CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lever, particularly for motorcycles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a lever, particularly for motorcycles showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof opposite to that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view thereof taken along line 7—7 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of a lever, particularly for motorcycles showing a second embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view opposite to that shown in FIG. 8;


FIG. 10 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 8;


FIG. 11 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 8;
