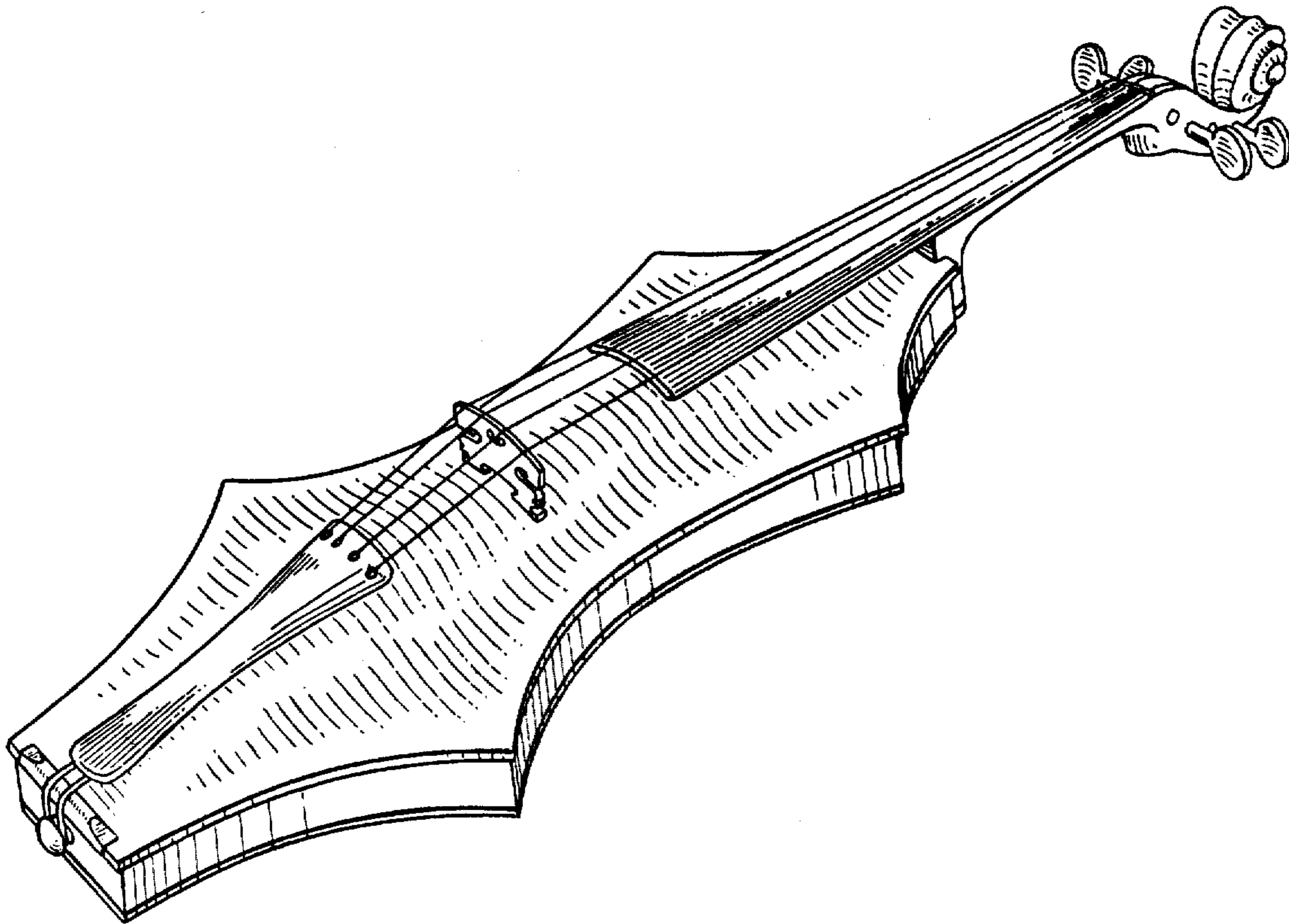

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view.



