The rear of the chest is plain and unornamented.

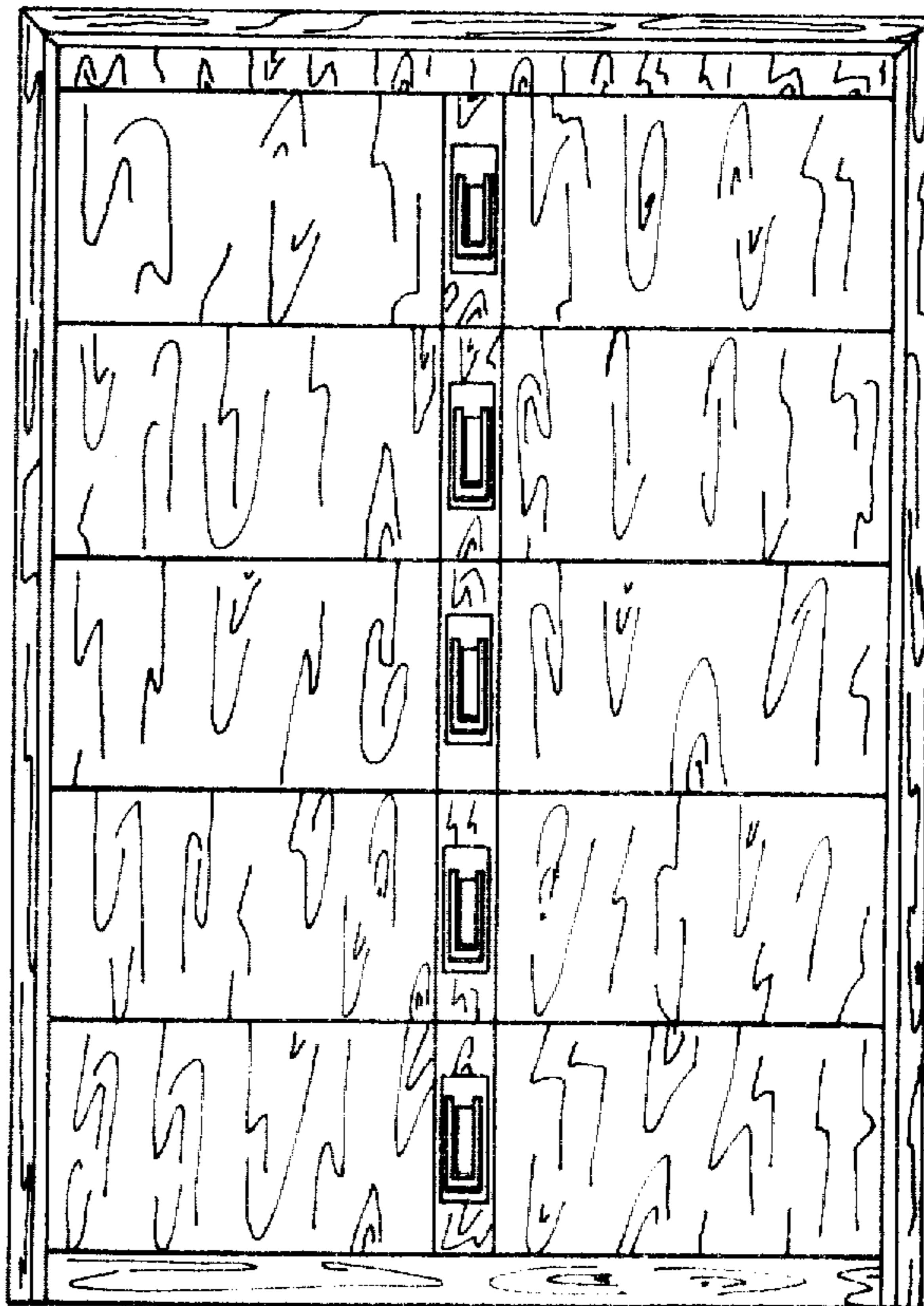
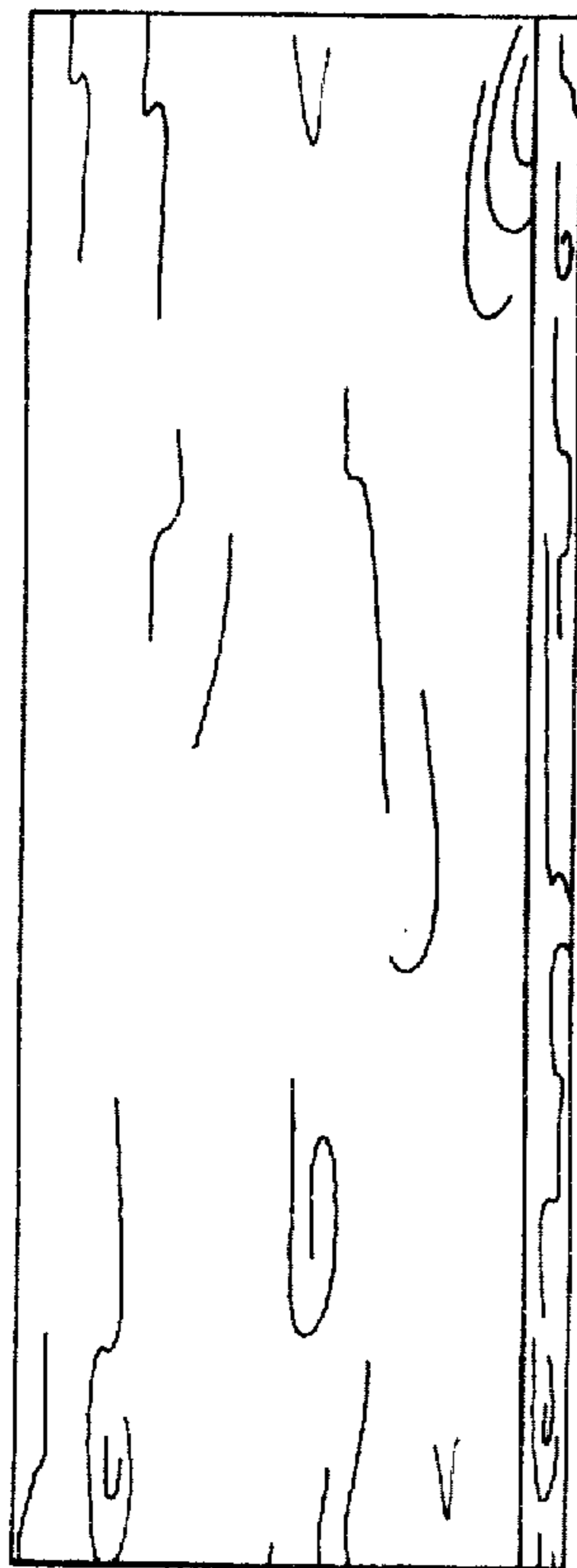

