The ornamental design for a stretch cord fastener, as shown and described.

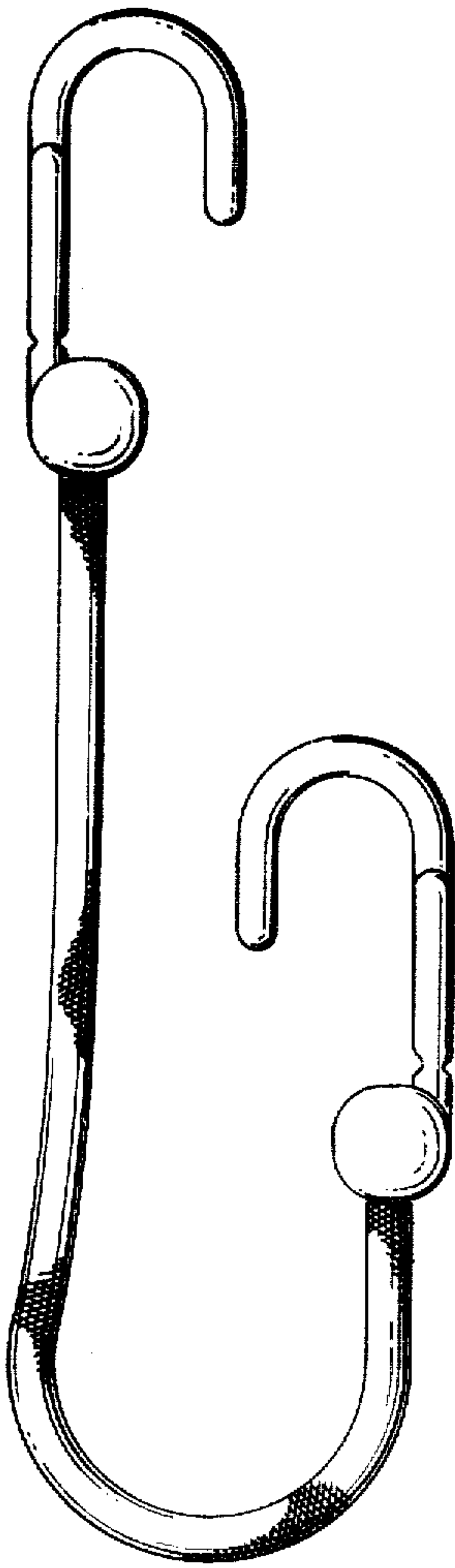
DESCRIPTION

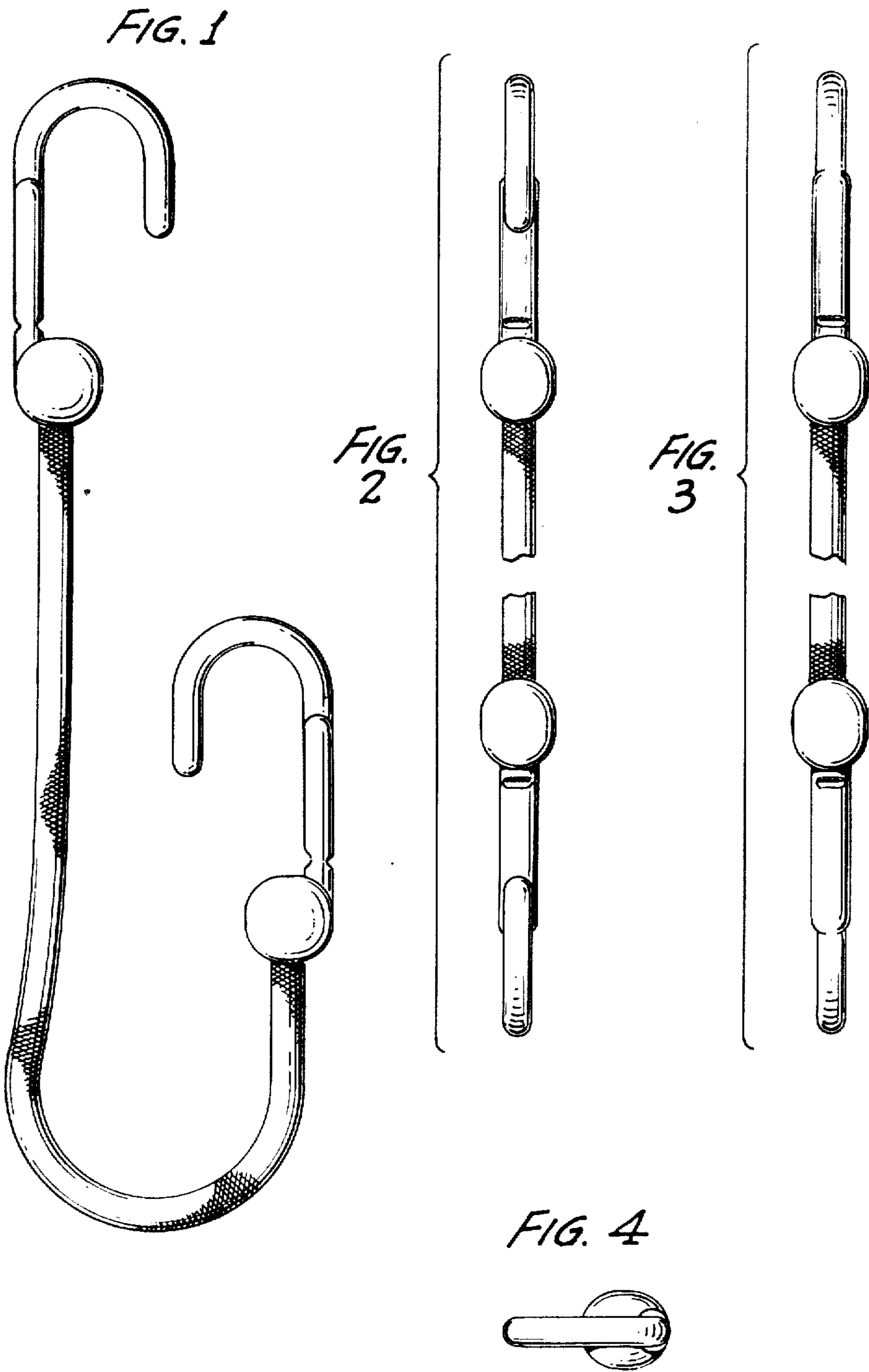
FIG. 1 is a side view of the stretch cord fastener showing my new design;
