FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a supporting stand for an intravenous solution bag for medical liquids, showing my new design;

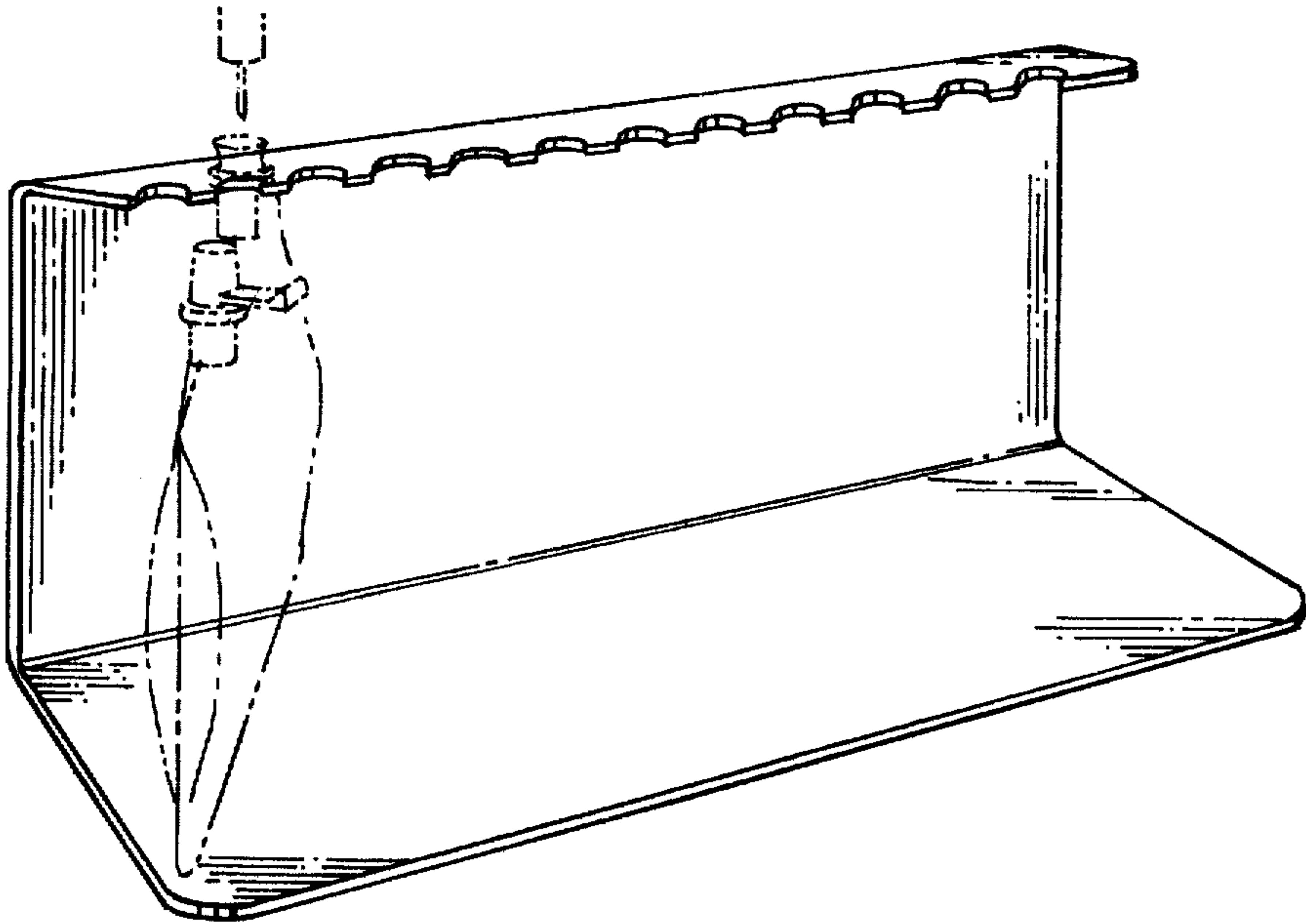
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

The broken line showing of a flexible bag and additive injector in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only.



