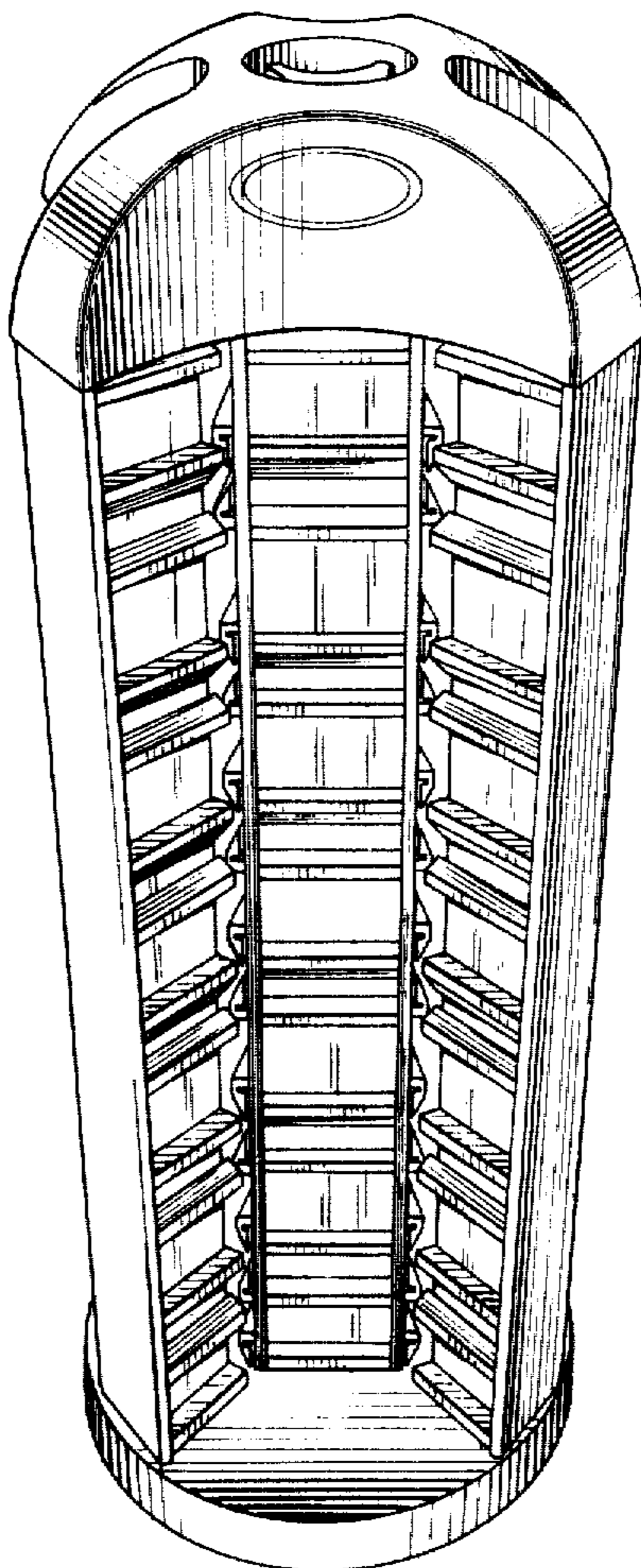

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a carded merchandise display unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a carded merchandise display unit showing our new design, the display cards removed for convenience of illustration;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a display card, the broken lines showing earrings being for illustrative purposes only; and
 FIG. 7 is a front perspective view, the broken lines showing earrings being for illustrative purposes only.



