The ornamental design for bidet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bidet embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof.

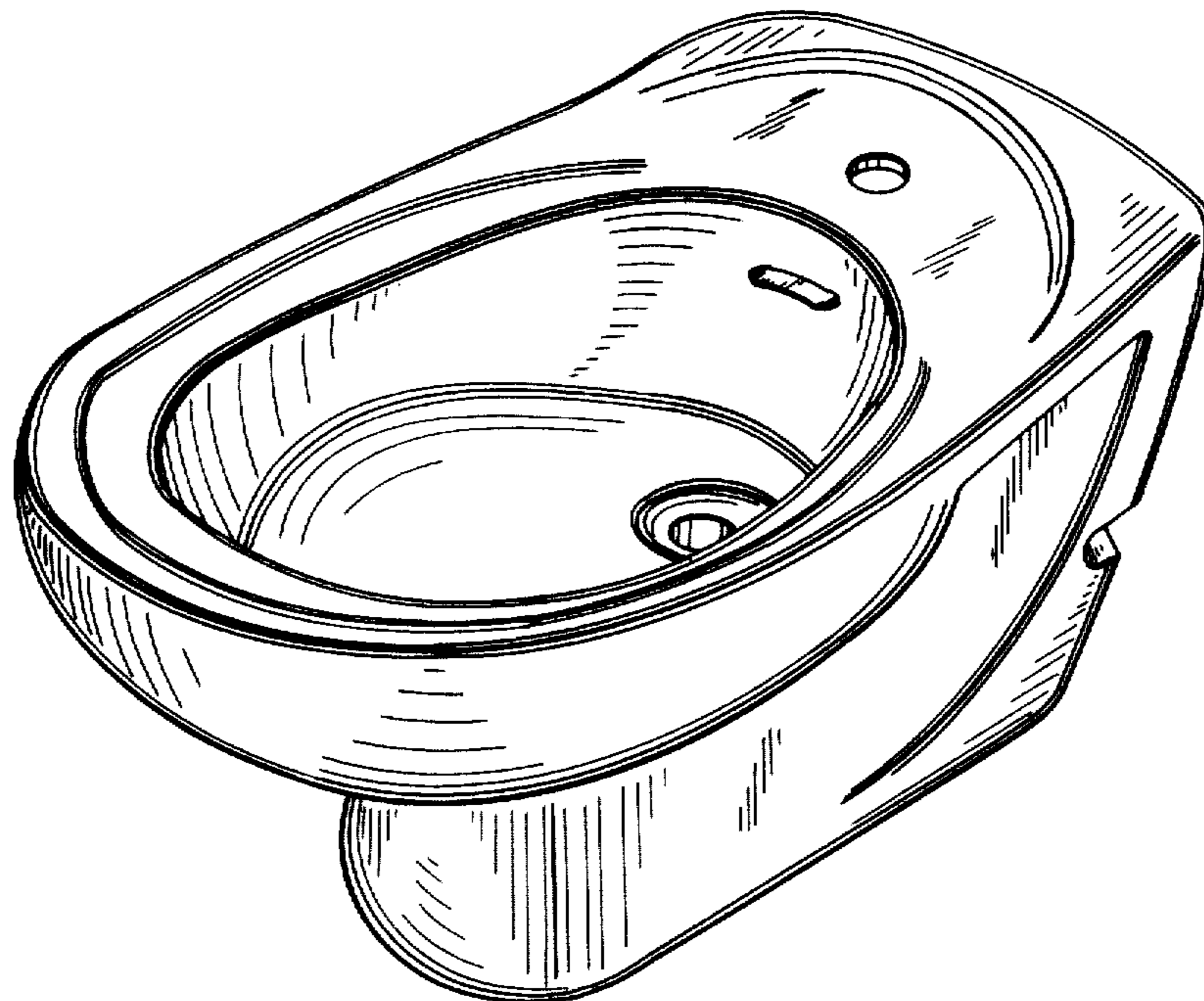