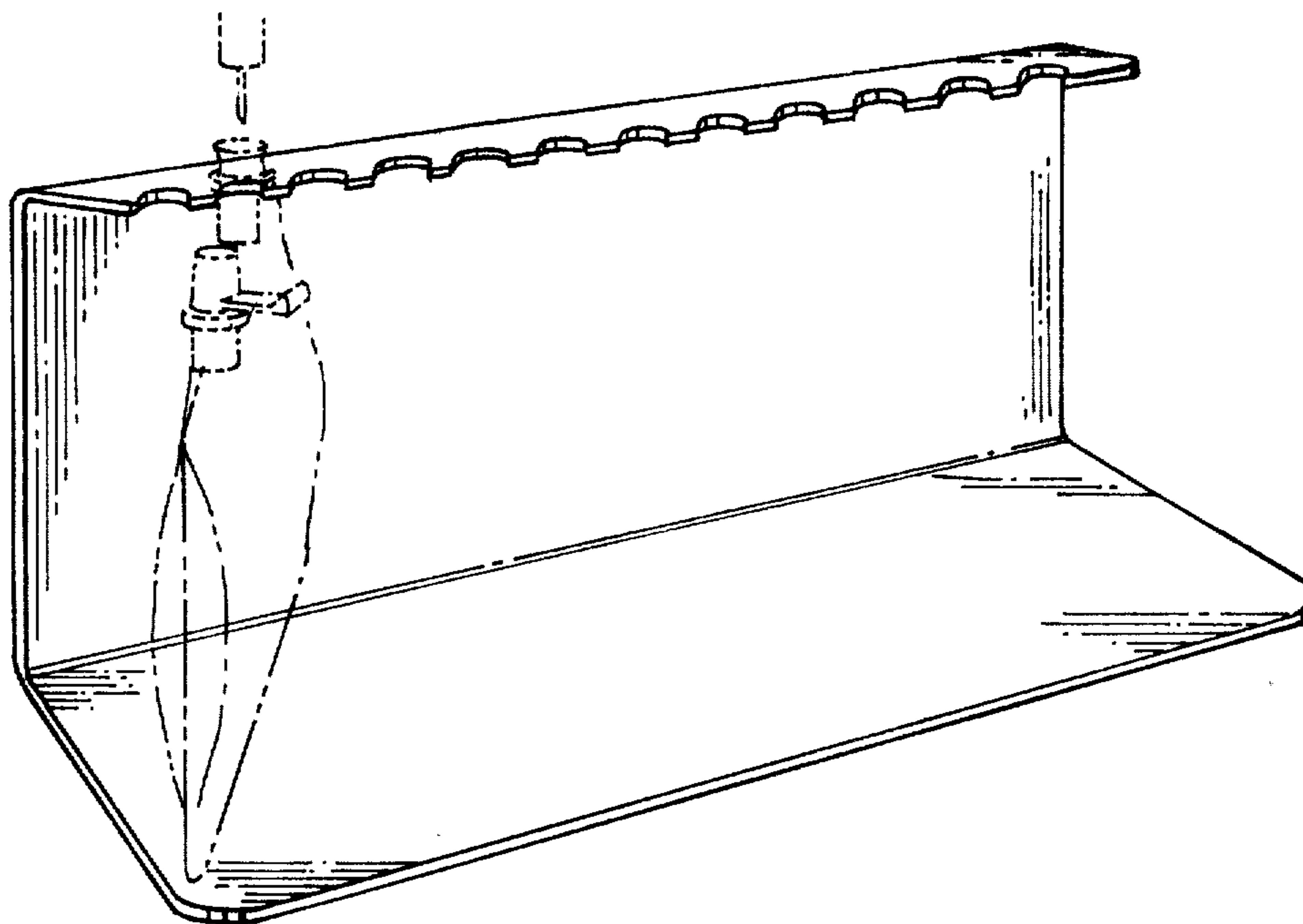