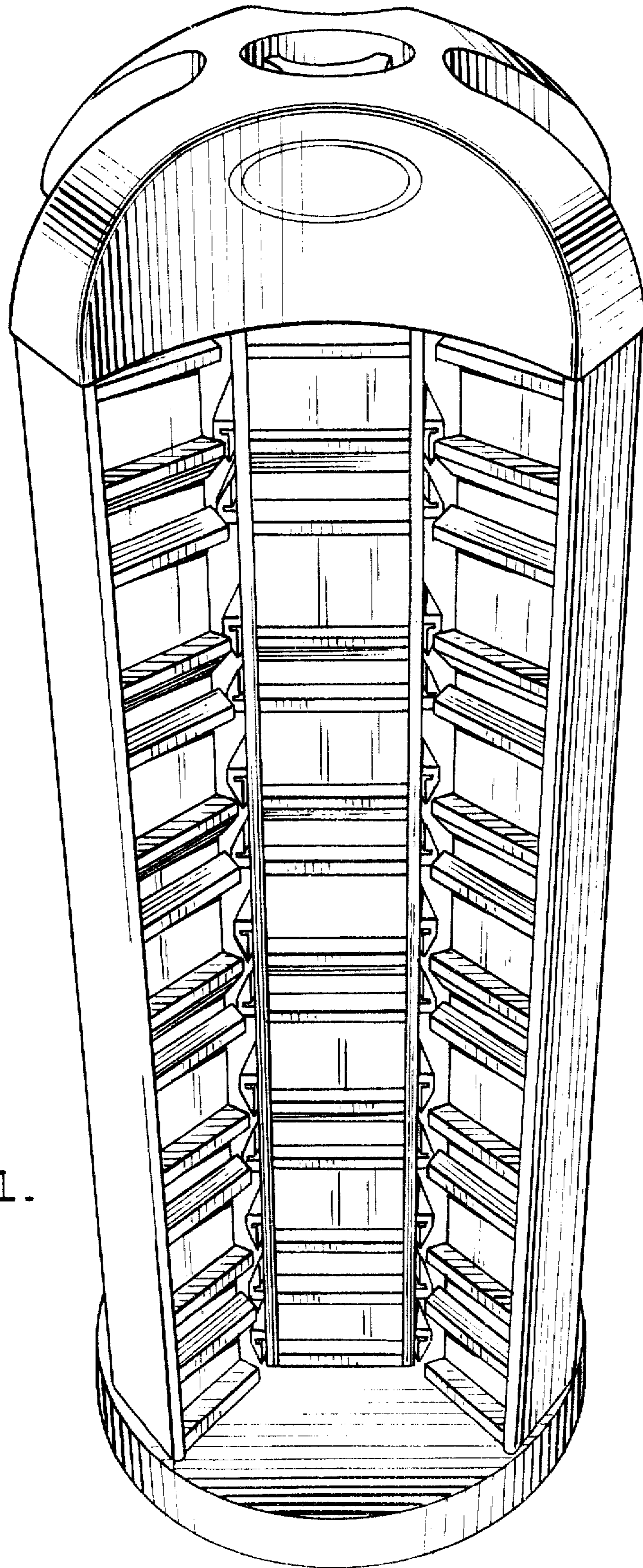

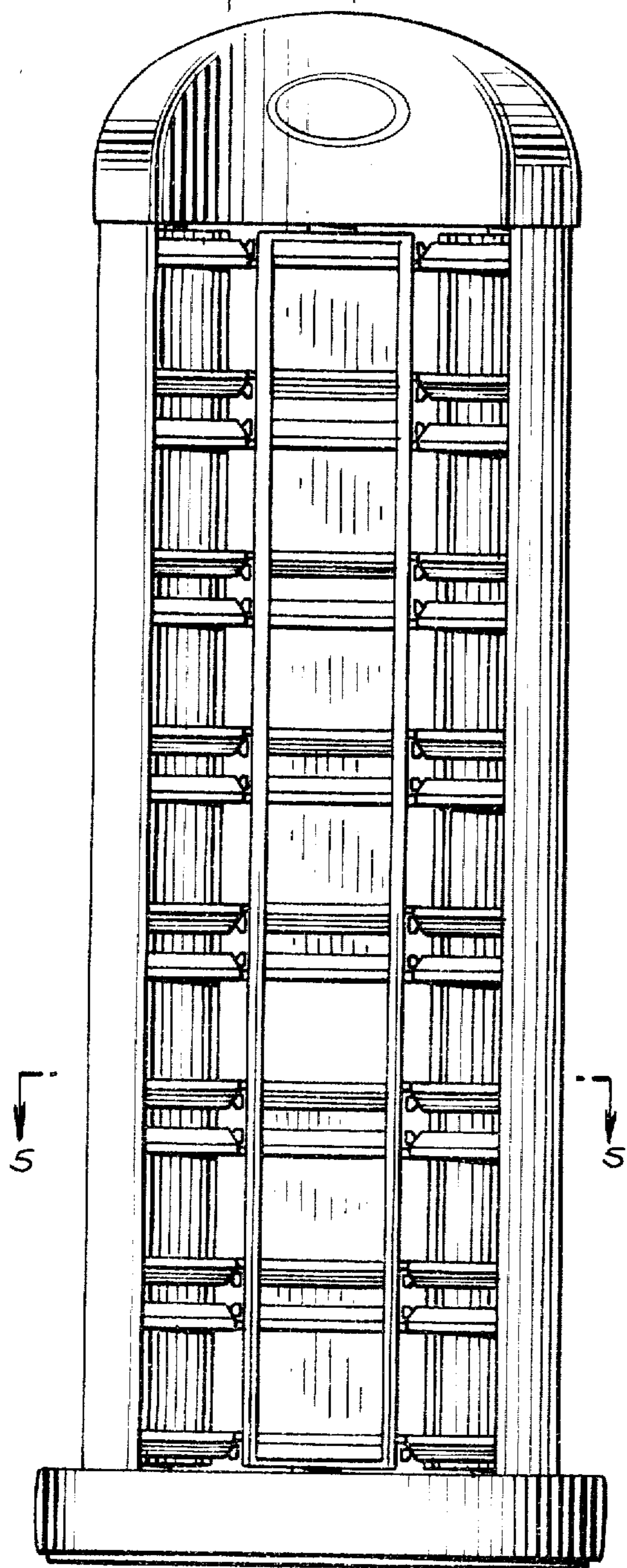
