FIG. 1 is a port side view of the watercraft with the outboard motor shown in dotted lines. The starboard side is like the port side.

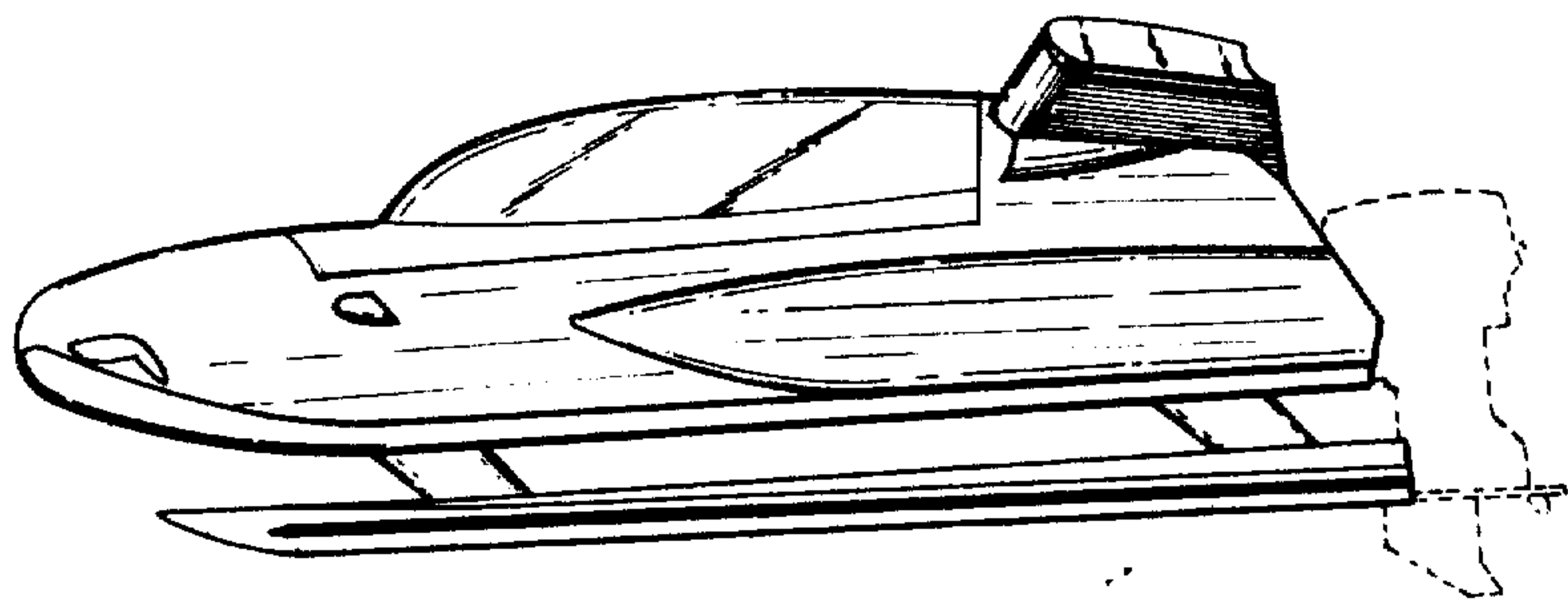
FIG. 2 is a frontal view of the watercraft of FIG. 1;

The dotted lines shown in the several views are disclosed for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claim.