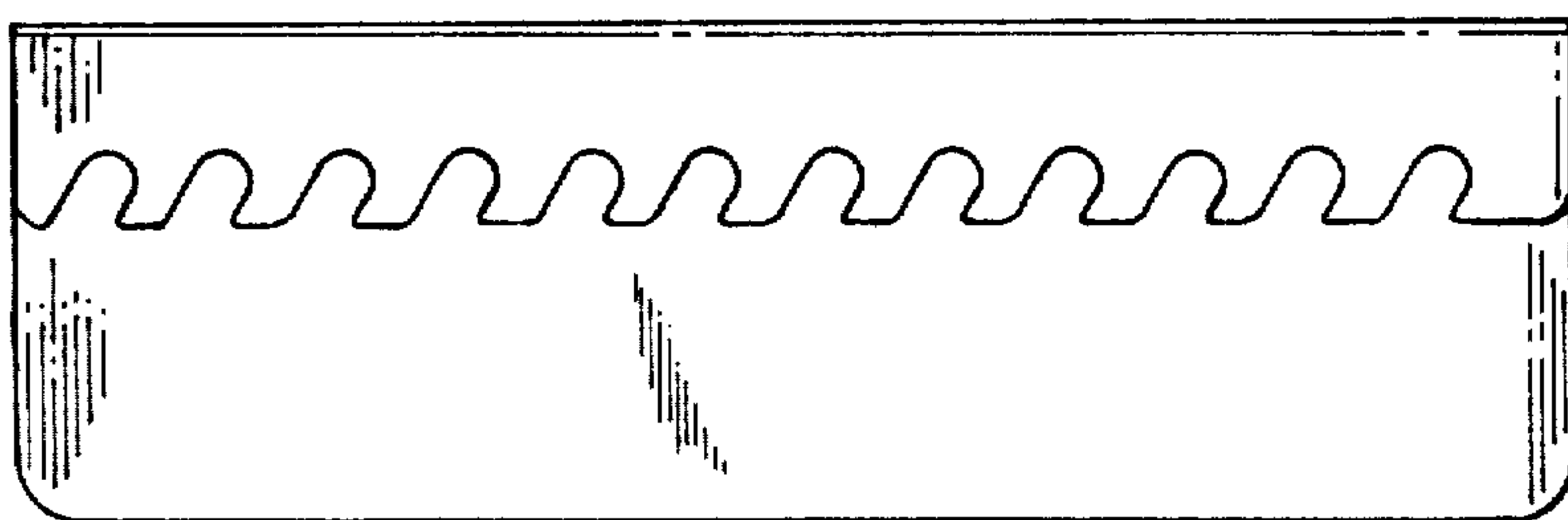

