[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the side not shown being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, with the rear being plain and unornamented;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a modified form of my new design, the side not shown being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the modified form of my new design, with the rear being plain and unornamented.

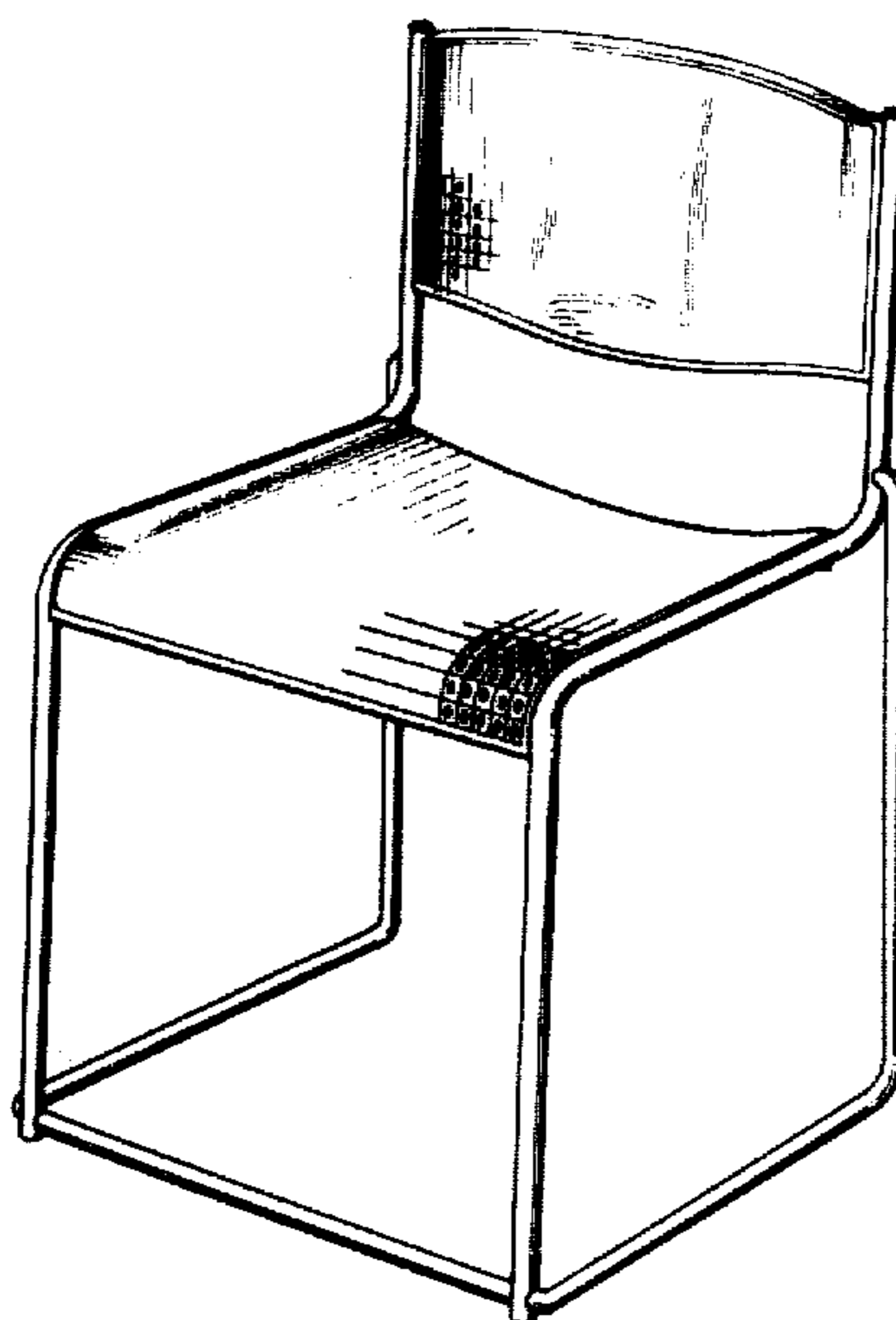

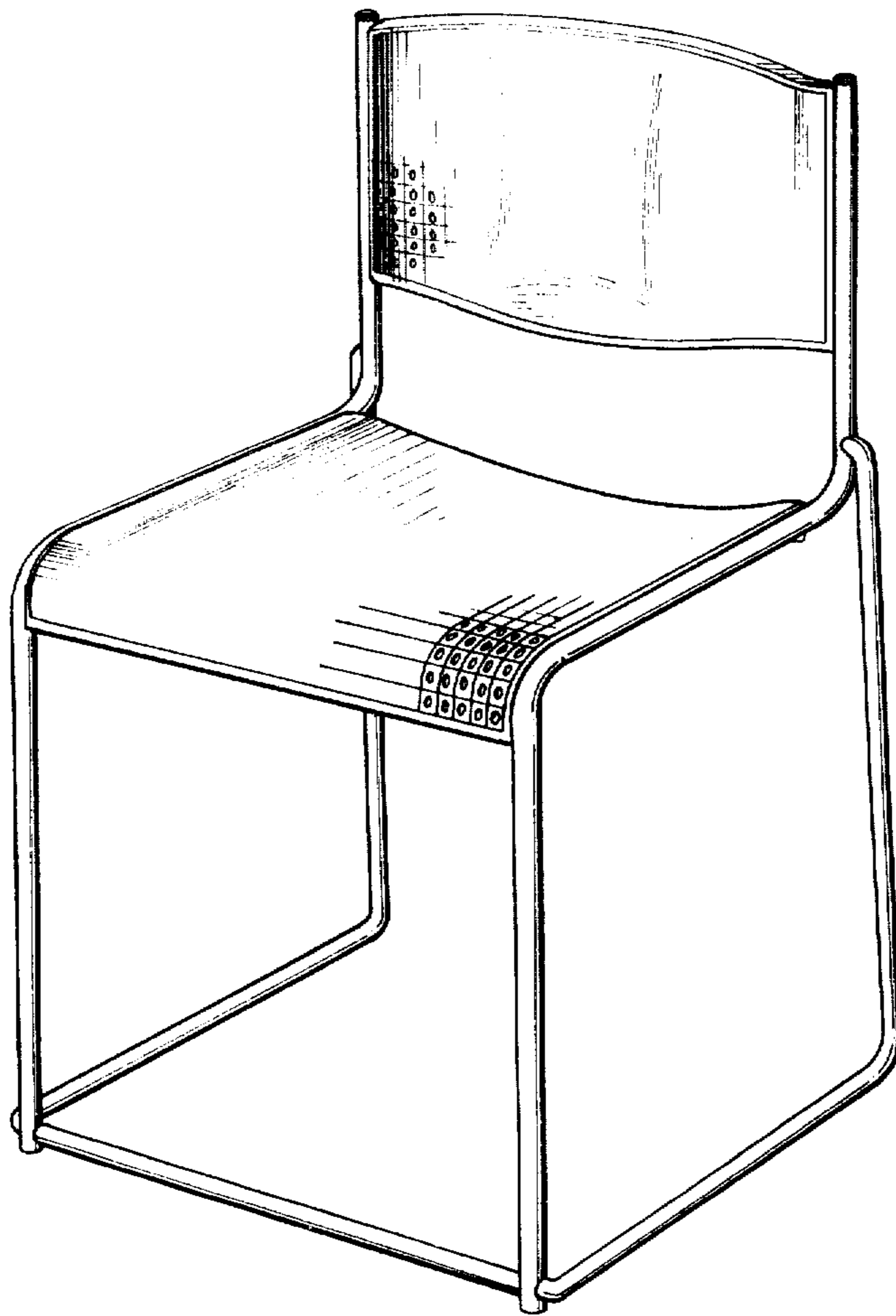

