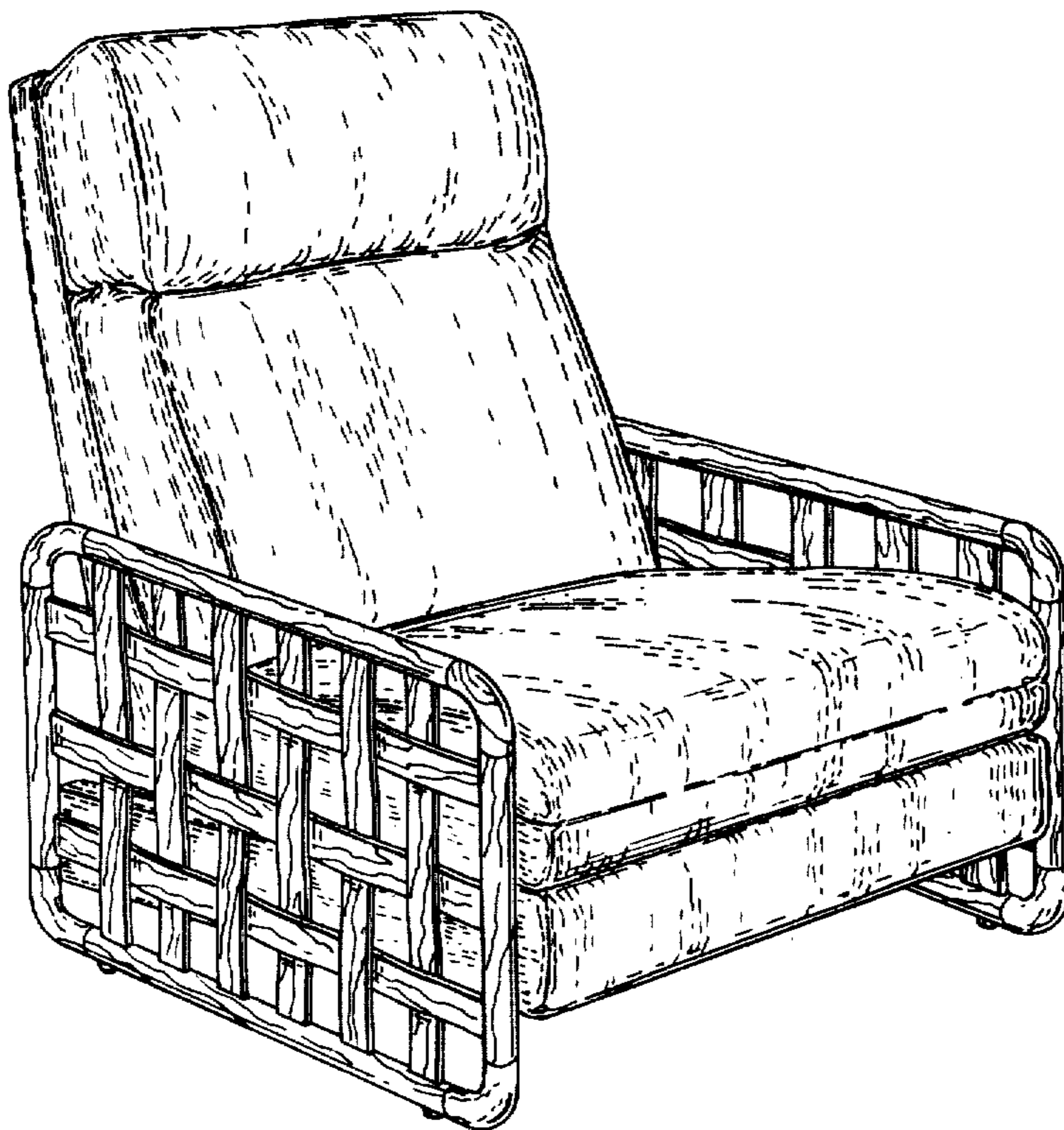

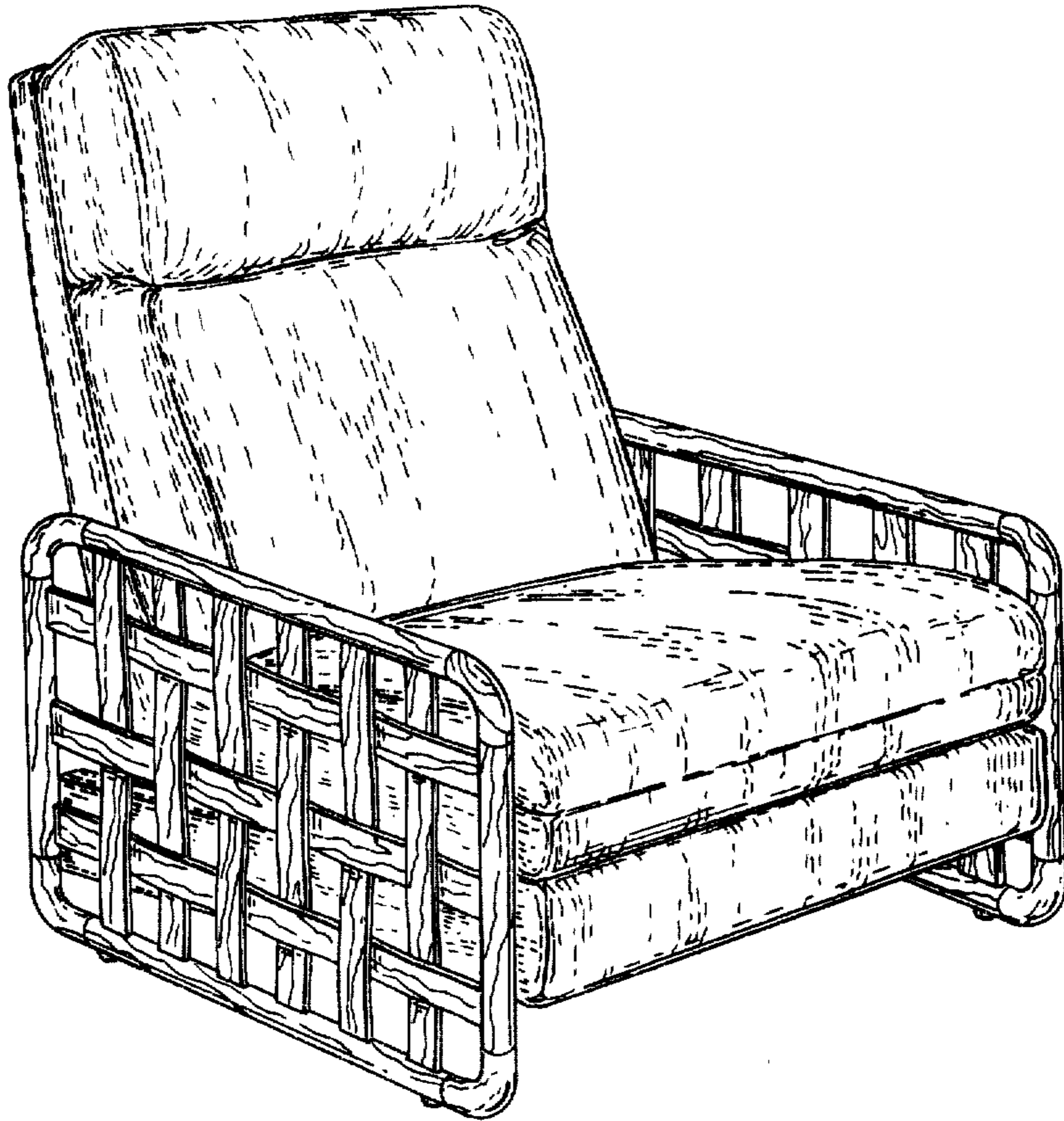
The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.
