CLAIM

The ornamental design for an anterior subperiosteal implant, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an anterior subperiosteal implant embodying the present design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the anterior subperiosteal implant shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the side of the anterior subperiosteal implant opposite the side shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and

FIG. 5 is a top plan view.

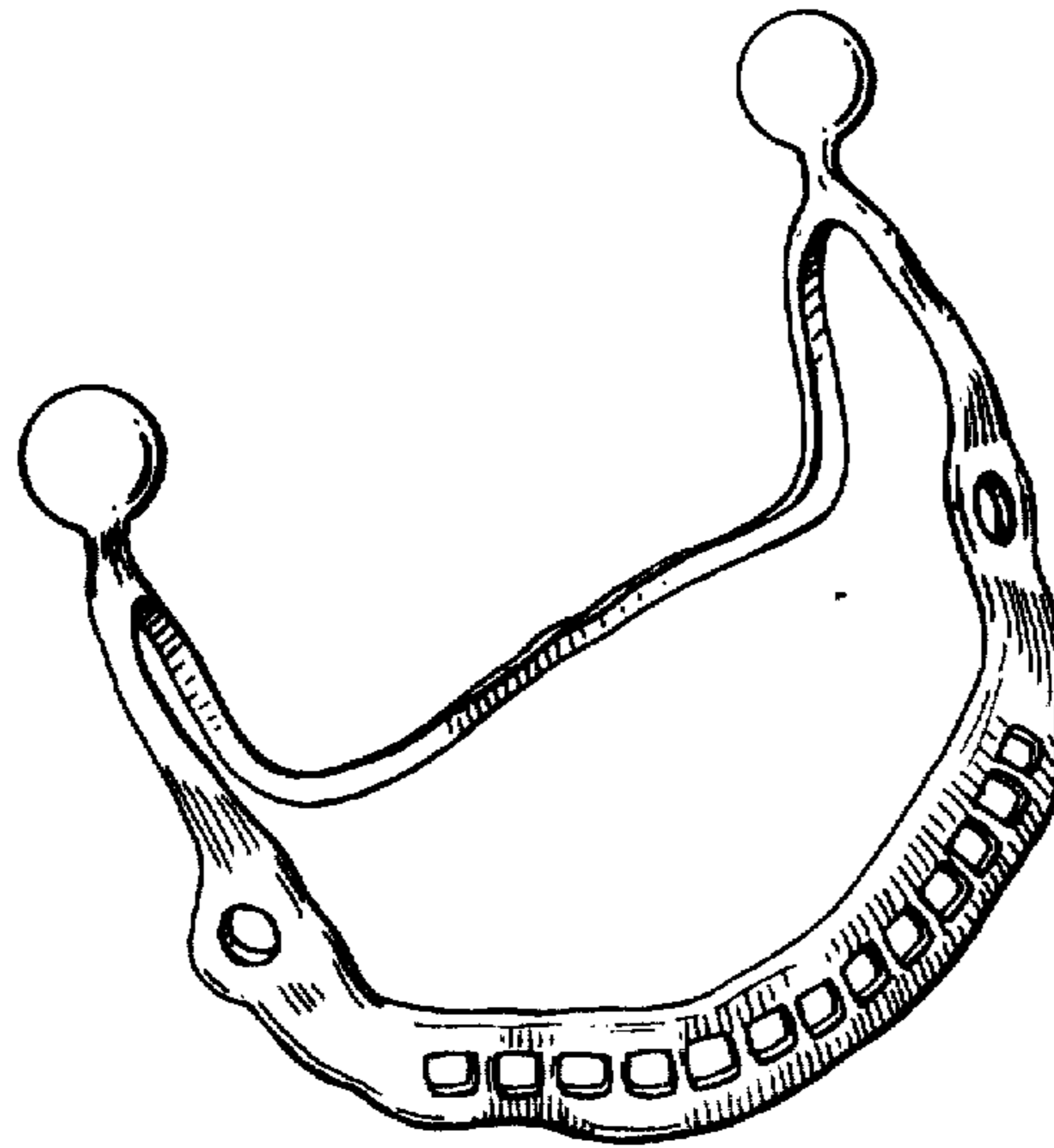

