FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a second embodiment of my design;


FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of the second embodiment;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the chair form shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the chair form shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the second embodiment shown in FIG. 3; and


FIG. 8 is a side elevational view thereof.