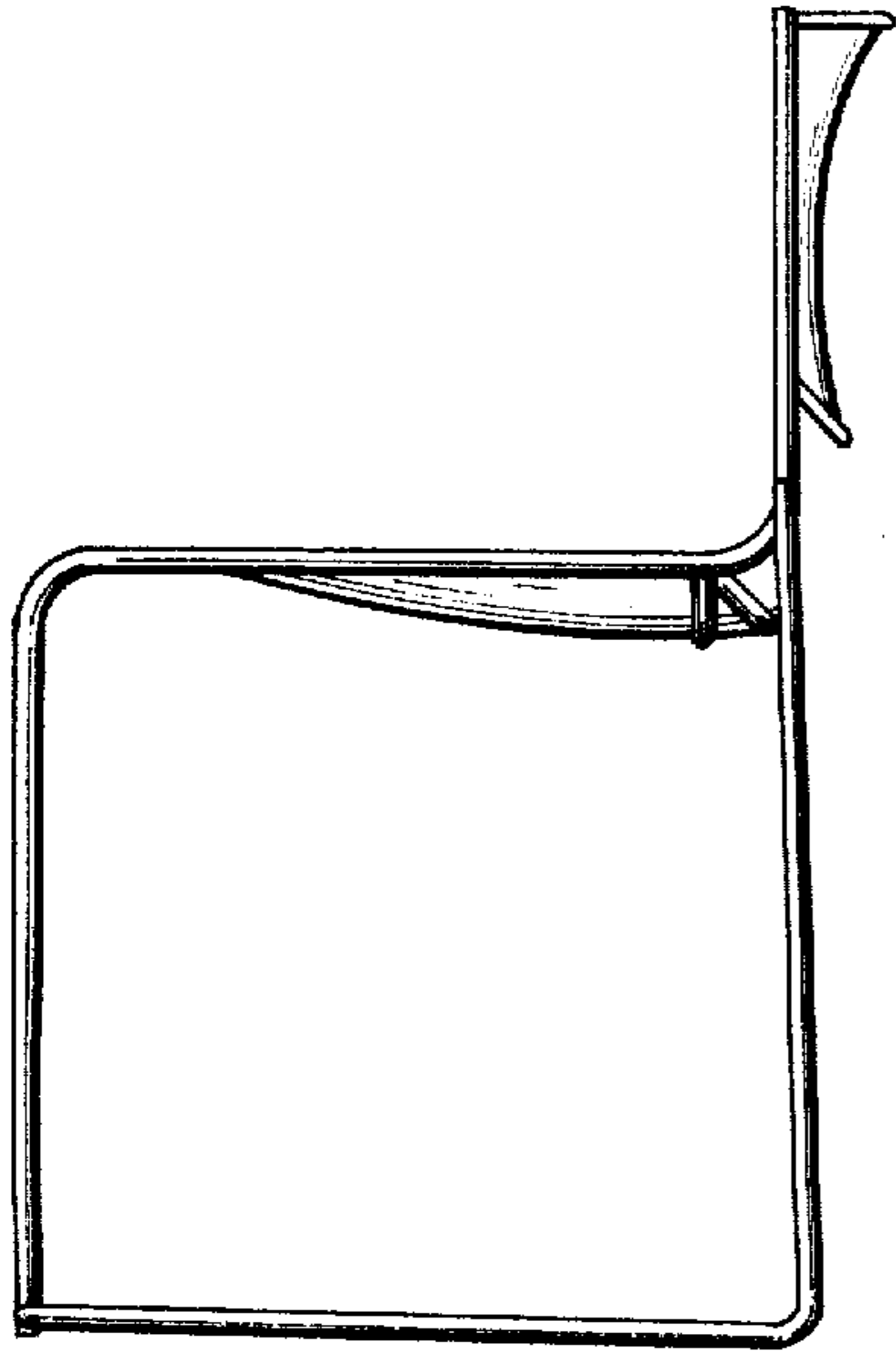

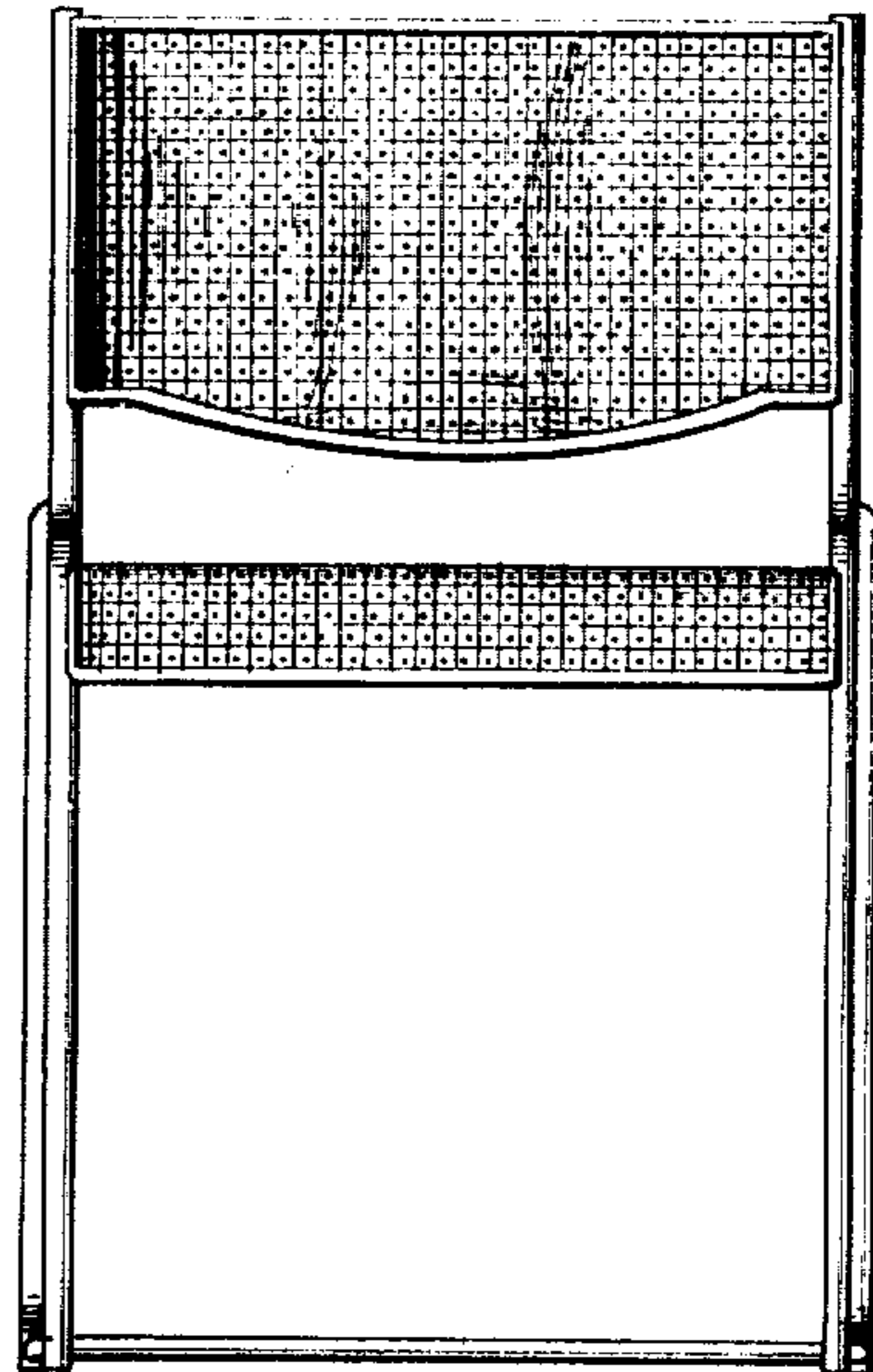

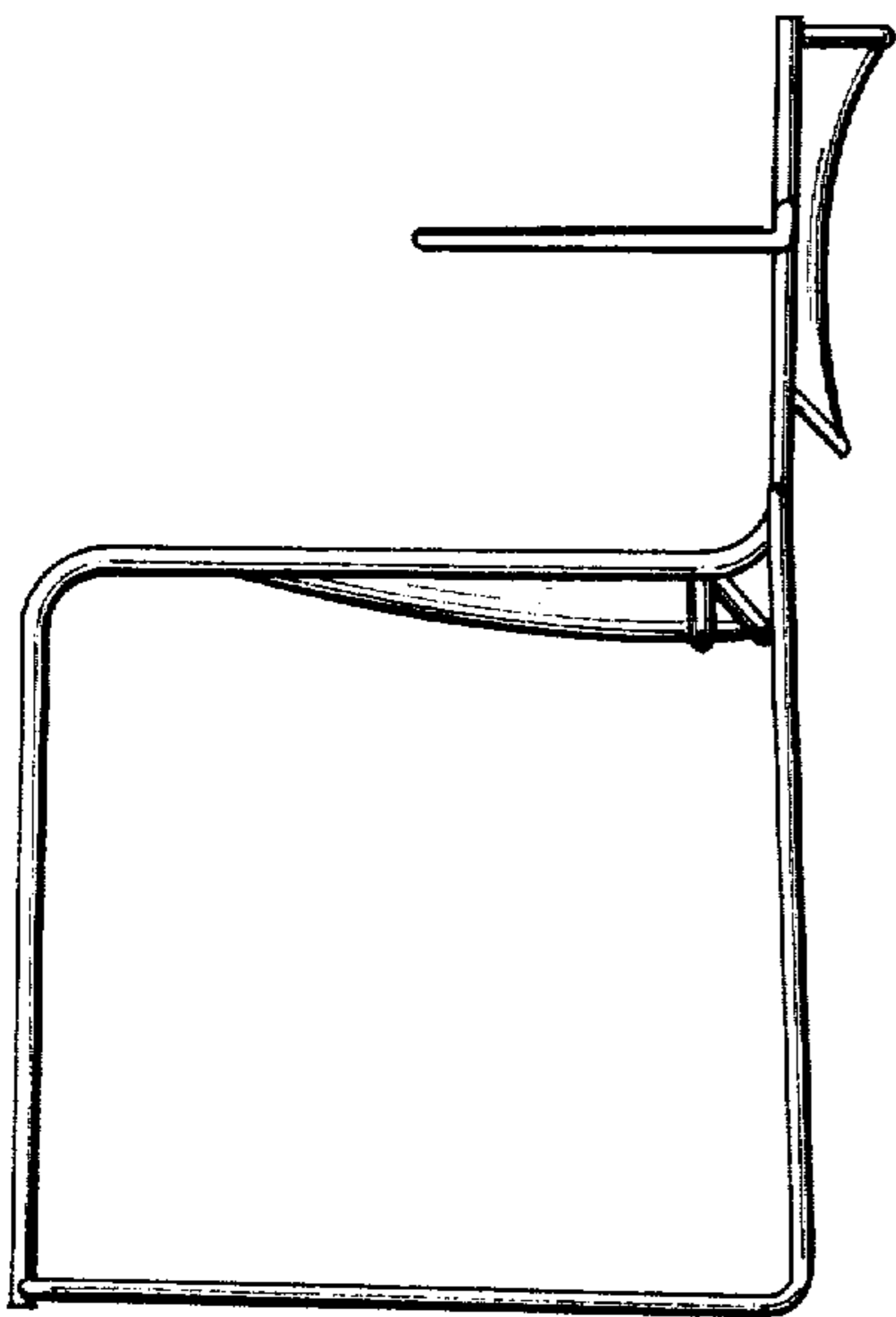