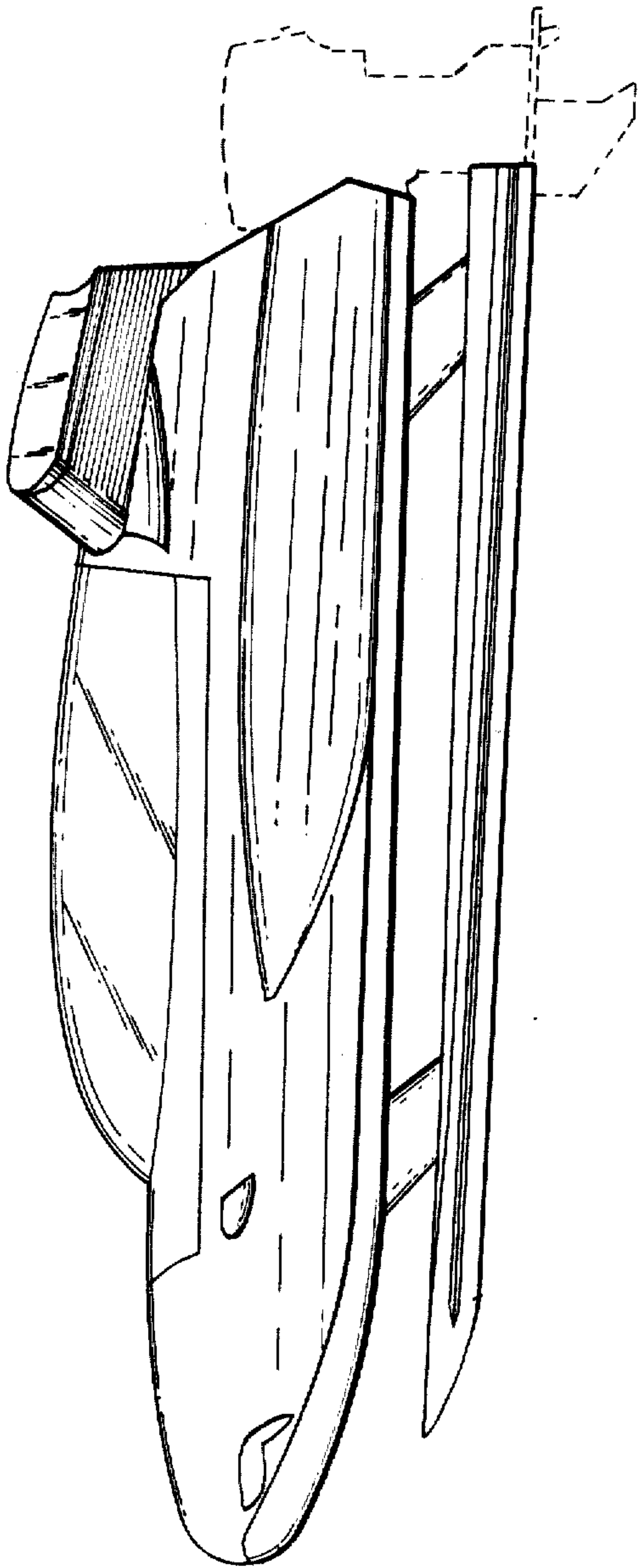