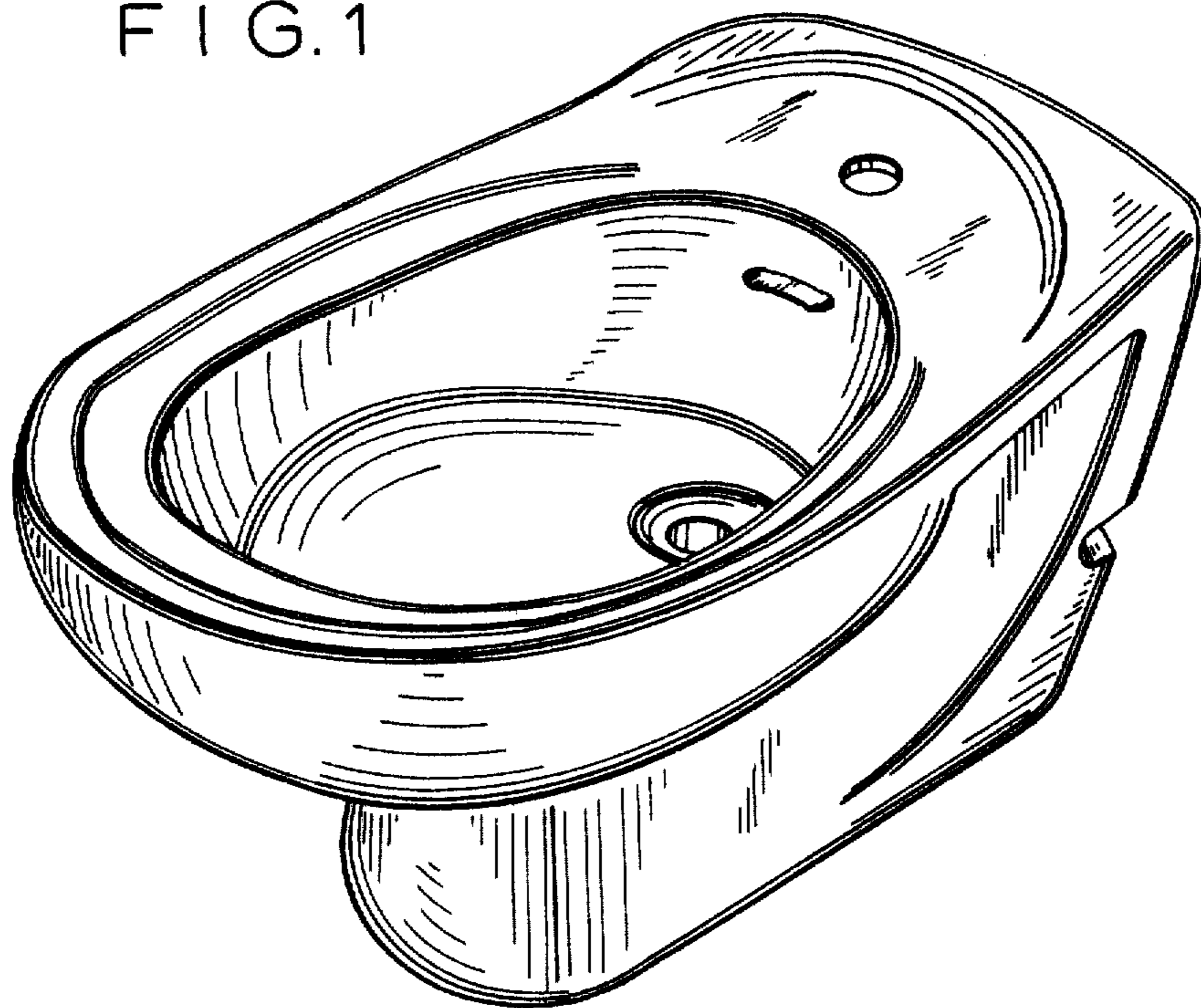

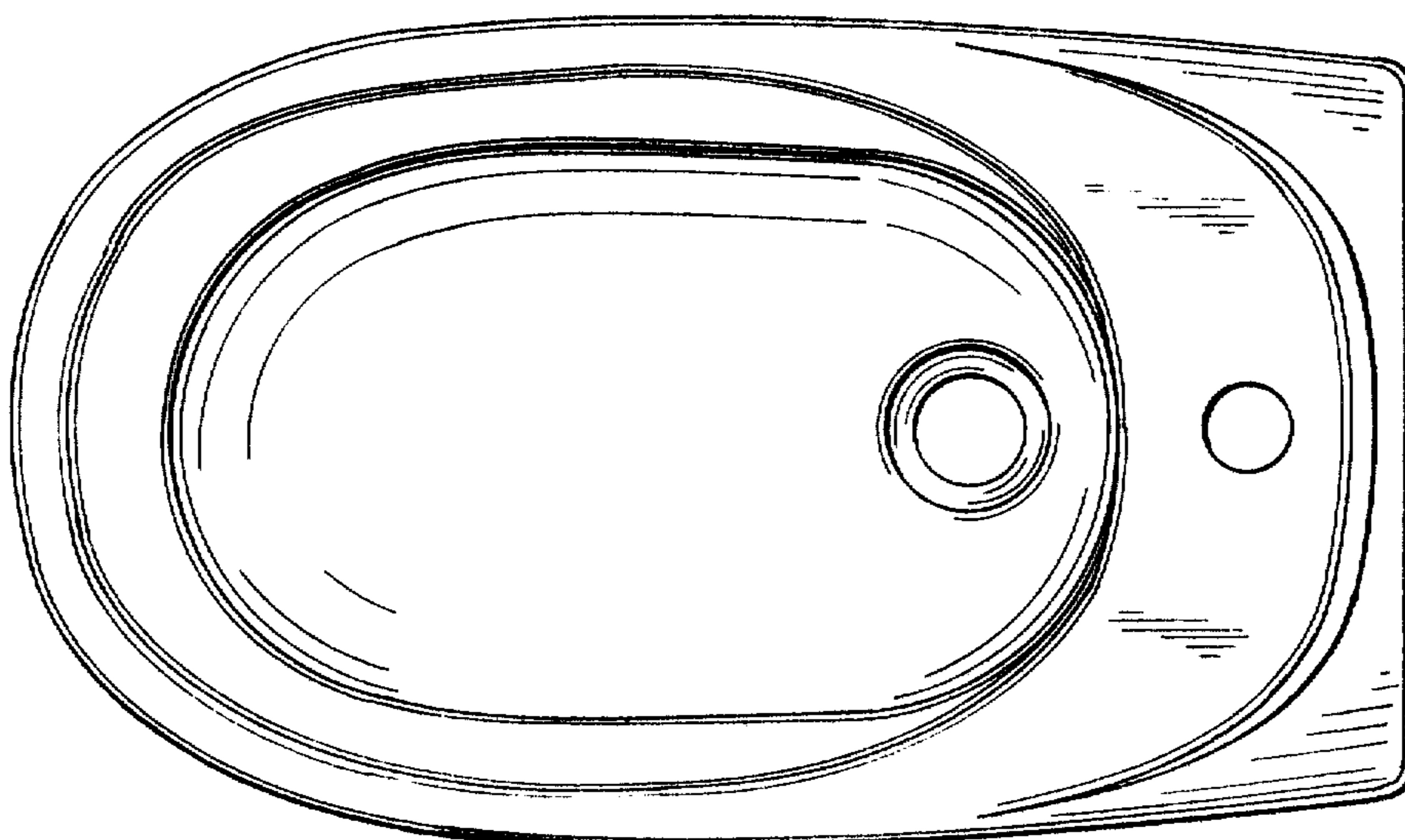