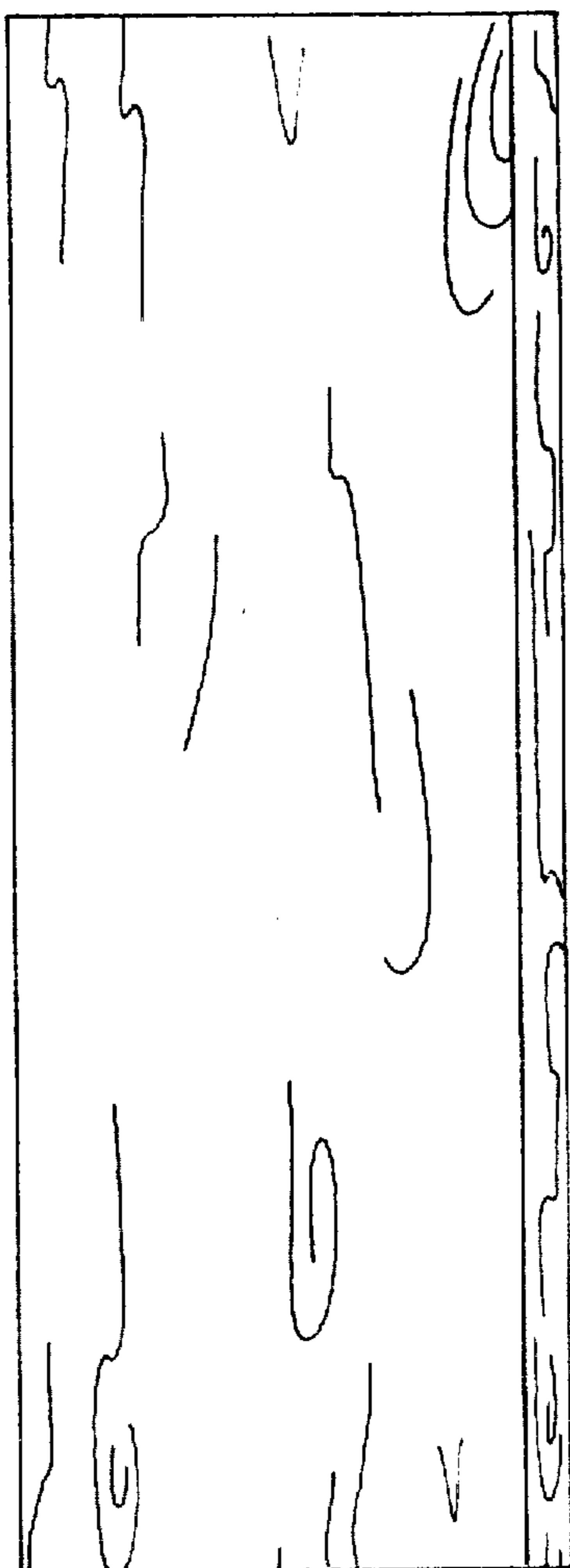