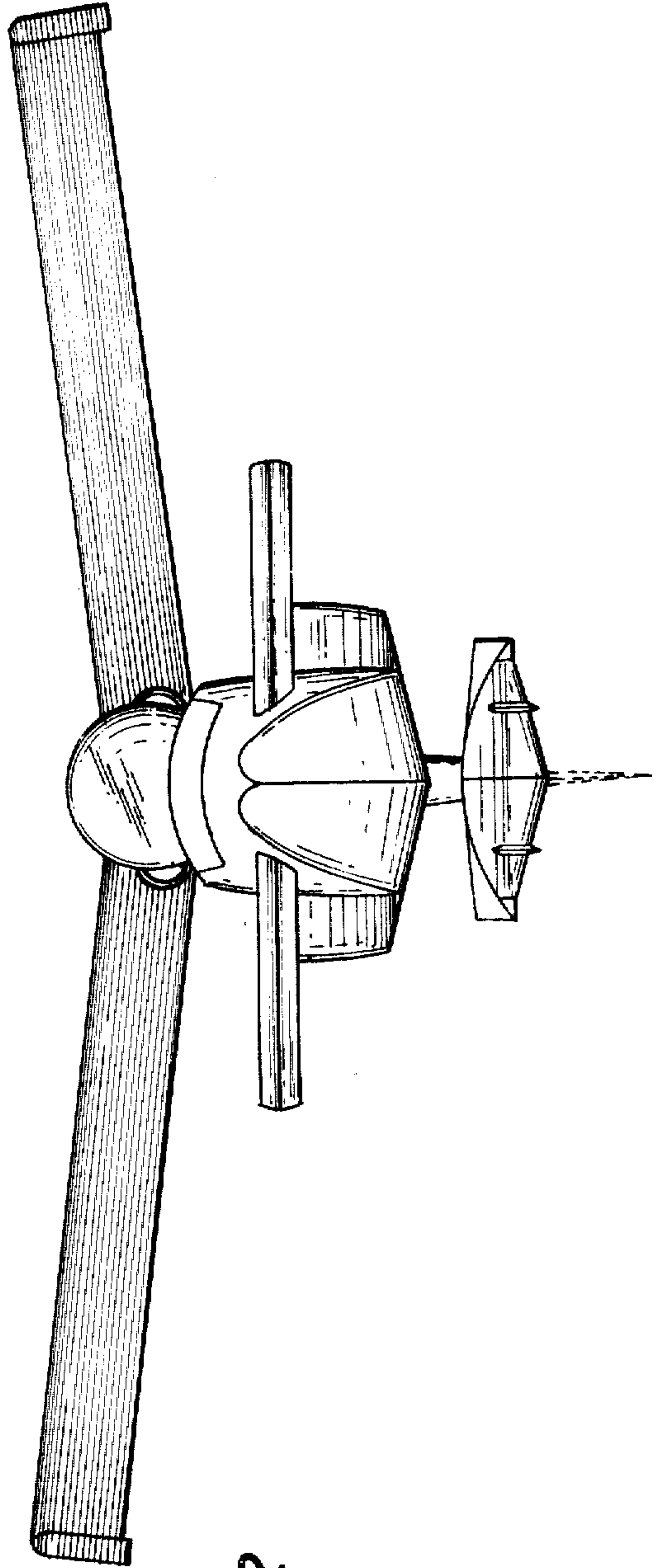

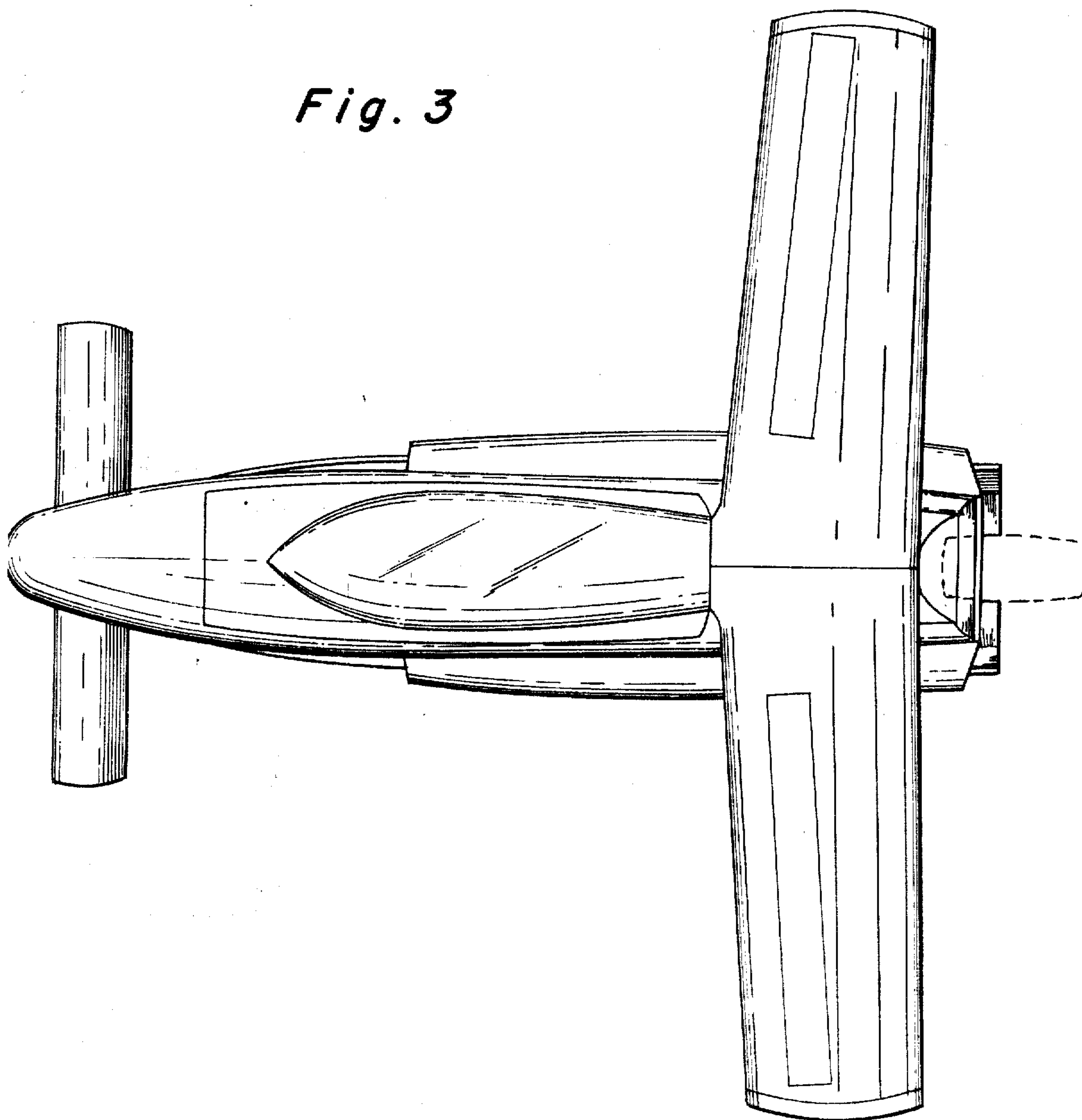

