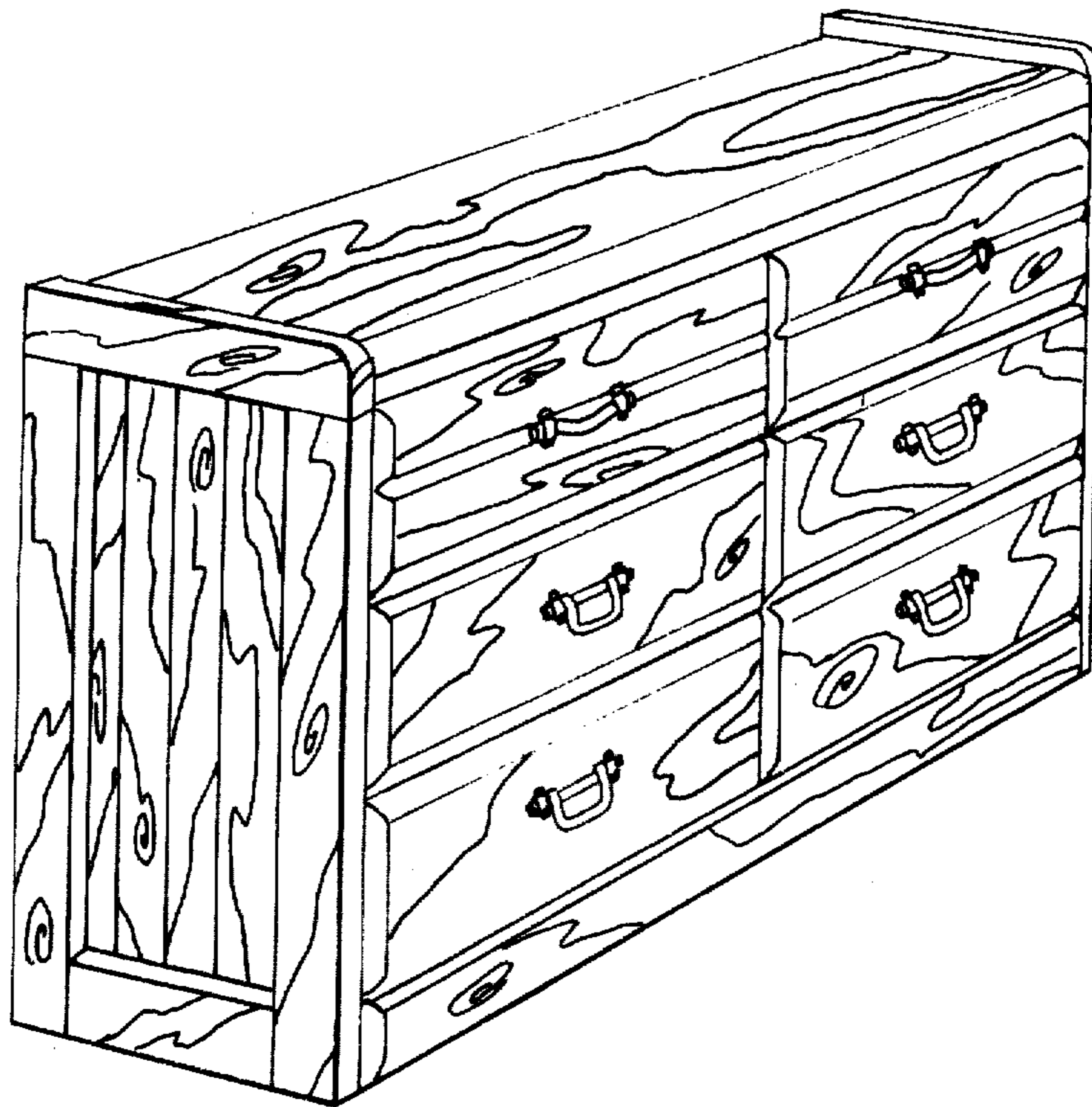

 