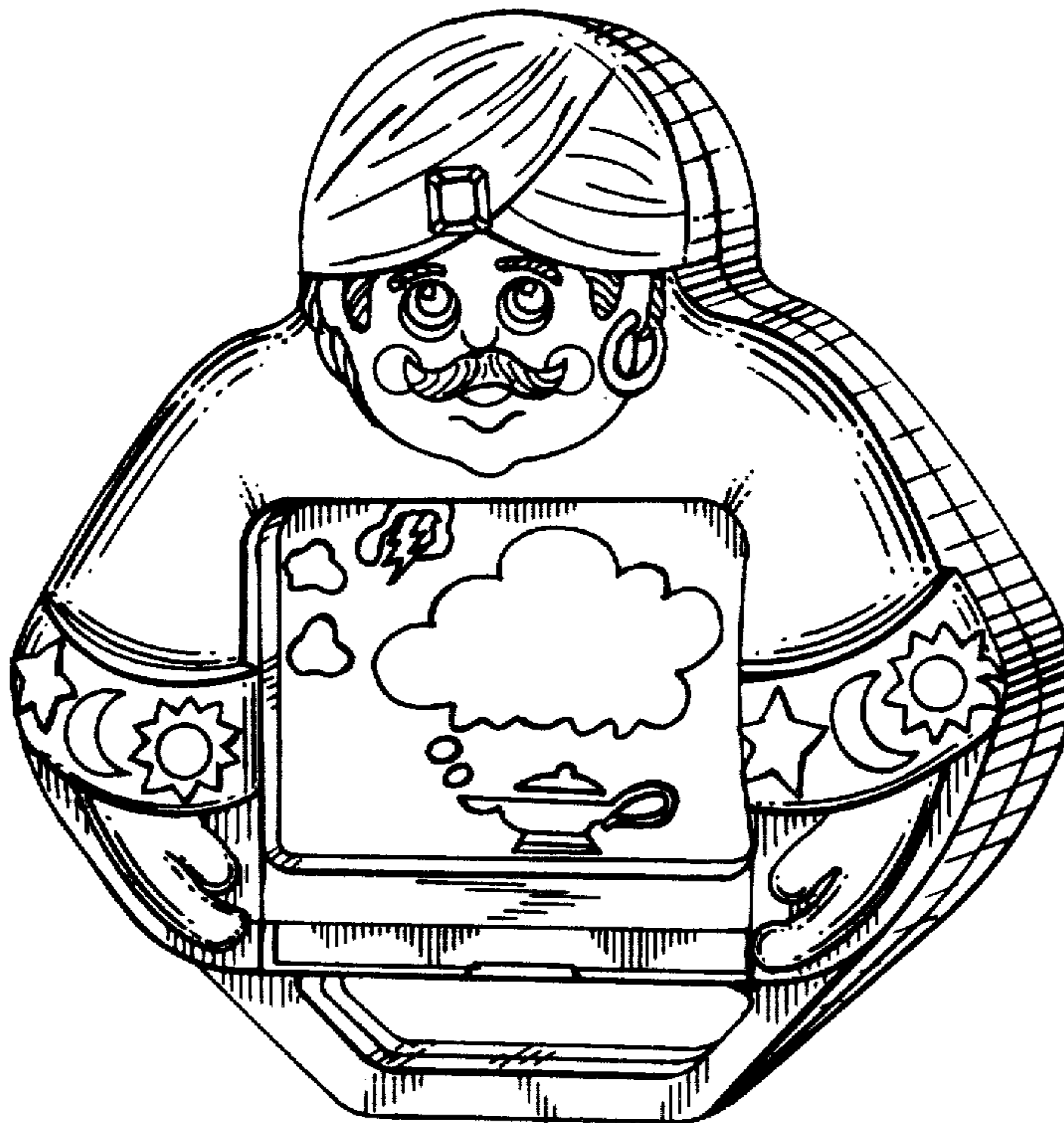

The ornamental design for electronic teaching aid, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electronic teaching aid embodying our design;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the toy with the instructional playing card removed;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.
The side not shown is identical to that shown.