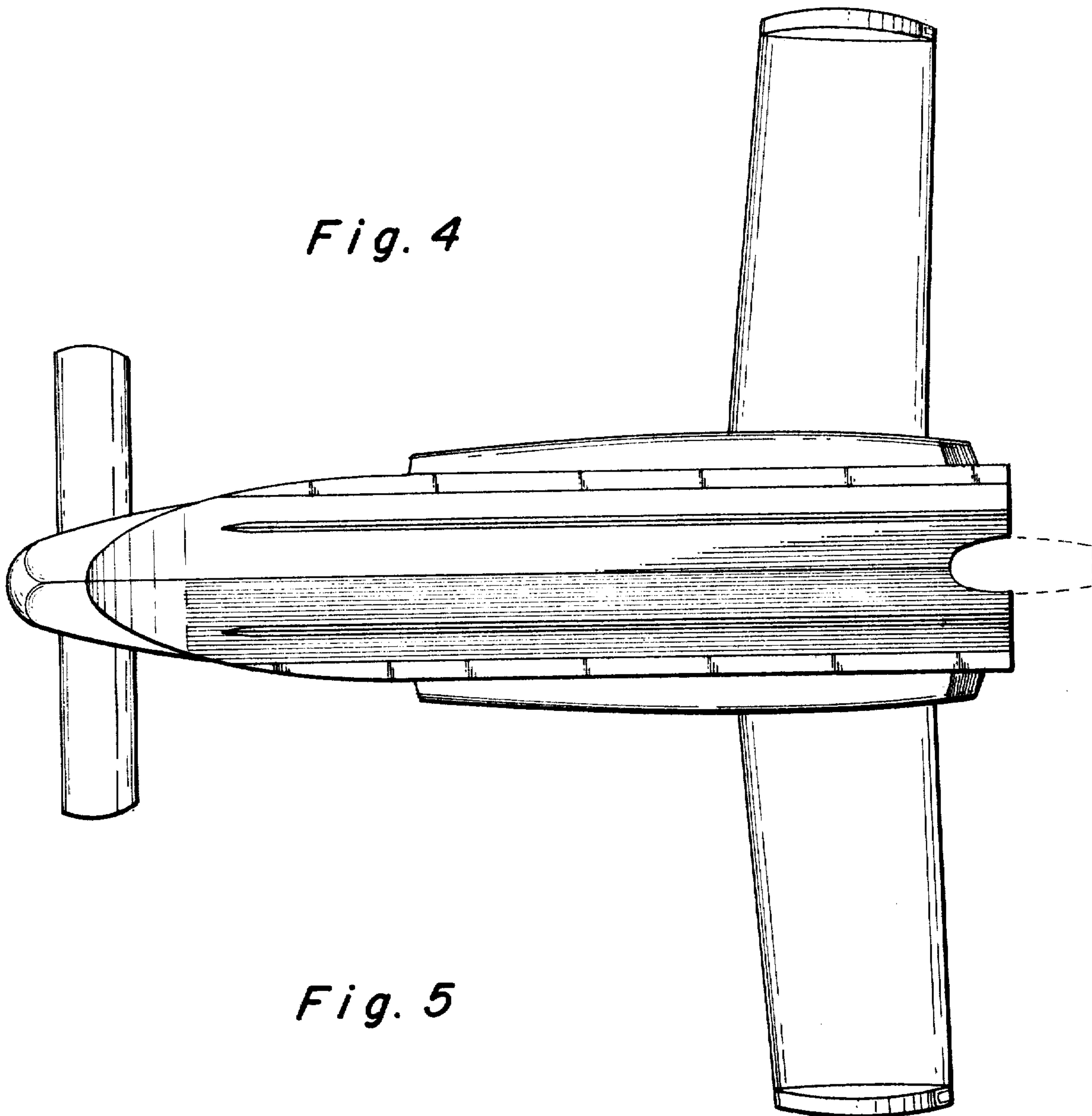