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



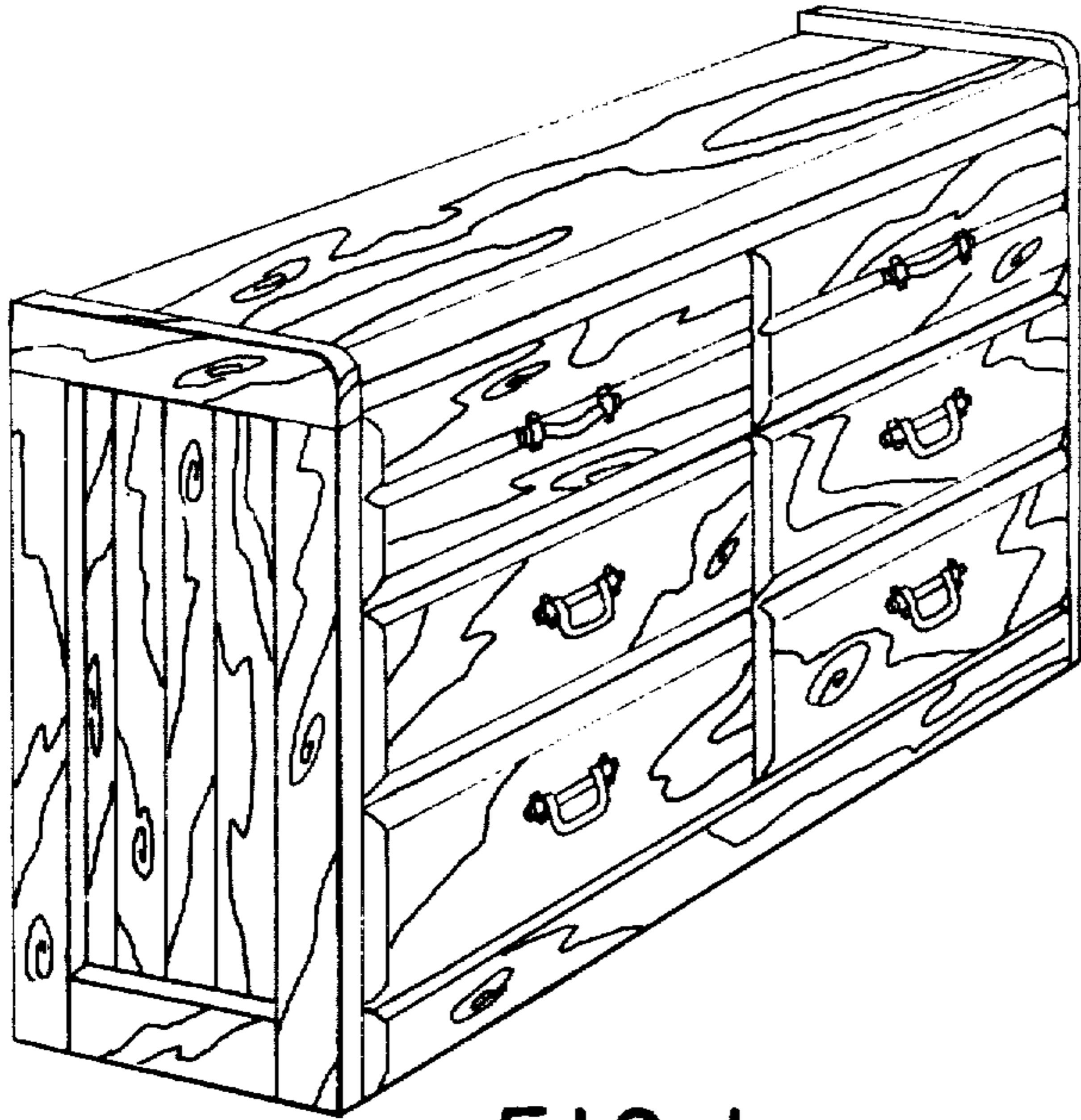