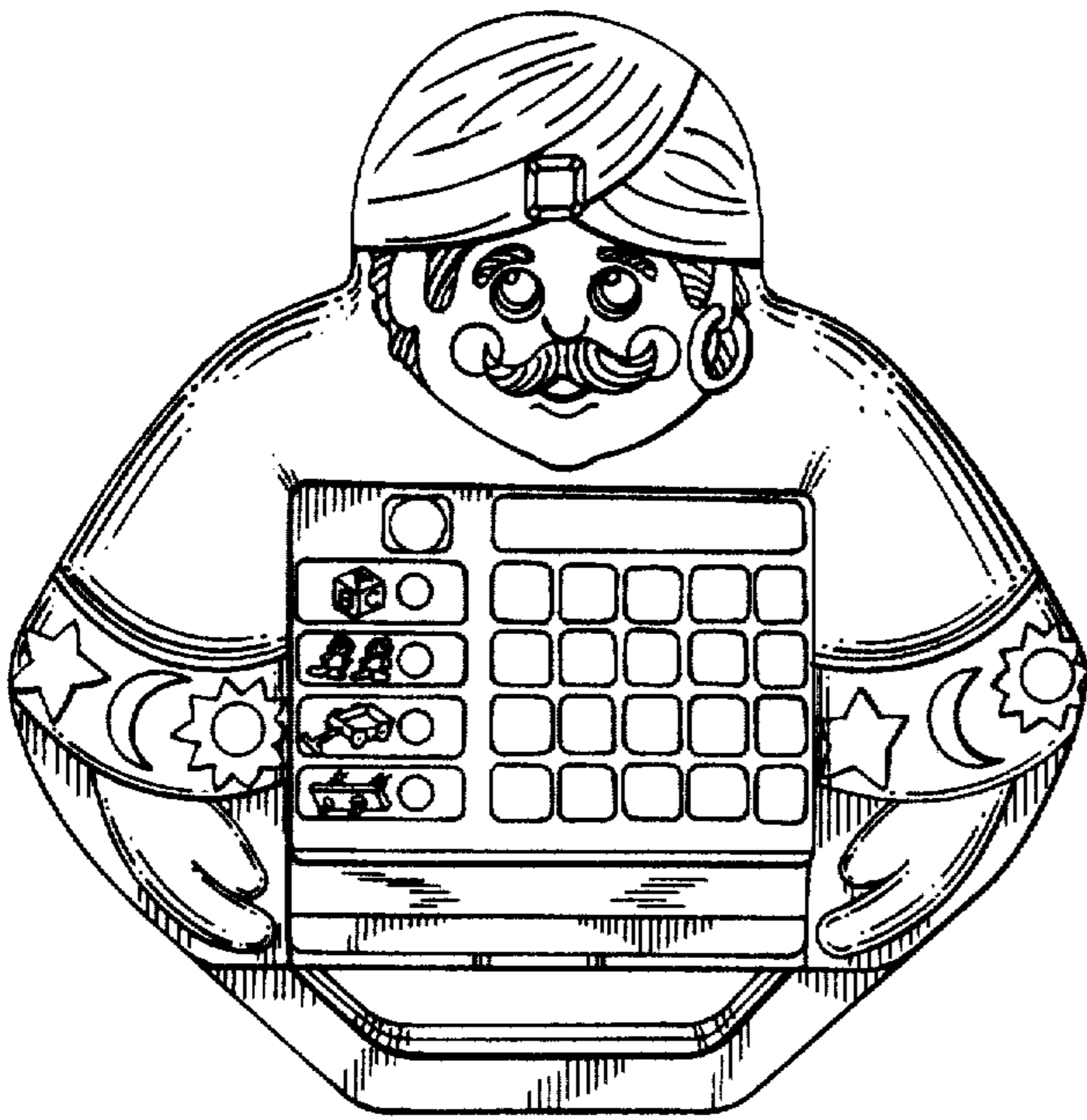

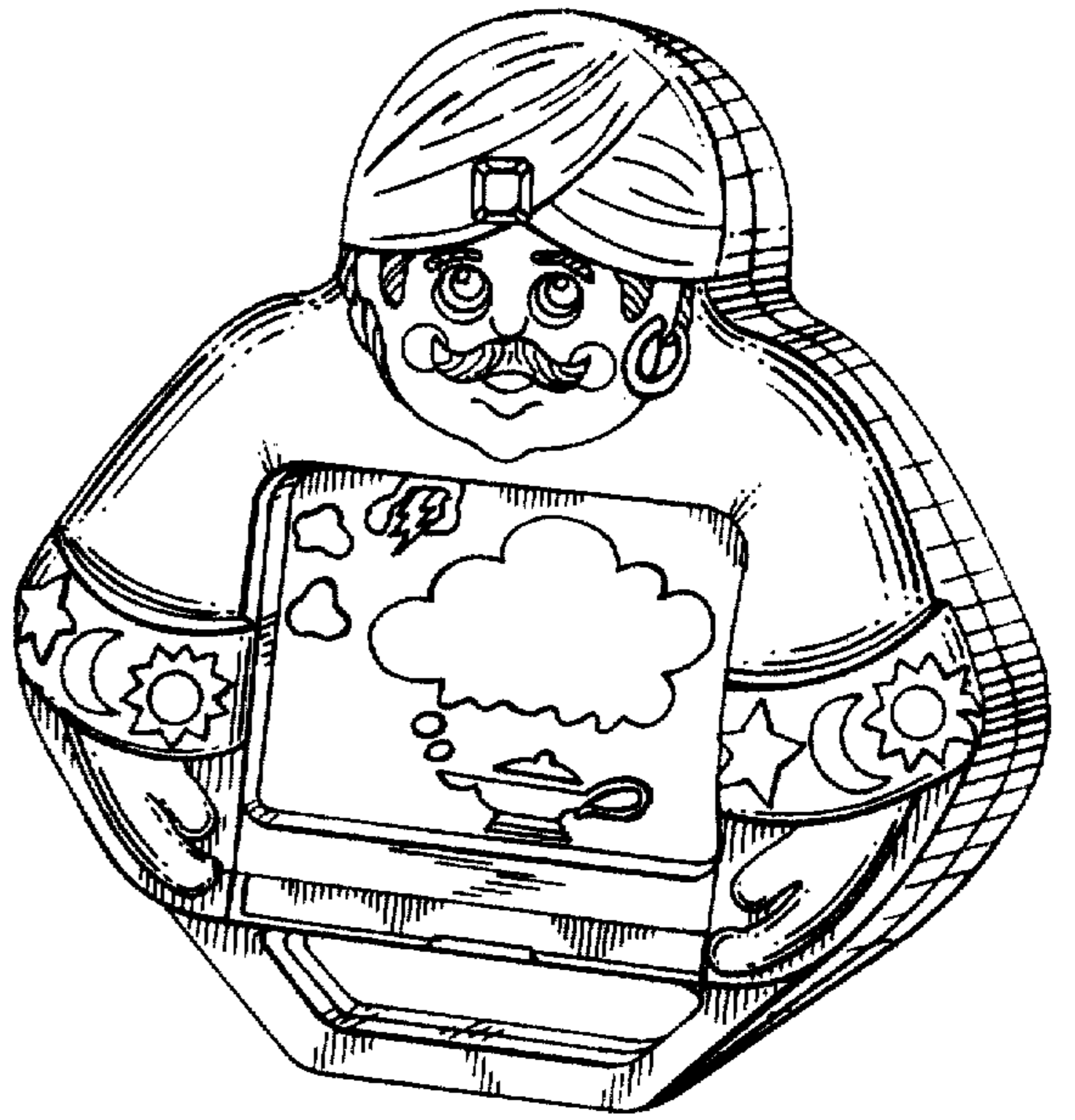

