DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair embodying my new design; and
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.
The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2 while the rear of the chair is conventional in appearance.

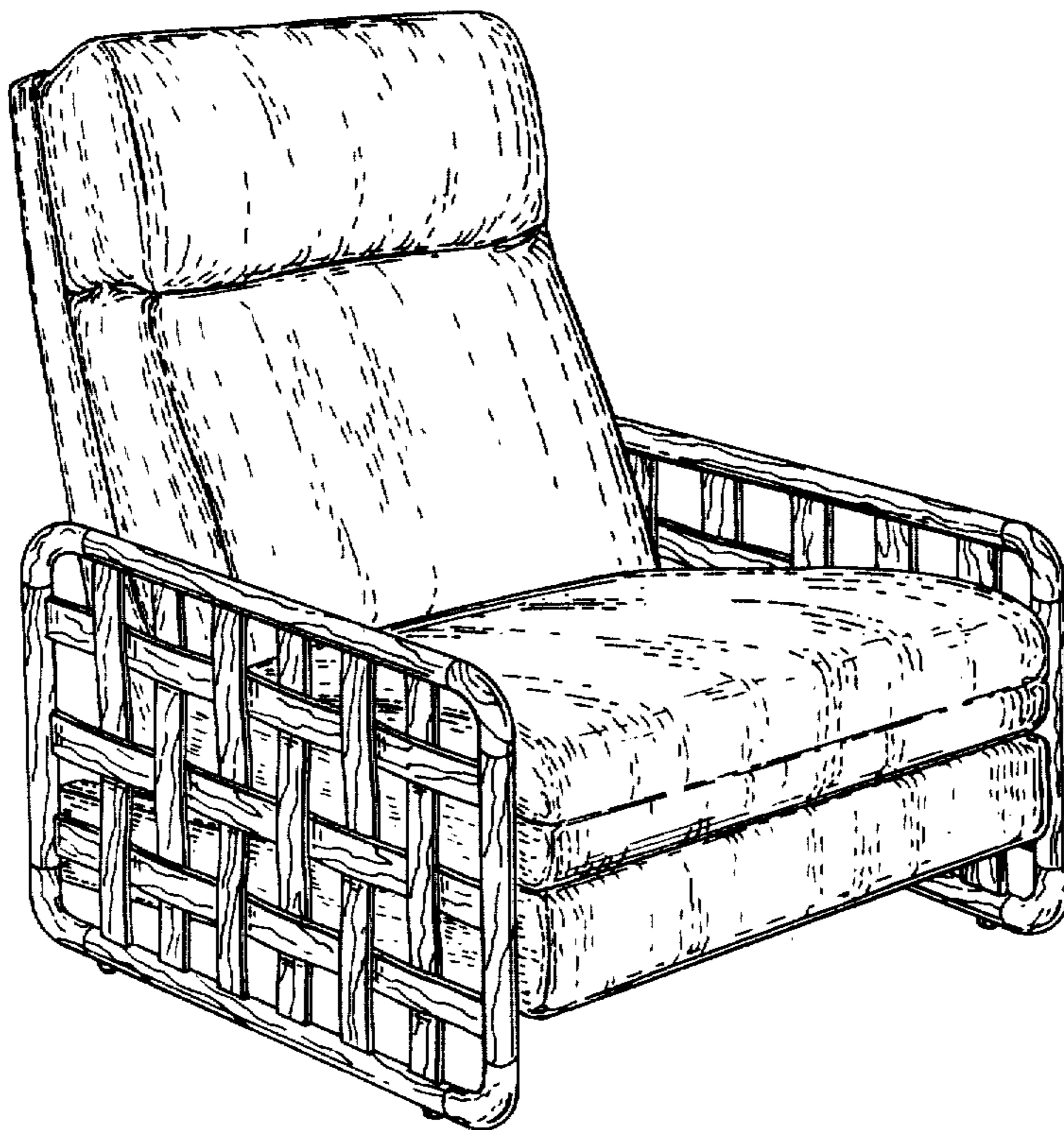

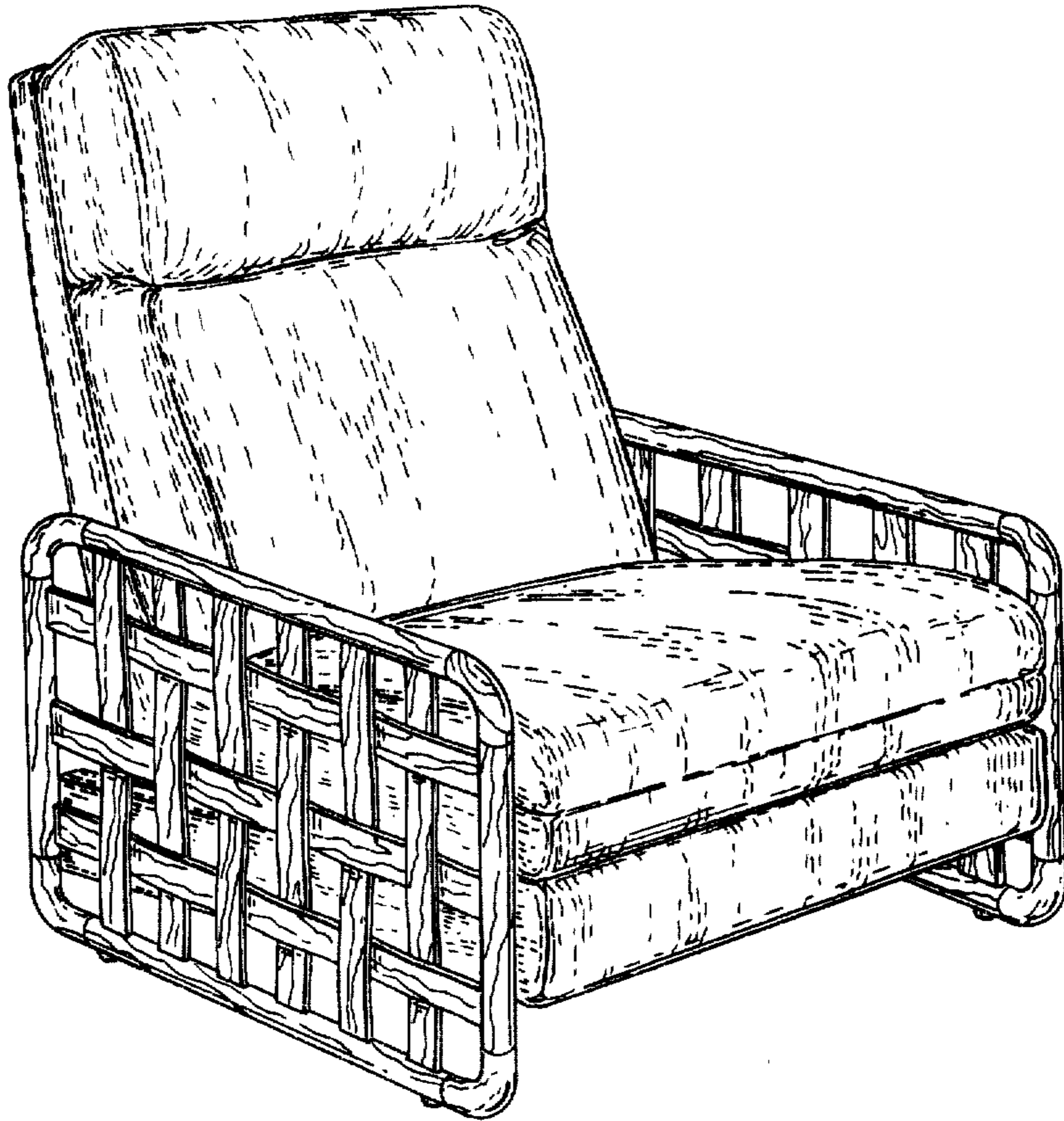