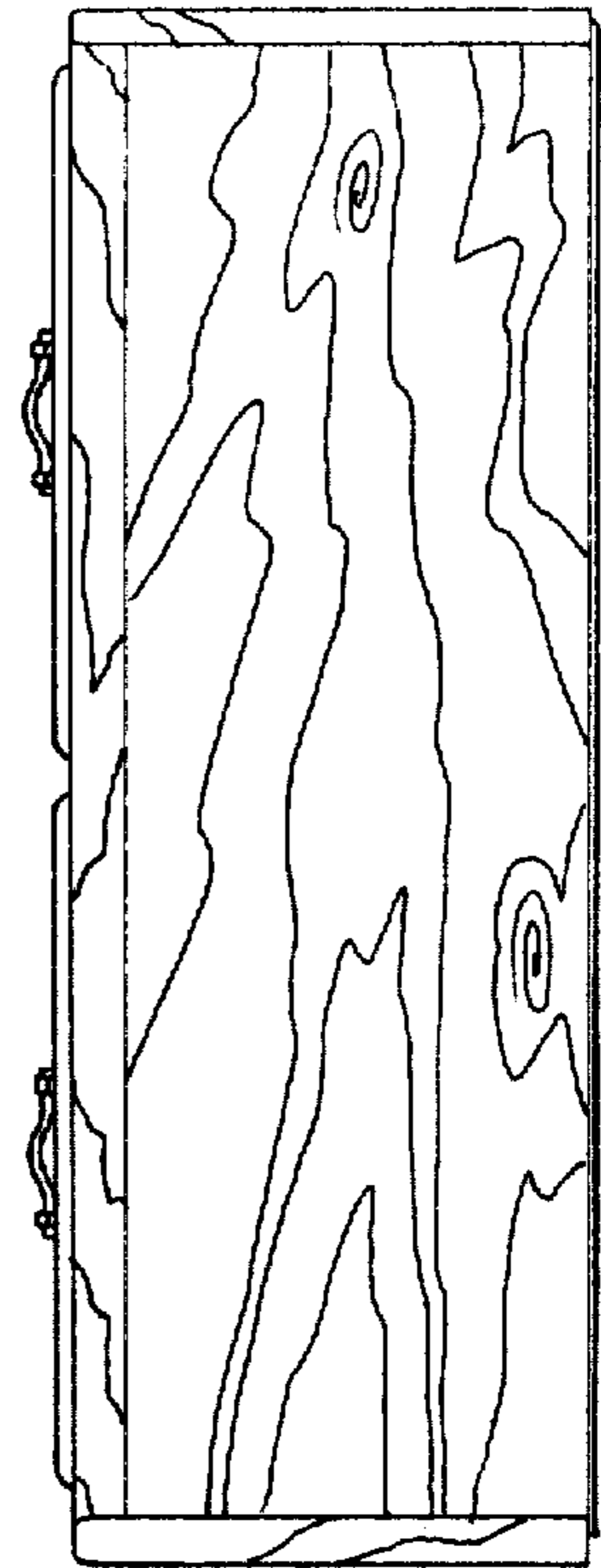