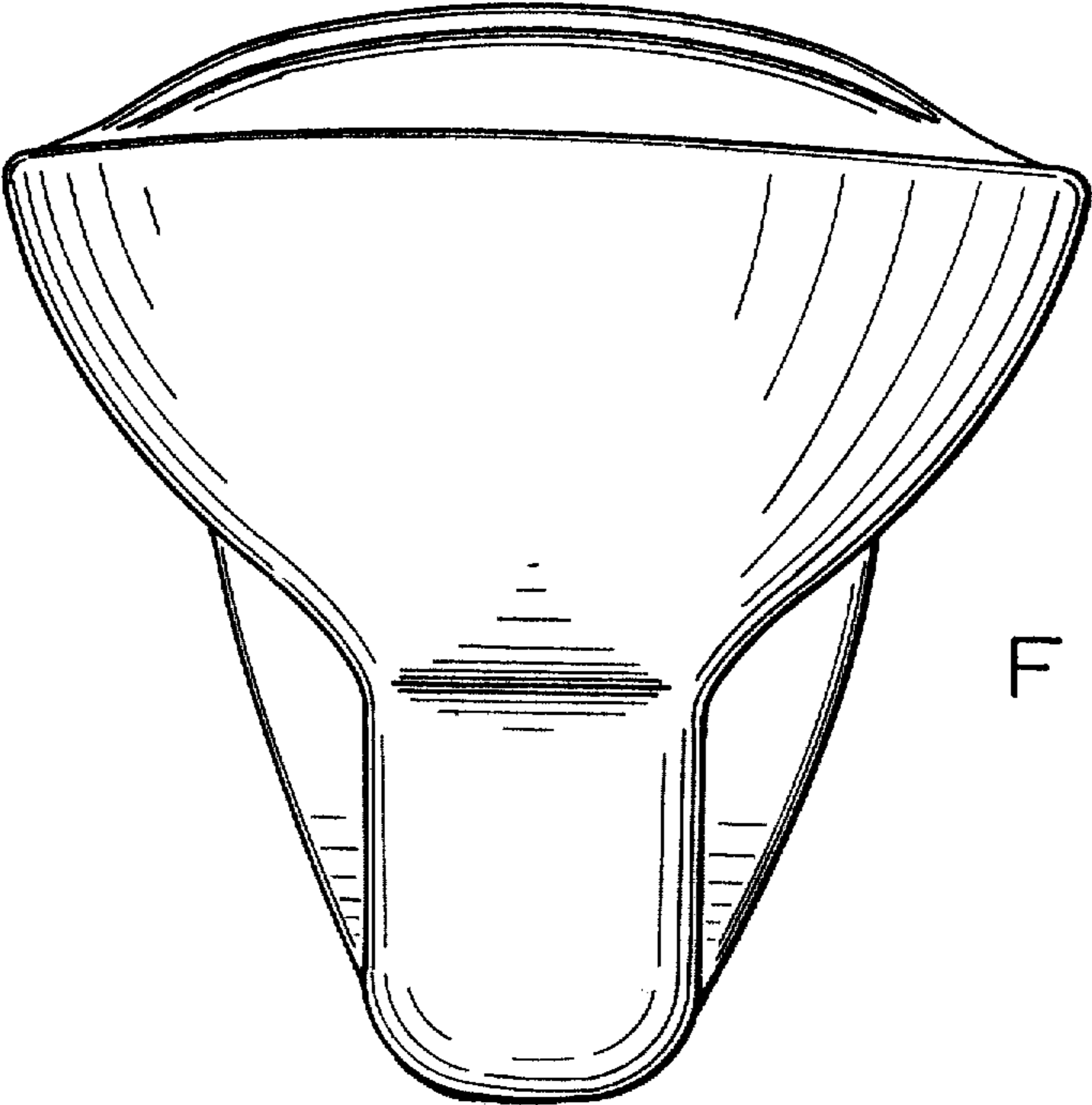
