
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a telescoping fishing pole,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective of the fishing pole of this design
in the partially extended configuration.

FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the fishing pole of this
design showing the pole in the collapsed configuration.
The reel shown in broken line in FIGS. 1 and 2 is shown
for purposes of illustration and does not constitute a
portion of the claimed design.