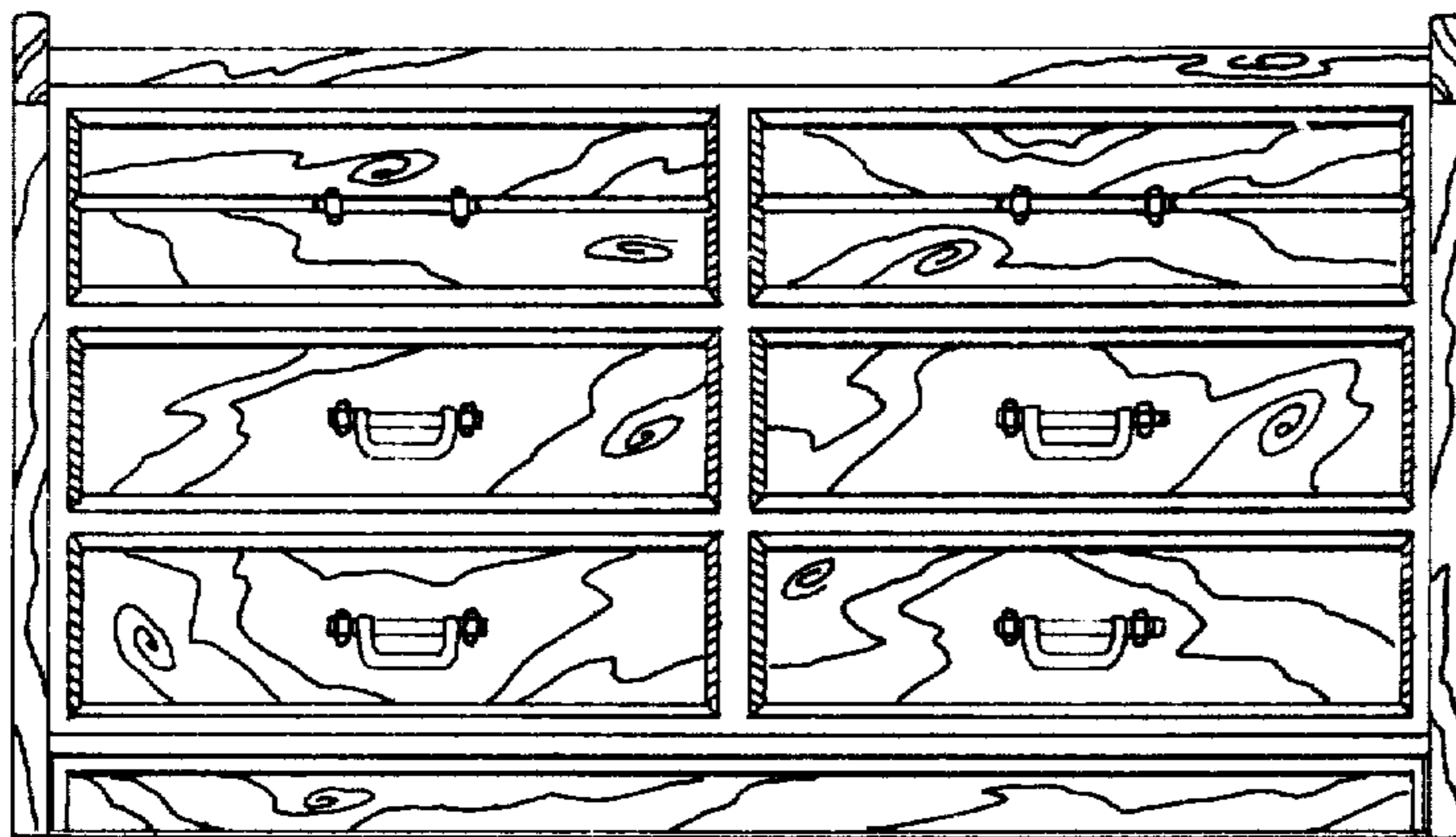

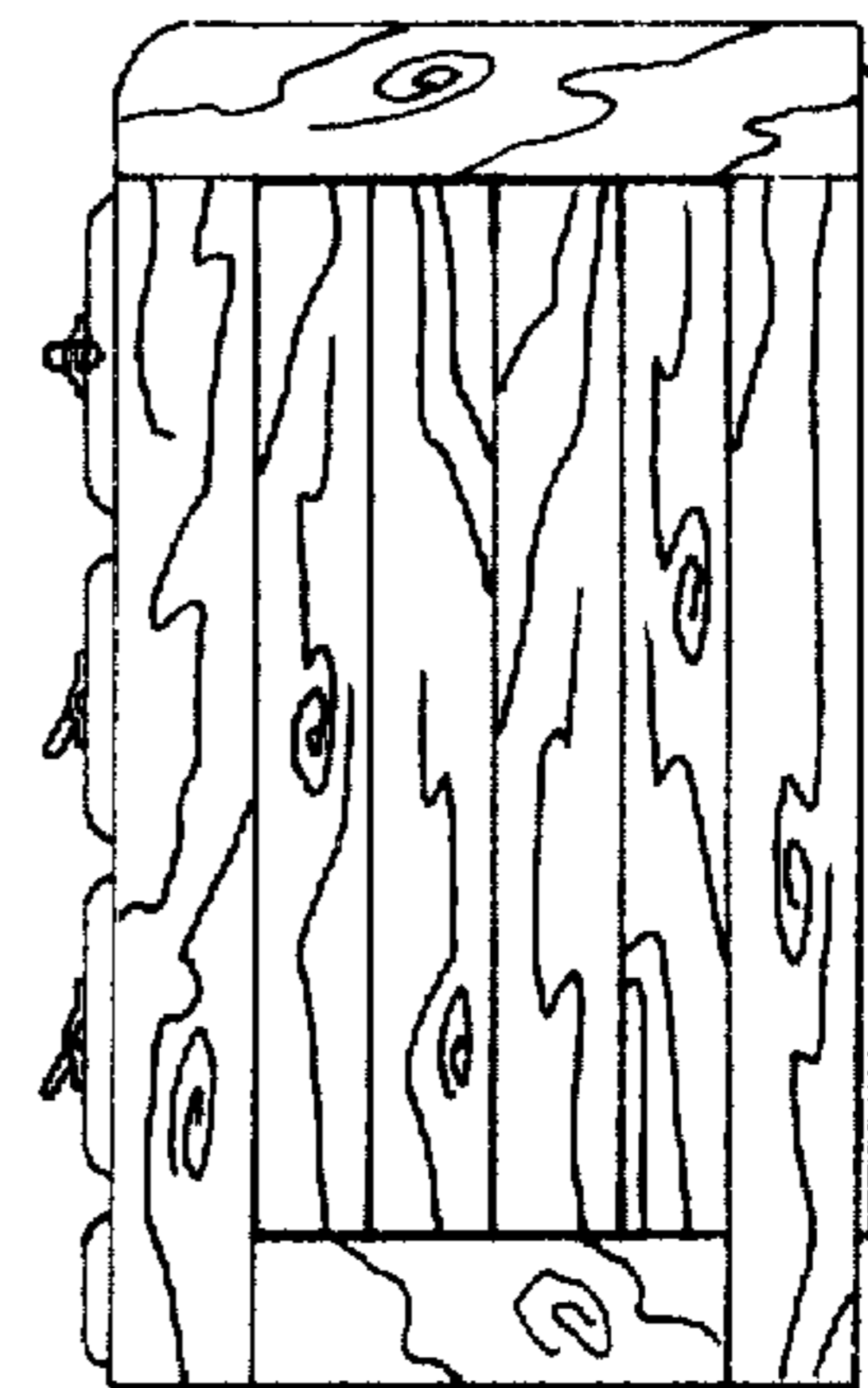