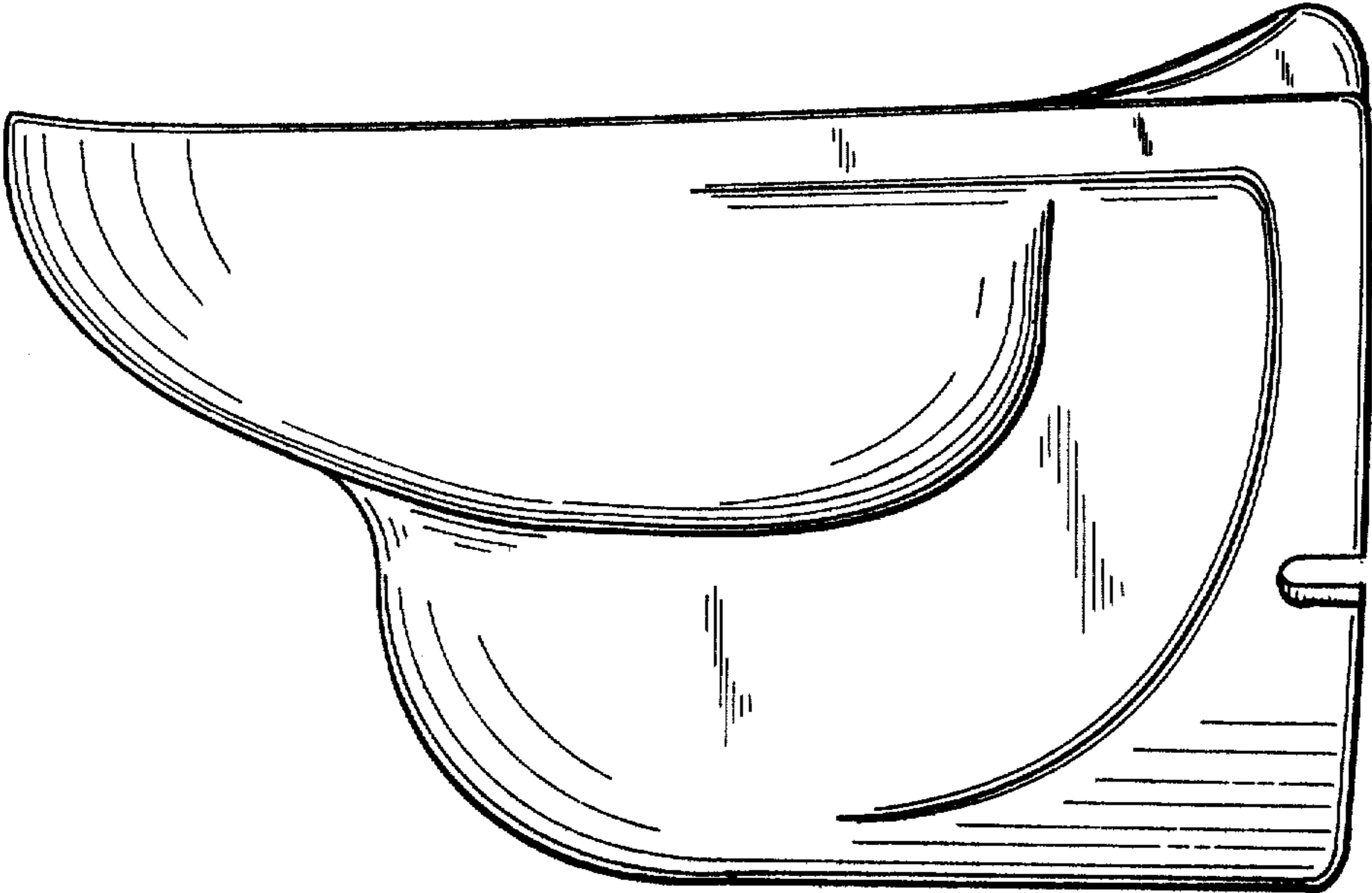

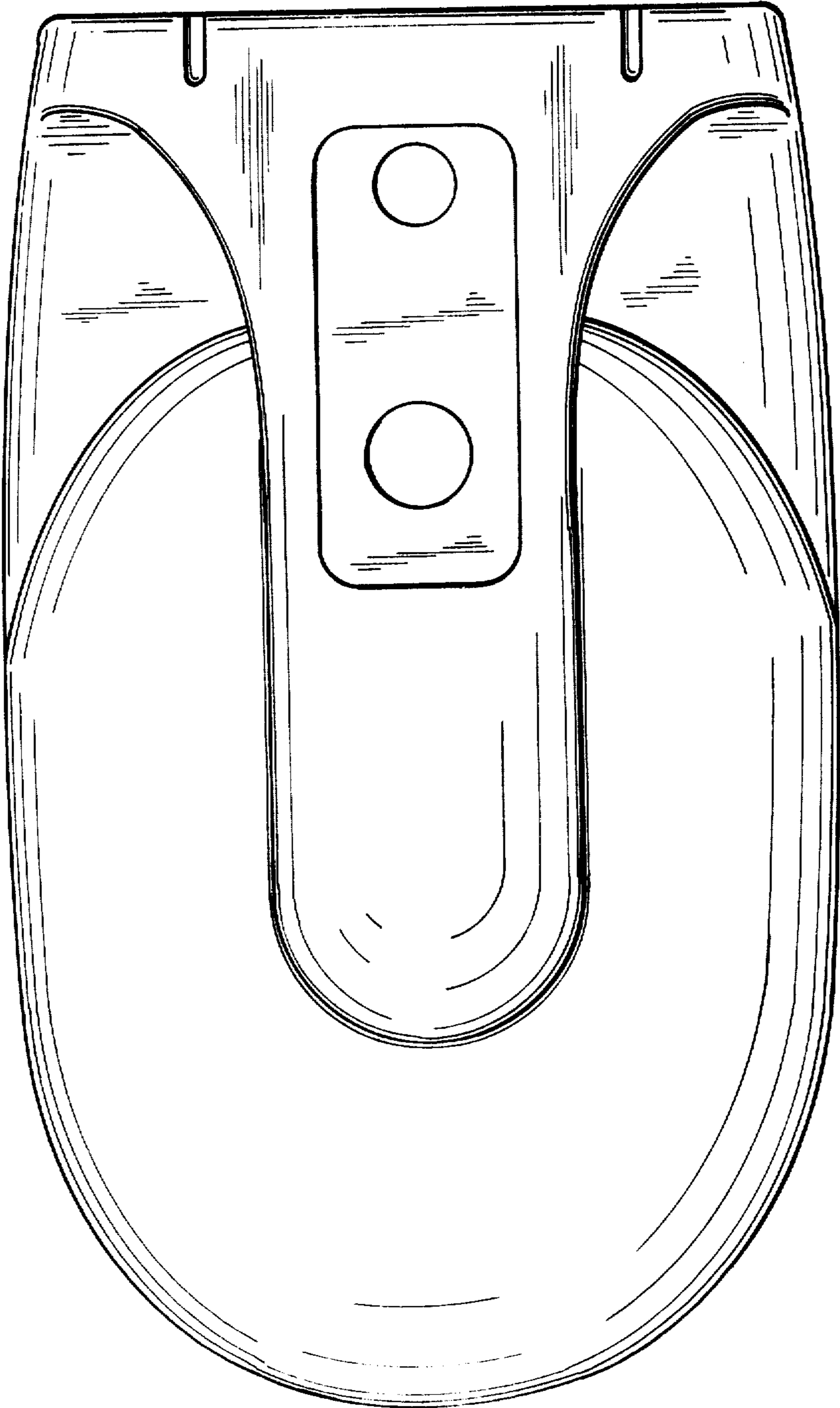