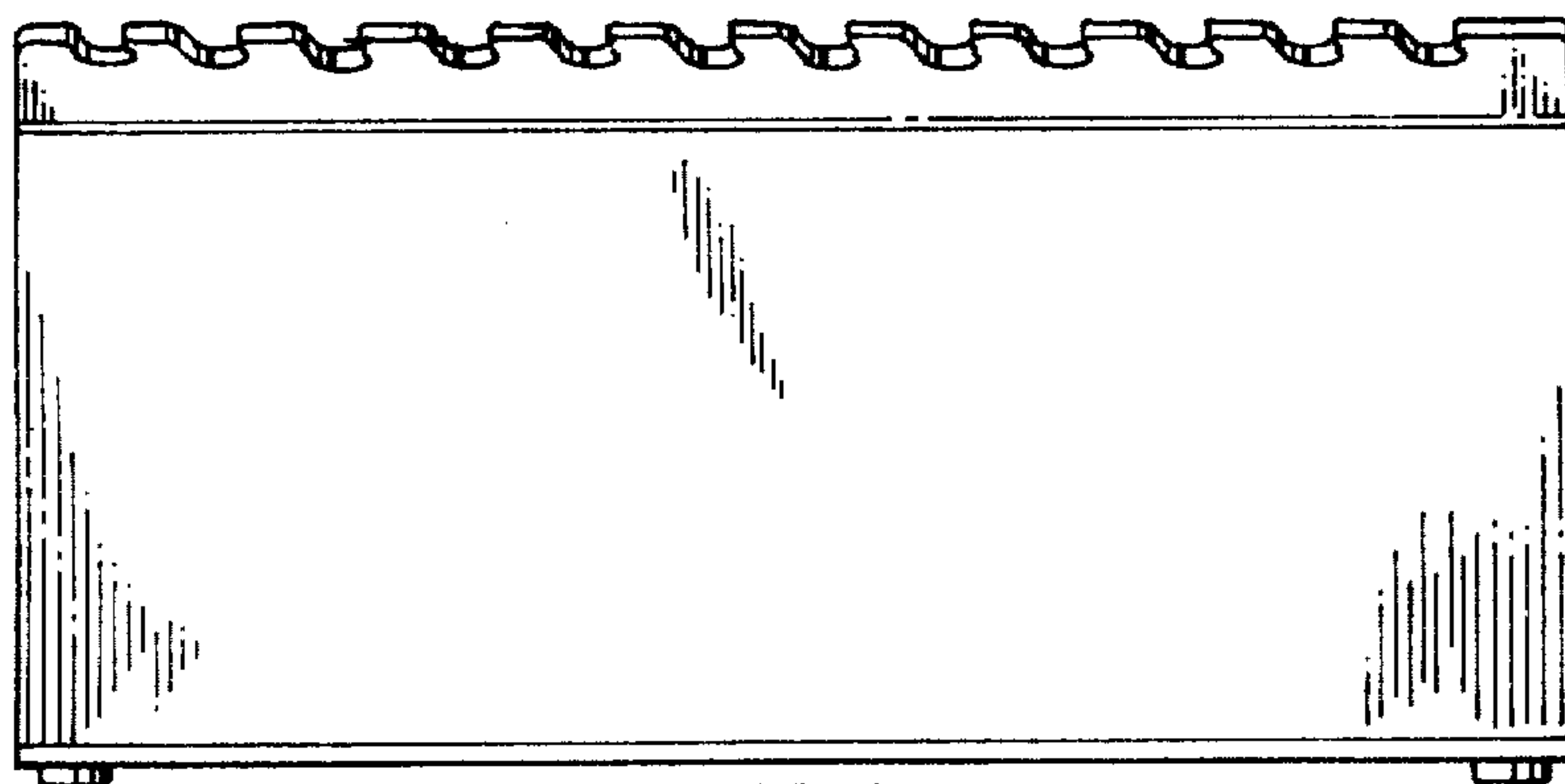

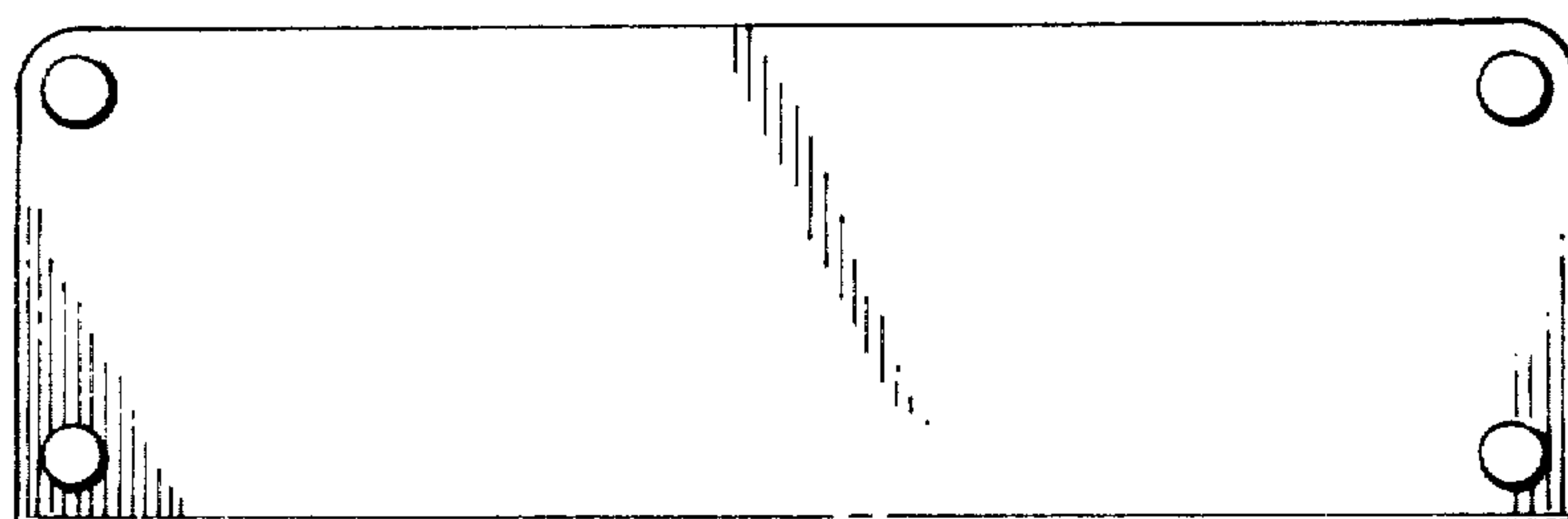