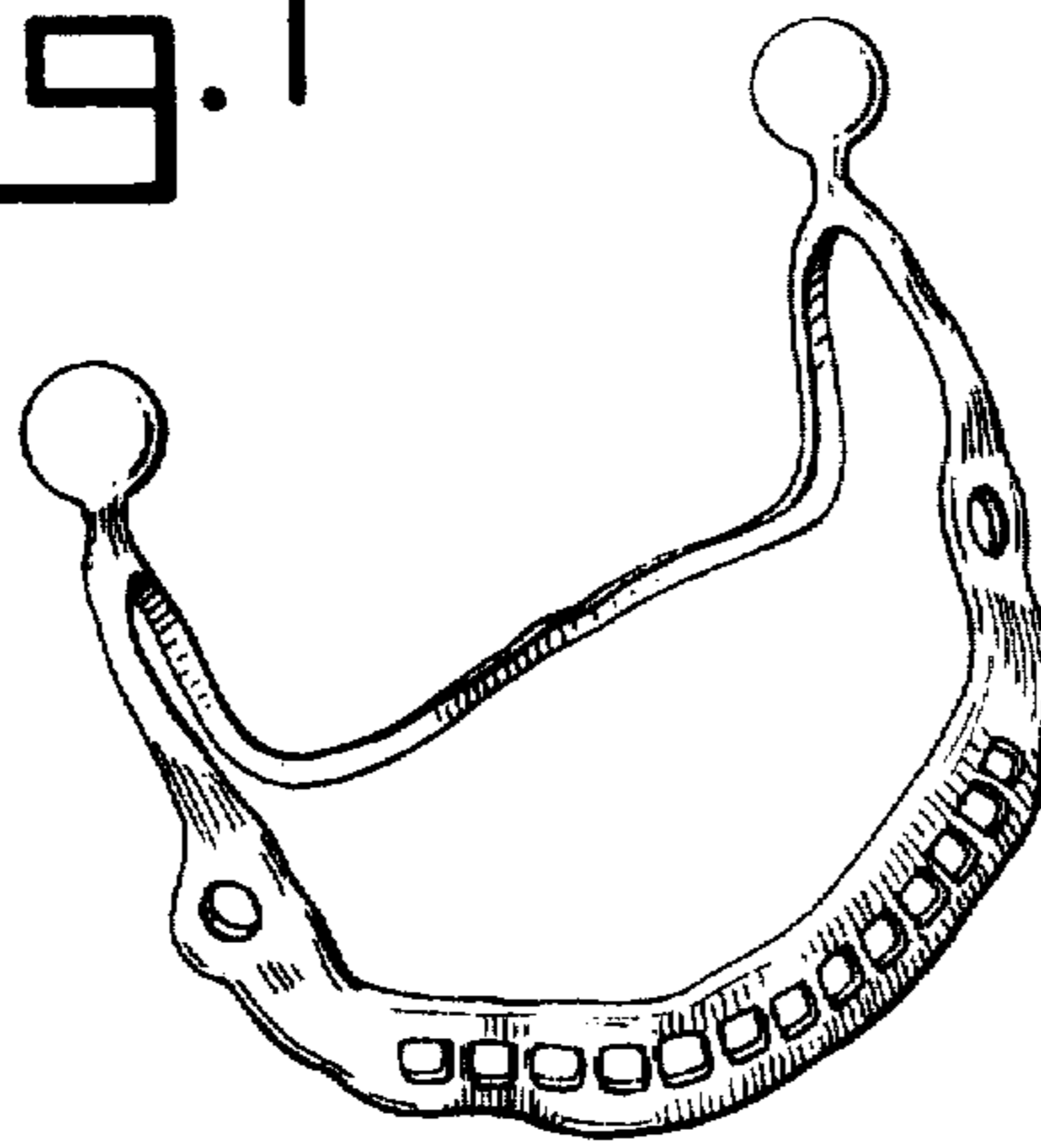

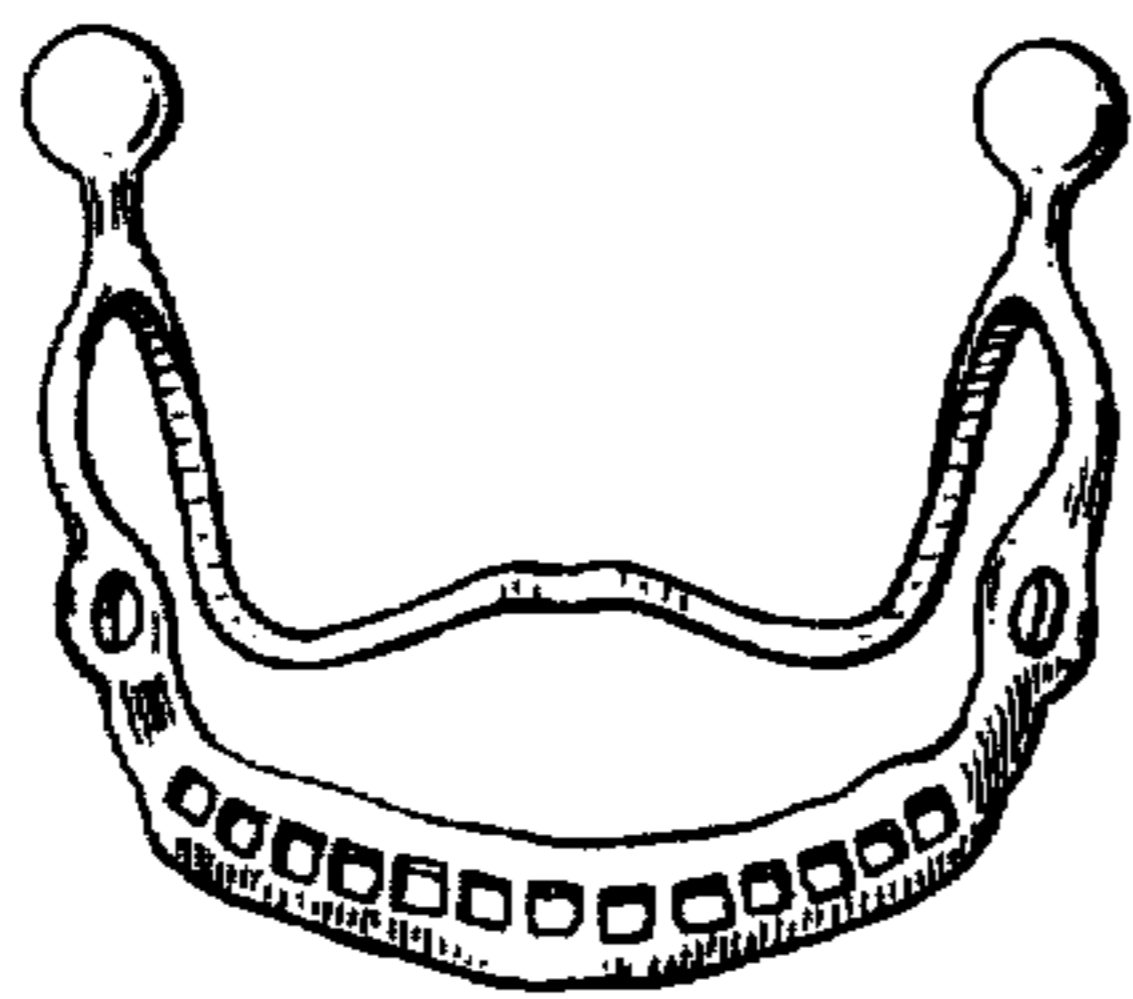

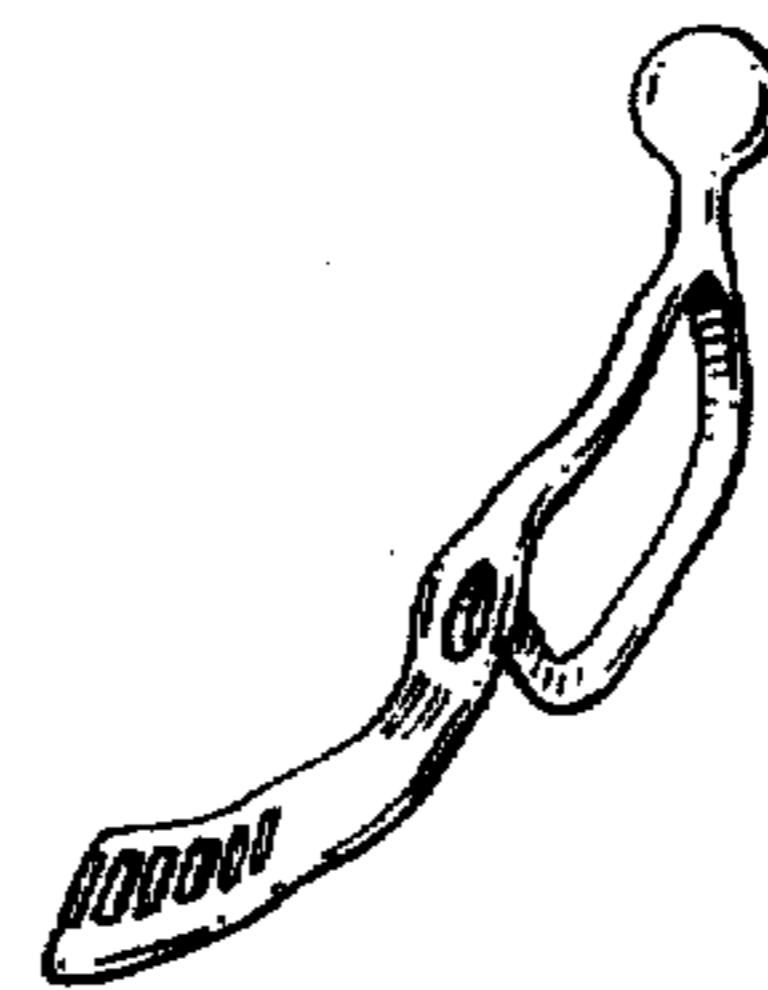

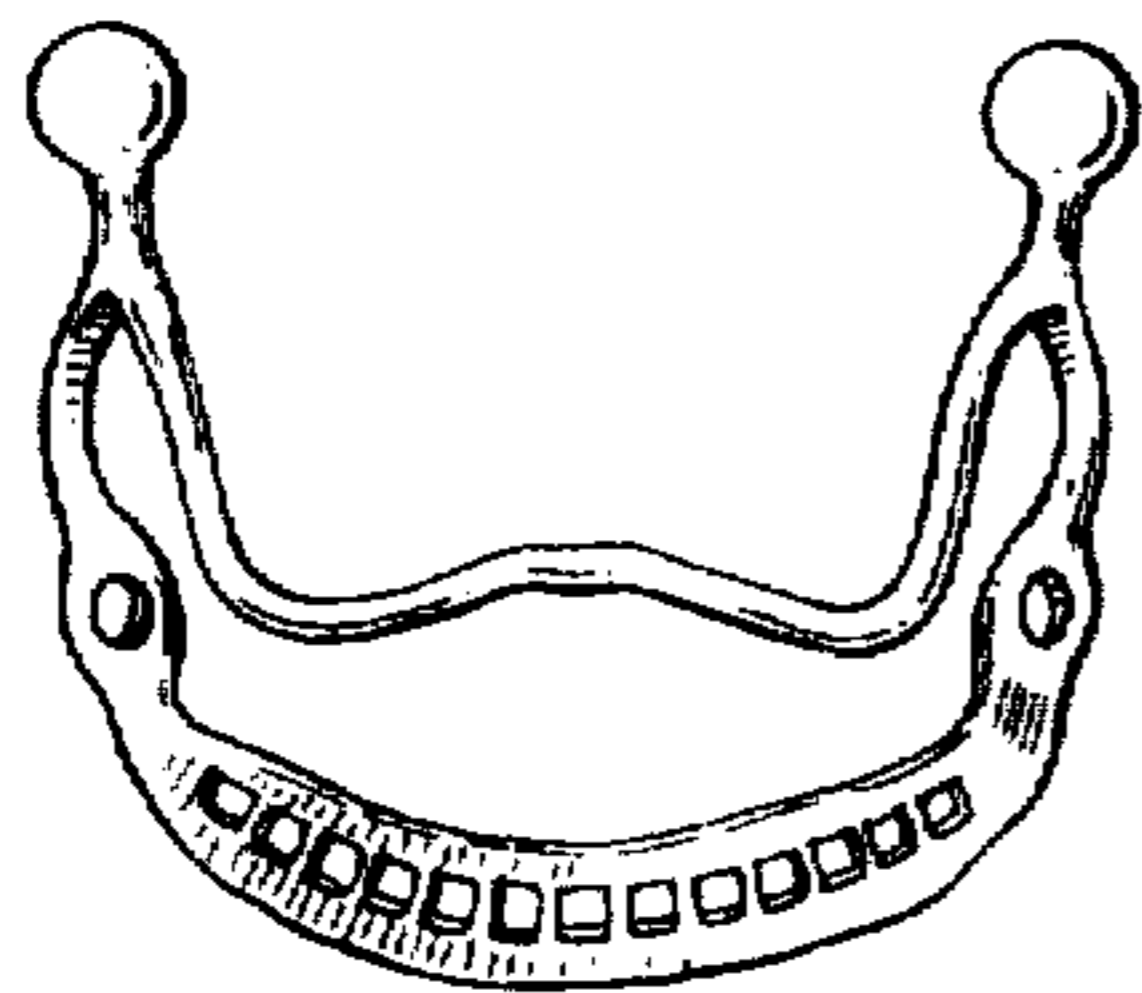