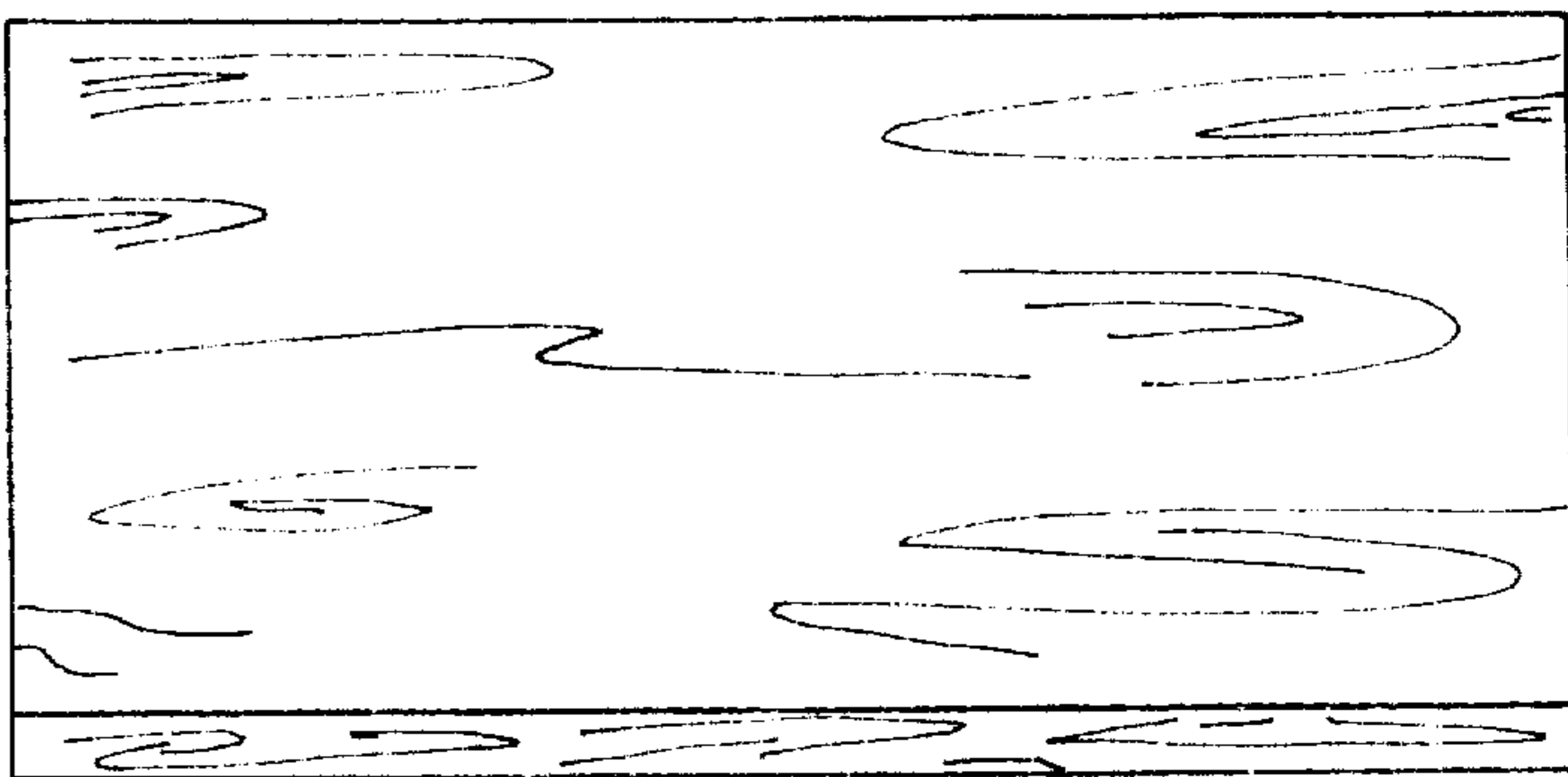

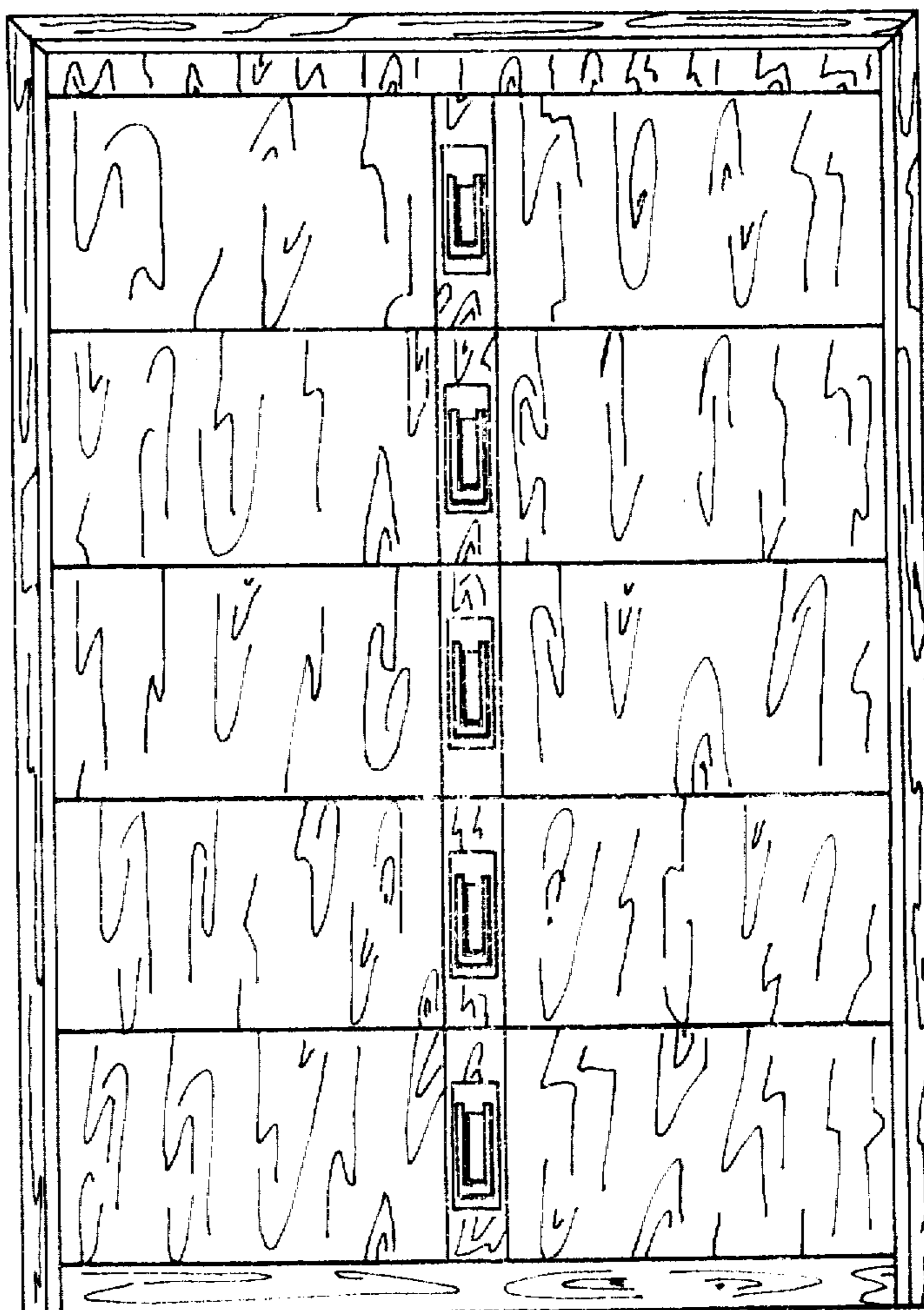