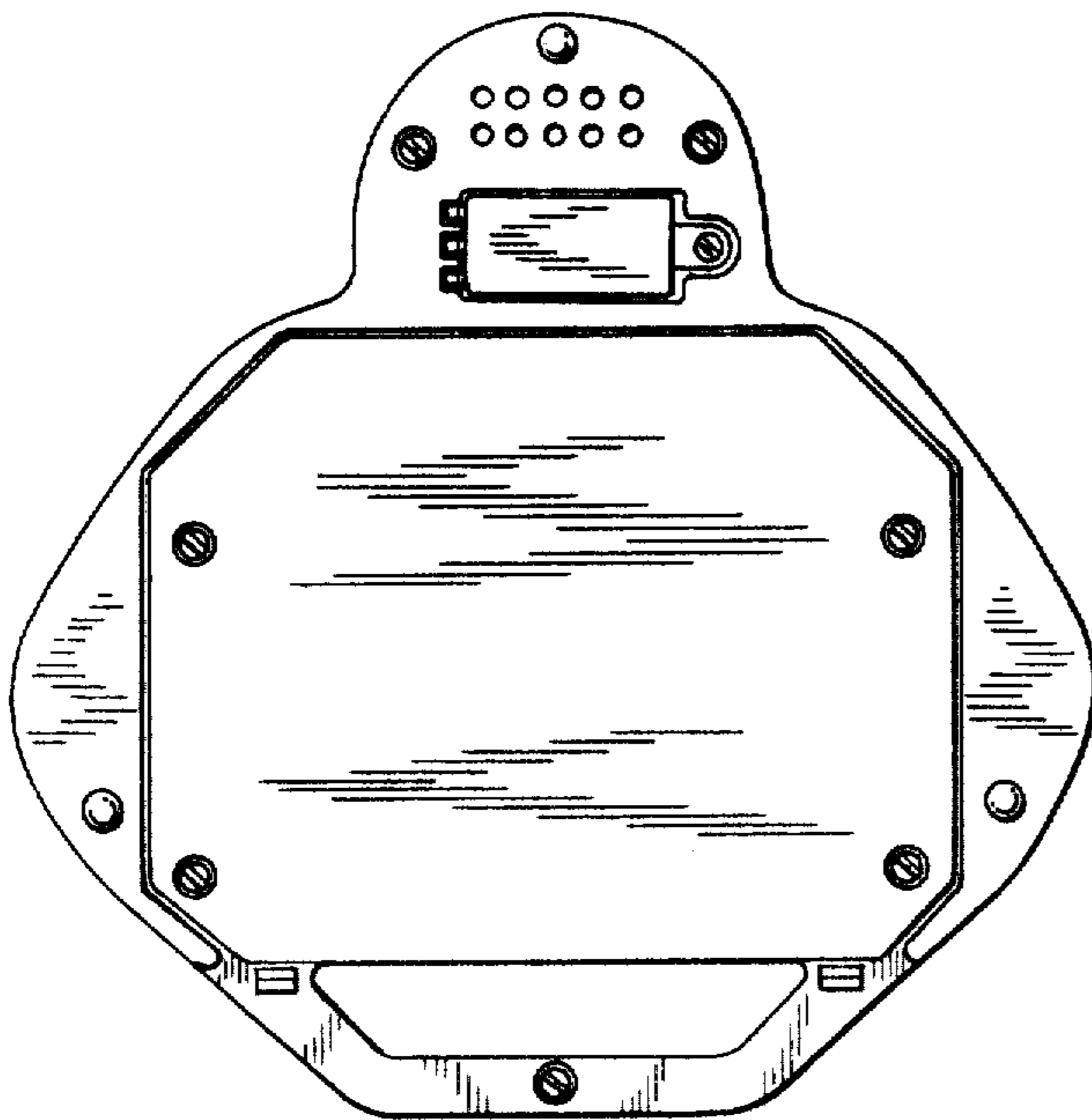