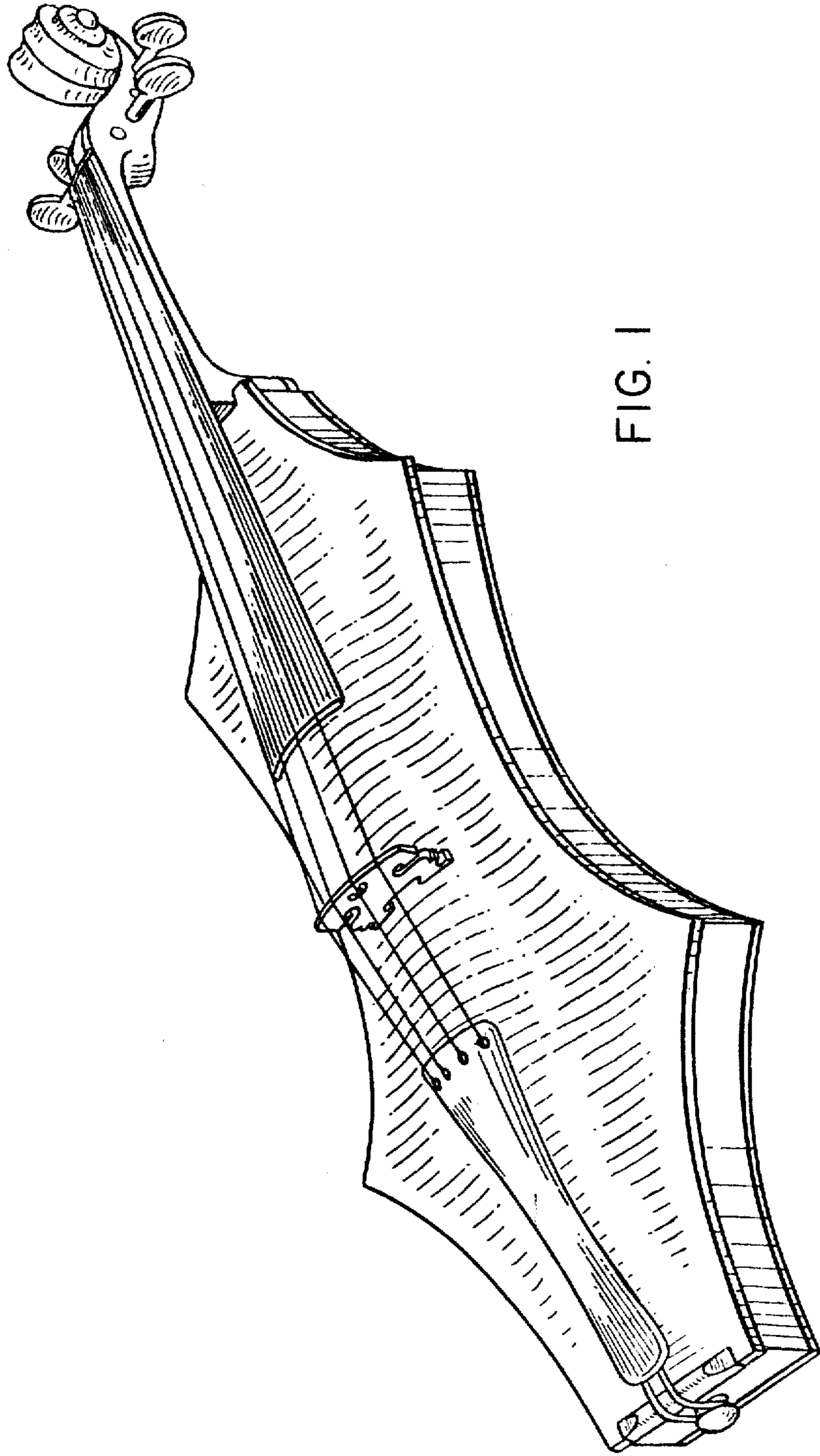

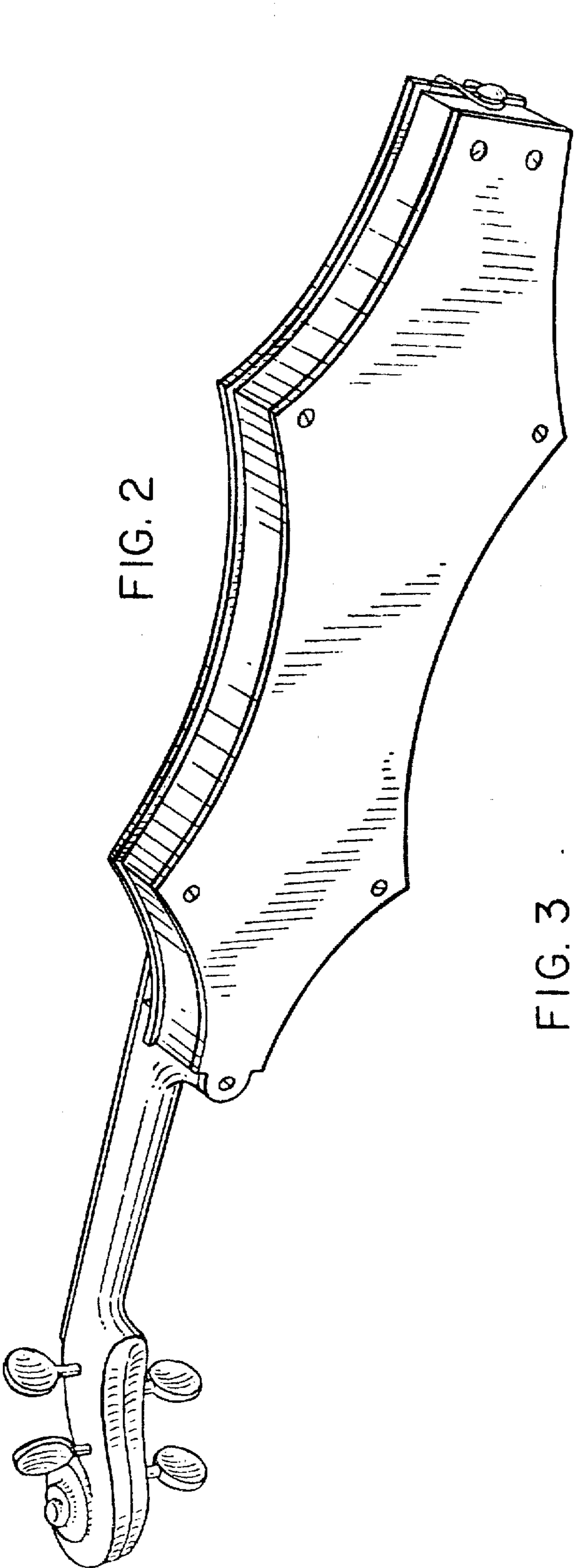