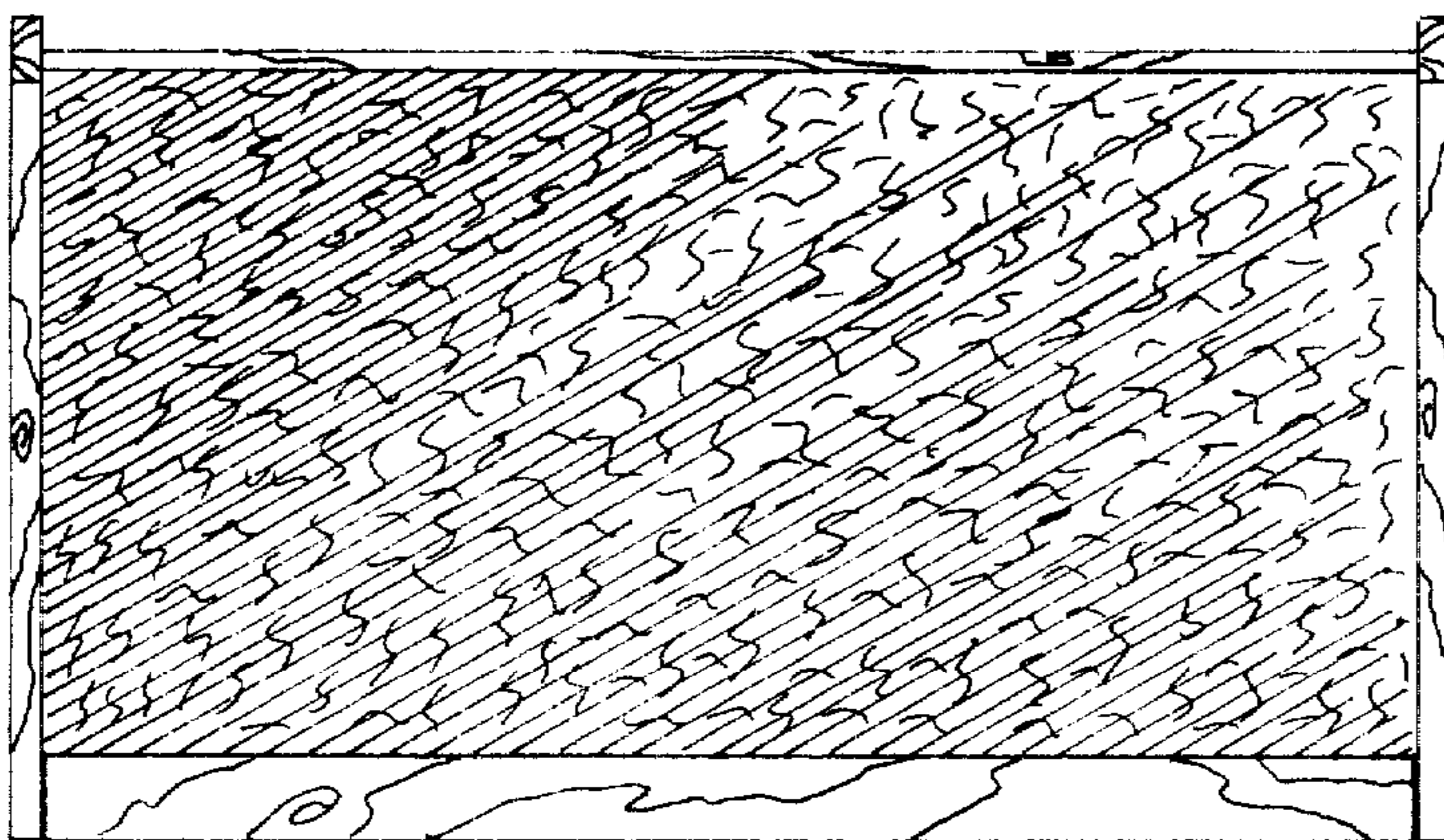