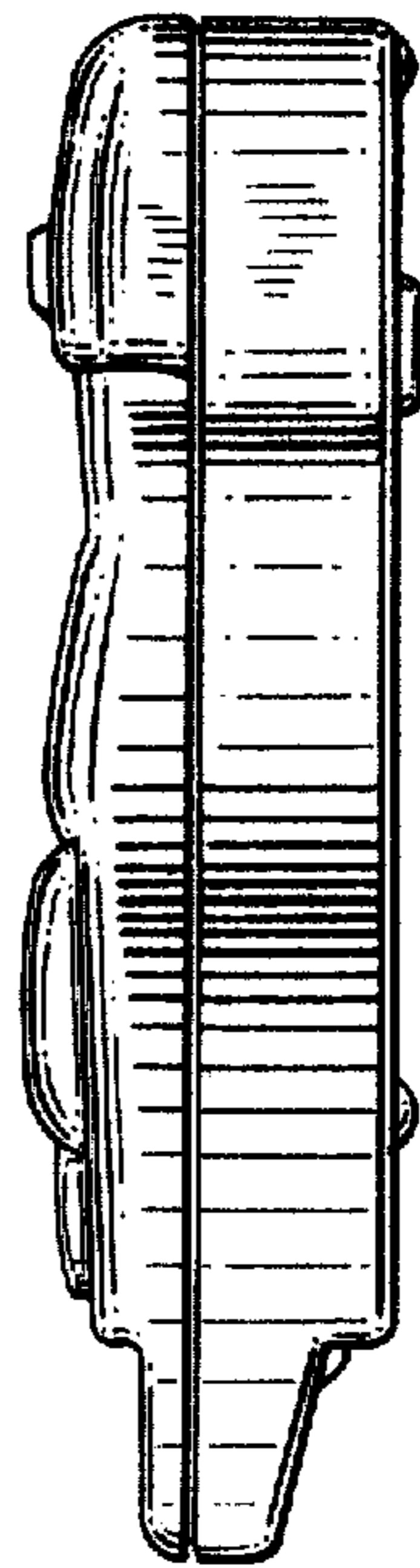

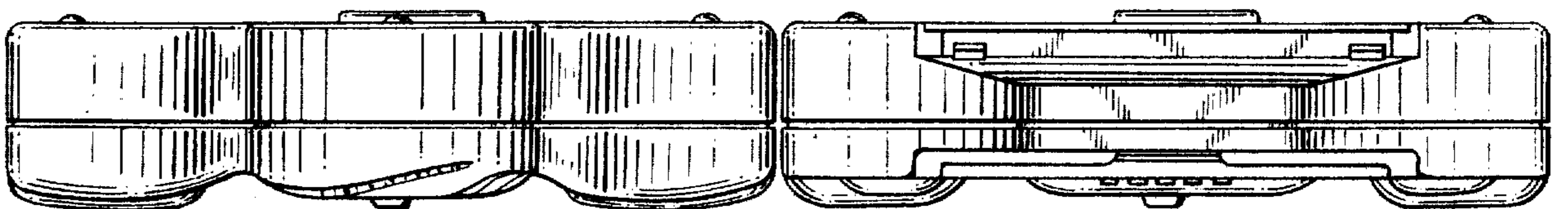