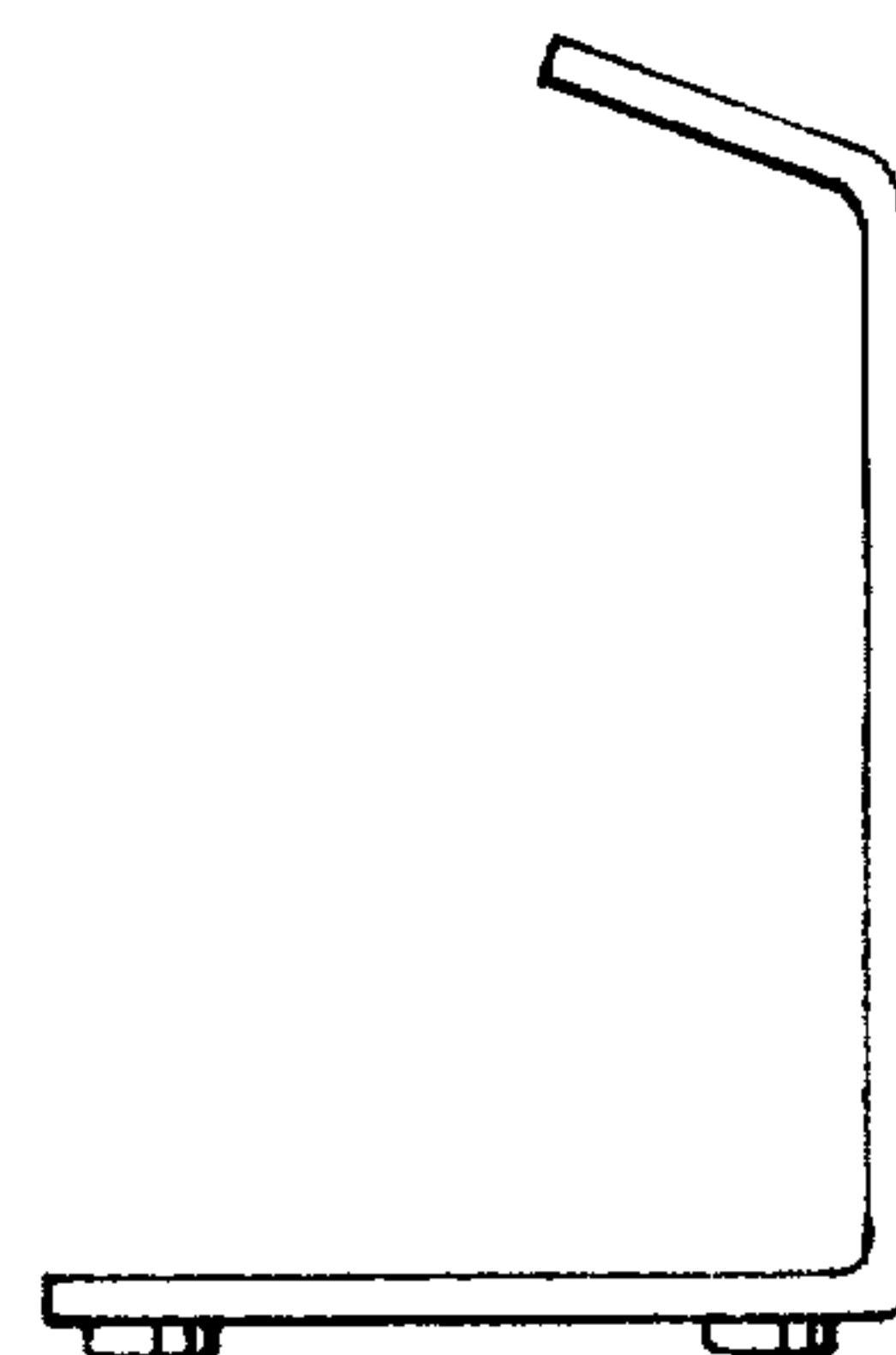
